Yeah, I know, not a big price or anything – hah! Still, I think the 3-1 on her is fair. She's one of two Casse entries and the other one, Janis Joplin, is likely to get all the attention, being multiple G3P. That typed, Janis is trying Tapeta for the first time, and while she may well take to it, not willing to endorse while favored. Not Negotiable, meanwhile, is proven on synthetic and has enough speed to make the rail draw not a detriment. She nearly wired on debut at Turfway Park. Just got caught on the wire to lose by a nose by French import Sixth Street who was making her 3yo debut after running well against MdSpWt competition on the NY circuit on grass. In start two, Not Negotiable had an even tougher field to contest. That was a much more quickly run race, with Cami Cat going 21 and 4 and 44 and 3 before folding out. She then came back to score a Md30 on the front end and by 4-1/2 lengths – put up a 72 Beyer. Winner of the March 11th start, She's On the Rocks, next ran 4th in the G2 Beaumont. Runner-up, American Heights, was a next out winner at Turfway – earned a 77. On a pedigree note, Not Negotiable is a ½ sister to multiple Woodbine stakes winner Lorena.
