NOTES

- Some levies fund regulatory expenses while the provincial Horse Improvement Program levy, net of oversight costs, is returned to various industry stakeholders. WE contributes a larger share of levies than it receives, resulting in it subsidizing the Canadian racing industry.
- Gross purses paid from all sources provide revenue to owners of horses who, in turn pay their agriculture-related expenses such as farm costs, labour costs, transportation, feed, blacksmiths, veterinarians, trainers, jockeys & drivers.
