- Dunn finished fifth in last year's event with Rockyroad Hanover
- Dunn will be driving Ario Hanover for the first time in the final

- Gingras became the 12th driver to have 10+ appearances in the Cup when he drove Southwind Gendry in last year's race.
- Dam Im With Her raced for trainer/driver MacDonell in 2017. Beach Glass is her first foal.
- Beach Glass is the only homebred in this year's race.

- Home track for Twaddle and driver Mike Wilder is The Meadows (near Pittsburgh, PA)
- Wilder has won over 8,000 races and driven the winners of \$72M during his career
- Twaddle and Wilder will be making their first Cup appearance. Pair competed with Fourver Boy in last year's Metro Pace, finishing third.

- Driver Louis-Philippe Roy is a two-time Canadian Driver of the Year (2018, 2019)
- Roy drove Frozen Hanover for the first time in the Somebeachsomewhere Stakes on June 4

- MacDonald is the reigning Canadian Driver of the Year and last season's leading driver at Woodbine
- MacDonald drove Kolby Two Step for the first time in the Somebeachsomewhere Stakes

- Trainer Jake Leamon will send out his first Cup starter
- Driver Tetrick has finished 4th or better in each of his last seven Cup drives, including wins in '13 and '15

- Night Hawk is the first foal out of Somebeachsomewhere mare Night Music.
- Night Hawk won both of his starts as a two-year-old. Brown shut down the son of Betting Line due to a sore cannon bone in his left hind ankle.
- Night Hawk is currently this season's fastest three-year-old, holding a mark of 1:48.4.

- Trainer Noel Daley will be making his official Cup debut
- Daley trained 2010 Cup finalist All Speed Hanover, however, Daley sent the horse to trainer Mike Vanderkemp for the Cup. He finished 10th in the final after winning his elimination
- Driver Todd McCarthy is making his Cup debut in just his third season racing in North America
- McCarthy followed the lead of his older brother Andy and relocated to America from Australia in the second-half of 2020
- McCarthy scored his first major Woodbine stakes win in last year's Canadian Pacing Derby with Allywag Hanover

- Driver Jody Jamieson has won the Cup twice (2007 with Tell All and 2011 with Up The Credit)
- Jamieson's first Cup drive was in 2006 with the Dean trained Doonbeg
