

#### IMPORTANT HORSEPEOPLE

## Information

#### **AGCO LICENSING**

Any individual or business actively involved in horse racing must be licensed by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) in order to participate in racing in the province. This includes owners of race horses, trainers, drivers, grooms, anyone requiring access to the backstretch or paddock of the racetrack.

All horse racing-related licensing transactions should be completed online at www.agco.ca/iAGCO.

If you need assistance, you can email racinglicensing@agco.ca to connect with a Licensing Agent. If you require an online access code to set up an account, contact AGCO Customer service at 416-326-8700 or toll free in Ontario at 1-800-522-2876. Please note that the AGCO no longer accepts cash or cheques. Payment should be made by Visa, MasterCard, Interac Online, Visa Debit or MasterCard Debit. #### STANDARDBRED CANADA MEMBERSHIP

- Trainers and drivers must be Standardbred Canada members in order to participate
- All current USTA owners are valid if USTA membership is current. If not, then full Standardbred Canada membership is required. Online forms can be found on their website at www.standardbredcanada.ca

#### **ACCESS CARDS**

Access Cards are used as verification of identification and license status at Woodbine Entertainment. They are also used, by applicable licensees, to gain access to the secure areas of racetrack facilities. Access Cards require a photo of the licensee to be taken and are only issued to licensees in person. You can have your photo taken and Access Card issued by Woodbine Entertainment Security in their office located in the Woodbine Mohawk Park paddock.

What should I bring with me to complete the Access Card application process?.

- Personal details and information to complete the application form(s), including birthdate, address and emergency contact information.
- Picture Identification (e.g. Ontario Drivers License).
- Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) License
- Signed Access Waiver Rights form





#### RETENTION PROGRAM

Horses competing in the 2025 Breeders Crown will be required to participate in 24-hour retention for the eliminations and finals. Horses must report to their designated area by 11:00pm the day before they are scheduled to race.

#### **RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

- a. It shall be the responsibility of the trainer to have the horses under his or her care, which are programmed to Race, signed into the retention area at the time prescribed by the Racing Secretary.
- The retention area will have restricted access and will be monitored by security at all times when any horse or horses are stabled in the retention area.
- c. Responsibility for the Applicant's horse while stabled in the retention area shall remain solely with the Applicant. In no event shall WEG assume any responsibility or liability for the Applicant's horse.
- d. All horses must wear halters while in a stall in the retention area.
- e. Horses reported late to the retention area may be scratched by the AGCO Official in charge.



- f. If required, all horses will be transferred to the paddock in a convoy with a Security Guard and an AGCO Official may assist. The groom or trainer is not permitted to ride in the trailer with the horse unless it is a pre-arranged carrier with the Security Guard who is acting as escort and who is present inside the trailer.
- g. Horses in the retention barn and horses arriving at the retention barn will not be permitted to leave the retention area once they have been checked in by a Security Guard.
- All horses entering the retention barn must have their time of arrival registered by a Security Guard and their identification confirmed. The racing department will supply security with a Standardbred Canada identification list.
- While in the retention area, no horses shall be parenterally or orally treated or medicated.
- j. No electrolytes, transpirators or other breathing apparatus will be permitted in the retention area. Any horse that is found to be parenterally or orally treated while in the retention area will be scratched by the AGCO Official in charge.



- At the time of declaration. k. the trainer must declare a maximum of three licensed people who may have access to the retention barn. They must be either the owner. trainer, or groom of the horse named on the declaration. Only these three persons listed by the trainer will be permitted access to the retention barn. All declared persons entering the retention barn must be signed in by a Security Guard and must show their valid AGCO License with a valid and up-to-date Stable Area Access Sticker affixed to the back of it. All persons leaving the retention barn must be signed out by the Security Guard. Feed people are not the responsibility of WEG.
- l. If a veterinarian is required to attend to a sick or injured horse, Security Guards will contact the Official Veterinarian. In the event of an emergency, and where the Official Veterinarian is not available, a resident veterinarian may be called. Security Guards will keep the horse and veterinarian under constant view and detailed notes are to be taken regarding the observation of any treatment given to the horse. Veterinarians are required to fill out veterinarian reports and sign upon completion of any treatment or medication given.



- m. Horses in the retention area are permitted to be walked in a designated area. This area will be monitored by Security Guards. Horses will not be permitted to leave the designated area. Horses requiring a blacksmith will be escorted by Security Guards who will keep the horse under constant view. Horses in retention will be allowed to jog on the main track at a specified time the morning of their race, which must pre-arranged with the Security Guard in charge of the retention area.
- n. Natural feed (oats, sweet feed, pellets, hay and hay cubes) and water will be allowed in the retention area. NO human food or drink of any kind is permitted in the Retention area. Molasses is NOT allowed. Carrots are allowed.

Horses on the Lasix program will have it administered in their retention stalls at the designated times

#### ITEMS ALLOWED

- Natural Feed (oats, sweet feed, pellets, hay and hay cubes)
- Carrots, water, soap, fly spray, bandages, brushes and blankets
- Rubbing alcohol
- CSA approved fans

All items are subject to search and seizure.

All items must be unopened, in original packaging (with original seal), clearly labeled, and easily identified.

#### ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

- Food and drink for human consumption (including molasses)
- Electrolytes, transpirators or other breathing apparatus
- Hoof freeze, leg paints, liniments, unlabeled substances, substances labeled 'For vet use only'
- Any substance/article open or in non-original packaging
- Any substance/article that raises the suspicion of security or cannot be clearly identified
- Any medications prohibited within 24 hours prior to post time
- House fans or a fan with an open back motor


