

## Rules for Additional Competitions 2020 (REVISED)

### LADIES OF THE LAWN

1. Horses are not required to start in all three (3) legs to be eligible.
2. Point System – 10 points – 1<sup>st</sup>, 7 points – 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5 points 3<sup>rd</sup>, 3 points – 4<sup>th</sup>, 2 points for 5<sup>th</sup>, 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> – Last. (Points will be prorated in the event of a dead heat.)
3. Bonus points are revocable in the event of a disqualification.
4. Series bonus awards will be prorated in the event of a tie in points.
5. Series bonus awards are revocable in the event of a disqualification.

### TURF ENDURANCE SERIES

1. Horses are not required to start in all four (4) legs to be eligible.
2. Point System – 10 points – 1<sup>st</sup>, 7 points – 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5 points 3<sup>rd</sup>, 3 points – 4<sup>th</sup>, 2 points for 5<sup>th</sup>, 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> – Last. (Points will be prorated in the event of a dead heat.)
3. Bonus points are revocable in the event of a disqualification.
4. Series bonus awards will be prorated in the event of a tie in points.
5. Series bonus awards are revocable in the event of a disqualification.
6. Fillies & Mares to be given equal preference.
7. In order to run for Starter Allowance your horse must of run for \$25,000 claiming or less in 2019 or 2020.

### TURF SPRINT SERIES

1. \*All races in the Turf Sprint series are considered overnight races therefore only two (2) common owners or trainers entries per race.\*
2. Qualifier(s):
  - a. Requires sixteen (16) or more entries to be split.
  - b. Maybe spilt up to a maximum of four (4) divisions.
  - c. In the event of over-subscription there will be preference to 2019- 20 earnings.
3. Semi-final(s):
  - a. Maybe split into a maximum of two (2) divisions.
  - b. In the event of over subscription preference by order of finish in the qualifying races (eg. 1<sup>st</sup> place finishers have equal preference over 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers which have equal preference over 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers ...)
  - c. For horses who have not competed in a qualifying race, preference will be given to 2019-20 earnings.

4. Series Final:
  - a. Series Final will not be split
  - b. In the event of over subscription preference by order of qualifying races (e.g. 1<sup>st</sup> place finishers have equal preference over 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers which have equal preference over 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers ...)
  - c. For horses who have not competed in the semi-finals, preference will be given by order of finish in the qualifying races.
  - d. For horses who have not competed in either the qualifying or semi-final races, preference will be given to 2019-20 earnings.
5. Fillies & Mares to be given equal preference.

#### WELCOME BACK HANDICAP

- In order to be eligible for nomination your horse has to have run for a claiming price of \$20,000 or less in 2019-20.
- Your horse must of raced at least 1 start at Woodbine in 2019.
- Nominations close at 12:00 P.M. Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup> 2020

#### MIDSUMMER HANDICAP

- In order to be eligible for nomination your horse has to have run for a claiming price of \$20,000 or less in 2019-20 by Thursday, July 16<sup>th</sup> 2020
- Nominations close at 12:00 P.M. Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup> 2020

#### GREY HANDICAP

- In order to be eligible for nomination your horse has to have run for a claiming price of \$25,000 or less in 2019-20 by Sunday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- Must be a registered Gray or Roan.
- Nominations close at 12:00 P.M. Tuesday, November 10<sup>th</sup> 2020

#### CRIMSOM HANDICAP & SCARLET HANDICAP

- In order to be eligible for nomination your horse has to have run for \$20,000 or less in 2019-20 by Saturday, November, 21<sup>st</sup> 2020
- Your horse must have raced 3 times at the 2020 Woodbine Meet by Saturday, November 21<sup>st</sup> 2020.
- Nominations close at 12:00 P.M. Sunday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> 2020
