
2025 Horse Acquisition Incentive Program

Criteria:

- Race Ready horses (3YO and upward) that have been purchased or claimed and have never raced or stabled at Woodbine before, and have made 1 start in the six month period of October 1, 2024 ending April 1, 2025 in a race at the \$25,000 claiming level (**Maidens \$40,000 claiming level**) or higher Pre-Purchase, in a jurisdiction other than Ontario, are eligible for the following incentives:

\$1,000 shipping allowance per horse, payable upon entering an allocated stall on the Woodbine backstretch on or before April 26, 2025 and makes at least one start on or before June 15, 2025.

\$1,500 per start the new horse makes at Woodbine between the dates of April 26, 2025 and June 15, 2025 up to a maximum of 3 starts.

- Applications must be submitted by the owner or trainer of qualified horses to the Woodbine Race Office by April 26, 2025

- All transfers of ownership must be submitted to the race office by April 26, 2025

- Any transfers of ownership after the application has been submitted will disqualify any incentives going forward in this program.

- Open to all local horsemen (Owners) who stabled at Woodbine during the 2024 season for at least 3 consecutive months and have at least one horse on the stall application for the 2025 season at Woodbine (all owners in Partnership or Stables must have had a horse at Woodbine for 3 consecutive months in 2024 for their horse to be eligible.)

- If any eligible horse is claimed between April 26, 2025 and June 15, 2025 it will be disqualified from any incentives going forward in this program.

- All payments will be made after June 15, 2025 at the conclusion of the program.

*The Horse Acquisition Incentive Program will be capped when there are 40 approved applications *

Total available incentive value per horse: \$5,500.

WEG, at its sole discretion, may make changes to this Horse Acquisition Incentive Program of any nature and kind whatsoever, including terms, conditions and incentive amounts. Program participants agree to be bound by any such changes.

Failure to provide the necessary supporting documentation as requested by WEG and/or failure to fulfill Program requirements may result in ineligibility for the Program and the legal requirement to reimburse WEG for any Program funds received in addition to a 20% administrative penalty.

WEG may at any time verify the information provided on the application. If this verification reveals information that is not in keeping with the criteria of the Program, the applicant will be required to return any amounts issued to the applicant by the Program.
