- Kevin Attard knows what it takes to win the Plate, having captured three of the past four runnings of Canada's most prestigious race. "Winning this race is something I dreamed of when I started out," said Attard. "To win it once was unbelievable. To have won it three times is nothing I could have ever imagined. And now, to be back again... I never take these moments for granted."
- A son of Good Magic out of the unraced Stormy Atlantic mare Pacific Dancer, Baaeed Alynna made just one start as a 2-year-old, finishing third in the 2025 Display Stakes. He returned this season to break his maiden in a 7-furlong maiden special weight on the Woodbine main track on June 28. "He showed a lot of determination to get up and win by a head," said Attard. "When he came to us, we liked him from the outset. We felt he had the ability to be competitive at the stakes level, so that's why we raced him in the Display. He's had a few little issues here and there, but he's coming into the Plate in great shape."
- The chestnut colt arrives at the \$1 million classic off a sixth in the Plate Trial on July 19. "He had a tough outside post to contend with, but overall, we were happy with the effort," Attard said. "That was his first time going two turns and, any time that is the case, you learn more about your horse and how to alter the game plan going forward. I think there were two important takeaways from that effort. First, he came out of it well, and second, he gave us confidence that he belongs in this race."
- Baaeed Alynna brings the same professionalism to his morning training as he does in the afternoon. "A total professional," said Attard. "I love the way he goes out and goes about his business. Whatever you ask of him, he's happy to oblige. When you see that in the mornings and it carries over to the afternoons, it puts a big smile on your face."
- "He is a horse that has a lot of talent. He is lightly raced, but that said, he is showing us every sign that he can handle the Plate distance."

Owner – Tagermeen Racing LLC

Tagermeen Racing LLC is a prominent Thoroughbred racing partnership formed by bloodstock agent Mahmud Mouni on behalf of a group of five owners based in Libya. The partnership drew widespread attention throughout the bloodstock industry after spending millions of dollars at leading North American auctions. Among its purchases were six horses for a combined \$2,795,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic May Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, along with several multi-million-dollar acquisitions at the Ocala Breeders' Sales (OBS) Spring Sale. The group campaigns its horses with some of North America's leading trainers, including Steve Asmussen, Saffie Joseph Jr., and Kevin Attard.

Trainer – Kevin Attard

Kevin Attard is one of Woodbine's leading trainers and was named Canada's champion trainer in 2024. The son of accomplished trainer Tino Attard and nephew of prominent horsemen Sid Attard, the late Joe Attard, and former jockey and trainer Larry Attard, he saddled his first career winner at Woodbine on July 12, 2001. Attard has earned more than 125 stakes victories, highlighted by Starship Jubilee, winner of the Grade 1 E.P. Taylor Stakes in 2019 and the Grade 1 Woodbine Mile in 2020, who was crowned Canada's Horse of the Year in 2019. In 2022, Moira delivered Attard his first King's Plate victory before going on to Horse of the Year honours. He added a second Plate triumph in 2024 with champion filly Caitlinhergrtness and completed a remarkable hat trick when Mansetti captured the 166th King's Plate in 2025. Other notable stars from his stable include 2021 Woodbine Oaks winner Munnyfor Ro, 2007 Prince of Wales Stakes winner Alezzandro, and graded stakes winners Amalfi Coast, Calgary Cat, Fashionably Fab, and Melmich.

Jockey – Sahin Civaci

Multiple graded stakes-winning rider Sahin Civaci, who won the 2024 Sovereign Award as Canada's champion jockey, was born in Vancouver, and moved to Ankara, Turkey, with his family when he was 10. In his early teenage years, he enrolled in a course sponsored by the Turkish Jockey Club and quickly realized he wanted to ride thoroughbreds for a living. He made the move to Woodbine, and his first win at the Toronto oval came on June 5, 2019, aboard Phil's Glory. In 2019, he won 39 races in 363 starts. He then had 92 wins in 2022. In 2023, he posted wins 141 wins, upping that number to 171 in 2024. Last year, Civaci recorded 116 victories and is closing in on 800 lifetime wins.
