- In the eyes of Dewolf's two-time King's Plate-winning trainer Kevin Attard, the dark brown Silent Name colt has yet to flash his full potential on race days. "Dewolf has been a little frustrating this season," said Attard. "He has trained brilliantly, and we are still waiting for him to run to his training."
- Dewolf's path to the 166th King's Plate started with a third in the Queenston Stakes on June 8 at Woodbine and continued with a sixth in the Plate Trial Stakes, also at Woodbine, on July 20. "His effort in the Plate Trial was okay," offered Attard. "He was shuffled back in the race, but I can't say for sure how much of an impact that had on where he finished. The good thing was that he came out of the race in great shape."
- In good form ahead of the main event, Attard believes the \$185,000 purchase at the 2023 Keeneland September Yearling Sale has all the tools to be a successful racehorse. "The Plate is all about a horse being able to put it all together at the right moment. We have always liked this horse and believe he has the foundation to be a good one."
- Attard is confident in Dewolf's ability to stretch out from 1 1/8 miles in the Plate Trial to 1 1/4 miles for the million-dollar Plate. "We don't have any reason to believe he can't get the distance. Hopefully, this is the day we see his best he gets a clean trip and can capitalize on it."

Owner - X-Men Racing IV LLC, Canuck Racing Club, Madaket Stables LLC, SF Racing LLC

X-Men Racing is a syndicate of Canadian racing friends put together by bloodstock agent Donato Lanni. The successful ownership venture includes a 2022 King's Plate win with Moira. Madaket Stables LLC is the stable of American businessman and philanthropist Sol Kumin. Madaket Stables owned a stake in Justify when he won the Triple Crown in 2018, and a stake in Authentic, the 2020 Kentucky Derby and 2020 Breeders' Cup Classic winner. Other top horses the stable has been part of include: Monomoy Girl, Lady Eli, Exaggerator, Mind Your Biscuits, and British Idiom. SF Racing LLC is headed by Tom Ryan, who also serves as the bloodstock agent at SF Bloodstock. SF Racing was a partner with Madaket Stables in Authentic and Justify. Other notable horses include G1 winners Pinehurst, Eight Rings, Improbable, and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint champion Bulletin. Canuck Racing Club (www.canuckracing.com) is a private Thoroughbred ownership and racing club that enables select individuals to simultaneously own multiple Thoroughbred racehorses with no cap on earnings. Invited members own a percentage of each equine athlete in a specific group at a pro rata share commensurate to their contribution. Canuck Racing Club is managed by three partners – Donato Lanni, Mark Halloran, and Rob Van Blokland – who have been friends since they were kids and grew up just a few streets apart.

Jockey - Flavien Prat
Plate Appearances: 2 - Plate Wins: 1 (2019)

The son of a Standardbred trainer, Prat was 16 when he began riding in France in 2008 and a year later was the nation's champion apprentice. In 2009, he started riding periodically during the winter in Southern California before returning home to ride. At Santa Anita, he worked for Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella. Prat was 17 when he rode his first winner at Santa Anita in January 2010. Prat's first full season in North America was 2015. At Del Mar, Prat earned his first North American Grade 1 win aboard Wild Dude in the Bing Crosby Stakes. He has won multiple titles as leading rider at meets in Southern California. In 2019, he won the King's Plate (then, Queen's Plate) on One Bad Boy. Prat has two Triple Crown wins, the 2019 Kentucky Derby on Country House and 2021 Preakness on Rombauer, and seven Breeders' Cup victories. He earned the 2024 Eclipse Award as North America's outstanding jockey. Win No. 2,000 came aboard Iron Max on June 27, 2025. Prat won five races that day.
