- The son of Silent Name (JPN)-Spun Lace comes into the Plate in the mode, with three consecutive medal performances, including a 5  $\frac{1}{4}$ -length maiden-breaking score on May 28 in a seven-furlong Tapeta race.
- Enjoythesilent debuted last July at 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  furlongs on the E.P. Taylor Turf. Sent off at 12-1, the dark bay finished fifth, 4  $\frac{1}{4}$  lengths behind the winner One for Chap.
- Although they didn't result in a winner's circle trip, his last two efforts have been just as impressive. On July 7, Enjoythesilent was third, less than a length behind the winner in a 1  $\frac{1}{16}$ -mile Tapeta race. Twenty-three days later, he was second, a neck behind Plate rival Twowaycrossing in a 1  $\frac{1}{16}$ -mile race originally scheduled for the turf.
- "His last three efforts have all been excellent," said Attard, of the Adena Springs-bred sophomore. "He's been a horse that can adapt to every new situation with ease. He's been learning something from each race and is able to put all of that to good use in his next start. We've added blinkers and he worked well with them in last move."
- "These are great owners and it's nice to see a group like Canuck Racing Club have a really nice horse to be excited about."

### Owner – Lanni Bloodstock LLC, Daniel Plouffe, Canuck Racing Club

Donato Lanni grew up in and around the Standardbred business but eventually moved to Kentucky to get involved with Thoroughbreds. He worked for John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm as Director of Bloodstock Services. Founding Lanni Bloodstock in 2019, the Montreal native is one of the most sought-after thoroughbred scouts in North America, a trusted advisor to his clients, and a partner in several ownership groups. By his count, he still sees about 15,000 horses a year. Among his past finds are Kentucky Derby and Horse of the Year winner *Authentic*, Breeders' Cup winners *Arrogate*, *Bayern*, *Gamine*, *Drefrong*, *Secret Circle*, Preakness winner *Lookin At Lucky*, *Dortmund*, and 2022 Queen's Plate winner *Moira*. A successful Standardbred owner for decades, Daniel Plouffe decided a few years ago to also try his hand at Thoroughbreds in partnerships designed by his longtime friend Lanni, who he got to know at now-defunct Blue Bonnets racetrack in Montreal. Plouffe and his spouse Alexandra Verret both have shares in the partnership that owns 2022 Plate winner *Moira*, and about a dozen other horses. Canuck Racing Club (canuckracing.com), managed by Lanni, Mark Halloran and Rob Van Blokland, is a private ownership and racing club that enables select individuals to simultaneously own multiple racehorses with no cap on earnings. Invited members own a percentage of each equine athlete in a specific group at a pro rata share commensurate to their contribution.
