- Named after rising NHL defenseman Brock Faber of the Minnesota Wild, the bay son of Improbable-Disobedient
 will aim to light the lamp in the 166th King's Plate. "Having a horse named after a star NHL player is pretty cool,
 obviously," said trainer Kevin Attard. "If we can get a top-shelf performance from Faber in the Plate, I'm sure
 that would be the Ulwellings' version of winning the Stanley Cup."
- No stranger to gritty efforts, Faber's determination has caught the eye of his Sovereign Award-winning conditioner. "There's no doubt at all that he's a trier," praised Attard. "He's always been a game horse with ability. The hope is he can take all of his strengths and come up big in the Plate."
- The \$37,000 purchase at the 2023 Keeneland September Yearling Sale made a strong first impression on his connections, scoring by a neck in his maiden start last August at Woodbine. "I thought his debut, which came on the inner turf, was excellent," added Attard. "He kept coming and had a nice late kick to get up for the win. I can't say I was surprised by that effort he had been working well going into the race and took what he did in the morning and brought his A-game in the afternoon."
- Ahead of his toughest test to date, Faber has remained the same even-keeled competitor. "It's all-systems go for the Plate," said Attard, who captured his second King's Plate title with Caitlinhergrtness in 2024. "He's been working well, and he's been focused and sharp leading up to the race."

Trainer - Kevin Attard
Plate Starters: 19 - Plate Wins: 2 (2022, 2024)

Kevin Attard is one of Woodbine's top trainers and was crowned Canada's champion conditioner in 2024. The son of accomplished local trainer Tino Attard and nephew of prominent Woodbine conditioners Sid Attard and the late Joe Attard and former jockey and trainer Larry Attard, won his first career race on July 12, 2001 at Woodbine and has won 114 stakes headed by Starship Jubilee (Grade 1 E.P. Taylor, 2019 and Grade 1 Woodbine Mile, 2020), Canada's Horse of the Year in the former season. In 2022, it was Moira, winner of the Woodbine Oaks, who gave Attard his first victory in The King's Plate, en route to Canadian Horse of the Year honours. Last year, he won his second Plate with Sovereign champion, filly Caitlinhergrtness. Other stars include Munnyfor Ro, the 2021 Woodbine Oaks heroine; Alezzandro, Fort Erie's Prince of Wales, in 2007; and multiple graded stakes winners Amalfi Coast, Calgary Cat, Fashionably Fab, and Melmich.

Jockey - Pietro Moran *Plate Apperances: 1 - Best Plate Finish: 4th (2024)*

Pietro Moran, son of jockeys David and Maria Moran, grew up in Ireland but moved to Canada with his family when he was six. For as long as he can remember, he wanted to take after his parents and become a rider. "My brothers and I used to do races on the street all the time and we had our own silks. I used to be the organizer of the races, and we got old silks from Woodbine. The ones I had are orange with a blue circle, with an orange "P" in the middle, with orange and blue sleeves." Moran's first race at Woodbine was September 10, 2023, and his first win came that October with Trizzel Trazzel. On July 1, 2024, he won his first stakes race, the Grade 3 Belle Mahone, with Kevin Attard trainee Fashionably Fab. He finished the 2024 season with 61 wins, 51 seconds, and 64 thirds across 347 starts. For his efforts, he was named a finalist for the Outstanding Apprentice Jockey Sovereign Award. Aside from his riding career at Woodbine, Moran is taking Kinesiology at the University of Guelph-Humber.
