- This chestnut son of Collected will be making his Canadian debut in The King's Plate after an impressive start to the season south of the border.
- He made a pair of starts last fall as a juvenile but has improved greatly this year. He broke his maiden at third asking in March at Gulfstream and followed that with an allowance score at Belmont.
- Next time out, he won his graded stakes debut in the Pennine Ridge (G2T) on June 3. All his wins have been on the grass, but he will be running on Tapeta for the first time in the King's Plate.
- "This is a great opportunity for me to win my first King's Plate," said jockey Kazushi Kimura. "I've been watching video and looking at what this horse is capable of. I really like the way the horse glides when he runs. He's very strong and he's very competitive."
- His most recent was the Belmont Derby Invitational (G1T), where he was fractious in the gate, and never seemed to get comfortable.
- An interesting note is that he is following the same prep schedule as 2021 Queen's Plate winner Safe Conduct. Safe Conduct was fourth in the Pennine Ridge, and eighth in the Belmont Derby Invitational (G1).

#### Trainer: Chad Brown


Chad Brown, who learned the racetrack ropes with trainer Shug McGaughey, moved on to work as an assistant to the late Bobby Frankel when the stable's stars included the likes of Ghostzapper, Intercontinental, Empire Maker and Medaglia d'Oro. Brown saddled his first winner on November 23, 2007. His rise since then has been nothing short of meteoric, including three consecutive Eclipse Awards as Outstanding Trainer. He recorded his 2,000th win on August 7, 2021. Brown continued to reside in the elite echelon of trainers during 2020–22, saddling top horses such as Raging Bull, Search Results, Dunbar Road, Public Sector, Bleecker Street, Jack Christopher, and Zandon. In 2022, Brown picked up his second win in a Triple Crown race when Early Voting took the Preakness. Brown added another Breeders' Cup victory to his career tally in 2022 when his 4-year-old filly Goodnight Olive won the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint.

### Owner: Robert V. LaPenta, e Five Racing Thoroughbreds and Madaket Stables LLC

Madaket Stables is the province of Sol Kumin, the man who has owned on his own but is also involved with multiple partnerships. The who's who of top horses with whom he has been affiliated includes Triple Crown champion Justify, Eclipse Award-winning distaffers Monomoy Girl, Midnight Bisou and Lady Eli; and 2020 champion sprinter Whitmore. Robert LaPenta was introduced to racing as a youth by his mother, and first became an owner in 1998 as a partner with then-University of Louisville basketball coach Rick Pitino. He started his own stable in 2001, in the name of Whitehorse Stables. In 2011, his stable was headed by Dialed In, who won the Holy Bull Stakes (G3) and the Florida Derby (G1). He has been a partner in other graded stakes winners, Tapwrit, Uni (GB), Coal Front, Current, Capensis, Far Right, Uncontested, Jeranimo, Hawkish, Catholic Boy, Whitmore, Jackson Bend, Dolce Zel (FR), Amy C (GB), Shantisara (IRE), L'Imperator (FR), and Delightful Joy. Starting operations in August 2015, e Five Racing's Bob and Kristine Edwards and their three children - Cassidy, Riley, and Delaney - have enjoyed tremendous success, winning the 2016 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf with New Money Honey. The group duplicated that in 2017, winning the Juvenile Fillies Turf with Rushing Fall. Bob is the owner of e5 Pharma, a pharmaceutical company for pets, and is the founder of Mizner Bioscience.

## Jockey: Kazushi Kimura

Born in Hokkaido, Japan, Kazushi Kimura joined the Woodbine jockey colony in 2018. He was the Sovereign winner as outstanding apprentice that year and repeated in 2019 when he also earned an Eclipse in the category. Kimura's career took a quantum leap in 2021 as he ran away from the pack with 139 winners and earned the Sovereign as outstanding jockey. He repeated as the Sovereign winner in 2022. His numerous stakes winners include G1 winners Rougir (FR), Gretzky The Great, and Gold Phoenix. He piloted Rougir (FR) to victory in the 2022 E.P. Taylor for Brown. "With Chad, you know the horse will be in top condition coming into the Plate. To be in The King's Plate is amazing. The race has so much history. You can feel the excitement building and I hope that we can say we won the first King's Plate since 1951. I know I have a big chance with this horse."
