- Bred in Kentucky by Calumet Farm, Admiralty Pier started his career on a winning note in early August 2017 over the E.P. Taylor Turf Course and was stakes-placed in the Grade 2 Summer Stakes. He also competed in the Grade 3 Bourbon at Keeneland that same year, finishing fourth over a sloppy track before returning to Woodbine only to be nosed out in a November 11 allowance race on the Tapeta track.
- Admiralty Pier's lone stakes victory came in the 2017 running of the Display, a gutsy head score. "He's matured a tonne," said trainer Barb Minshall after the win. "He's just gotten better and better. I still think he's better on the turf. I think he's going to move up lengths and lengths on the turf, but he's just getting better all the time."
- Sporting a record of 3-1-2 in 13 starts, the chestnut English Channel-Full Steam Ahead gelding heads into the Ricoh Woodbine Mile off a fifth-place finish in the Grade 2 Play the King Stakes over seven furlongs of turf on August 24 at Woodbine.
- "He has a challenging personality, but he's in a good frame of mind right now," said Minshall, who was named Canada's top trainer in 1996. "He's in a very good place right now."
- "He's been a good horse from the get-go. Unfortunately, he's had a few breaks in the program, mainly, he's had some muscle injuries that recurred. He's a nice horse, and he's training really, really well."

Owner – Hoolie Racing Stable LLC and Bruce Lunsford

Andrew Hudson and his father Greg and brother David, long involved in racing through various partnerships, decided to buy horses together under the Hoolie Racing Stable banner, which began with the purchase of three yearlings, including Dream It Is (Shackleford).

Bruce Lunsford has served as state commerce secretary and an integral member of several Kentucky businesses. He is also a successful owner and breeder. Lunsford co-owned multiple stakes winner Stacked Deck, and his sire, First Samurai, winner of the 2005 Champagne and Hopeful Stakes (both Grade 1). One of his first successful homebreds was Vision and Verse, winner of the 1999 Illinois Derby (Grade 2). Vision and Verse was best known for his narrow second-place finish to Lemon Drop Kid in that year's Belmont Stakes. Another standout runner he owned was Grade 1 winner Madcap Escapade, whom he later sold for \$6 million. Lunsford also bred Canadian Horse of the Year Arravale and Golden Missile. The latter was a star on the handicap scene in 1999 and 2000, before becoming a Grade 1 winner and multimillionaire.

Trainer – Barbara Minshall

Barbara Minshall grew up around horses. The Montreal native rode jumpers and later qualified for the Canadian Olympic and Pan-American Dressage teams, which finished fifth in the 1976 Olympics. She obtained her trainer's license in 1995, and credits her late husband, Aubrey Minshall, with teaching her almost everything she knows about racing. As a rookie in 1995, Minshall posted 23 wins at Woodbine, including six stakes wins, and became the first female trainer to capture a Canadian Triple Crown race when Kiridashi won the Prince of Wales Stakes. In 1996, Minshall sent out Prince of Wales Stakes winner Stephanotis, the second time she has won a leg of the Canadian Triple Crown. She also saddled Mt. Sassafra to a fourth-place effort in the Breeders' Classic at odds of 10-1. A banner year in 1996 brought the Minshall operation five Sovereign Awards: Outstanding Breeder, Outstanding Owner, Champion Older Male and Horse of the Year (Mt. Sassafra) and Outstanding Trainer. She became the first woman to be recognized with the honour. More recently, Minshall campaigned Sovereign honourees Strut the Course, who counted the 2015 edition of the Grade 2 Canadian Stakes among her conquests, and the Bruce Lunsford-homebred Stacked Deck.

Jockey – Patrick Husbands

Patrick Husbands has been a force at Woodbine since 1994. Born in Barbados where he started his career, Husbands comes from a riding family. His father was a rider while brother Simon also rides. In 1990, at age 16, Husbands became the youngest rider to win the Cocksbur Cup. He also won the Bajan riding title in 1993. Top horses he guided to victory during Canadian Horses of the Year campaigns include Lexie Lou (2014), Sealy Hill (2007) and Triple Crown champ

Wando (2003). Husbands has a record eight Sovereign Awards as Outstanding Jockey, the most recent coming in 2014 in which he won his seventh Woodbine title. He counts 302 stakes, 78 of the graded variety, among his 3,331 winners. Husbands suffered serious injuries in a spill at Woodbine last fall, which had the potential to be career ending, but he has bounced back with a vengeance since returning to action on April 27 and leads all Woodbine jockeys for stakes wins this meet with a dozen entering Mile weekend.
