- Sporting a record of 1-3-2 from 11 starts, Morstachy's will be making his stakes debut on Sunday.
- What a claim to fame it would be to win The King's Plate with a horse you claimed for \$40,000. Stakes-winning trainer Renico Lafond claimed Morstachy's, on behalf of owner Kris Manohar, on July 23. "His closing speed would be his best attribute to this race, he has an eye-catching turn of foot," said Lafond. "He is not a big horse, but he covers ground immensely."
- The gelding has only been in the Lafond barn for a short amount of time, which has created some challenges, but has also led to several rewarding opportunities. "He's a hot horse and very frontal, in the sense of using his front end to train rather than his hind," said Lafond. "I've got him to relax a little in the first two-and-a-half weeks of his training, and he has begun using his hind end a lot. It wasn't easy at all but he's starting to come around."
- Now, the connections will look to pull off the upset in Canada's iconic race with a horse whose modus operandi is coming from off the pace with a big run. "I know this race will be tough, no doubt about that, but I know we're going to give it everything we have, and if we were to win it well that's another story."

## Owner – Kris Manohar

**Kris Manohar** has been in racing for a total of five years. The owner and CEO of All-Pro Transmission was 26 when he owned his first horse. Although it didn't pan out initially, Manohar jumped back in four years later with more knowledge of the sport. Now 34, Manohar sees a parallel between racing and his life. "I was able to start from very little and turn it into something special, like a King's Plate appearance." Manohar's greatest thrill in racing is being able to be the youngest owner and trainer combination with his partner and friend Renico Lafond. "We've had many great wins and now an appearance here with many more to come. To be a part of our rapid growth and development is exhilarating and a journey that I am grateful for, as I know this is the beginning of many great opportunities to come."

## Trainer - Renico Lafond

Renico Lafond was born into the horse racing game. Introduced to the sport by his father Nicholas, a lifelong horseman, the younger Lafond worked hard to move up the ranks. After moving to Canada at the age of 9, Lafond would get his start in Canadian racing with legendary horseman Reade Baker. He then became an exercise rider before earning his trainer's license in 2011. His top horse to date is Silent Serenity. The daughter of Silent Name (JPN) won the 2012 Ruling Angel Stakes as the longest shot on the board. Lafond's top horses also include Wings of Victory, Canadiansweetheart, and Speed Chess. He heads into The Plate during a career year. "It's been my dream from a kid to one day be in the Plate when I became a trainer. Now, at the age of 36, I get to participate in the first King's Plate since 1951. I can't express the excitement coursing through me. It's truly mind blowing."

## Jockey – Leo Salles

Hailing from Brazil, Leo Salles has ridden and won races across the world, including Dubai, Canada, the United States and Saudi Arabia. The graded stakes-winning jockey teamed with Lucky Score to win the 2022 Vigil Stakes (G3). Salles had a career-best North American campaign last year, winning 68 races with purse earnings of over \$2 million.
