- No Time is only filly in this year's King's Plate. The Plate has been won by fillies 39 times in its 165 years – including last year when Caitlinhergrtness was victorious. Fillies have won the Plate two times in the last three years and six times in the last 14 years.
- Seven of No Time's eight lifetime starts have been at Woodbine. The only exception was her 2025 seasonal debut at Gulfstream Park in April.
- No Time, a dark bay daughter of No Time out of Count to Three by Red Ransom was the winner of the \$500,000 Woodbine Oaks in her last start on July 20 at Woodbine in 1:50.14. The time was faster than the colts ran that same day in the Plate Trial (1:50.37) and trainer Mark Casse said, “it looks like [No Time] can run even farther.”
- “Early, she was just off the pace [in the Oaks] and then for her to finish the way she did, Johnny [Velazquez] said when he asked her to pick it up, she took off with him,” Casse said.
- “She has a heck of a pedigree,” Casse noted. “She’s by one of the best sires in the world and she’s a half-sister to two Grade 1 winners. She has the pedigree to be any kind.”
- “We bought her at Saratoga as a yearling, and we paid \$250,000 for her, which seems like a lot, but with her pedigree, you would have thought she would have brought a lot more than that,” Casse said. “But, she was on the small side and with that sire, they tend to be a little on the smaller side, but I feel like she really has grown up and has gotten stronger and better as time goes on, which happens a lot of times when you have these great pedigrees.”
- Casse said No Time got her name because he nearly missed bidding on her at the 2023 Saratoga Sale while distracted by a media interview and conversation after purchasing And One More Time – the 2024 Grade 1 Natalma Stakes winner at Woodbine – for \$750,000 one horse before No Time sold. Fortunately, No Time’s owner Gary Barber called Casse to ask if the trainer planned to bid on No Time and Casse quickly threw up his hand before the hammer fell. “If Gary hadn't been paying attention, we don't get her because, yeah, I was distracted,” Casse said.

In June 1988, Velazquez entered the jockey school in Puerto Rico. He kicked off his riding career shortly after and scored his first victory at El Comandante Racetrack in 1990 aboard Rodas. He relocated to New York in March 1990 with Racing Hall of Fame rider Angel Cordero Jr.'s guidance. Cordero has acted as his agent since 1998. John won the first two Grade 1 races of his career in 1995, and the following spring captured his first riding title, at Aqueduct. He was the regular rider of Yanks Music, champion 3-year-old filly of 1996, who was trained by his father-in-law, Leo O'Brien. He and Mike Smith are Co-Chairmen of the Jockeys' Guild. Velazquez has won the Plate one time – in 2018 with Wonder Gadot for the same connections (Casse and Barber). He is the sport's all-time purse earnings leader and on June 13, 2025, became the first jockey in North America to surpassing \$500 million. He has won more than 6,700 races in his career. He was inducted into the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame in 2012.
