- Paramount Prince won the 2023 Plate Trial Stakes, a mile and an eighth event, which was the race that impressed trainer Mark Casse the most in the horse's career thus far.
- "After the race, he kept going, he galloped out a good mile and a quarter so I don't think the distance [for The King's Plate] would be an issue for him. And I think Patrick [jockey, Husbands] let him do it too because we knew down the road, he's going to have to run a little farther."
- Paramount Prince broke his maiden at Woodbine in November 2022, in a six-furlong race. Casse shared that the horse's biggest challenge so far is that he gets in his head and is a bit of a worrier. However, "as he's gotten a little older, he's gotten a little better and matured over the winter."
- The dual hall of fame conditioner spoke of the team effort to get Paramount Prince to this point. "We have an amazing team led by David Adams here at Woodbine, he's been with me for 25 years."
- That tight-knit operation extends across North America, including those at the training centre in Ocala, Florida, including Mitch Townsend, who has been with Casse for 41 years, and Cindy Black, who has worked for Casse for over 30 years. "All of our horses are a product of the team we have all over North America."

Jockey – Patrick Husbands

Patrick Husbands has been a force at Woodbine since 1994. Born in Barbados where he started his career, Husbands comes from a riding family. His father was a rider while his brother Simon also rides. In 1990, at age 16, Husbands became the youngest rider to win the Cockspur Cup. He also won the Bajan riding title in 1993. Top horses he guided to victory during Canadian Horses of the Year campaigns include Lexie Lou (2014), Sealy Hill (2007), and Triple Crown champ Wando (2003). Husbands has a record eight Sovereign Awards as Outstanding Jockey, the most recent coming in 2014 in which he won his seventh Woodbine riding title. A two-time Queen's Plate winner (Wando in 2003, Lexie Lou in 2014), Husbands, named the 2014 recipient of the Avelino Gomez Memorial Award, has over 3,600 career victories and earnings of more than \$176 million (U.S.).

Owner – Gary Barber (see Elysian Field bio) and Mike Langlois

Mike Langlois, who works in financial services, purchased his first horse via the claim box last fall. Magic Spin, an Ontario-bred son of Twirling Candy, had five outings in 2021 and then won his maiden in October 2022 for Langlois' first win as an owner.
