

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# Blue Chip Trainer Angles

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Welcome to *Woodbine Blue Chip Trainer Angles*, an annual publication that will provide you with dozens of “live” plays at the current WOODBINE meet.

## NUTS AND BOLTS

### What Is A Blue Chip Trainer Angle?

In the stock market, a blue chip company is one that shows an above-average rate of return on a consistent basis. Investors who don't have a lot of time to analyze financial statements know they can rely on a blue chip stock. Moreover, most blue chip stocks perform well even when the market goes into the dumper. Thus, an investor doesn't have to worry about conflicting data (good stocks versus poor market outlook).

Our goal was to find trainer angles that fit the blue chip definition. In order to ferret out the Blue Chip angles, we developed a filtering method similar to that used by conservative mutual fund managers. Like the Wall Street boys, we wanted to assure future performance.

**We are very strict about our Blue Chip criteria and thus our formula for selecting the Blue Chip angles hasn't changed over the years. Each angle must meet the following four specifications:**

- Trainer must have maintained a 12% winning average at last two meets.
- The angle had to score at least 3 times.
- The angle had to score at least one time at the previous meet.
- The angle had to produce a 33% win average and a 100% ROI.

### Number of Meets In The Sample

Depending on the length of the meet, our Blue Chippers are based on the last two or three meets which provides a sufficient sample. Requiring the angle to show a win at the most recent meet guarantees that the angle is currently clicking. At Woodbine, the Blue Chippers are based on the last two meets.

### Keeping It Simple

We like to adhere to the KISS philosophy (Keep It Simple Stupid). As such, most of our angles based on handicapping factors and *usually include no more than two factors.*

### Angles Based ONLY on Woodbine Races

The statistics in this book only relates to a trainer's Woodbine performance. For example, look at Horse A below:

In the above sequence, Horse A moved from Parx to Woodbine while stretching out in distance and moving down in class. Our computer doesn't recognize those two moves. It classifies Horse A's 05/10/18 Woodbine start in the "First Start of the Meet" category. It will then classify Horse A's 05/30/18 start as a stretchout and a move down in class.

Many Blue Chip angles involve class, surface and distance moves. **Our data only recognizes those moves in which both legs were made at the WOODBINE meet.**

### Should You Deviate From the Formula?

What happens if you spot a Blue Chip play but the horse is making **its first start of the meet?** For example, a stretchout angle where the first leg took place at Turfway Park. If you like the horse for other reasons and the price is right, go for it. However, we recommend that you don't play the horse based on the Blue Chip angle. The horse may win, but we have no data to support that move. And if the horse should win, we won't count it in our tally.

**Layoff and jockey switch angles are the exceptions.** Although these types of moves may also involve a horse making its first start of the meet, our computer does note a jockey switch and the number of days between races.

*In order to make sure everyone understands the above concept, we have included a table at the end of this chapter which will spell out the angles that may be applied to horses making their first start of the meet.*

### The Eliminators

Occasionally, a Blue Chip angles may contain what we call an "Eliminator." Our research for each angle was exhaustive. We examined both the winners and losers in the angle sample of starters. If we found a common thread among either group, we felt obligated to filter it in to the original angle.

However, before we accepted an elimination factor, we compared it to the trainer's record in that category. If the trainer was weak in that area, we used the eliminator. *We didn't use an eliminator if the trainer showed average or superior ability with the factor.*

# WHAT RESULTS CAN YOU EXPECT?

We make no guarantees with this product. Instead, we simply stand behind the previous year's results with the understanding that the cumulative profitability attained doesn't assure positive ROI at the current meet.

Like we said, the results speak for themselves and summarize as follows:

- Positive ROI at ALL SIX meets covered.
- ROI ranging from 10% to 25%.
- ON THE BLIND, THE ANGLES SCORED AT AN 18% CLIP.
- A \$2 wager on each Blue Chip in the sample required a \$998 investment but returned \$1,200.

## A Word About Rate of Return (ROI)

For each angle, we provide you with an historic ROI figure. Although this is a common term, it has various interpretations. Our definition of ROI follows more of a financial approach. Assume that you invest \$1,000 in a stock, and then sell it a month later for \$1,500. Your net profit was \$500 and the ROI was 50% (\$500 profit divided by a \$1,000 investment).

Thus in *Woodbine Blue Chip Trainer Angles* we calculate ROI as follows:

- Assume a \$2 flat bet wager on each angle starter (**total invested**)
- Determine the total combined pay out from all angle winners (**total return**)
- Calculate the net profit (**total return less total invested**)
- Calculate ROI by dividing (C) by (A)

# RESULTS AT OTHER MEETS COVERED

As you can see from the results below, Blue Chip OVERALL success carries over to other meets. While the number of profitable individual seasons might vary by the meet, *each track covered shows positive ROI over time.*

## FORMAT FOR EACH BLUE CHIP ANGLE

Each Blue Chip Angle is organized in identical fashion and includes the following parts:

- **Angle Performance**—Shows the angle's record at the last 2 or 3 meets.
- **Eliminators**—Lists and explains the eliminators (if any). If an angle doesn't have an eliminator, then this section will not appear.
- **Angle Winners**—Capsule summaries of each angle winner.

# LOOKING UP BLUE CHIP PLAYS

Blue Chip plays are not always a daily occurrence. There are two methods used to finding the Blue Chip: (1) scanning the *DRF* pps for a match; (2) using Progressive Handicapping's *Daily Sheets*, a product that will list every Blue Chip play for the day as well as other high % trainer plays and low % plays as well. You can sign up for *Daily Sheets* by calling us at 800-272-8039. It's very inexpensive and will save you hours.

## BLUE CHIP BETTING STRATEGIES

Everyone has their own style of betting at the track. And that style will dictate how you use the Blue Chip angles on a daily basis.

### WIN PLACE OR SHOW

The most conservative wagers are WIN, PLACE and SHOW. Many of our readers wait for the Blue Chipper and then play it the conservative way.

### VERTICAL WAGERS

Other players like to delve into VERTICAL wagers which require picking the order of finish be it an EXACTA (1-2), TRIFECTA (1-2-3) or SUPERFECTA (1-2-3-4). Blue Chip plays can be used in all spots as they historically hit the board at better than a 40% clip. Others may also want to KEY the Blue Chip on top.

Author Mazur suggests that handicappers try to also identify "PIECES" runners in the field to use in the VERTICAL WAGER. These runners usually have developed chronic "2nditis" or "3rditis." Thus the player can save money by using these sorts "underneath."

Plus handicappers can use our WinPlace angles located in the back of the book to focus on trainers who have compiled high ITM averages in certain scenarios.

### HORIZONTAL WAGERS

During the last decade, HORIZONTAL wagers have become very popular. In the very old days, the DAILY DOUBLE was the only HORIZONTAL bet available. Now, there are four more popular plays: (1) PICK 3; (2) PICK 4; (3) PICK 5; and (4) PICK 6.

Author Mazur uses a Blue Chip play as the "anchor" for his Pick 4 wager. While he may not "SINGLE" the Blue Chip, it will probably make his "A" team if it matches up "speed-wise" to others in the field. If not, Mazur uses the Blue Chipper on the "B" team especially if the Blue Chipper is going off at decent odds.

## GAME DAY DECISIONS

What follows is list of possible factors that may derail the Blue Chip play. This is not meant to cover ALL contingencies, but does include the most common.

### Blue Chippers On OFF DIRT or TURF

What happens if one of our Blue Chip angle starters winds up running on an off track? The conservative approach IS SIMPLY NOT TO PLAY. However, there is another tool available in the Progressive Handicapping arsenal: *Sire Ratings* an annual publication that rates thousands of sires in various categories including OFF TRACKS and OFF TURF.

Step #1 is to look at the runner's past performances. If it shows previous success on OFF dirt or turf, then why not play especially if you are wagering on a serial bet like the Pick 4. If the runner has no experience on the OFF, then look up its sire and damsire in *Sire Ratings* to see if they rate high in these categories. In the end, it's all up to you.

## Jockeys

Some Blue Chip angles involve a specific jockey/trainer combination. WHAT HAPPENS IF THE JOCKEY IS OUT OF TOWN and the horse is a perfect fit when compared to the angle winners' profile? That's another tough call. Again, the conservative approach is not to play. However, if the odds are right, you may want to decrease your betting units and make it an "action" play or if playing the VERTICALS put it on the "B" team.

The other alternative is look at the replacement rider's stats with the trainer. This can be looked up by using DRF stats in the pps (generic) or Progressive Handicapping's *Handicapper* book for that meet.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THE TRAINER ISN'T USING THAT JOCKEY AT THE CURRENT MEET? Jockey's get injured, suspended and even retire mid meet. Again, you will have to make the call. However, if the trainer is consistently using the same rider at the current meet, go ahead and make the substitution. Again, we have to make some value judgments. If in doubt, try calling the authors at 800-272-8039.

## Robot Handicapping

One has to be careful not to blindly jump on a Blue Chip. Read the book. Read the text which accompanies each Blue Chip. Some of readers don't read the text analysis and may be heading for disaster. *The best way to use the Blue Chips is to apply other common sense handicapping fundamentals and to exercise some flexibility.* Here are some examples:

### **Track Bias**

A strong track bias can render even the best Blue Chip into a Cow Chip. Let's face it, when the track is playing toward speed, the best horse doesn't always win. We can think of several examples in which our Blue Chips failed to fire into the heart of a track bias. For this product to be truly effective, one has to watch the track bias.

### **Too Slow**

Invariably, we will come across a horse that fits the Blue Chip angle and may even be a perfect fit under the winners' profile BUT JUST DOESN'T MATCH UP BEYERWISE WITH OTHER HORSES IN THE FIELD. THE HORSE IS SIMPLY TOO SLOW.

The key to this concept is the horses' age and experience. We should heavily discount the chances of an older horse with established running lines that appear hopelessly slower than the competition *unless the past performances show that the trainer has scored with the horse at boxcar mutuels albeit infrequently.*

On the other hand, a young or lightly-raced horse often has room for improvement. These younger horses provide us with our best opportunity to hit a scud especially in the hands of a skilled trainer. Remember that a runner's Beyers often improve 1.5 ticks per month off the layoff between his final 2-year-old start and his 3-year-old debut. Similar improvement can also occur between ages 3 and 4.

### **Wrong Place, Wrong Time**

Sometimes, even our Blue Chip trainers lose control and enter their horses in impossible spots. These spots include horses that are running at the wrong distance, wrong class level, or maybe on the wrong surface.

## **Past The Layoff Date**

Some of our angles might include playing a horse making its first start off a 31 to 60 day layoff. If you spot a horse that fits the profile BUT is coming off a 65-day layoff, don't jump off the angle. Instead, take a look at the tote. Since this is a marginal situation, you may want to take a pass if the horse is 2-1. Maybe, you'll just use the horse in a Pick 3. However, if the horse is 11-1, you may want to make your regular play.

## **THE ODDS QUALIFIER**

Several of the Blue Chip Angles may have an ODDS qualifier attached. For example, in the '16 WO Blue Chip sample JUSTIN NIXON'S angle reads as follows:

### **Starter Going Off In the 5-1 to 10-1 Odds Range With J.M. Campbell Aboard**

The reason for this qualifier is simple: at the past three WO meets, Glyshaw compiled a 1-for-28 record with starters going off 11-1 and higher. His record with runners in the 5-1 to 10-1 range is far better: 3 for 8

So what happens when a Nixon potential Blue Chipper with an 8-1 ML is sitting at 9-1 through most of the wagering and then drifts up to 12-1 on the last click? There is NO right answer. If the runner took money early that would be a positive sign as opposed to if it opened at 16-1 and then drifted down toward its morning line.

But let's not get too cute here. The authors have played that game many times and gotten burned, leaving some nice payouts on the table. **BOTTOM LINE? DON'T SPLIT HAIRS OVER THE ODDS. DON'T BE A ROBOT HANDICAPPER.** Chances are many of you would've already bet the runner and that would be that.

## **BEING IN THE RIGHT PLACE, AT THE RIGHT TIME**

There is no doubt about it. Unless you are playing the meet every day and paying very close attention, you will miss out on a Blue Chip winner. And there will be days when an angle that hits at a 45% clip doesn't come through. We hope that you cash out on enough Blue Chippers that you are in the black for the long run. And it should play out that way.

But "*Timing is Everything in Life.*" And sometimes we are simply in the right place at the right time. In January 2012, author Mazur was having lunch with his son Andrew at their favorite spot, *Robert's Restaurant*, in Dania Beach, Florida. On the way home, the plan was to stop at *Brooklyn's Water Bagels* and pick up a dozen to go.

But at lunch, Mazur had taken a look at the Gulfstream card and noticed a Darin Miller Blue Chipper as part of the early Pick 4. He decided to skip the bagel run and get home in time to play the Pick 4. Good move. The Blue Chipper flew home to win at 20-1 and keyed a nice IRS payout. If he had stopped for bagels, he would've missed all the fireworks. The Miller angle is reproduced below as is the the winning pp for Diez.





**Bullet Points:**

1. Barker had the following overall record for the meet going into this race: 13-0-0-1
2. The race was a Mdn C/Im \$25k originally carded for the turf at 8f. This race was recarded to the main track at 7f over a sealed sloppy track.
3. Sundae's A Meese was a perennial maiden with 13 lifetime starts including 0/4 on wet tracks. Of the 6 other starters in the race; all had 2 or less starts on a wet track with 4 of the 6 having had only 4-5 starts overall.
4. The switch to Irad Ortiz for this race is a negative move considering that the 3 most recent riders were Shaun Bridgmohan, Ramon Dominguez and Cornelio Velazquez.
5. Additionally, the switch to the main track is a negative as Sundae's A Meese had finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in 5 of it's last 6 turf starts. In this horses' last dirt start it was beaten 18 lengths.

Results: Sundae's A Meese finished 6<sup>th</sup> beaten by 35 lengths at 20-1 odds.
