Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 TWIN B ARCHIE was unable to get near Unevergonnagethis in an OSS Gold tilt on August 25th and was two lengths in arrears to the rival at the wire as the odds-on choice at 4/5. He was overland for much of that mile and tore off his cover more than two weeks prior when he got up to score by three quarters of a length at that same level. This winner of more than \$650,000 has been no worse than second in eight of his nine outings so far as a sophomore and only faces one invader from south of the border in this division of the Simcoe. He will work from the inside of the gate and gets our top honors versus a short field in the opener.

#4 SAFE CONDUCT followed the one above last week and got up alongside that one in the dying strides but had to settle for the show spot under the wire. He was more than two lengths behind the winner but was less than a length away from the one above at the wire when vying for OSS Gold two back. This son of Archangel has hit the board in eight of nine so far this season and will not have too much ground to make up when going against just four other rivals. He looms as the main danger and can be right there at the finish.

#3 CHULO is the lone invader from the United States and disappointed as the 3/5 favorite when going postward in the OHSS in his most recent effort. He finished last in his elimination for the Hambletonian on July 30th but won two of three going into that, including a NW2 event at the Meadowlands where he trotted to his lifetime mark of 1:52.3. This son of What The Hill will have Dave Miller back at the controls and is worth using in the exotics.

#5 DULY RESOLVED has not had the success he enjoyed at the age of two when he was second or better in 10 of 12 and banked over \$630,000. He has hit the board in three of nine so far in his three-year-old campaign and is just under \$2,000 shy of \$100,000 in earnings. This son of Resolve has finished fifth or better in three of his last six and will have to raise his game significantly if he wants to contend for the lion's share. He starts from the outermost post in the contest and the bottom end of the trifecta or super is likely his ceiling.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 COOP A LOOP finished fifth to the unbeaten Stockade Seelster in an OSS Gold event in the previous installment of this race and tried to take on that rival in the first-over position before fading in the stretch. He was more than eight lengths away from that winner in eighth at the finish and was placed up to that same position in the final of the Battle of Waterloo 18 days earlier after going parked for the entire mile from post-seven. This son of All Bets Off was a winner in his lifetime debut at The Meadows on June 25th and was a runner-up at this level in just his second attempt over this surface. He will have Dexter Dunn in the driver's seat for the first time and is worth taking a shot on at what should be a decent price.

#7 WRITE ME A ROSE made a good account of himself when taking on open company on the Grand Circuit when finishing third in the Nassagaweya last week and was just under two lengths away from the highly-regarded Save America under the wire. He started off his season going three-for-three with two victories at this level but was no match for Stockade Seelster in the previous installment of this race. This son of Sportswriter does not have to worry about that rival this time out but must overcome the outermost post in the contest from post-seven.

#4 SANTANA HANOVER improved four positions to finish fourth to Stockade Seelster after getting way eighth off the switch in an OSS Gold contest at Mohawk Park on August 19th. He was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half 55.2 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat. This son of Big Jim was first-over for the entire mile in the Battle Of Waterloo and still managed to finish within a length of winner Sounds Good at 43-1. He will now have driver Yannick Gingras in the sulky for the first time and had never been worse than second in four tries going into his latest.

#5 WHATCHULOOKIN AT just missed by a nose in his latest when he shifted to the inside in the stretch but could not get past Ahi Sunshine before the wire. He started a long first-over bid from fifth at the halfway point and looked like he was going to emerge with the victory in the dying strides before the winner battled back just before the wire. This son of Hes Watching had won two in a row going into that effort, including a victory in the OSS Grassroots. He might have his gas pedal pressed off the switch and can stick around for a share.

#1 MONKEY QUEEN won by nearly 25 lengths when facing much easier rivals in an overnight race in Lexington on August 16th and stopped the clock in 1:53.2 at odds of 1/9. She jumped it off in the Continental Victory at the Meadowlands prior to that and was the runner-up to a pair of decent rivals in July when finishing second to Theresnolimit S and Pink Coco Chanel, who went on to be the bridesmaid in the Hambletonian Oaks. This daughter of Chapter Seven trotted to her lifetime mark of 1:53 flat in her lifetime debut back in June and might be tough to beat in this division of the Simcoe if she can stay on the trot.

#3 MISCHEVIOUS ROSE claimed the show spot in each of her last four at the stakes level and was just over a length away from Adare Castle on August 26th when facing open company in the Casual Breeze. Her lone victory of the season came in NW2 on August 4th but she has hit the board in seven of nine as a sophomore, banking over \$100,000 along the way. This daughter of Muscle Mass has been no worse than fourth in six tries since the addition of lasix back in early June and will not have to chase the foe that dominates her division of the OSS Golds this time around. She figures to be making noise in the late stages and can be right there at the finish.

#6 SAUNDRA exits the same race as the one above and was refunded in that contest because she was deemed to have not received a fair start after making a break in stride behind the gate. She took advantage of the pole position prior to that at Grand River Raceway in an OSS Gold tilt and rode the pocket behind Adare Castle before getting within three quarters of a length of that rival in third at the finish. This daughter of Resolve has made miscues in two of her last three but has been second or better in five of 10 so far this season and is not without a chance in this spot if she can mind her manners. She must work from the outermost post in the contest and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#4 SAMOSA was fifth in her division of the Casual Breeze last week and could only muster a fourth between a pair of outings in overnight races before that. She notched a victory in the PASS earlier in the season and has hit the board in each of her last three at that level in Pennsylvania. This daughter of Cantab Hall won back-to-back races over this surface back in April and picks up the driving services of Tim Tetrick for the second time in her career this evening. She is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

He was a strong runner-up to Lets Get Pickled two back when he was flying in deep stretch after escaping from the pylons at the head of the lane. This son of Betterthancheddar will now drop back down to NW3 and was fourth in this class on July 2nd when he was sent off as the 5/2 favorite. He is one of four that will have a maturity edge on the sophomores in this field and he will be leaving from the pole position. Giving him a whirl and hoping for value.

#8 TWIN B POWERBALL was the runner-up to the streaking Dreamfair Arnie B in his latest when competing at this level and got up in the nick of time to score by a head over Southside Eddy two back. He has hit the board in four of six so far in his aged career and will get another crack at this class tonight. This son of Artspeak gets to work from the center of the gate and was Trevor Henry's choice over Century Inspector. He might utilize his tactical speed in the early stages and can pick up a decent chunk.

#8 CENTURY HEINEKEN rode the cones for most of the mile in the top condition class on August 20th and was three lengths away from the winner Cold Creek Cabo when finishing eighth under the wire. He won two in a row before that with his most recent victory coming in NW10500L5 when he held on by three quarters of a length in 1:50.3 after building up a big lead on his rivals at the top of the lane. This eight-time winner gets major class relief in this NW15000L5 event and gets reunited with driver Doug McNair, who has guided him to seven victories and 17 on the board finishes in the 24 times they have been paired together. Giving him the edge.

#4 LAWLESS SHADOW was in tight quarters in deep stretch when getting up for fifth under the wire in NW20000L5 last week. He blazed home in 26.1 off a back-half in 53.2 and will drop back down a notch on the class ladder this evening. This former Meadowlands Pace champion has not broken through with a victory in his aged career as of yet but has hit the board in each of his last three at this level. He will have Sylvain Filion aboard for the third straight outing and will likely have his gas pedal pressed off the gate.

#5 SOUTHBEACH HANOVER was fourth to Codename Cigar Box in his latest when competing in NW20000L5 and could not hold that rival off two back when he skimmed the cones to get the better of him in deep stretch after he was placed on the lead on the backside at 25-1. This son of Somebeachsomewhere has earned a cheque in all of his last six and will now make his fifth consecutive start on the lasix program. He will likely get forwardly placed from the center of the gate and can hit the ticket.

#6 STOCKADE SEELSTER is a perfect five-for-five to kick off his career and he has not really had to break a sweat in any of those victories. He has won those contests by more than a combined 14 lengths and has gone off as the odds-on favorite in each of his last four. This son of State Treasurer has shown no signs of slowing down and will be looking to make it a fourth straight victory in the OSS Gold ranks. He will only have to best five rivals to keep his unbeaten streak alive and he should make quick work of this group, where only two others have competed at this level before. It is hard to imagine him getting beat in this spot and he should make it six in a row at the shortest of prices.

#2 ACE OF ACES rallied into second to get within two lengths of Tickertape Hanover after getting relegated to the three-hole on the bend for home in the Nassagaweya last week. He willingly chased that winner to the wire and was the runner-up to the one above in an OSS Gold tilt on August 19th before that. This son of Bettors Delight was a convincing winner when he went all the way on the lead in an overnight race to break his maiden near the end of July and has been no worse than fourth in each of his last four. He has been steadily improving for trainer Shawn Steacy and will be our main player underneath.

#1 MOMENT IS HERE was scratched out the most recent installment of this season-long series on August 19th due to lameness and will now return to the races after being out of action for more than a month. He was fourth in the Battle of Waterloo at Grand River Raceway on Industry Day after getting away eighth off the gate and was winner at first asking back in June when he scored by open lengths in his lifetime debut at 65 cents to the dollar. This son of All Bets Off was bet down to 1/5 in his follow-up effort but ran into the freight train that is our top selection and had to settle for second. He might need a start to get back in the swing of things but can still hit the ticket.

#3 VERDUN rallied from a long way out of it to break his maiden in NW1 last week when he blazed home in 26.2 on the heels of a back-half in 54.4. He has hit the board in all of his last four and claimed the show spot in an OSS Grassroots tilt two back. This other son of Bettors Delight got the nod from Louis-Philippe Roy and can round out the trifecta or super with the right kind of trip. He looks overmatched to get anywhere near the business end of this contest but only has to beat one rival to pick up a piece of \$100,000.

#7 ALRAJAH ONE IT has been nothing short of breathtaking when being perfect through his first three starts in North America after shipping over from Europe to join the barn of Ake Svanstedt. He caught everyone's attention when he blew up the tote board in the Crawford Farms Open at the Meadowlands and then made it look easy when scoring from the outermost post in the Spirit of Massachusetts at Plainridge Racecourse. This Italian bred had his momentum broken by his stablemate below when moving forward rapidly on the final turn on Hambo Day in the Cashman but still managed to trot away with condescending ease to the wire. He possesses talent that might be on another level and is our clear choice to take down this installment of the Maple Leaf Trot.

#2 ECURIE D DK was unable to stay with his stablemate above in the stretch after he edged off the cones in front of that rival on the turn for home. He was two lengths back of that winner at the wire and disappointed as the 1/9 favorite in the Crawford Farms Open when he could only watch that foe when he was a going away winner at the wire. This 18-time winner was supposed to be boss of this division but now has had to take a backseat to our top selection but is less than \$50,000 away from \$1M in career earnings. He was a winner in a qualifier at the Meadowlands on August 25th in a tightener for this contest but will likely have to play second fiddle again tonight.

#8 ATLANTA was an easy winner in the 2020 version of this race when she won by four lengths in 1:50.4 and was the runner-up the year before when she could not get to Guardian As before the wire after starting from post-10. She was fifth in the most recent installment of this race last September and was a winner over this surface in the Armbro Flight back in June. This winner of more than \$3.5M is a Hambletonian champion and prepped nicely for tonight's tilt with an easy score in the Open at Mohawk last week. She gets reunited with her regular driver Yannick Gingras but landing on the bottom end of the exotics might be her ceiling.

#5 FASHION FRENZIE is a perfect five-for-five in his four-year-old campaign and most recently dominated his competition in the Honorable Earl Rowe at Georgian Downs when he won by as much as he pleased in 1:52.3. He had not raced in 19 days going into that stakes event and was victorious in three consecutive outings in the Open at Mohawk Park before that. This 16-time winner was a standout in the OSS Program at both two and three but has transitioned nicely into his aged career to now establish himself as a contender against some of the best trotters in the world. He can grab a share.

#1 WARRAWEE XENIA jumped it off in the Casual Breeze last week as the 1/2 odds-on choice when she appeared to be headed for the lead in the opening turn. She was in tight quarters when she made that miscue and has since qualified successfully on the morning of August 30th after making breaks in both of her last two. This daughter of Walner was sent off as the 7/5 favorite in the Hambletonian Oaks before making an early break in stride and took all that support after she won from an impossible spot in her elimination the week before. She blasted home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 54.4 and that victory completed a seven-race win-streak, with six of those victories coming here at Mohawk Park. Bob McClure will be back in her driver's seat and she can rebound in a big way. Top call.

#3 ADARE CASTLE was a winner in the Casual Breeze last week in a race where the one above jumped it off in the early going as the heavy favorite. She seized early control of that contest and then had a comfortable margin for much of the mile before holding on by three quarters of length at the wire. This winner of more than \$920,000 has won four in a row and 13 of 16 so far in her career. She has been a dominant force in the OSS Program and once again establishes herself as the main danger in this follow-up Grand Circuit event.

#6 BABY LONGSTOCKING got a perfect two-hole ride behind the one above last week and got within three quarters of a length of that winner at the wire at 50-1. She has been an improving type throughout her sophomore campaign and has cashed in with a cheque in all of her last eight with six top two finishes over that span. This daughter of Muscle Mass will make her third straight start on the lasix program and any piece of it this evening will push her over \$150,000 in lifetime earnings. She will likely utilize her early foot from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and can hit the ticket.

#2 PENCILS DOWN rounded out the superfecta in her latest when she was just over two lengths back of our top selection at the finish. She was a runner-up two back in NW3 and notched her first victory of the season on August 8th when she went a big trip first-over to score in NW2. This daughter of Royalty For Life has hit the board in six of 13 so far this season and can pick up another decent slice with a favorable journey. She is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super but that is likely her ceiling when having to go postward against our top two choices.

#4 BULLDOG HANOVER had to race from off the pace last week when he was settled back to sixth in a field of seven in his elimination for this event. He latched onto the cover of our third choice and then paced away from his rivals in the stretch to score by more than two lengths under no urging to the wire in 1:48 flat. This 23-time winner has now won nine in a row and became the fastest standardbred of all time on July 16th when he did what was once unthinkable by stopping the clock in 1:45.4 in the Haughton at the Meadowlands. He is a perfect three-for-three over this surface so far this season and is 14 for 19 at Mohawk Park in his career. It has been a spectacular run for this son of Shadow Play and he has shown no signs of slowing down anytime soon. He has the luxury of picking a favorable post for this final of the Canadian Pacing Derby and is not one that we are willing to side against.

#2 JIMMY FREIGHT made a triumphant return to Mohawk Park when he came up the pylons to get past Warrawee Vital in deep stretch in his latest to stop the clock in 1:49.1 at a juicy price of 7/2. He was sidelined due to injury after his dramatic score in the Mohawk Gold Cup on June 18th when he held on by a nose over Linedrive Hanover in 1:48 flat. That victory completed an incredible run that included a monstrous effort to be second in the Battle of Lake Eries at Northfield Park and six straight victories going into that outing, which culminated in the Camluck Classic on May 27th when he emerged victorious over Tattoo Artist. This winner of more than \$1.8M will now make his third start back after a layoff of two months and has been quite the story since returning to the racetrack after retiring to the breeding shed. He will be our main player underneath.

#6 DESPERATE MAN went a big mile to be the runner-up to our top selection in his elimination last week when he forged to the lead from the first-over position but could not hold off the powerful late strides of that winner. He took a big step forward from his last three outings and that helped rekindle a rivalry that was enjoyed in Ontario for much of last season. This other son of Shadow Play got the better of that one in the North America Cup and the OSS Super Final last season but will likely have to settle for a spot somewhere underneath that for this evening. He is trending in the right direction and is worth using everywhere underneath in the exotics.

#8 TATTOO ARTIST claimed the show spot to Bulldog Hanover in his elimination and was charted with broken equipment at the finish. He sat a two hole trip in that contest to a long-priced rival in This Is The Plan. He had to stickhandle for clearance in the stretch and was inching in on the one above for the place spot at the wire. This 27-time winner had won three in a row going into that effort, including the #SendItIn Invitational at Scioto Downs and the Joe Gerrity Jr. Memorial at Saratoga. He will have the circuit's leading teamster in the sulky and can pick up a prize in what is a murderer's row of aged pacers.

This daughter of Big Jim will have to start from the outermost post in this compact field but has proven she can win with any type of trip throughout her career. She is hard to go against but the price will be of the shortest variety.

#4 AWESOME HILL has been the runner-up in all of her last three, with two of those second-place finishes coming to the one above in this class. She was sent to the lead in her latest outing and then gave way to the winner on the bend for home but held on gamely for the place spot over Amazing Dream N. This 11-time winner is making her third straight start on a regular schedule after missing nearly two months of action after being scratched due to sickness on July 30th. She has established herself as the main contender to the one above and can once again complete the exacta.

#5 VOELZ DELIGHT got within three quarters of a length of our top selection when finishing third behind that rival and the one above at this level on August 19th. She got things her own way on the engine in a top condition class the week before that and scored with ease in 1:51.3 at 45 cents to the dollar. This daughter of Bettors Delight has hit the board in all of her last five with three of those efforts coming against the top mares at Mohawk Park but has missed a week coming into this. #2 CODENAME CIGAR BOX has won two in a row in classes below this and lit up the tote board two back in NW16500L5 when he came up the cones from the two-hole to score at 29-1 in 1:49.4. He then blew his rivals away when stepping up to NW20000L5 in his latest and will now try his luck in the top condition class from an inside post position. This 21-time winner is loaded with gate speed and figures to be pushing out for position off the switch. He should be brimming with confidence coming into this and can make it three in a row if the trip is reasonable enough. Giving him the edge.

#6 WHEELS ON FIRE was the runner-up at this level in his latest when he was on the engine for nearly every step before Cold Creek Cabo went past in the dying strides. He disappointed as the 6/5 favorite and has now been the runner-up in two of his last three. This 40-time winner was seventh in the Open two back and that snapped his cheque-getting streak at 50 but he has still managed to hit the board in 28 of his last 32. He has missed a week between starts and typically does his best work when racing on a regular schedule, so we will lean in the direction of the one above this time around.

#7 MAPPOS LION looked our top selection in the eye last week but was turned away by that rival before settling for second as the 2-1 favorite. He had gotten away third off the gate and tried to cruise up in the first-over position but could not get past that leader despite blasting home in 26.4. This 19-time winner had traffic trouble in this class two back and claimed the show spot in the Open prior to that. He must start from the outermost post in the contest but has shown he can race from anywhere.

#1 SINTRA helped fulfill a lifelong dream for driver Anthony MacDonald when he won one of Canada's most prestigious races, the Gold Cup & Saucer, in Charlottetown on August 20th in PEI. He paced away to score by more than five lengths in 1:50.1 over that half-mile surface and was only two ticks slower in his elimination the week prior when he also won by a clear margin. This winner of more than \$1.5M has regained his form when hitting the board in each of his last six since being acquired by The Stable and should be feeling good about himself coming into this. He gets reunited with James MacDonald and can get a piece of it with a decent trip.

#10 WOODMERE STEALDEAL has been doing good work in the mornings with a pair of dominant qualifying victories when getting ready for this return to the races. He scored by 14 lengths on August 30th when he stopped the clock in 1:54.4 with a final quarter in 26.3 over a track that was one second off. This 24-time winner had some rest and relaxation at one of his owner's farms for more than a couple of months and that might be just what he needed. He must start from the dreaded 10-hole but has more than enough tactical speed to get forwardly placed if that is the game plan when racing off the bench. Carmen Auciello typically has them ready to roll and we will try him in this spot before the price likely shortens up in subsequent outings.

#2 CONTROL HEAVEN found room along the pylons in deep stretch but could only get within half a length of Fabrizio N at the wire. He sat in the three-hole for much of the mile and banged home in 25.3 but still disappointed as the 3/5 favorite. This son of Control The Moment steps up a notch on the class ladder but should still be more than competitive with this group. He will leave from the inside of the gate and can be right there at the wire once again.

#6 FABRIZIO N has won two in a row since returning north of the border to Mohawk Park and to the barn of trainer Duane Marfisi. He has now won his last three starts over this surface and that prior victory came in this class back in February before he hit the road for the Meadowlands. This 14-time winner should be brimming with confidence and might be sent to the lead again from the winningest post at Mohawk Park. He merits respect and should not be taken lightly.

#5 COMMANDING OFFICER could not fire in his latest in NW6000L5 when he was hammered down to favoritism at 3/2. He settled for third under the wire in that contest when racing back on a regular rotation after missing most of July. This 10-time winner has now missed another few weeks before making this first start out of the barn of trainer Jean Tourigny and we have seen horses moving in this direction have success recently. He might raise his game this evening and is worth a look if the price is right.

#9 ROCKME ROLLME was overland for much of the mile in his latest before finishing third in this class and was only beaten three quarters of a length in fourth two back at this level. He has raced well in each of his efforts since returning from a layoff of nearly a month and would have likely been rated higher if not for the tricky starting spot. This 17-time winner fits well with this group and should be included on the bottom end of the exotics.

C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

In the unlikely event that bets can not be combined into a host track's pursly from the end of a race, Federal Regulations require that such bets must be refunded. Refunding bets at some sites can affect odds and payouts at the remaining sites.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
