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# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

**Helpful facts for betting**

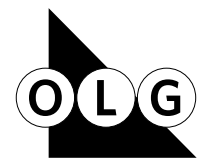
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

**3 Tips to remember**

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#### Race 1 Selections

#### THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#5 GOLDIN GREATNESS** pushed out hard from the pole position in his latest to secure the pocket at the quarter pole but was relegated back to fourth on the backside before slipping out in the second-over position behind Save America on the bend for home. He could not stay with that rival in the stretch and faded back to seventh under the wire to be nearly eight lengths away from that winner. This son of Huntsville had hit the board in four straight going into that effort and broke his maiden on September 1st when Dexter Dunn hopped aboard for the first time. He is one of a few in the field that had to do some racing last week before missing out on the final and gets our nod to take down the consolation for the Metro.

**#2 STORMALONG** got away fifth off the gate from post-two in his elimination last week and was shuffled back to last before advancing along the cones with some pace in the stretch drive. He was five lengths away from the winner Tip Top Cat under the wire and paced his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.3. This son of Stay Hungry finished 10th in the Champlain two back after starting from the trailing post but was no worse than third in his previous four tries at Mohawk Park. He will work from the inside of the gate and can be right there at the wire.

**#4 HUNGRY MAN** exits the same elimination as our top choice and got away ninth off the switch from post-nine in that contest to be 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He paced his back-half in 52.3 with a final quarter in 26.2 and advanced to sixth before the wire but was more than seven lengths away from the winner Save America at the finish. This son of Sweet Lou has had to contend with that tricky starting spot in both of his last two and will now leave from a favorable post position in the four-hole after having post-seven or worse in his last three. He might get forwardly placed this time around and can land somewhere on the ticket.

**#6 HURRIKANE HUNTER** tried to make his presence felt on the turn for home last week but then tired in the stretch and faded back to eighth under the wire. He was used hard in the early stages of the NYSS Final one week earlier at Tioga Downs and was the runner-up by a neck to our top selection at the Meadowlands in division of the Kindergarten on September 1st. This other son of Huntsville will be making his second attempt out of the barn of trainer Rob Fellows and will once again have Yannick Gingras at the controls. He should not be easily dismissed and is worth using in the exotics.

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**RACE 2 SCRATCH TIME CHANGES**

TRUFFLES TOO Trevor Henry to Dexter Dunn

**#8 FASHION FRENZIE** was sent to the early lead in the Maple Leaf Trot before releasing Atlanta on the backside and then popped the pocket early on the final turn but could not hold off a trio of trotters in the stretch. He did a lot of racing in that contest before having to settle for fourth and had rhymed off five straight victories to kick off his aged career going into that effort. This 16-time winner was dominant in the Earl Rowe at Georgian Downs on September 3rd after missing nearly three weeks of action and won three in a row at this level before that. He has been handed the outermost post by the race office and looks primed to return to the winner's circle when getting back down to palatable competition.

**#7 PATRIARCH HANOVER** sat an inside trip on September 12th in this class and had to wait for clearance in the stretch before emerging as the runner-up to a strong winner in Forbidden Trade. He blasted home in 27 seconds flat off a back-half in 55.3 and has now been second in each of his last two. This 15-time winner has hit the board in 17 of 27 so far this season and is just shy of \$170,000 in earnings. He must slide out three spots on the gate this evening but will still be one of our main players underneath.

**#4 DREAM NATION** was an impressive winner in NW2000L5 on September 13th when he got past Hp Mama B in the stretch after making a first-over bid on the final turn and managed to equal his lifetime mark of 1:52.3. He has fired home in 26.3 in each of his last two and has only missed out on a cheque in three of his 28 outings this season. This 18-time winner notched a pair of victories at the Preferred level early in the season and will now get the nation's leading driver James MacDonald at the reins for the first time. He is taking a significant step back up the class ladder but can land somewhere on the ticket with the right kind of trip.

**#6 HP ROYAL THEO** claimed the show spot at this level in his latest when he was two lengths back of the winner Forbidden Trade at the wire. He blew up the tote board at 28-1 when he completed a two-race win-streak in the Preferred on September 5th and was no worse than second in seven straight prior to his most recent effort. This 15-time winner has hit the board in 10 straight and will pick up the driving services of Tim Tetrick with J-Mac opting to pilot the one above. He has been racing at the top of his game and can make his presence felt from the winningest post on the circuit.

**#7 COLD CREEK QUESO** got away fifth off the switch from post-10 in NW12000L5 last week and finished up strongly when rapidly closing the gap on a trio of pacers that broke away from the field. He was just over two lengths away from the winner Cadillac Bayama at the finish in fourth and paced his back-half in 52.1 with a final quarter in 25.3. This son of Betterthancheddar had no right to make up that kind of ground in that contest and was stepping way up in class after pacing to a new lifetime mark in NW3 two weeks prior. He slides in a few spots on the gate this evening and will race back on a regular schedule. Giving him the nod and hoping for value.

**#2 THATLL BE SPORTY** exits the same race as the one above and was never a factor in that contest after getting away last off the gate from post-nine. He claimed the show spot two back when bet down to favoritism at 2-1 and had picked up a share in seven straight prior to his latest. This 11-time winner has a maturity edge over many of his rivals in this race as one of three four-year-olds in the event and will have driver Tim Tetrick in the driver's seat for the first time. He gets to work from an inside starting spot this time around and merits consideration.

**#5 KOLBY TWO STEP** was not able to advance a position after getting away seventh from post-four last week and was more than nine lengths away from our top choice under the wire. He had not raced in more than three weeks going into that outing and was a strong winner in an OSS Gold tilt on August 26th when he went most of the way on the lead before stopping the clock in 1:51.2. This other son of Betterthancheddar has won two of his last four at that level and might be more forwardly placed this evening. He gets back into a regular rotation but does have more important engagements coming up on his schedule.

**#9 RON** has hit the board in four of his last five and most recently finished as the runner-up to Fourever Boy in the Simcoe on September 10th. He was more than two lengths back of that rival under the wire but paced his own mile in 1:49.2 with a final panel in 26.2. This son of Sportswriter is just one for 12 on the season but has been no worse than third in his four tries in the OSS Gold ranks and completed the superfecta in the North America Cup back in June. He must overcome the outermost post in the contest but can grab a share if his trip is not too taxing.

She released a pair of rivals to sit in the three-hole for much of the mile and skimmed the cones in the stretch to get up for third before the wire. This 12-time winner was fourth in her elimination the week prior and got within half a length of Dabarndawgswatchin in second when competing in NW1500L5 on September 2nd when she had not raced in nearly a month. She will have Tim Tetrick back in the sulky and gets the nod.

**#9 VOELZ DELIGHT** was a strong winner in the F&M-Preferred last week when she paced away from her rivals in the stretch after sitting a perfect pocket trip for most of the mile. She was sent to the early lead from post-six and released the one below before coming back around that rival with ease in the lane. This 10-time winner stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:49.3 and has hit the board in seven of nine so far in her aged career. She has raced well since moving to the barn of trainer Jean Tourigny but has been handed a difficult starting assignment this evening with the outermost in the contest.

**#7 WESTERN WISH** had to settle for the place spot last week and was more than two lengths in arrears to the one above at the finish after having the lead for much of that contest. She has hit the board in six of her last seven since returning north of the border to Mohawk Park and has won two her last five, with both of those victories coming at the NW1500L5 level. This 15-time winner was fourth or better in her two tries in this class and will likely try to get forwardly placed again this week from post-seven. She is likely a notch below the two above but can still land somewhere on the ticket with a decent trip.

**#5 AWESOME HILL** exits the same race as the two above and picked up a minor award in that contest when finishing fifth under the wire. She was more than five lengths back of our second choice at the wire but was the runner-up in three consecutive starts in August. This 11-time winner was second to So Much More at this level in two of those outings and might show more interest tonight if she is put into play at the start from the center of the gate. She should be more than competitive with this group and is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

He sat an inside trip in his latest and skimmed the cones in the stretch to score by half a length over the one above in a new lifetime mark of 1:50.3. This 11-time winner has managed to find room up the inside late in the mile to claim victory in both of his last two and has now won three of his last four overall. He has had luck on his side as of late and might need something similar to happen this evening for him to triple-up in the culminating race of the series.

**#11 WARRAWEE XENIA** did not have much of a chance last week when she got away seventh off the gate and was a major pace disadvantage to our third-choice, who went all the way on the front-end. She was more than nine lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and was only able to advance to third after trotting her back-half in 53.3 with a final quarter in 26.2. This daughter of Walner was an impressive winner in the Simcoe when she was unhurried on the rim before confidently getting past Adare Castle in the dying strides and was electrifying when emerging victorious from an improbable spot in her elimination for the Hambletonian Oaks. She has been hampered with the dreaded trailing post but should start her charge earlier this time around when there is \$350,000 on the line in this final of the Elegantimage.

**#4 RAISED BY LINDY** was third in the New Jersey Classic on September ninth when she completed the trifecta behind the likes of Hambletonian Oaks Fashion Schooner and Jiggy Jog S. She sat in the pocket for much of that mile behind the odds-on winner and blew her competition off the track in an Open Handicap in Lexington two back when she stopped the clock in 1:51.2. This other daughter of Walner had missed more than three weeks going into that victory after finishing sixth in a Hambletonian Oaks elimination that was won by our top choice and will now make her first attempt at Mohawk Park. She looks like she is primed for a big effort and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#1 MON CHEVAL** got things her own way last week after getting to the lead just past the quarter marker after the opening panel was set in just 28.2 in a race that essentially played out as a prep for this prestigious stakes event. She trotted her middle-half in 56.1 and did not give anyone an opportunity to run her down when opening a healthy margin with a final panel in 27.2. This daughter of Father Patrick had competed in three consecutive major stakes events south of the border prior to that and fits well with this group. She should be confident coming into this but will have to motor off the gate to get into a favorable spot from the pole position.

**#9 ADARE CASTLE** has dominated her rivals in the OSS Gold ranks again this season and has won six of nine overall as a sophomore, with her only off the board finish coming last week when vying for one of the lowest purses of her career. She was unhurried in the early going in fifth and finishing fourth in that contest should not be held against her. This 13-time winner was the runner-up to our top selection in the Simcoe after setting a reasonable tempo on the engine and is just under \$57,000 shy of \$1M in career earnings. She will have to overcome a tricky starting spot in post-nine but is more than good enough to get a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

**#4 SAVE AMERICA** was confidently handled in his elimination when he marched up first-over from sixth on the bend for home and wore down the leader before scoring by a comfortable length at the finish. He stopped the clock in 1:49.4 after blazing home in 26.3 and has now won four in a row, with three of those victories coming at Mohawk Park. This son of Captaintreacherous dug deep in the stretch drive of the Champlain when it looked like he might be collared by Ace of Aces and will now race back on a regular schedule for the second straight start. He seems to get better every time he steps on the track and has established himself as the clear one to beat.

**#5 MOMENT IS HERE** made a huge move to the lead on the backside and blasted his own third-panel in 26.1 to have a clear lead when he tripped the three quarter marker in 1:22.4. He was unable to hold off the above in dying strides but was clearly the best of the rest when maintaining a healthy margin over the third-place finisher. This son of All Bets Off has hit the board in three straight since missing a month of action after a vet scratch due to lameness on August 19th and has only missed the board twice out of eight career outings thus far. He got a favorable draw with post-five and can once again land underneath if he can keep trending in the right direction.

**#2 STOCKADE SEELSTER** was intent on cutting the mile in his elimination last week when he refused to let the one below clear in the early going and then chopped out the first three panels in 27, 55 and 1:23. He began to weaken in mid-stretch and was passed on both sides when Tip Top Cat was victorious up the pylons and Tickettape Hanover got past on the outside for the place spot. This son of State Treasurer was a perfect six-for-six before that and was untouchable in all of those efforts, including four easy scores in the OSS Gold ranks. He will start from the inside of the gate and might rebound in a big way.

**#8 TICKERTAPE HANOVER** was parked around the first turn when the one above would not release him to the lead and had to take a tuck in the pocket behind that rival. She rode shotgun in the two-hole for much of the mile and then got past that leader in deep stretch but had to settle for the runner-up spot behind Tip Top Cat, who skimmed the cones to victory. This son of Huntsville has been second or better in each of his last four and was a winner in his first try over this surface on August 27th when he won by open lengths in the Nassagaweya in 1:51.2. He will race back in a regular rotation this evening and will likely be put into play off the switch from post-eight.

**#7 BRANDED BY LINDY** notched just his second victory of the season when he trotted past the favorite Rebuff in the stretch drive of the Kentucky Championship Series Final last Sunday in Lexington, stopping the clock in 1:50.3 with a final quarter in 26.3. He was fourth or better in three consecutive preliminary legs for that event but did not have much to offer in his elimination for the Hambletonian on July 30th when he faded back to last under the wire. This 10-time winner might be rounding into form at the right time and should be feeling good about himself coming into this. Giving him the edge.

**#9 PRETENDER** was the winner of the New Jersey Classic at the Meadowlands on September 9th and popped out of the pocket on the final turn in that contest before scoring by three quarters of a length at the wire. He only had to take on three other rivals in that \$275,000 stakes event but was a strong runner-up to Temporal Hanover in the Beal before that and has hit the board in nine of his last 10 overall. This son of Muscle Hill will have to overcome a difficult starting post with post-nine but has more than enough early foot to get into a decent position off the gate. He figures to take support at the windows and merits respect.

**#5 SLAY** faded to third under the wire as the lukewarm 5/2 favorite in the NYSS Final on September 10th and was just over two lengths away from the Hambletonian champion Cool Papa Bell in third. He had won two at that level going into that championship event and took support to the tune of 11-1 in his elimination for the Hambo back on July 30th. This son of Chapter Seven has won three of his last five overall and will now make first start north of the border in the Canadian Trotting Classic. He might get spotted well in the early going from the center of the gate and can add some value to the ticket.

**#3 KEG STAND** went a long way on the lead in both of his last two but had to settle for runner-up finishes by slim margins in both of those contests. He could not hold off Pour Mea Double in the final of the PASS in his latest after building up a big lead in the stretch and was only beaten by a nose to Rebuff two back when almost stealing a victory on the engine at 23-1 in Lexington. This son of Bar Hopping has been second or better in four of seven so far as a sophomore and has gotten a favorable spot on the gate with post-three. He will have Todd McCarthy at the controls for the first time and can grab a share.

**#1 OH WELL** has only tasted defeat once in his last four and that came at the hands of Kilmister in the Peter Haughton Memorial at the Meadowlands on Hambo Day. He disappointed as the 3/5 favorite on that occasion but was clearly the best of the rest when finishing well clear of the third-place finisher. This son of Muscle Hill returned to the races more than a month later and rebounded with a front-end victory in the New Jersey Classic, stopping the clock in 1:53.4 as the odds-on choice. He will now ship north of the border to compete for a \$1M in this dynamic stakes event and should be able to give this group all they can handle.

**#6 WINNERS BET** went forward off the gate from post-10 last week in the Champlain Stakes and was sent wide to the opening turn before trudging on to the lead at the halfway marker. He had to work hard to get to the front and then immediately had to take on a first-over challenge from Ghostly Casper but could not hold off the fresh legs of Gaines Hanover, who got a sweet ride behind him in the pocket. This son of Walner had not raced in nearly three weeks since punching his golden ticket for this event when winning the William Wellwood Memorial on August 27th and should benefit from already having three outings over this surface. He will start from the winningest post at Mohawk Park this time around and can be right there at the wire.

**#8 DWS POINT MAN** has won two in a row in the OSS Gold ranks since shipping north of the border to join the barn of the circuit's leading trainer Richard Moreau. He has been no worse than second in his last six overall and turned heads on August 12th when he scored by more than a length in his first outing at Mohawk Park in a new lifetime mark of 1:57.1 and then shaved a tick off that time more than three weeks later when he doubled-up at that level over the half-mile surface at Flamboro Downs. This son of My MVP has done everything right for his new connections and should not be taken lightly. He is an intriguing option but might have to settle for a spot somewhere underneath when going up against the likes of the two above.

**#4 YO BETH D** is an invader from Indiana that has won four of her last five in the ISS with her only blemish over that span coming when she made a miscue two back on August 30th. She held on by a nose in her latest after rhyming off the opening two panels in 27 seconds flat and 55.3 but demolished her competition by 11 lengths on August 17th when she trotted to a career best clocking of 1:54.3. This daughter of Helpisontheday has only tasted defeat twice in her seven lifetime tries but now enters much deeper waters when vying for \$1M this evening. She will have her regular driver Trevor Smith aboard and should not be ruled out of the exotics.

**#8 POINTS NORTH** was a late scratch due to sickness on September 10th when scheduled to make his return to Mohawk Park and first start back under the care of trainer Carmen Auciello. He has spent his last 13 starts stateside and had four wins and six on the board finishes over that span but now returns to a circuit where he was racing at the Preferred level back in April. This 33-time winner was fourth in a race that was won by Jimmy Freight on that occasion but was an impressive winner the week prior in NW24000L5 when stopping the clock in 1:49.3. He scored with ease the last time he competed in this class back in October of last year and has won four of his last 11 for this outfit. Giving him our top honors again and hoping for a decent price from the outside of the gate.

**#2 COMMANDING OFFICER** had the throttle down last week when he paced his own middle-half in 53.3 when setting up shop on the front-end but could not hold off a pair of rivals before the wire. He was beaten by less than a length to both Cadillac Bayama and Legion Seelster, who both towed along behind him in the three-hole and pocket, respectively. This 11-time winner was a lights-out winner two back in NW6000L5 when he scored by three lengths in 1:49.2 and was cemented along the cones the start before that. He has been doing good things since moving to the barn of Jean Tourigny and will get another crack at this class with Dexter Dunn in the bike.

**#3 WHICHWAYTOTHEBEACH** has taken on much tougher competition in the Open Handicap in both of his last two but could only muster a sixth-place finish in NW20000L5 before that and was seventh in the top condition class on August 20th after getting roused to move forward in the first-over position from the three-hole. This winner of nearly \$680,000 will likely take a lot of support based on the significant drop down in class but we need to see more from him before we are willing to put him on top. He will have Mark MacDonald in the driver's seat for the fourth time in his career and can hit the ticket.

**#1 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER** followed rivals around in eighth for much of the mile last week and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He managed to advance two positions before the wire and paced his back-half in 52.2 with a final quarter in 26 seconds flat. This 19-time winner was victorious from off the pace in NW10000L5 on August 20th and will pick up the driving services of Jody Jamieson this evening. He might have a sneaky chance from the pole position and should not be ruled out of the trifecta and super.

He most recently landed the three-hole from post-seven in an Open Handicap that was won by Tattoo Artist and was just over three lengths away from that rival at the wire when pacing his own mile in 1:47.4. This 13-time winner went a tick faster when finishing in that same position to Bulldog Hanover two back in the Canadian Pacing Derby and has now finished third in all of his last four. He was an impressive front-end winner from post-seven in NW17000L5 over this surface back in July and he has a good chance to return to the winner's circle if similar tactics are deployed tonight.

**#3 CARBINE** finished fourth in NW20000L5 at the Meadowlands on September 10th when making his first start back after a hiatus of more than two months. He was only beaten by half a length at the wire and paced his mile in 1:49.3 with a final quarter in 26.3. This 10-time winner was victorious in a leg of the Graduate on June 4th and paced to his lifetime mark of 1:47.4 one week prior to that as the overwhelming favorite in an overnight event. He has missed a week between outings but should benefit from getting his most recent effort under his belt and looms as a danger.

**#5 AMERICAN HISTORY** has not had much of a chance in his last two when he got away eighth off the switch from post-eight and had a double-digit lengths deficit at the quarter pole in both of those outings. He improved three positions to finish fifth last week and paced his back-half in 51.3 with a final quarter in 26 seconds flat. This 32-time winner will now face an easier group overall and will start from the center of the gate in his second straight start on a regular rotation. He was Sylvain Filion's choice over Cold Creek Cabo and figures to be handled much more aggressively this time around.

**#7 CODENAME CIGAR BOX** emerged victorious in the Open Handicap two back at 7-1 in his first attempt at that level and was fourth in his latest when coming right back in that class at the same price on the board. He was second or better in each of his prior five going into this latest and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. This 22-time winner must start from the outermost post in the contest but should be able to make his presence felt and can pick up a decent chunk with a favorable journey. He cannot be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

He had built up a huge margin on his foes in that contest after pacing his own middle-half in 53.4 and now steps back up the class ladder in his fourth start back after a hiatus of more than three months. This 25-time winner will get to work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and has proven he is more than capable of claiming victory against this level of competition in the past. He should be feeling good about himself and will be our main player underneath.

**#7 FLYINGEVENBETTOR N** has competed in tougher classes in each of his last four and will get down to a more palatable spot tonight in this NW12000L5 event. He has had to work from tricky starting spots in two of his last three and was a winner at the level just below this on August 13th when he paced his mile in 1:50.3. ### CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
