Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
|----------|---------------------|---|
| Win | U U U | Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds. |
| Place | U U | Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show. |
| Show | U | Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs. |

Exotic multiple-horse bets

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
|----------------------------------|---------------------|---|
| Exacta* | U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds. |
| Daily double | U U U U U | Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races. |
| Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6 | U U U U U U | Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager. |
| Triactor* | U U U U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses. |
| Superfecta* | U U U U U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible. |

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

| Odds | 1/2 | 2/1 | 7/2 | 5/1 | 10/1 |
|------|--------|--------|--------|---------|---------|
| Pays | \$3.00 | \$6.00 | \$9.00 | \$12.00 | \$22.00 |

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#7 BROOKDALE MIKI stayed on the cones in his latest and was shuffled back to last on the bend for home before catching fire in deep stretch to get up for the show spot. He paced his back-half in 54.3 with a final quarter in 26.2 and was doing his best work in the last sixteenth of a mile. This son of Always B Miki's first priority was likely to get a flat line under his belt after jumping it off in the slop two back and was also flying late in his first start over this surface on September 20th when he only missed by a head at the wire. He might get handled more aggressively this time around and will be hard to hold off if he can stay on his gait. Giving him the nod in the opener.

#1 DONT POKE THE BEAR was a runner-up in his latest when being sent off as the even-money favorite and has been no worse than third in each of his last four. He returned from a layoff of nearly six weeks on October 6th and has turned in a pair of decent efforts over the last couple of weeks. This son of Betterthancheddar is still winless through 28 lifetime tries but has hit the board in nine of 17 so far this season. He picks up the driving services of Dexter Dunn and that might finally get him to victory lane for the first time in the 29th start of his career.

#2 CONTROL THE SMILE has finished fourth in two of his last three over this surface and has been no worse than sixth in his five tries at Mohawk Park since transitioning from the B-tracks in early September. He has been put into play from outside draws in both of his last two and was second or better in each of the first three starts of his career at Grand River Raceway in the summer. This son of Control The Moments slides down to the inside of the gate this evening and will have Trevor Henry in the driver's seat for the first time in his career. He is not out of place against this group and is worth a look if the price is right.

#10 BETTER SUNSET has been freshened up for over a month and has not missed a cheque in any of his four career outings so far. He was only beaten by two lengths in fourth in his most recent effort on September 20th and claimed the show spot in back-to-back starts prior to that. This son of Bettors Delight might need a start to get back in the swing of things and was not done any favors at the post draw when getting the 10-hole. He has enough tactical speed to get into a decent spot off the gate and can pick up a decent slice if his trip is not too taxing. Bob McClure picks up the drive.

#9 WINNERS BET was the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial at Mohawk Park on August 27th and was then used hard from post-10 in the Champlain more than two weeks later before he jumped it off in the late stages of the Mohawk Million. He appeared to be gearing up when moving three-wide on the bend for home when he made that miscue and has since finished second to Volume Eight in a stakes event in Lexington. This son of Walner must overcome the outermost post in the contest but was able to navigate his way into contention from an even worse starting spot in the Champlain. He has hit the board in seven of eight so far in his rookie campaign and has our top honors in the first Breeders Crown elimination of the evening.

#7 CROWN was the runner-up to Espresso in each of his last two in Lexington and most recently disappointed as the 4/5 favorite when he went a long way on the lead before getting nailed at the wire by that rival. He won four in a row to kick off his career and was then hard used in the early going of the NYSS Final at Tioga Downs before fading to finish seventh under the wire at 25 cents to the dollar in a race where the one below emerged victorious. This son of Chapter Seven is versatile in his racing style but will likely make his presence felt off the switch. He has been in good order coming into this and is among the top chances.

#6 THE GRUFFALO made a miscue in his latest at Freehold after dropping into the two-hole behind the odds-on choice on the spin for home and would have been no worse than second if not for that mishap. That stands as the lone time that he finished outside of the top two and he was a winner in the final of the NYSS on August 13th and won all three of his preliminary races for that season-long event. This other son of Chapter Seven will start from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and might appreciate getting back on a bigger racing surface. He can hit the ticket. Todd McCarthy picks up the steer.

#5 GAINES HANOVER did not have much of a chance in his latest when he took on older horses in NW3 and was trapped inside for much of the mile. He was shuffled back to seventh in the stretch and advanced two positions before the wire when trotting home in 26.4 off a back-half in 56.3. This son of Cantab Hall was an upset winner in the Champlain on September 15th when he got past our top choice in deep stretch and was third to that rival in his elimination for the Wellwood before making a break in stride at the start in the final. He will work from the center of the gate and has home field advantage.

#4 SYLVIA HANOVER is six for seven so far in her career with her only blemish coming when she had the disadvantage of starting from the second-tier over this surface in the second round of the Whenuwishuponastar back in early August. She has rhymed off five in a row since then as the odds-on favorite and most recently captured the Shes A Great Lady by three quarters of a length over Charleston. This daughter of Always B Miki has gotten better every time she steps out on the track and paced home in less than 27 seconds in all but one of her career efforts. She has been off for nearly a month going into this elimination for the Breeders Crown but is hard to look past at what will be another short price.

#7 MCSEASIDE is currently riding a two-race win-streak and was most recently victorious in a stakes event in Lexington on October 7th when she was sent off as the odds-on choice and won by a comfortable margin. She took down the championship event for the OHSS prior to that at Dayton Raceway and has hit the board in six of eight in her rookie campaign with over \$280,000 stashed away so far. This daughter of Downbytheseaside is another that has progressed nicely throughout the season and will get paired back with driver Dexter Dunn after that teamster guided to victory lane in her latest. She must start from the outermost post in the contest but has proven she can be versatile in her racing style.

#1 PROUD MARY finished fifth in the Shes A Great Lady on September 24th after starting a first-over bid before the turn for home. She was never able to get near our top selection but was only a quarter of a length away from the show spot under the wire. This daughter of Sweet Lou turned in a decent effort to be third in her elimination for that stakes event and finished in the same position when going postward in the final of the PASS prior to that. She has hit the board in six of eight so far in her career and will start from the pole position.

#5 LIGHT AND TIGHT closed nicely in her latest in Lexington when she completed the trifecta at 38-1 in a stakes event that was won by Twin B Joe Fresh. She banged home in 26.1 on the heels of a back-half in 54 seconds flat and has finished third in her last two over that one-mile surface. This daughter of American Ideal was a winner in the Reynolds on September 23rd at Tioga Downs and has hit the board in her last five after going on the shelf for nearly two months after her lifetime debut back in early July. She should be brave coming into this and is worth using in the exotics. Todd McCarthy picks up the steer.

#2 OH WELL was a dominant winner in the Mohawk Million when he opened up a wide margin on his rivals in the stretch before scoring by just over two lengths at the wire in 1:53.4. He was victorious in the New Jersey Classic prior to that but had no answers for Kilmister in the stretch of the Peter Haughton Memorial on Hambo Day at the Meadowlands when he disappointed at 70 cents to the dollar. This son of Muscle Hill has been second or better in all six of his career outings so far and has amassed a bankroll that is more than four times greater than any of his rivals in the contest with nearly \$860,000 stashed away. He also gets a post position advantage over most of his main challengers with post-two and is hard to look past.

#8 INTERNATIONAL MAN was third in a stakes event in Lexington in his latest and competed on this surface for three straight outings prior to that. He was third in the Champlain when sent off as the 4/5 odds-on choice on September 15th and was only beaten by three quarters of a length to his stablemate Winners Bet in the Wellwood Memorial. This son of International Moni has hit the board in all six of his career efforts so far but will have to overcome an outside draw with post-eight. He will likely have his gas pedal pressed off the switch and can loom as a danger with the right kind of trip. Dexter Dunn picks up the steer.

#9 CELEBRITY BAMBINO was an easy winner in NW2 at Pocono Downs on October 11th when getting a tightener for this event and notching his second victory of his career. He shared second with Gates Hanover when finishing in a dead heat behind our top selection in the New Jersey Classic prior to that and has only missed the board in one of his seven lifetime tries so far. This son of Muscle Hill retains the services of Yannick Gingras and that teamster opted to stick with him over the one above. He must start from the outermost post in the contest but is capable of making his way onto the ticket.

#7 DIRE STRAITS was caught behind a wall of horses for much of the stretch drive in the final of the Kentucky Championship Series on September 18th and was a winner in back-to-back preliminary divisions of that event in August. He won four out of five to begin his career and has now been freshened up when coming into this elimination for the Breeders Crown. This other son of Muscle Hill comes into this off a decent looking qualifier on October 11th and might be worth a look if the price is right. He is worth keeping an eye on and should not be dismissed from the bottom end of the exotics.

She deployed similar tactics two back when capturing the final of the Kentucky Championship Series on September 18th and she blasted home in 26.3 in back-to-back outings over that one-mile surface prior to that. This daughter of Walner has only been worse than second once in seven career efforts and has banked nearly \$385,000 along the way. She should be brimming with confidence coming into this and is difficult to side against.

#3 WALNER PAYTON got back to the winner's circle for the first time since July when she got away from the one above in her latest and cruised to a four-length score in 1:52.2 at the Red Mile. She had to face our top selection in all of her previous five and was the runner-up to that foe in each of her last four. This other daughter of Walner was victorious in the NJSS Final on July 22nd and has hit the board in eight of 10 so far in her career, never finishing worse than fourth in any of her races over that span. She will work from a favorable spot on the gate but will once again run into her nemesis that she has never been able to get the better of.

#1 MAMBACITA has won two in a row in Lexington and scored comfortably in both of those outings, winning by a combined margin of more than five lengths. She set a new lifetime mark two back when she stopped the clock in 1:53.2 but had to settle for fourth before that when going up against the two above in the final of the Kentucky Championship Series. This daughter of Tactical Landing has hit the board in seven of nine and like the one above, has never been worse than fourth in any of her career efforts. She will start from the pole position and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#8 SECRET VOLO is just one for nine in her rookie campaign but has hit the board in seven of those outings to bank more than \$164,000. She was a runner-up to our second choice in her latest in Lexington and claimed the show spot to our top selection prior to that. This filly had a big lead in the stretch of the New Jersey Classic before getting caught right on the money by Quick Stop and might get overlooked on the odds board in this elimination event. She has enough early foot to get spotted in a favorable spot off gate from post-eight and can grab a share.

This daughter of Downbytheseaside prepared for this contest with a strong qualifying score at Harrah's Philly on October 11th and will get the luxury of starting from a post position that has had all kinds of success this season at Mohawk Park. She has never been worse than second in any of her seven career efforts so far and looks like the one to beat.

#8 STRONG POISON was the runner-up to Twin B Joe Fresh in her latest in Lexington and was a winner two back when she got up by a neck as the odds-on favorite. She has spent her last seven competing on that one-mile oval and went a monster mile in a preliminary division of the Kentucky Championship Series on August 22nd when she scored by nine lengths and stopped the clock in 1:49.3. This daughter of Always B Miki has to settle for second in the final of that summer-long series but has only missed out on a top two finish in two of her 10 lifetime attempts and those came when she made back-to-back miscues in July. She looms as a danger and will be our main player underneath.

#5 SAVETHELASTDANCE was a runaway freight train in an OSS Super Final last week when she rocketed to the lead from the post-10 and chopped out the opening three panels in 26.1, 53.4 and 1:22 flat before getting tired in the stretch drive. She ended up finishing fourth under the wire in a race that was won by Cheesy Smile and was likely sent on a front-end mission because of the traffic trouble she got into two back. This daughter of Bettors Delight has shown incredible talent at multiple times in her rookie campaign and might have upset potential if her speed can be throttled tonight. She is worth a look if the price is right and is worth using in the exotics.

#2 ZANATTA is just one for eight to kick off her career but has managed to hit the board in six of those efforts on her way to banking nearly \$170,000. She was second to McSeaside in her most recent effort in Lexington after blasting out for early position from the nine-hole and was only a length away from that rival under the wire. This daughter of Stay Hungry's lone victory came when she scored in a division of the Kentucky Commonwealth Series on August 14th and she does not look out of place against this group from an inside starting spot. She might be able to work out a favorable trip to pick up a piece.

He was nine lengths off the lead at the quarter pole in seventh and then paced his back-half in 53.3 with a final quarter in 27 seconds flat to stop the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:49.2. This son of Sweet Lou has won four in a row by a combined margin of 13 lengths but has not raced in over a month coming into this effort. He will work from the most successful starting spot at Mohawk Park and has our vote of confidence.

#10 SAVE AMERICA disappointed at odds of 1/9 in his latest at the Red Mile after grinding it out in the first-over position and was beaten by a head at the wire by Mamba, who came up the pylons from the two-hole in deep stretch. He has now fallen to defeat as the favorite in both of his last two and could not fend off the late legs of Stockade Seelster in the Metro over this surface on September 24th. This son of Captaintreacherous was widely considered to be the top two-year-old pacer prior to that when he reeled off four straight victories and appeared to be getting stronger every time he stepped on the track. He can rebound in a big way but must overcome the toughest of post positions to do so.

#1 LYONS SURFING was a strong winner in Lexington on September 30th when he powered away from his rivals to score by more than five lengths in 1:50.2 and demolished his competition two back at Harrah's Philly when he stopped the clock in 1:51.2 at 30 cents to the dollar. He was fifth in the PASS Final in early September and hit the board in three of his four starts in preliminary divisions in that series. This son of Stay Hungry has been off for three weeks coming into this but produced a good looking qualifier on October 11th in preparation for this effort. He loses Tim Tetrick to our top selection and picks up the driving services of Andrew McCarthy.

#9 GOLDIN GREATNESS exits the same race as the one above and was flying at the end of his mile after getting shuffled back to eighth at the head of the stretch. He had to wait for clearance before he was able to angle out and around horses but then sprouted wings in the final sixteenth of a mile on his way to pacing his final quarter in 26 seconds flat. This son of Huntsville tired on the lead as the 7/5 favorite in the Metro Pace Consolation two back over this surface but should be brave coming into this and might try his luck from off the pace tonight. He can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

This daughter of Artspeak has hit the board in eight of nine so far in her sophomore campaign and figures to be brimming with confidence coming into this. She must overcome another outside draw but has managed to get to the early lead in both of her last two when working from post-seven or worse.

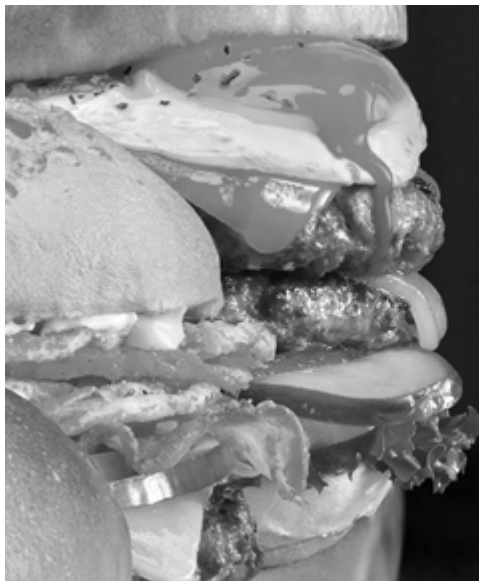

He has proven he can step up against this level of competition and might be able to do so again tonight.

She paced her back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.2 and just over a length away from the winner Parisian Blue Chip at the wire. This 31-time winner will come back in the same class for the fourth straight start and has been fourth or better in each of her last three at this level. She loses Sylvain Filion to an entrant from the barn of Richard Moreau but picks up a suitable replacement in Louis-Philippe Roy and can hit the ticket.

#5 TRAFALGAR comes out of the same race as the two above and faded back to eighth in the stretch after being spotted in the second-over position behind the eventual winner. She was bet down to favoritism at 5/2 when dropping down to this class two back but faded on the lead before finishing fifth under the wire. This daughter of Dali will be reunited with driver Doug McNair and was a winner the last time that teamster was aboard on August 13th in this class. She has hit the board in 11 of the 20 starts where they have been paired together and cannot be ignored on the bottom end of the exotics.

#2 UNIQUE ERA closed from a long way out of it last week to claim the place spot to a heavy favorite after getting away last off the gate from post-six. She was nearly 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing her back-half in 53.4 with a final quarter in 26.2 and almost got within three lengths of Horizontal at the finish. This daughter of Jk Endofanera has raced from off the pace in both of her last two and might get handled more aggressively this time around after showing life in her latest. She will now make her fifth start out of the barn of trainer Mike Bishop and gets our top honors.

#4 BEYOND THE SEA needed her most recent effort when she had missed nearly a month of action after shipping back north of the border following a five-race stint at Lexington to compete in the Kentucky Championship Series. She got away seventh off the gate before going an overland journey and was four lengths away from the winner in fifth under the wire in a race that was dominated by Horizontal. This daughter of Downbytheseaside was a strong winner on July 5th at this level and should benefit from getting back into a regular rotation. She slides down to a much more favorable starting spot in post-four this time around and can be right there at the wire.

#8 IVORY HANOVER was used hard in the early stages last week when she blasted to the early lead from post-10 and tripped the quarter marker in 26.2 before getting a breather of 29.4 in the second quarter. She then battled a first-over challenger in One Last Wish through the third quarter and was no match for Horizontal in the stretch when that winner flipped off her second-over cover. This daughter of Bettors Delight still managed to finish third at nearly 15-1 and should be more than competitive with this group tonight if she gets put into play. She is among the main chances in the contest and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#3 DIVIDE has spent her last two in NW3 and completed the superfecta in fourth in both of those outings. She was making progress along the cones in her latest and should appreciate getting back down to NW2, where she was also fourth in back-to-back efforts in September. This daughter of A Rocknroll Dance has not missed a cheque in six tries for trainer Shayne Barrington and was a strong winner for this barn on July 26th in NW1. She will work from the inside of the gate and can pick up a decent chunk with a favorable trip.

#3 STONE CARVER was sixth in NW3 last week in a race that was won by The Boss Said and got past two rivals in deep stretch to finish sixth after sitting last on the turn for home. He paced his back-half in 53.1 with a final quarter in 25.4 and will now get class relief when dropping back down to NW2. This son of Bettors Delight was a winner the last time he competed in this class back on June 7th and has been second or better in his last two attempts at this level. He will start from post-three for the fourth consecutive start and picks up the driving services of David Miller for the first time in his career. Giving him the nod in the nightcap.

#10 SIP OF BOURBON made a first-over bid against Control The Power in this class last week and was turned away by that eventual winner before clinging to third at the finish. He had competed against OSS Grassroots rivals in his previous seven outings and finished eighth in the championship event for that season-long series on October 1st. This son of Sunshine Beach must work from the outermost post this evening but managed to get into a decent spot off the gate from post-eight last time. He can build off that latest effort and will be one of our main players underneath.

#2 TANGO SEELSTER exits the same race as the one above and was handled aggressively in that outing when he was sent to the early lead and had a two length cushion at the quarter pole in 26.3. He released the eventual winner to the lead on the backside and never did find room in the stretch until it was too late. This other son of Sunshine Beach has hit the board in both of his last two when Jody Jamieson has been at the controls and that teamster will likely have him moving forward off the switch again tonight. He might be able to work out another favorable journey and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#8 HOWYOUPLAY THEGAME finished fourth at 33-1 in his latest at this level after getting away eighth off the gate. He was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and paced his back-half in 55.2 with a final panel in 28.1 and has now picked up a share in two of his last four in this class. This son of Sportswriter was a winner in NW1 on September 8th and should be acclimated to this level of competition after having four straight outings in NW2. He was J-Mac's choice over three others in the contest and can spice up the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

#4 BOOTLEGGER CHARLIE claimed the show spot in this class in a race that was won by Called In Sick on October 8th and was fifth against tougher competition in a pair of efforts in NW3760L3 at Flamboro Downs prior to that. He has missed a week between efforts but does not look out of place against this group. This gelding picks up Colin Kelly in the bike and might get forwardly placed off the gate from post-four. He is more than capable of picking up a sizable piece with the right trip scenario.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
