Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

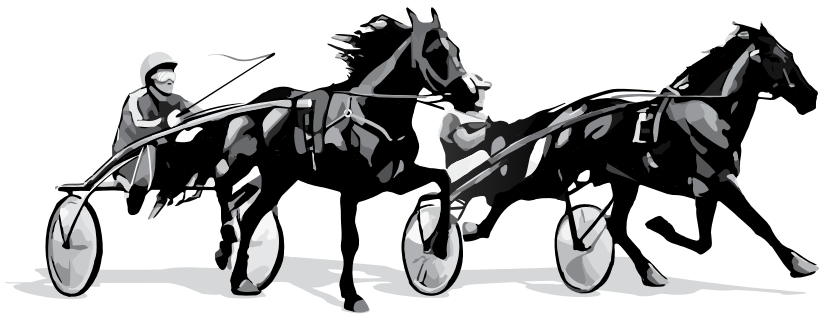
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 BETTER SUNSET was moving well at the end of his mile last week when he advanced three positions in the stretch to finish seventh after getting away last off the gate from post-10. He was 18 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and paced his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.3. This son of Bettors Delight was freshened up for a month prior to that effort and had earned a cheque in each of his previous four lifetime tries. He should benefit from getting that outing under his belt and will work from a much more favorable starting spot on the center of the gate. Bob McClure will be back in the sulky and we will give him the nod to kick off the card.

#10 ALLSTAR CHEDDAR exits the same race as the one above and rallied into the place spot by following that dominant winner and then held off a late charge from Dont Poke The Bear to finish as the runner-up. He was nearly four lengths in arrears to the winner but has made a good account of himself in his two attempts over this surface and has come home in 27.3 or faster in each of those outings. This son of Betterthancheddar gets hampered with post-10 this evening and also gives up a maturity edge to the one above at the age of two. He can still make his presence felt if he can work his way into the race and he will be one of our main players underneath.

#4 CONTROL THE SMILE was sent to the lead last week from post-two and chopped out reasonable fractions through the opening three panels before fading back to fourth under the wire at odds of 21-1. He has completed the superfecta in three of his six attempts at Mohawk Park and had been no worse than second in the first three starts of his career at Grand River Raceway before that. This son of Control The Moment appears to be acclimated to the speed over this larger surface and will have Trevor Henry back in the sulky. He will leave from a desirable post position and might be able to work out a favorable journey if he can get forwardly placed off the switch.

#6 LETS GO JUDE was just under a length ahead of our top choice in his latest when making his first start at Mohawk Park after spending the first seven efforts of his career on the B-tracks. He got away eighth off the gate from post-four and was more than 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55.3 with a final quarter in 27.1. THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 GAINES HANOVER likely has many wondering what might have been if he did not break stride at the start of the William Wellwood Memorial back in August because he has won three in a row when going up against fellow two-year-olds since then. He rallied in the stretch to get the better of Winner's Bet in the Champlain on September 15th and could not have been more impressive in his elimination for this race when he set legit fractions on the engine before scoring by nearly three lengths in a track record 1:53 flat. This son of Cantab has hit the board in five of seven so far in his career and might not have the accolades of some of his rivals but might be the "now horse" at the right time. He did not get much of a reward for winning last week when he drew the rail but does have home field advantage once again in his favor. Giving him the edge.

#5 KILMISTER was a long way back at the start of a stakes event in Lexington on October 7th when he made a break in stride and trailed his rivals by a wide margin before coming his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.4.. He has made miscues in two of his last three and missed nearly three weeks prior to his more recent effort after he was scratched due to sickness on September 29th. This son of Chapter Seven rhymed off five straight victories to begin his career, including the Peter Haughton Memorial on Hambo Day where he trotted away to win by four lengths at the finish. He can reassert his control of this division if he can mind his manners and summon his best but that risky proposition might not be worth the odds he will offer.

#9 OH WELL disappointed as the favorite last week when he was unable to get to the one below and had to settle for second at 2/5. He was nearly three lengths away from that rival at the wire but had not raced in nearly a month going into that outing. This son of Muscle Hill has been no worse than second in each of his seven lifetime attempts and was the winner of the Mohawk Million on September 24th when he converted by a comfortable margin as the odds-on choice. He might benefit from getting back into a regular rotation but will have to overcome a tricky starting spot with post-nine.

#4 CELEBRITY BAMBINO made multiple moves on his way to victory in his elimination and sprinted out to the early lead from the nine-hole before releasing International Man on the backside. He popped out of the two-hole on the bend for home and moved away from his foes to score by nearly three lengths. This other son of Muscle Hill has come into this on a two-race win-streak and has only missed the board on one occasion so far in his career. He slides down to a favorable spot on the gate this time around and can pick up a decent chunk.

#5 SYLVIA HANOVER gave the favorite backers a scare last week when she was looped by our fourth choice on the turn for home but then angled back out around horses in the stretch before accelerating to score by a length under the wire. She had been off for nearly a month between starts going into that effort and has won six in a row, including the Shes A Great Lady on September 24th as the 1/2 favorite. This daughter of Always B Miki's only defeat came in a follow-up leg of the Whenuwishuponastar when he rallied for the place spot after getting away seventh from the dreaded trailing post and has won all of her other seven outings in her rookie campaign. She is just \$1,700 shy of \$500,000 in earnings and has shown resilience several times in her young career. Starting from the center of the gate will only help her chances and she is hard to look past.

#1 CHARLESTON got past a determined pacesetter in the one below in her elimination after making a first-over bid on the bend for home and did not appear to be fully-extended under the wire. She stopped the clock in 1:50.4 with a final panel in 26.3 and has raced on this surface in each of her last three with her only defeat over that span coming when she got within three quarters of a length of the one above in the Shes A Great Lady two back. This daughter of Downbytheseaside is six for eight to kick off her career and has never finished worse than the place spot. She is another that drew the pole position after winning last week and that should further play into the hands of our top selection.

#2 STRONG POISON exits the same race as the one above and went a long way on the lead from post-eight in that contest before giving way to that rival in the late stages. She was only beaten by a neck at the wire and has now been second or better in her last eight overall. This other daughter of Always B Miki paced to a lifetime mark of 1:49.3 on August 22nd when she scored by nine lengths in a preliminary division of the Kentucky Championship Series but could not hold off Twin B Joe Fresh in the championship event in mid-September. She will likely be pushing out for position from post-two and can hit the ticket.

#4 MCSEASIDE was sitting sixth on the backside before making a three-wide move to blast to the lead past our top choice with about three-eighths of a mile to go. She paced her own third-quarter in 53.4 and gamely fought off a challenge from Horizontal in the stretch before giving way to the heavy favorite in the dying strides. This other daughter of Downbytheseaside almost stole it with a clever steer by Dexter Dunn and has hit the board in each of her last seven, with four consecutive second or better finishes coming into this. She will have Tim Tetrick aboard this time around and can pick up a slice.

#7 RIGHTEOUS RESOLVE had last week off when she took a bye to the final and made easy work of her competition in her latest when she was the easiest kind of winner in the OSS Super Final on October 15th. She has won seven in a row and has been no worse than second in her nine career attempts, with her only defeat coming at Georgian Downs back in July when she had traffic trouble in the stretch. This daughter of Resolve has three victories against open company and was not under much duress when she captured the Peaceful Way near the end of August. She has not had to go to the bottom of the well in any of her efforts and can hopefully keep her streak alive when it matters most this evening.

#4 SPECIAL WAY is riding a six-race win-streak and was ultra-impressive in her latest when she strided away from her competition in the lane to score by three lengths at the wire. She stopped the clock in 1:54.1 and moved first-over on the final turn before trotting her final quarter in 27.2 off a back-half in 55.2. This daughter of Walner has been getting better every time she steps on the racetrack but will now have to go up against the best Canada has to offer and in her own backyard at Mohawk Park. She will likely take a lot of support again tonight and will be hard to hold off.

#3 INSTAGRAM MODEL is another that has been racking up the wins with four in a row and most recently went all the way on the front-end by a comfortable margin in the Reynolds at Tioga Downs on September 23rd. She took down the Jim Doherty Memorial on Hambo Day at the Meadowlands and her lone defeat of her young career came when she was a pace disadvantage in the elimination for that prestigious stakes event after getting away ninth off the gate from post-nine. This daughter of Chapter Seven should be confident coming into this but she is likely at a fitness disadvantage to the two above with the time between starts being an obvious concern. She will leave from a favorable spot on the gate and will have Scott Zeron back in the driver's seat.

#6 WALNER PAYTON was the runner-up to our second choice last week after following that rival in the second-over position on the bend for home. She was three lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire but was clearly the best of the rest when she was well clear of the pacesetter Mambacita in second at the finish. This other daughter of Walner has been no worse than second in each of her last six and has been fourth or better in 11 efforts in her career so far. She will have the luxury of starting from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and should get every chance to grab a share.

#3 CONFEDERATE was sent to the engine in his elimination and held a comfortable lead throughout before expanding his margin to more than two lengths under the wire in 1:50.2. He paced his back-half in 54 seconds flat with a final panel in 26.3 and has now paced home in 27 seconds flat or faster in all six of his lifetime tries so far. This son of Sweet Lou looked like he was launched out of a cannon in the stretch drive of the Kentucky Championship Series Final in Lexington when he stopped the clock in 1:49.2 and won by three lengths going away. He has won each of his last five by a combined margin of more than 15 lengths and will race on the lasix program for just the second start of his career. Giving this versatile colt our top honors.

#2 HANDLELIKEAPORSCH was impressive in victory last week he marched up alongside the one below on the final turn and then forged past that rival in deep stretch to score by a length. He comes into this on a three-race win-streak and was only beaten by half a length to Voukefalas in the New Jersey Classic on September 16th at the Meadowlands. This son of Lazarus N has never been worse than second in any of his seven lifetime tries so far and has just under \$250,000 stashed away. He lived up to his name in his elimination for this Breeders Crown Final and deserves respect again tonight.

#7 STOCKADE SEELSTER blasted off the wings of the gate from post-10 and was parked out past the quarter pole before getting to the lead on the backside. He paced his own middle-half in 56.1 but could not match strides with the one above when that rival came to call in the lane. This son of State Treasurer faded to third under the wire but produced a gritty effort in the OSS Super Final just six nights earlier when he had to work hard for the victory in 1:50.1 as the 1/9 favorite. He will slide in a few spots on the gate this evening and can land somewhere on the ticket if his trip is not too taxing.

#5 HUNTIN THE LAST DOLAR came from a long way out of it to complete the exacta behind our second selection at 50-1 after getting away seventh off the gate. He was more than eight lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.3 with a final panel in 26.3 and had to move wide on the final turn before finding his best stride in the stretch. This son of Huntsville had not raced in nearly a month going into that outing after grabbing a small share in fifth in the Metro Stakes on September 24th and has earned a share in all eight of his career attempts so far. He will likely take more wagering support this time around but can still add some value to the bottom end of the exotics.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#9 SETTN A PRECEDENT has spent her last three in NW12000L5 and has raced deceptively good in each of those efforts when going up against much tougher competition. She closed nicely in the late stages in her first two tries in October and appeared to be loaded with pace in her latest when she was surrounded by horses in the stretch drive. This 12-time winner had to settle for sixth under the wire but now takes a significant drop down in class and gets paired back with driver Sylvain Filion, who guided her to a dead heat victory at this level last December. She has been racing much better than her paper would indicate and has our vote of confidence in the finale.

#3 GOT SEXY SCARS went a long way on the lead in her latest in NW3 but could not hold off a pair of rivals in the dying strides and had to settle for the show spot under the wire. She transitions back to NW6000L5, where she was the runner-up to Chiefs Dream Girl on September 30th, and only gets into this race because she is entered for the optional claiming tag of \$45,000. This 10-time winner has hit the board in nine of her last 10 and typically utilizes her tactical speed to race on or near the lead. She will be reunited with driver James MacDonald and will be one of our main players underneath.

#6 CASIMIR SWAMP GIRL grabbed a smaller share in fifth at this level in her latest and did not have much room in the stretch two back when stepping back up to this class. She was a 10-1 winner in NW3000L5 on October 7th after getting a troubled trip the week before at the bottom condition level and should appreciate getting to leave from the winningest post at Mohawk Park. This 25-time winner does not look out of place against this group and can land somewhere on the ticket if her trip is sweet enough.

#1 MY MOTHER PEARL exits the same race as our top choice and finished eighth in that contest at odds of 39-1. She made up ground in the late stages to finish fourth in this class on October 14th and followed Sporty Tori in the second-over position three back at this level before taking down the place spot. This daughter of Big Jim has just seven wins from 63 lifetime attempts but has hit the board 31 times over that span. She will work from the pole position and will have Jody Jamieson at the controls.

#4 GOODNIGHT IRENE rallied from a long way off the pace to finish fourth in this class last week and got within three lengths of the winner Just Daisy at the wire after getting away ninth off the switch. She was 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole in ninth and paced her back-half in 55.4 with a final panel in 27 seconds flat. This 17-time winner got a confidence boost when she won back-to-back races at Flamboro Downs in September and has since completed the superfecta in her last two trips around the big track. Louis-Philippe Roy picks up the drive and she can grab a share.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

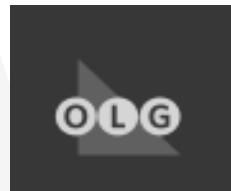
WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
