# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#6 ROYAL RENEGADE** was used hard in the early going last week when he was wide into the opening turn before getting to the lead and then released his stablemate on the backside before re-taking that rival at the halfway point. He held a clear margin on the field coming out of the bend for home but got leg weary in the stretch and faded back to fourth at the wire. This 36-time winner has disappointed as the favorite in each of his last two since dropping back down to this level but can get back to the victory lane with a more reasonable trip this evening. He will start from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and has our nod on top to kick off the card.

**#5 MODERN ROCK** exits the same race as the one above and got away in the early two-hole in that contest before getting relegated to third on the backside. He got stuck behind a pocket-sitter that dropped anchor on the turn for home and lost several positions because of that but did not have an abundance of pace when he did eventually get extricated from that spot. This 10-time winner has not been able to pick up a cheque in his last three since returning to the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau but had been second or better in five of his previous six starts for this outfit. He will work from the center of the gate and has rebound potential.

**#3 STATE OF PLAY** was away last off the gate from post-two in his latest before making up ground in the late stages to claim the show spot at odds of 10-1. He was aided by a hot pace up front and has gone similar trips in his two efforts since being claimed back by trainer Joe Pereira. This 18-time winner has picked up a cheque in 12 of his last 14 overall and has managed to hit the board in five of those outings. He will have James MacDonald aboard for the second consecutive start and can hit the ticket.

**#7 PRIVATE SCOTT** made a first-over try last week when our top choice was free-wheeling on the front-end and was not able to get near that rival until deep in the stretch but never did get past before the wire. He had to settle for a minor award in fifth and will now make his second start out of the barn of Jay Polifroni after that conditioner plucked him for \$18,000 on November 16th at Flamboro Downs. This 11-time winner must start from the outermost post in the contest and can pick up a slice if his trip is not too taxing.

### Race 2 Selections

### THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#8 WHITE TIGER** has competed against the best trotters that this circuit has to offer in each of his last two and in three of his last five overall. He finished second to Hp Mama B in NW25500L6 three back at 15-1 and was a winner the last time he raced at this level on September 19th. This 17-time winner has hit the board in six of his last nine and should appreciate the plunge down the class ladder this evening. He will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but has proven to be versatile in his racing style. James MacDonald stays aboard and he is hard to go against in this spot.

**#5 THE LIONKING AS** has missed by a narrow margin in second in each of his last two and has been no worse than fourth in three tries over this surface since relocating north of the border to this circuit. He battled in the early stages last week before releasing the eventual winner Hammer Time to the front on the backside and then got within a neck of that rival at the wire. This 26-time winner has hit the board 114 times through 177 career attempts but seems to have an affinity for the place spot with 51 second-place finishes over that span. He will be making his fourth start out of the barn of trainer Boyd Wilson and picks up Jody Jamieson in the driver's seat.

**#7 FREE WILLY HANOVER** exits the same race as the one above and advanced four positions to pick up a prize in fifth after getting away last off the gate from post-eight. He was 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole at odds of 44-1 and then trotted his back-half in 57.3 with a final quarter in 28.2. This 31-time winner has picked up a slice in five of his last six and has hit the board in five of his last 11 overall. He slides in one spot on the gate for tonight's tilt and is worth using in the exotics.

**#1 ALL WRAPPED UP** sat last for much of his journey on NW12000L5 and was able to make up ground on the inside in the early part of the stretch drive. He appeared to have a lot of trot when waiting for clearance but then did not punch through with authority when an opening presented itself. This 20-time winner has been fourth or better in five of his last seven and will work from the pole position this evening after having the seven-hole or worse in his last two. He can make his presence felt against this group and should not be taken lightly.

### Race 3 Selections

### THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#5 MACH ART IN MOTION** scored by more than a length in this class last week after being spotted second-over on the final turn and powered away from his rivals in the stretch to stop the clock in 1:54.4. He managed to lock down his first victory in his last 13 outings but hit the board on eight occasions over that span going into this latest. This 11-time winner gets jammed right back in for the same price tag in what will be his second attempt off the claim for trainer Joe Pereira and will have James MacDonald back in the sulky for an encore. He will start from the center of the gate and can double-up with another favorable journey.

**#2 COIN FLIP** exits the same race as the one above and forged to the lead at the top of the stretch but was no match for the late strides of the one above. He managed to hold onto third under the wire and has now hit the board in each of his last four at Mohawk Park. This 18-time winner was claimed out of that contest for \$12,000 by Shayne Barrington and that conditioner has won five of his last nine at the time of writing this. He has been in good form as of late and will have Jody Jamieson at the controls after J-Mac opted for the one above.

**#6 JIM STRIKESITRICH** is not the most appealing entrant on paper after being scratched out of his most recent scheduled start due to sickness and finishing last in each of his last four starts by a wide margin. He has returned to the care of top trainer Ricahrd Moreau since those lackluster efforts and was no worse than fourth in six previous tries out of this barn. This 12-time winner enjoyed back-to-back victories for this outfit earlier in the season and will have the luxury of starting from post-six. He has not raced in over a month but the time between starts might be a good thing in this scenario and might rebound in a big way.

**#1 BIG JOURNEY** rallied to finish fourth last week at nearly 41-1 after being more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole in eighth. He paced his back-half in 56.4 with a final panel in 27.1 and was a runner-up two back when going off at even higher odds of 68-1. This son of Mister Big has not done much wrong in his last two over this surface and will likely be trying to make some noise in the late stages again this evening. He can grab a share.

He is less than \$5,000 shy of \$200,000 in lifetime earnings and will have James MacDonald aboard for the first time in his career. Giving him the nod.

**#9 SIMCOE SEELSTER** has won two of his last three when competing in NW3 with his lone defeat over that span coming two back when he was sent off as the 4/5 favorite in a race that was won by Warrawee Xalt. He came from off the pace in his latest and scored by more than five lengths under the wire and trotted his lifetime mark of 1:53.4 three back on November 14th. This son of Royalty For Life has been in top form as of late and while he is moving up in class, he has recently gotten the better of five of his nine rivals in this contest. He will have to overcome a tricky draw with post-nine but can be right there at the wire.

**#4 HP ROYAL THEO** finished last in a field of six when going up against much tougher competition in NW25500L5 in his latest and is just two starts removed from six straight outings against the best trotters this circuit has to offer. He will now drop down to the level below where he was a winner on August 29th and was the runner-up in four consecutive tries in this class before that. This 15-time winner has returned to the barn of trainer Ben Baillargeon since his most recent effort and will have Louis-Philippe Roy back at the controls. He has not raced in nearly a month but gave this group all they can handle with anything close to his best.

**#5 HAMMER TIME** was sent to the lead in his latest when he was hammered down to favoritism at odds of 3/2 and held on by a neck at the wire over The Lionking As. He was forwardly placed two back in this class but was shuffled back to eighth at the top of the stretch before encountering traffic trouble in the lane. This 21-time winner has been no worse than second in three of his last four and will work from the center of the gate again when coming right back in this class. He will likely have his gas pedal pressed in the early going and is among the main contenders.

**#3 RESOLUTE BAY** was second to Hang On Baby in his latest and came from a long way off the pace to only miss by a head to Truffles Too on November 21st at this level. He has been second or better in eight of his last 10 overall and went on a six-race win-streak that included an incredible performance in the championship event of the OSS Grassroots. This son of Resolve has proven he can be competitive in this class but does face off against some tricky rivals this evening. He can hit the ticket with the right kind of trip.

**#6 MACALLAN** got a confidence boost last week when he dropped down to NW6000L5 and went most of the way on the engine before scoring by three quarters of a length at the wire as the odds-on choice. He stopped the clock in 1:54.1 and had finished no better than fifth in his previous four starts after being on hiatus for nearly four months. This 10-time winner has been the type that gets brave after a victory and won three in a row while moving up the class ladder last May. He might have to settle for a smaller piece of it tonight but should not be excluded from the exotics.

She has won five of 16 this season, with one of those victories coming in the Open, and should be feeling good about herself after her latest. Top call.

**#1 PHOENIX** took support to the tune of 6-1 in this class last week but jumped it off behind the gate and will have to start from that same tricky post position this evening. He turned in a solid effort two back when he finished third to Hang On Baby and trotted his own mile in 1:53.2 and will now be making his fourth start back after a hiatus of more than five months. This 13-time winner is a risky proposition but can certainly make his presence felt against this group if he can mind his manners. His top priority will likely be to get a flat line under his belt but he is still worth including in the exotics.

**#8 TEXACO MAN** was one we were fond of in his latest in NW3000L5 when he only missed by three quarters of a length to the one below at nearly 11-1. He got away sixth off the gate and was closing rapidly down the center of the track in deep stretch after being caught behind a stalled rival on the bend for home. This 12-time winner trotted his back-half in 57.3 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat but will have to slide out another spot on the gate this evening when stepping up in class. He should be making noise in the late stages again and can hit the ticket.

**#7 AUSSIE LOVER** managed to slip to the outside after a ground-saving trip last week and held on by three quarters of a length over the one above at the wire. He had no chance two back when getting away last off the gate from post-nine and had not raced in more than three weeks going into that contest. This 17-time winner moves up a level this evening but can still work his way into the race for a smaller share. He should not be excluded from the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

He stopped the clock in 1:51.2 in his latest after sitting fourth for much of the mile and got up by a head at the wire. This 53-time winner was charted with broken equipment in that effort because he lost a shoe at some point during the race and he paced to a new lifetime mark of 1:50.3 at the age of 11 two back. He will have his price tag raised by \$3,000 this evening and will have Travis Cullen aboard in the absence of Trevor Henry.

**#7 JULERICA** likely needed an easier trip in his latest when he was taken back to eighth off the gate from post-eight and made up ground before the wire but was unable to improve his position. He had been sent to the early lead in 17 of his 19 tries prior to that outing and has had a week off between starts coming into this effort. This 52-time winner will be making his third attempt back in the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau and has 18 victories and 28 on the board finishes in 36 tries for this outfit. He might rebound with a better performance this time out and is worth considering if the price is right.

**#4 CENTURY GIGALO** is another that recently returned to the care of conditioner Richard Moreau when he was claimed back for \$28,000 on October 24th. He finished sixth in this class on November 7th and followed that up by claiming the place spot to Bayfield Beach in NW60000L at Flamboro Downs on November 16th. This 15-time winner was taken to the safety lane as the even-money favorite when something went amiss on the lead in his most recent effort over that half-mile surface and might enjoy getting back on the big track this evening. He got the nod from Sylvain Filion over the one above and will likely be forwardly placed.

**#6 QUAN BLUE CHIP** has been popular in the claiming box when changing hands after each of his last three and will now go postward for trainer Garry Merner. He will have his price tag increased by \$1,000 this evening and has hit the board in each of his last six in this class. This 24-time winner will be reunited with the circuit's leading driver James MacDonald, who has piloted him to victory in both of the last two times he has been aboard. He will start from the best post position on the circuit and should get every chance to pick up another sizable slice.

**#1 LOGAN PARK** disappointed as the heavy favorite last week when made a break in stride in the stretch after locking horns with the one above. He had sped through opening panels in 27 flat and 55.4 and then had to take on a challenge from the winner on the bend for home when she vacated the pocket early. This 12-time winner was an impressive winner in the Open on November 14th and had bested our top choice in both of their previous meetings prior to that last effort. He will have to leave from a tricky spot on the rail but should be right there at the wire if he stays on the trot this time around.

**#5 LOCATELLI** has finished third in each of his last two since moving back up to the top trotting class and took support to the tune of 2-1 two back in the Open when he was unable to draw level with the one above from the first-over position. He won two in a row by open lengths in higher conditioner classes in October and has picked up a prize in all of his last nine. This 10-time winner has proven he can be competitive at this level but will likely have to settle for an underneath spot on the ticket again this evening. He should not be excluded from the bottom end of the exotics.

**#3 TRUFFLES TOO** inherited the place spot at 31-1 last week when our second choice made a miscue in the stretch. He was nearly three lengths in arrears to our top selection at the wire and was a winner two back in NW12000L5 when he squeezed up the pylons in the stretch to convert as the 3/2 favorite. This 13-time winner has hit the board in 27 of 40 this season and added nearly \$190,000 to his lifetime earnings. He will start from a favorable spot on the gate and picks up the driving services of Sylvain Filion for the second time in his career.

#### THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#3 NEVER MIND N** will have an opportunity to sweep the series after being an easy winner as the odds-on choice in each of the two preliminary legs. He went all the way on the engine in both of those efforts and scored by more than five lengths in the opening round on November 21st when racing on just two days' rest. This 17-time winner has won three of his last four since returning to the barn of trainer Carmen Auciello and will have the circuit's leading driver James MacDonald in the sulky for the fourth straight start. He has not shown any signs of slowing down against these types and there is no reason to think he will not triple-up tonight. Giving him the nod to close out the card as a hefty favorite.

**#4 SERENITY CRUISE** has completed the superfecta in both of his last two and was just under three lengths away from our top choice in his latest at odds of 18-1. He took support to the tune of 5/2 in the first leg of the series and banged home in 27.2 to get within a pair of lengths of the winner. This 14-time winner was competing against tougher competition before going postward in this event and might have a better effort up his sleeve when the chips are down in the final this evening. He will be one our main players underneath and should offer a decent number on the board.

**#7 SOUTHWIND CAESER** has finished second in each of his last two since shipping north of the border from Hoosier Park to join the barn of trainer Jodie Cullen. He made up a lot of ground in the late stages on November 21st when getting within three quarters of a length of Wishyoudtellme at the wire and made a first-over bid last week but could not get to our top selection, who was under-wraps to the finish. This son of Father Patrick will race on a regular rotation for the second straight start after missing more than a couple of weeks of action and should get every chance to hit the ticket.

**#8 LOOK AT DAT KAT** rallied into the place spot after following the cover of the one above in his latest and was just a length away from our top choice under the wire. He trotted home in 28 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 56.1 and was a much the best winner two back when he scored by more than three lengths in NW2100L3 after making an early miscue. This son of Jailhouse Jessie races for a barn that has been winning at a high clip again as of late and can work his way onto the ticket if he can work out a reasonable trip from post-eight. He will have Louis-Philippe Roy in the driver's seat for the first time and should not be ignored.

**#9 CASCADA** was sent straight to the lead last week and maintained a healthy margin throughout before scoring by more than a length at the wire at odds of 5/2. He was third two back at the bottom level in a race that was won by P L Opportunity and had not raced in nearly three weeks going into that effort. This 11-time winner will have Bob McClure back in the bike and try to get forwardly placed from a difficult draw. He should be included on the bottom end of the trifecta and super but appears to be up against it for lion's share.

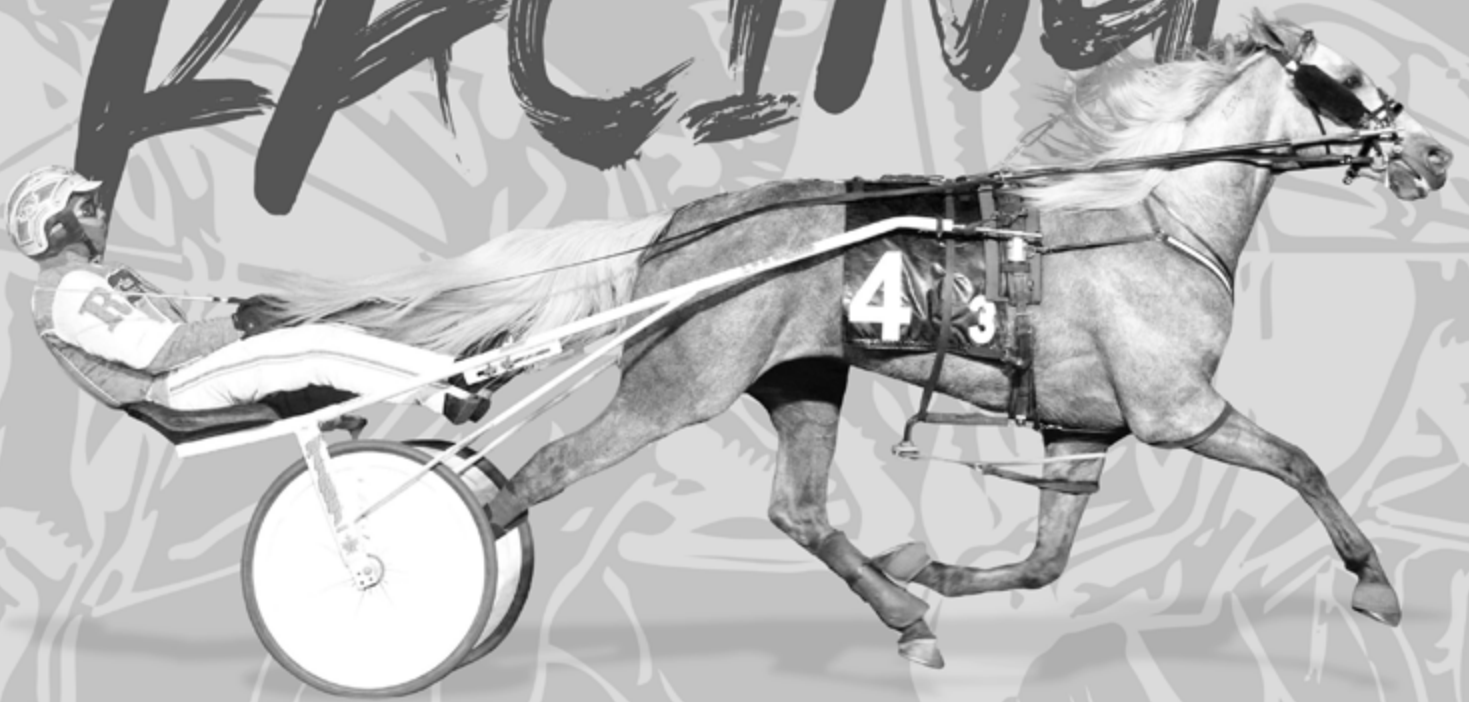

### CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
