# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

**Helpful facts for betting**

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

**3 Tips to remember**

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#2 DAY AT THE GYM** did not have much to offer in his first start back off the bench last week when he faded back to ninth under the wire as the 6/5 favorite. He looked lively behind the gate when he got away fourth but never really took a step forward after that before trotting his own mile in 1:57.4 over a surface that had a track variant of two seconds. This son of Muscle Mass had not raced in more than a year prior to that outing and qualified against a decent group that featured Stay Close and Run Director on November 25th. He will have to significantly raise his game this evening but should take a step forward when getting into a regular rotation. Giving him the edge in a soft-looking installment of NW2.

**#4 SHES BEER LEAGUE** exits the same race as the one the above and had some of the best late legs in that contest when advancing to fifth before the wire to pick up a minor award. She had gotten away eighth off the gate from post-six and was nearly 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before trotting her back-half in 56.2 with a final quarter in 27.4. This daughter of Angus Hall claimed the show spot at this level two back and will be making her fourth start back after missing more than two months of action. She appears to be trending in the right direction for trainer Jared Bothwell and can be right there at the wire.

**#3 MUSCLE ENVY** broke through for the first victory of her career on December 1st when she went all the way on the lead in NW1 to convert as the 1/9 favorite in her 26th career outing. She held on by three quarters of a length at the wire over Give Me Karets K and stopped the clock in 1:59.2 over a track that was two seconds off. This daughter of Muscle Up The Goal will now make the difficult transition up to NW2 but has hit the board in eight of 19 so far this season. She will now race out of the barn of trainer Matt Dupuis and figures to get forwardly placed from post-three.

**#7 LIONS WISH NL** was never a factor when making his North American debut on November 24th and got beat by a wide margin in last as the odds-on choice. He had shipped overseas from the Netherlands to race under the care of top trainer Richard Moreau and will now race on the lasix program for the first time after that lackluster performance. This son of Muscle Mass was victorious in his lone qualifier at Mohawk Park in preparation for that latest effort and held off P L Opportunity in the late stages, who has since returned to the races to win two in a row.

He was more than four lengths back of Dg Rainrunner in his lifetime debut after getting away third from post-nine and will now have the best starting spot of his career so far with the four-hole. This son of Sunshine Beach will be reunited with driver Phil Hudon and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket again this evening.

**#10 SERIOUS DRAGON** finished fourth in his latest when transitioning to the big track and was within four lengths of the heavily-favored Bettor Than Pride when completing the superfecta at odds of 16-1. He had raced from off the pace from difficult starting spots in his two previous outings at The Raceway in London and has now missed a week between starts when making his attempt over the big track. This son of Fear The Dragon will have Bob McClure back at the reins and will be making noise in the stretch drive again this evening after starting from a difficult draw with post-10. He has hit the board in three of six so far in his career and is worth using in the trifecta and super.

He picks up Bob McClure in the driver's seat for the first time with Sylvain Filion booking off for the one above and is a logical choice to finish underneath.

**#7 KABOOM NL** shipped overseas from the Netherlands to join the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau and produced a decent qualifier on December 2nd when finishing rounding out a short field of three that included Run Director and Tymal Riggs. This son of Explosive Matter did not try to take a step forward on those two rivals until the dying strides and he finished under a hard hold to J-Mac under the wire when coming home in 28.2 off a back-half in 57.2. He is eight for 40 lifetime with 24 on the board finishes and is not one to leave off the bottom end of the exotics.

**#1 MUSCLE UP THE GOLD** completed the trifecta behind our second choice and Stable Genius in her latest at odds of 17-1 and was a long way back in the early going of that contest after getting away ninth off the gate from post-eight. She trotted her back-half in 55.2 with a final panel in 27.1 and has now been fourth or better in five of her last six overall. This daughter of Muscle Up The Goal made a good account of herself in the Harvest Series in November and might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position. She can grab another share.

This son of Control The Moment held a clear margin throughout in that contest and was not under any urging from Tyler Jones when he banged home in 28.2 on the heels of a back-half in 57.3. He will start from the inside of the gate and gets a slight edge in a race where we will be leaning heavily on a trio of first-time starters.

**#4 WARRAWEE YANKEE** was a \$70,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be making the first start of his career for conditioner Shawn Steacy. He is a half-brother to the Warrawee Veloce, who has hit the board in 50 of his 104 lifetime appearances with over \$185,000 in earnings so far at the age of five. This son of Sweet Lou was an easy winner in his first qualifier on November 25th when he scored by three lengths in 1:59 flat after drifting out to the center of the track in the stretch and was briefly bothered at the head of the lane in his latest before firing home in 27.2. He looks like he is ready to roll for rock-solid connections and should be right there at the wire.

He was unable to advance with any kind of authority when shown clear racetrack and had to settle for fourth under the wire, more than three lengths back of the one above. This nine-time winner was claimed out of that contest for \$16,000 by trainer Carmen Auciello and he will be reunited with the circuit's leading driver James MacDonald, who guided him to a victory and three on the board finishes in the three times they have been paired together. He has won four of his last nine overall and should not be taken lightly.

**#2 BELECHICK** was a winner at Flamboro Downs in his latest when he got up by a neck at the wire and was racing for the same price tag that he will carry this evening. He disappointed as the 1/9 favorite two back over that half-mile surface but is three for five since joining the outfit of Richard Moreau via the claim on October 18th. This nine-time winner has picked up a cheque in 13 straight outings and has cracked the top three in each of his last seven. He might enjoy the return to the big track with his come from behind racing style and will have Sylvain Filion in the driver's seat for the first time.

**#9 HES REALLY KEEN** was the runner-up to our top selection last week when he nearly got within a length of that rival at the wire. He has been no worse than third since returning to the claiming ranks and was taken for \$17,000 in his most recent effort by trainer Rob Fellows. This eight-time winner shifts to the outside of the gate this evening after having favorable starting spots in his last two but should be brave coming into this. He retains the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy and cannot be dismissed from the exotics.

#### THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#7 THANKYEVERYMUCH** made up significant ground last week to be fourth in this class after getting away ninth off the gate and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He paced his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat and was only beaten by just over a length at the wire. This 27-time winner got into all kinds of traffic trouble two back before causing interference to a rival when forcing his way to the outside in the stretch and might get activated sooner in the mile this time around. He moves in one spot on the gate and gets the edge in the nightcap.

**#2 ROCKINMYDREAM** exits the same race as the one above and secured the early pocket in that contest before tiring badly in the stretch to finish last by wide margin. He crawled his final quarter in 31.3 but turned in a decent effort to be second two back and will now race off the claim for trainer Richard Moreau. This nine-time winner might rebound in a big way this evening and can be right there at the wire. He is among the main chances in the contest and should be forgiven for his latest.

**#9 MAJOR ON THE BEACH** got a difficult trip last week when was stuck in the first-over position for a long way after attempting to rush to the lead before the bend for home. He finally got past the pacesetter in the stretch drive but could not hold off the fresh legs of the top two finishers. This son of Art Major faded to third under the wire but was just over a length away from victory and his connections thought enough of his effort that they increased his price tag by \$500 this evening. He must work from an outside starting spot but merits consideration.

**#4 UPGRADE VALLEY** advanced five positions to pick up a minor award in his latest after getting away last off the gate from post-nine. He was 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and paced his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 28.1. This 15-time winner will be making his fifth start off the claim for trainer Cameron McQueen and slides down to a much more favorable starting spot this evening with post-four. He should be in the mix throughout and cannot be left out of the exotics.

**#8 FOUR FOR ORR** comes back on just two days' rest after being placed back to sixth from fifth in the class above this on Monday night and has only managed to pick up one minor award in three tries against tougher opponents since getting claimed by this outfit. He should appreciate getting to face softer rivals this evening but must contend with a tricky post position and lackluster form, with only one prize in his last six overall. This 18-time winner can wake up to a better performance and is worth using in the trifecta and super.

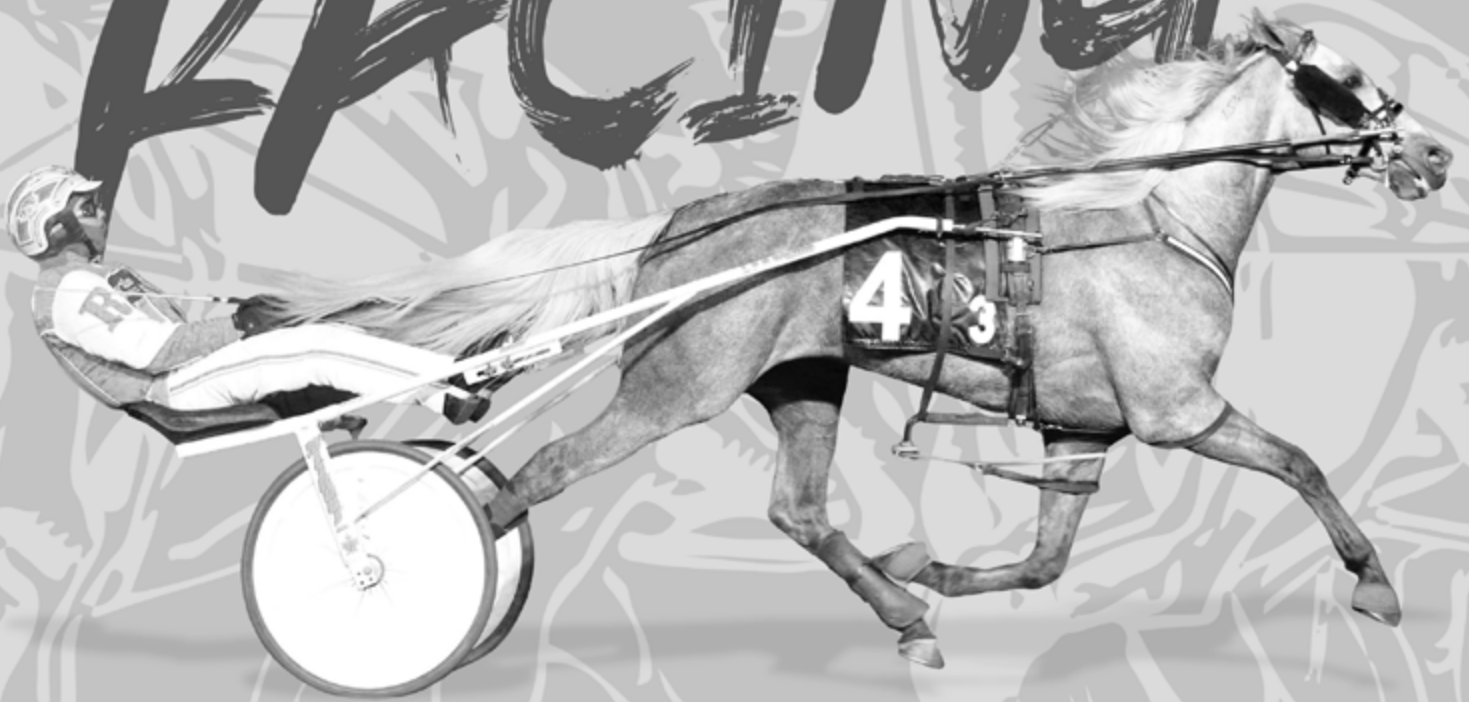

### C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### A L L O W A N C E S F O R P U R S E E A R N I N G S

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
