Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 BETTORHOLDONTIGHT went an overland journey in his latest after getting away eighth from post-10 and was out wide on the final turn before fizzling out in the late stages to finish eighth at 7-1. He was moving well at the end of his mile on December 1st and only missed out on third by a small margin when closing rapidly in the center of the racetrack. This son of Bettors Delight got away eighth off the gate from post-two in that contest and was 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 27.1. He will now have the nation's leading driver James MacDonald in the driver's seat for the first time and is one we are more than willing to come right back. Giving him the nod.

#1 TWO FACED was a \$26,000 yearling purchase at the Ontario Select sale that will now be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Murray Brethour. He was unraced at two and comes into this with three qualifiers to his credit, missing by just a head to Nora D in his most recent morning prep on December 9th. This son of Shadow Play paced his own mile in 1:57.4 on that occasion and fell just short of a rival that has six lifetime victories from 35 career outings. He was Sylvain Filion's choice over the one below and looks like he is ready to roll.

#8 DONT POKE THE BEAR has missed by a head or less as the runner-up in both of his last two and was within a nose of Juju Hanover at the wire last week at odds of 3-1. He has hit the board in 19 of his 34 career starts but has not broken through with his first victory yet. This son of Betterthancheddar has only missed a cheque twice this season and typically turns in strong efforts but falls short of a trip to the winner's circle. He has an affinity for finishing underneath and that is where we will continue to utilize him. Chris Christoforou picks up the steer.

#6 SERIOUS DRAGON has made up ground from a long way out of it in his last two since transitioning to the big track from the B's and picked up a smaller share in each of those efforts. He got away seventh off the switch in his most recent outing and paced his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 27.3. This son of Fear The Dragon has hit the board in three of seven so far in his career and will pick up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy for the first time in tonight's tilt. He will work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park after having tricky starting spots in each of his last four and is worth a look if the price is right.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 MATS MVP claimed the show spot in his return to the circuit last week and was just over two lengths away from the winner Storm Trotter at the wire. He notched the second victory of his career at Northfield Park three back and has only missed one cheque in his last 10 overall. This son of My Mvp broke his maiden over this surface on September 29th in NW1 and will get reunited with James MacDonald this evening. He has hit the board in eight of his 15 career attempts and gets the edge on top.

#5 MUSCLE ENVY finished fourth when stepping up to this level in her latest and had a perfect two-hole trip in that contest before rounding out the superfecta. She missed out on the show spot by the slimmest of margins but could not get past the pacesetter before the wire and broke through with the first victory of her career in her 26th lifetime try the week prior. This daughter of Muscle Up The Goal should benefit from having her latest to get acclimated to this level and gets another favorable draw in post-five. She will likely be part of the early pace scenario and is among the chances.

#6 R ROYAL PORT has not raced since September 19th when he faded on the lead at this level to finish fifth and come back to the races in the same class with a pair of qualifiers under his belt. He was no match for the late strides of Talismano in his latest morning prep but managed to go all the way on the engine on the morning of November 25th when he stopped the clock in 1:59.3 over a track that was one second off. This son of Archangel will have Bob McClure aboard for the first time under the lights and might be rolling forward off the gate from post-six. He can go a long way on the front-end if that is the strategy and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#7 SHES BEER LEAGUE took support to the tune of 8-1 in her latest but was just 4-1 when the gate entered the stretch before the start and she was a long way behind after making a miscue. She ended up being distanced throughout but had some of the best late legs in her effort on December 1st when she trotted home in 27.4 off a back-half in 56.2 to finish fifth under the wire at 7-1. This daughter of Angus Hall's first priority tonight will likely be to get a flat line to his credit but she has raced well enough to be more than competitive with this group. She should go off at an inflated number after her mishap last time and is worth including in the exotics.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 REYS N A ROCKET was a strong winner last week at Flamboro Downs when racing off the claim for trainer Richard Moreau and will now transition back to the big track in this condition claiming event. She got the best of open claimers in her latest when being sent off at 6/5 and went a difficult trip three back when she got parked the route in this class from post-three. This 46-time winner has had success out of his barn in the past and now has eight victories and 19 on the board finishes in 29 starts for this outfit. She does not take a big step up in competition this evening, if any at all considering this is a condition claimer, and has our top honors in what looks like a winnable spot.

#8 P L OOOOOOOOOYAH disappointed as the 2/5 favorite last week when she was picked up by a head at the wire by the one below. She went to the early lead from post-seven and looked comfortable on the lead until that rival came to call in the dying strides. This daughter of Thinking Out had won back-to-back races in her two previous tries at this class and will now make her second start off the claim for trainer Rob Fellows. She has hit the board in nine of her 16 career attempts and will have J-Mac back aboard tonight.

#7 SUNSHINE SALLY could not have gotten a better trip in her latest when she rode in the pocket behind the heavy favorite above and then got past her by a head at the wire for a mild upset at odds of 4-1. She had faded back to fifth two back after getting a similar journey but has now hit the board in four of her last five overall. This daughter of Sunshine Beach has earned a share in nine straight since relocating north of the border to the barn of trainer Carmen Auciello and figures to get put into play off the gate again tonight from post-seven. She should be feeling good about herself coming into this and can hit the ticket.

#4 RMISSASHLEE has hit the board in each of her last two at this level and most recently completed the trifecta behind the two above at odds of 9-1. She was the runner-up to our second choice at an even longer price two back and has proven she can be competitive with this group. This daughter of Ashlees Big Guy has been fourth in the three times when Louis-Philippe Roy has been at the controls and she will have that teamster back in the sulky for a third straight start. She might be able to work out a favorable trip from post-four and cannot be dismissed from the bottom end of the exotics.

#2 CLODAM BAYAMA forged to the lead from the first-over position on the bend for home last week but did not have any answers for the two above when they came to call in deep stretch. She had to settle for third under the wire at odds of 9/2 and has been no worse than fourth in her last six overall. This 21-time winner comes right back in for the same price tag and will have Louis-Philippe Roy at the controls for just the second time in her career. She will work from the inside of the gate and should have every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#7 PEGGY J was not able to make any impact in her latest after getting away sixth off the gate in the bottom condition class and did not advance a position before finishing nearly 13 lengths off the winner Western Wish at the wire. She was a runner-up against a softer group at that level two back when making her first start out of the barn of trainer Shayne Barrington and will now drop down into the claiming ranks for the first time on this circuit. This 16-time winner should appreciate the reclassification and can pick up a decent chunk if she can work out a reasonable trip from post-seven.

He had to settle for a smaller prize in fifth after pacing home in 28.1 and will be making his second try back on a regular schedule after missing nearly a month of action. This son of Sweet Lou will be reunited with driver Travis Cullen and might be able to work out a decent journey from the pole position. He should offer some value in a race where it might be wise to avoid a shorter price and has our top honors in the night cap.

#9 TRION DE VIE finished fourth in his latest after trying to race from off the pace and was just a pair of lengths away from a short-priced winner at the wire at odds of 13-1. He got away eighth off the gate from post-10 and will slide in one spot on the gate tonight after having that starting spot in each of his last two. This son of Huntsville has been no worse than fourth in his last six overall and will be reunited with driver Sylvain Filion in his fourth start off the claim for trainer Gerard Demers. He might get launched off the gate this time around and can be right there at the wire.

#4 THE TWIST bullied his way to the front at the top of the stretch after being parked for every step of the mile prior to that but had to settle for third under the wire behind Bluemoon Bayama and Shes Watching Me. He has hit the board in his last two for Brett Lester and will now be making his fourth attempt out of that conditioner's barn. This eight-time winner slides down to post-four when having his claiming tag discounted by \$1,000 this evening and should be in the mix throughout. He can hit the ticket.

#7 JITTERBUG FLIP has not finished better than sixth relocating to Mohawk Park from south of the border for trainer Carmen Auciello but will now transition to the condition claiming ranks after spending his recent outings in NW2. He has just one victory from 32 career outings but has managed to hit the board on nine occasions and should appreciate the reclassification. This son of Rock N Roll Heaven is not without a chance but might take more support than we would be willing to accept for the lion's share. He can pick up a piece.

#10 TOUCHEM ALL JOE was stuck first-over a long way before making the lead at the halfway point and was immediately challenged by our third choice, who was on his cover before that. He faded back to sixth in the stretch but was the runner-up in this class two back when he was nearly six lengths in arrears to Tuf Cooper at the wire. This son of Roll With Joe will have to overcome a difficult draw with post-10 but retains J-Mac in the driver's seat. He will likely be looking for a softer trip this time out and can pick up a prize.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

1. Woodbine, Mohawk and Greenwood fully support the responsible consumption of alcohol. Consequently, our bar staff are only permitted to serve two drinks at a time, per person, at all draft units and bars. Customers appearing to be intoxicated will be escorted off the property.

2. The consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in alcohol-free seating areas.

3. Customers are required to present their money to the mutuel staff before placing a wager. Please check to ensure that your mutuel ticket and change are correct before leaving the mutuel window.

4. In consideration of others, please refrain from smoking in non-smoking areas, as required by municipal bylaws. There is NO SMOKING anywhere within 9 meters of the buildings entrance or exit. Cigar and pipe smoking are not permitted.

5. Woodbine, Mohawk and Greenwood offer a wide selection of snacks and full-course meals. We therefore ask that food and beverages purchased elsewhere not be brought into our facilities.

6. Please refrain from using profanity throughout the facilities.

7. Children under 18 years of age are welcome at Woodbine and Mohawk during live racing events only, from two hours before the first race until one hour after the last race.

8. Parents who become separated from their children should report immediately to the Customer Service booth on the 2nd floor at Woodbine, or to the security office at Mohawk.

9. Dogs and other pets are not allowed into Woodbine, Mohawk and Greenwood with the exception of certified Working dogs.

10. Customers are welcome to use cameras and/or camcorders while visiting Woodbine and Mohawk racing areas. However, please refrain from using flashes around the horses, and from taking pictures of other customers.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
