# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#6 MAGICAL MAJOR** shipped back north of the border to return to the care of trainer Gary Lance in November but jumped it off as the 2/5 favorite in NW2 at Flamboro Downs in his first attempt back in this barn. He is one of five previous winners in the contest and has hit the board in eight of his 21 lifetime tries so far. This son of Father Patrick should appreciate getting back to NW1 for the first time in 17 outings and will be racing on the lasix program for the second time in his career. He showed promise early in his career and will start from the winningest post on the circuit in what looks like a winnable spot.

**#5 DEVILS ARCH** went up against OSS Grassroots rivals in his only two career attempts in August and made breaks in stride in both of those efforts. He returns to the races more than four months later and will take on older foes in this NW1 event. This son of Archangel went all the way on the engine in his qualifier on December 1st from the pole position and stopped the clock in 1:58.1 with a final quarter in 28.2 over a track that was two seconds off. He will have Jody Jamieson back in the driver's seat and can be a top contender if he can mind his manners.

**#3 R HOT TODDY** blew up as the 4/5 favorite when he made miscues in each of his last two at Western Fair and has not been able to stay flat in any of his five tries on the shorter surfaces on the B-tracks. He returns to Mohawk Park after qualifying successfully at this venue on December 9th and was over a length away from our top choice in that morning prep when settling for second. This son of Muscle Mass went a long way on the lead in his last two over this surface before rounding out the superfecta and will now be making his sixth start out of the barn of Stephen Bossence. He is in desperate need of a flat line but can land somewhere on the ticket.

**#4 WANIA** has finished second in each of his last two at Flamboro Downs and only missed by a quarter to City Lady in his latest. He finished more than six lengths in arrears to Kickin Your Mass two back in a race where our top selection made a miscue as the heavy favorite and has managed to hit the board in 14 of his first 30 career attempts. This son of Wheeling N Dealin will likely try to get forwardly placed off the switch from post-four and can stick around for a share. He is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

**Race 2 Selections**

**THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.**

**#2 BETTORHOLDONTIGHT** went an overland journey in his latest after getting away eighth from post-10 and was out wide on the final turn before fizzling out in the late stages to finish eighth at 7-1. He was moving well at the end of his mile on December 1st and only missed out on third by a small margin when closing rapidly in the center of the racetrack. This son of Bettors Delight got away eighth off the gate from post-two in that contest and was 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 27.1. He will now have the nation's leading driver James MacDonald in the driver's seat for the first time and is one we are more than willing to come right back to. Giving him the nod.

**#10 TWO FACED** was a \$26,000 yearling purchase at the Ontario Select sale that will now be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Murray Brethour. He was unraced at two and comes into this with three qualifiers to his credit, missing by just a head to Nora D in his most recent morning prep on December 9th. This son of Shadow Play paced his own mile in 1:57.4 on that occasion and fell just short of a rival that has six lifetime victories from 35 career outings. He was Sylvain Filion's choice over the one below and looks like he is ready to roll but must overcome a tricky draw with post-10.

**#7 DONT POKE THE BEAR** has missed by a head or less as the runner-up in both of his last two and was within a nose of Juju Hanover at the wire last week at odds of 3-1. He has hit the board in 19 of his 34 career starts but has not broken through with his first victory yet. This son of Betterthancheddar has only missed a cheque twice this season and typically turns in strong efforts but falls short of a trip to the winner's circle. He has an affinity for finishing underneath and that is where we will continue to utilize him. Chris Christoforou picks up the steer.

**#5 SERIOUS DRAGON** has made up ground from a long way out of it in his last two since transitioning to the big track from the B's and picked up a smaller share in each of those efforts. He got away seventh off the switch in his most recent outing and paced his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 27.3. This son of Fear The Dragon has hit the board in three of seven so far in his career and will pick up the driving services of Doug McNair for the first time in tonight's tilt. He will work from the center of the gate after having tricky starting spots in each of his last four and is worth a look if the price is right.

**#6 NO CONTROL** was one that we were fond of in his lifetime debut but had no chance at the lion's share after getting away sixth off the gate and being at a significant pace disadvantage when 10 lengths off the lead in the early going. He was hindered by a non-advancing outer flow on the final turn before blasting home in 26.2 off a back-half in 55 flat and was just two lengths behind the one below at the wire. This son of Control The Moment was a strong winner in his lone qualifier in preparation for that effort and will now make his second attempt under the lights. He will start from the best post position on the circuit and might get put into play off the gate this time around. Sticking with him but expecting many to flock in this direction tonight.

**#9 WARRAWEE YANKEE** was an impressive winner in the first start of his career on December 8th after being sent to the lead on the backside and then maintained a comfortable margin before stopping the clock in 1:54.4. He drifted out in the lane and then powered away from a rival that was trying to make gains to his inside but appeared to be within himself when coming home in 27.2 off a back-half in 56.3. This son of Sweet Lou should benefit from getting that experience under the lights and prepped for that effort with a pair of decent qualifiers. He goes up against a field that includes four of the rivals he bested last time but might face a more lively version of the one above this time around.

**#2 CATCHMEONTHEBEACH** exits the same race as the two above and was overland in the early going before landing seventh off the gate from post-10 but then made up ground along the pylons before settling for fourth under the wire. He was a long way back of tepid fractions in the early stages and was nearly 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.1. This son of Hes Watching is another that should benefit from a start to his credit and will slide down to the inside of the gate this evening with post-two. He retains Jody Jamieson in the sulky and can hit the ticket.

**#8 DELIGHTFUL LEADER** has not raced since September 12th in an OSS Grassroots tilt where he made a break in stride to take himself out of contention at odds of 45-1. He claimed the show spot at that level two starts prior and has since turned in a decent qualifier on December 9th, when he was just over eight lengths away from Nora D and Two Faced. This son of Bettors Delight has hit the board in three of his seven lifetime tries and might be able to work his way into the race from an outside draw. He will likely need a start or two to get back into the swing of things but can still pick up a slice with the right kind of trip.

He is just two for 20 in his career but notched those victories in back-to-back outings in October, with his most recent score coming in NW3. This son of Walner might enjoy the change of scenery and his new barn has had success with these types in the past. He gets the luxury of starting from post-six and will have Sylvain Filion at the helm for the first time.

**#1 BRASH LADY** finished second on December 8th as the 7/5 favorite after getting sixth off the gate and was more than eight lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. She managed to get within a pair of lengths of winner Lions Wish NI at the wire after trotting home in 28 seconds off a back-half in 56 flat. This daughter of Royalty For Life has hit the board in six of eight this season and has only missed out on a top two finish on two occasions. She might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position and is among the main chances.

**#3 ILUVMYMIUMIUS** has not raced since October 27th and made breaks in stride in each of her last two. 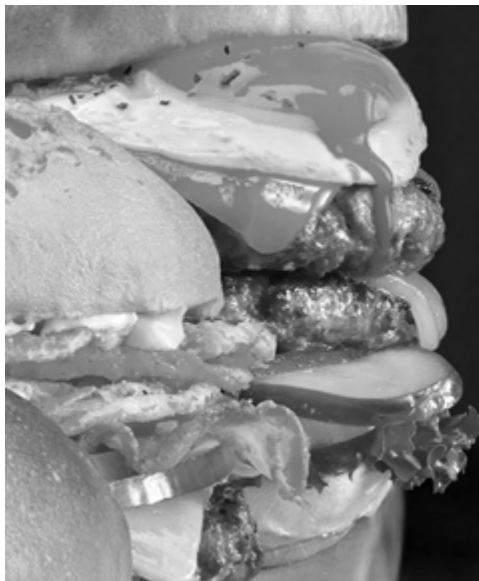

She does not take a big step up in competition this evening, even though it might appear that way on paper, and has our top honors in what looks like a winnable spot.

**#3 P L OOOOOOOOYAH** disappointed as the 2/5 favorite in her latest when she was picked up by a head at the wire by the one below. She went to the early lead from post-seven and looked comfortable on the lead until that rival came to call in the dying strides. This daughter of Thinking Out had won back-to-back races in her two previous tries at this class and will now make her second start off the claim for trainer Rob Fellows. She has hit the board in nine of her 16 career attempts and retains J-Mac in the sulky.

**#6 SUNSHINE SALLY** could not have gotten a better trip in her latest when she rode in the pocket behind the heavy favorite above and then got past her in the final strides for a mild upset at odds of 4-1. She had faded back to fifth two back after getting a similar journey but has now hit the board in four of her last five overall. This daughter of Sunshine Beach has earned a share in nine straight since relocating north of the border to the barn of trainer Carmen Auciello and figures to be moving forward off the gate again this evening from post-six. She should be feeling good about herself coming into this and can hit the ticket.

**#4 RMISSASHLEE** has hit the board in each of her last two at this level and most recently completed the trifecta behind the two above at odds of 9-1. She was the runner-up to our second choice at an even longer price two back and has proven she can be competitive with this group. This daughter of Ashlees Big Guy has been fourth in the three times when Louis-Philippe Roy has been at the controls and she will have that teamster back in the sulky for a third straight start. She might be able to work out a favorable trip from post-four and cannot be dismissed from the bottom end of the exotics.

## Race 11 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#8 SUNSHINEINMYPOCKET** only missed by a neck to the one below last week when racing alongside that rival for much of the stretch drive and has hit the board in each of her last three since transitioning to this classification. She was a pumped-up winner on November 17th when she scored by more than four lengths in 1:54.4 and had to settle for third two back when making her first start off the claim for trainer Richard Moreau. This 18-time winner turned in a better effort in her latest when getting back on a regular rotation and picks up the driving services of Doug McNair with Sylvain Filion now opting to pilot the one below. She will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but will likely be looking to neutralize that with her tactical speed off the switch.

**#7 LITTLEBEARCAT** has won two in a row at this level and somehow offered more than 4-1 when scoring by a neck in her latest after being last for much of the mile. She paced her final panel in 27.4 on the heels of a back-half in 56.2 and was claimed back by top trainer Richard Moreau in that contest. This 13-time winner was the runner-up to the one below in her only other start for this outfit on November 17th and disappointed as the 2/5 favorite on that occasion. She leaves the care of a barn that has had incredible success with her and she will likely offer a shorter price tonight after giving nice returns in each of her last two. Sylvain Filion opted to drive her over her stablemate above after making the opposite choice last week on a card that was canceled due to weather.

**#3 CLODAM BAYAMA** forged to the lead from the first-over position on the bend for home last week but did not have any answers for the two above when they came to call in deep stretch. She had to settle for third under the wire at odds of 9/2 and has been no worse than fourth in her last six overall. This 21-time winner comes right back in for the same price tag and will have Louis-Philippe Roy at the controls for just the second time in her career. She will work from the inside of the gate and should have every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

**#5 PEGGY J** was not able to make any impact in her latest after getting away sixth off the gate in the bottom condition class and did not advance a position before finishing nearly 13 lengths off the winner Western Wish at the wire. She was a runner-up against a softer group at that level two back when making her first start out of the barn of trainer Shayne Barrington and will now drop down into the claiming ranks for the first time on this circuit. This 16-time winner should appreciate the reclassification and can pick up a decent chunk if she can work out a reasonable trip from the center of the gate.

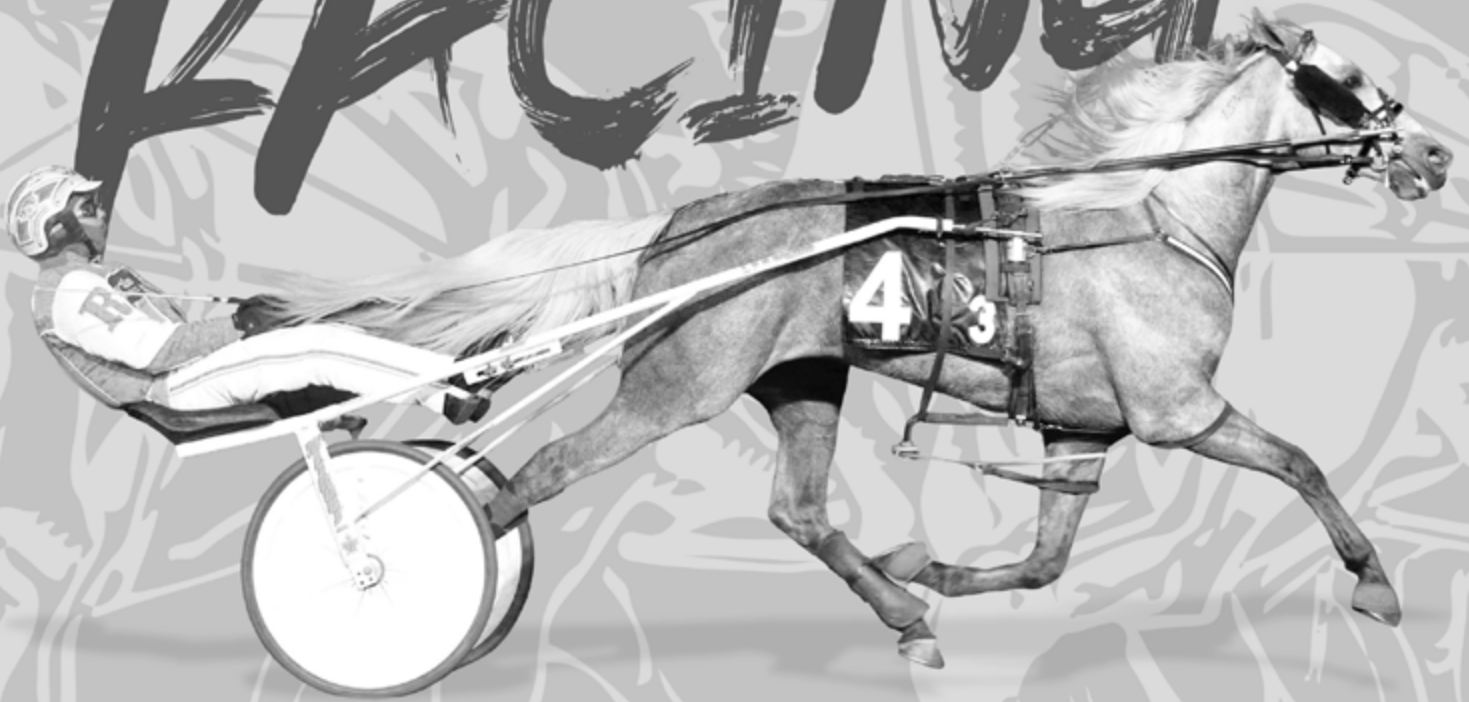
**#2 THE AMAZINGSANDO** rallied into the place spot in the claiming handicap class above this on November 28th after getting away last off the gate from post-eight and paced his back-half in 56 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.2. He will now make his second attempt out of the barn of conditioner Richard Moreau and has his price tag slashed by \$5,000 after being scratched out of his latest due to sickness. This son of Dali has hit the board in eight of his last nine but has been off for more than three weeks coming into this. He picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy and should appreciate going up against softer rivals this time around. Giving him the nod in the nightcap.

**#5 ROCKINMYDREAM** was able to slip into the two-hole in his latest after being on the cover of a rival that cleared to the lead on the backside. He managed to emerge victorious by half a length as the 2-1 favorite and will now be making his second start off the claim for top trainer Richard Moreau. This 10-time winner has been second or better in two of his last three in this class and gets jammed right back in for the same price tag this evening. He will leave from the center of the gate and got the nod from Sylvain Filion over his stablemate above.

**#9 THANKYEVERYMUCH** is one that we have been chasing and he managed to get within three quarters of a length of the one above last week when once again racing from off the pace. He rolled wide on the bend for home in that effort and paced his final quarter in 28.2 off a back-half in 57.1. This 27-time winner does not have much tactical speed off the switch and that typically puts him in a deep hole. He will likely have a lot of work to do again in the stretch after having to start from post-nine but is more than capable of working his way onto the ticket.

**#10 FOUR FOR ORR** exits the same race as the two above and rounded out the superfecta in that contest at odds of 12-1. He got away last off the switch from post-eight and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and rolled wide on the final turn before pacing home in 28.3 off a back-half in 57.2. This 18-time winner will get another crack in this class in his fifth outing for trainer Courtney Bishop and will have to avoid a taxing journey when trying to work his way into the race from post-10. He can pick up a slice but that is likely his ceiling.

## CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
