Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



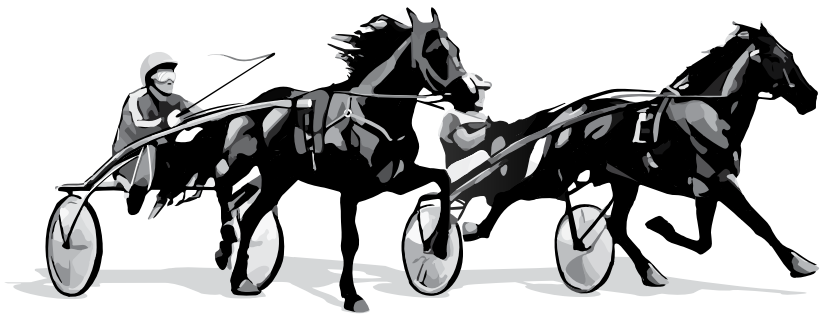
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 NIGHTLIFE SEELSTER was an easy winner last week in the class below this when she strided away by more than two lengths in 1:55 flat over a track that was two seconds off. She engaged in battle with Twin B Tipster on the bend for home and was too much for that rival to handle in the stretch. This 11-time winner rallied into fourth at this level on December 2nd and did not have much of a chance two back at this class when she got away ninth off the gate at 10-1 and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. She should be feeling better about herself going into this contest and will leave from the center of the gate with post-five. Giving her the edge in the opener.

#4 CASIMIR SWAMP GIRL got up by a nose at 21-1 in this class on December 9th after sitting in the pocket behind our fourth choice. She paced home in 27.2 off a back-half in 56.2 and has now won two of her last three, with that prior victory coming at much shorter odds of 8/5 in a second leg of a Pop-Up Series. This 27-time winner has earned a cheque in 10 of her last 12 and has emerged victorious in three of her last 10 overall on this surface. She has missed a week between outings but will likely get forwardly placed from post-four.

#3 BAD ROSSA improved two positions last week after getting away seventh off the gate and was four lengths back of Lock Bridge at the wire when grabbing a minor award in fifth over a track that was two seconds off. She got within half a length of that rival two back when blazing home in 26.1 and had hit the board in nine straight prior to her latest. This 10-time winner will now transition to NW6000L5 and will start from post-three for the second straight start after having the seven-hole or worse in four of her last six. Ryan Desroche picks up the steer.

#2 VOLUPTUOUS shipped back north of the border in prior to her effort two back and returned to the care of trainer Gregg McNair. She went a long way on the lead in her first start back on the circuit on December 9th but had to settle for the show spot when getting picked up by our second choice and Tuggingoncredit. This daughter of Sunshine Beach was taken back off the gate in her latest when going up against a tough group for the level and will be reunited with driver Doug McNair this evening, who has guided her to six victories and 10 on the board finishes in the 13 times they have been paired together.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 SOUTHBACH HANOVER was sent to the front-end last week in this class and held a comfortable margin for much of the mile before giving way to Woodmere Stealdeal and Rockin N Talkin before the wire. He was just a length away from the prior of those two rivals at the finish and more than three lengths better than the fourth-place finisher. This son of Somebeachsomewhere held on by a head on December 10th in NW3000L5 as the 1/5 odds-on choice and had not raced in more than two months going into that effort. He does not appear to hook the toughest field for this classification and will likely be tough to catch from post-two.

#1 NAUTICAL HANOVER switched back to racing from off the pace in his latest and could only improve one position before the wire when finishing sixth in a race that was won by Cadillac Bayama. He was at a pace disadvantage in that contest and came home in 53.2 with a final quarter in 27 seconds flat and likely needed an easier go of it after getting used hard in the opening panels at this level on December 10th. He looms a danger and can be right there at the wire.

#4 STONEBRIDGE REX got away fourth off the gate last week and moved to the outside on the bend for home but was unable to pass a rival before settling for the bottom spot on the superfecta. He was a runner-up two back in this class and has hit the board in four of his last six overall. This son of Control The Moment is just three for 41 on the season but has hit the board on 19 occasions and will have his regular pilot Doug McNair back at the helm this evening. He has finished second in each of his last three when that teamster has been aboard and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket tonight.

#3 DONTPOKETHEDRAGON returned to the circuit at this level in his latest and was unable to advance a position after getting away sixth off the switch. #2 JKS ROLLIN BABY was the runner-up last week when getting picked up by our top selection at the wire and only missed by a head in that effort after getting away fifth of seven off the gate. She went an even mile to finish fourth in her first start on the circuit two back and had not raced in over a month going into that effort. This 11-time winner has hit the board in 20 of her 29 career attempts and should benefit from racing back on a regular schedule for the second consecutive outing. She will start from another inside post position and has been progressing nicely for trainer Richard Moreau.

#8 NEED TO BREATHE exits the same race as the three above and sat in the two-hole for part of that mile before making a first-over bid on the turn for home. She got the lead in the stretch drive but could not hold off the three above when rounding out the superfecta, just half a length away from the winner. #1 J M SPEAK EASY took support to the tune of 9/5 last week when Louis-Philippe Roy jumped aboard for the first time but had to settle for the runner-up spot when she had no answers for our top selection in the stretch. She was parked out a long way before making the lead just past the half and crawled home in 31 seconds before being more than three lengths in arrears to the winner at the wire. This daughter of Artspeak has not been worse than fourth in her last five overall and will leave from the pole position after having post-nine last time. She should offer an opportunity to take back some value for those who supported her last time and is not without a chance.

#9 GETITGETITGOTIT got away third off the gate in her latest and then moved first-over on the turn for home before having to settle for the show spot. She was unable to get past the one above in the stretch and has now earned a share in all of her five efforts so far at Mohawk Park after shipping north of the border from Hoosier Park. This daughter of Always A Virgin will have to overcome an outside draw but can pick up another prize with a decent trip. Jonathan Drury picks up the drive.

#1 HUNTER HILL did not have much of a chance in his latest when getting away eighth off the gate in the bottom condition and was 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He only advanced two positions before the wire but made up significant ground when pacing his back-half in 54.3 with a final quarter in 26.4. This 11-time winner has only picked up one prize in his last three over this surface but might get handled more aggressively this evening when making his fourth start on a regular schedule after missing nearly a month of action. He is not out of place against this group and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#3 DR JOE has earned minor awards in each of his last two at Rideau Carleton but was second or better in each of his previous four over that five-eighths of a mile surface. He will compete on the big track for the first time since August and will get to start from a favorable spot on the gate with post-three. #3 SAULSBROOK VICTOR was an impressive winner last week when he made multiple moves on his way to victory and scored by a comfortable margin when stopping the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:49.2. He was home in 27 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 54.2 and has now been second or better in three of his last five. This son of Source Of Pride picked up a minor award in his last two tries at this level but was climbing over top of rivals in deep stretch two back and would have likely done much better than a fifth-place finish if he had found a clear path in the late stages. He has never been better and has upset potential when getting back up to the top class on the circuit as one of only three in the contest that raced last week.

She only missed by half a length the week before when the one below was able to knife through late after getting a perfect trip and had another incredible season, where she has hit the board in 28 of 34 and added another \$423,127 to her ever-growing bankroll. This 57-time winner is the undisputed Queen of Pacing in Canada and it would be no surprise if she was able to double-up tonight. She will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest and should land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 SINTRA has been second or better in each of his last three and was a runner-up to the one above last week at odds of 5-1. He was able to get the better of that rival two back after splitting foes in the shadow of the wire after getting a pocket trip and will likely be in search of a similar journey this evening from post-five. This 46-time winner has enjoyed a resurgence ever since being purchased privately by The Stable and can pick up another decent chunk tonight. He will have Anthony MacDonald back in the sulky and cannot be dismissed from the exotics.

#10 STONE CARVER has spent his last two against much tougher competition in NW13650L5 and was unable to finish better than seventh in either of those two outings. He went on a four-race winning streak prior to that and was a dominant winner in each leg of the Harvest Series on his way to sweeping that late-closing event. This son of Bettors Delight should appreciate the transition back to a lifetime non-winners classification and might be able to overcome the 10-hole with a racing style that typically sees him come from just off the pace. He loses J-Mac to the one below but will have Austin Sorrie back at the helm, who has piloted him to a victory and five on the board finishes in the past.

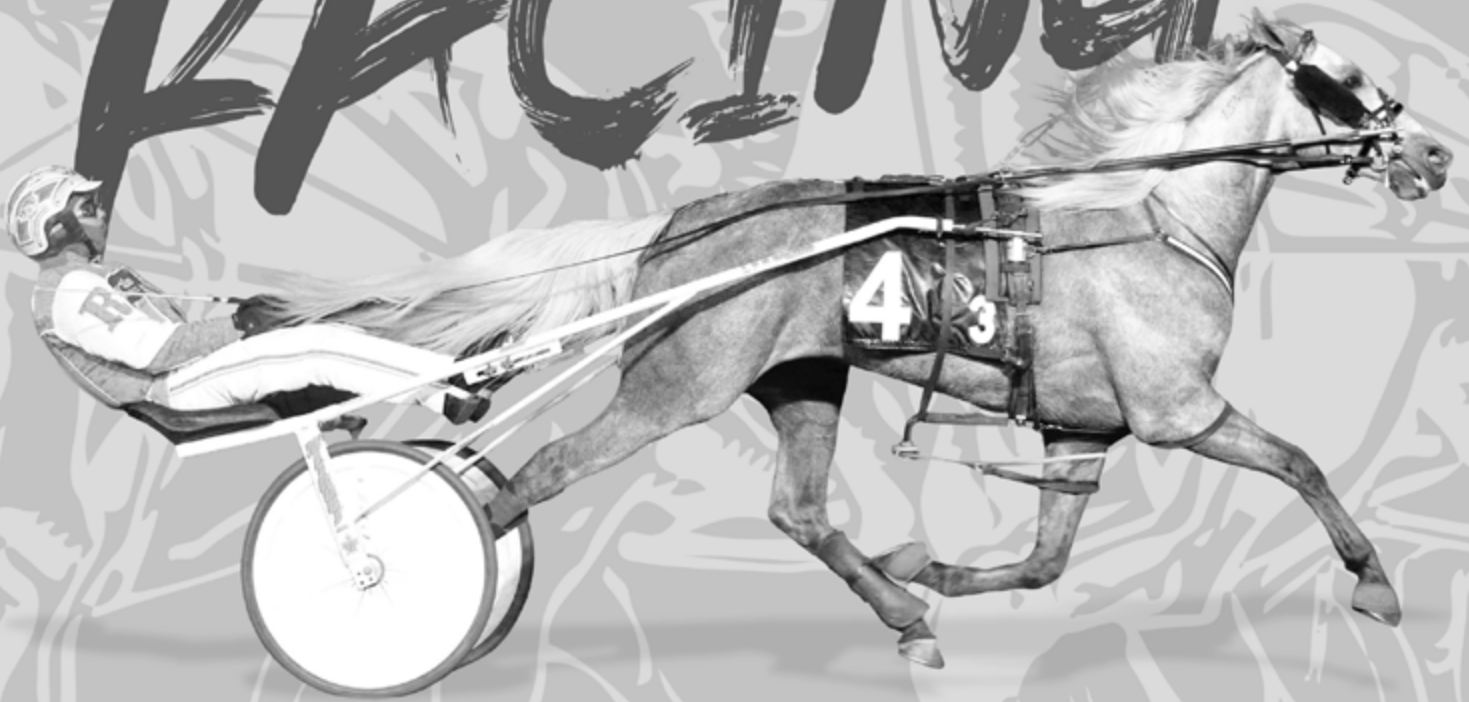
#2 ACAPULCO SUNBURN faded to sixth in the stretch after making a first-over bid in his latest and had missed a week of action going into that outing. He was placed up to fourth two back after going a similar journey as the 4/5 favorite and won back-to-back races at this level prior to that. This son of Big Jim will once again carry an optional claiming tag of \$50,000 and moves off the rail one spot to post-two. He might try racing off a helmet this time around and can get back the winner's circle in this spot with anything close to his best.

#12 YOURTHEONE won by a head last week in this class after getting away in the two-hole from post-six. He set hot fractions on the front-end the start prior before fading back to seventh and claimed the place spot under the wire three back but was placed back to fifth via disqualification. This 14-time winner has hit the board in 14 of 32 this season and is another that only gets to come back at this level because he will race for a price tag of \$50,000. He has been stymied with a starting spot from the dreaded second-tier but can make his presence felt if he can avoid getting caught in traffic.

#3 CONTROL THE POWER has had to leave from an outside draw in each of his last two and faded back to last in his latest after going to the lead and tripping the opening marker in 27 seconds flat. He did not have much of a chance two back when getting away eighth off the gate and and picked up a small prize in fourth on November 12th in this class. This son of Control The Moment will be reunited with driver Doug McNair and he has piloted him to two victories and four on the board finishes in the eight times they have been matched together. He should offer some value on the board and is worth using on the bottom end of the exotics.

#5 HOWIES MAN took all kinds of wagering support when getting bet down to 5/2 last week in NW2 and then dominated at every call to score by nearly three lengths in 1:52 flat. He was beaten by a wide margin two back when going postward at this level but had managed to hit the board in two of his last three. This son of Shadow Play loses J-Mac to our second choice and picks up Scott Young in the sulky. He must take a step back up the class ladder but can be competitive with this group if he progresses off his latest.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
