Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

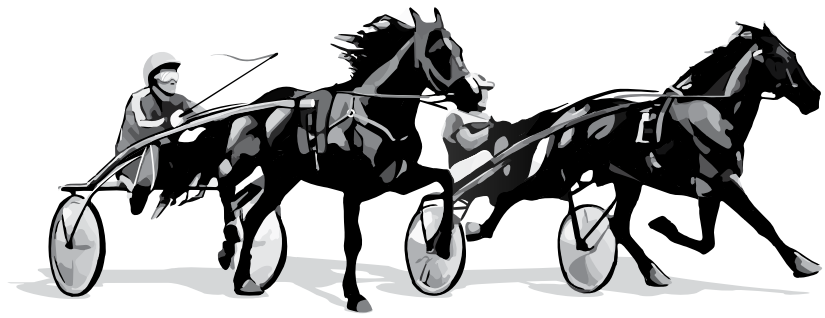
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 HEAVENSDOR HANOVER has been outrun in his last two when getting beaten by a wide margin and made a miscue three back to get distanced from his rivals. He was on the lead when entering the stretch on November 4th in this class and was only picked up by Villefranche As in that contest when going off as the third choice in the betting at odds of 5/2. This son of Donato Hanover faces an easier installment at this level today and should appreciate leaving from the inside of the gate after having the eight-hole or worse in each of his last four. He will be reunited with driver Jody Jamieson and has our vote of confidence to kick off the card.

#4 HAWAII took all kinds of action when being off at 2-1 on December 16th in this class and was sent to the lead on the backside before tiring to finish seventh in the stretch. She crawled home in 32.1 when getting beaten nearly 14 lengths to winner Not So Cool but went into that effort off a strong looking qualifier where she followed Run Director around the racetrack in a loose pocket before trotting her own mile in 1:56.4. This eight-time winner is five for 19 in her four-year-old campaign and will now be making her second start back after missing more than two months of action. She picks up James MacDonald in the sulky and has rebound potential.

#7 VICTOR INVICTUS is just two for 39 this season and has been camera-shy throughout his career with just six victories from 85 attempts. He has managed to hit the board 25 times over that span and has picked up a prize in three of his last four. This son of Kadabra rounded out the superfecta at 25-1 in the class above this on December 16th and was a winner at this level back in August. He should be more than competitive against this group and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 MR FRITTER was sent to the early lead in his latest but then faded back to sixth in the stretch and was beaten by more than 17 lengths in a race that was won by O Narutac Perfetto. He went into that outing off a break in stride at Flamboro Downs on December 3rd but was the runner-up in a pair of consecutive outings prior to that, missing by three quarters of a length in each of those efforts. This son of Muscle Mass is another that is light in the win column in his career with just three victories in 35 appearances but has managed to hit the ticket 15 times over that span. He will get a driver switch to Chris Christoforou for today's tilt and can grab a share.

#8 ACRIMONY was scratched out of the second leg of the series after she fell on her way to the track for the post parade. She was an impressive winner in her first attempt on the circuit the week prior when she scored by a comfortable margin at odds of 3/5 and stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.2. This daughter of A Rocknroll Dance had not raced in more than a month going into that effort and will now race back on a regular rotation in her second attempt out of the barn of Jean-Francois Maguire. She has been no worse than second in each of her last five but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest and will likely still get hammered at the windows.

#3 J ONE TWENTY was a lights-out winner last week when she made every move a winning one and scored by nearly six lengths when equalling her lifetime mark of 1:55.3. She benefited from the scratches of both the one above and below in that contest but turned in a solid effort against those foes the week before when finishing with pace behind them in the show spot under the wire after having to wait for clearance in the stretch. This 12-time winner also had some traffic trouble three back when making her return to this surface and rhymed off five straight victories at Western Fair prior to that. She has gotten along well with driver Scott Young and should be confident coming into this.

#1 BABY BONITA was scratched in her latest due to sickness and was the runner-up to our top choice in the opening round of the series after having a pocket trip for much of the mile. She gamely chased that winner to the wire but was still more than a length in arrears at the wire when settling for the place spot at 7/2. This daughter of Sunshine Beach has been second in three of her last four but is just one for 23 in her sophomore campaign after winning five of 11 as a two-year-old. She will likely try to push out for position off the gate from the rail and should be in the mix throughout.

#2 QUEEN OF SOUL was the runner-up to our second choice last week and was nearly six lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire at odds of 3-1. She has hit the board in four of six since joining the barn of trainer Meg Crone and has cracked the top three in 11 of her 22 lifetime tries so far. This daughter of Classic Card Shark might be able to work out a favorable journey from post-two but finishing on the bottom end of the trifecta or super is likely her ceiling.

#8 JIM STRIKESITRICH moved first-over on the bend for home last week and picked up some cover near the top of the stretch before grinding down his rivals before the wire. He was not under much urging when inching away from his foes in the dying strides and was hammered down to even-money in that contest after turning in a much-improved effort the start prior when claiming the show spot in NW2800L3. This 13-time winner will now make his fourth start back in the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau and has finished in the top two in five of nine when racing for this outfit. He has paced home in 27.3 in each of his last three and will likely try to get past them all in the late stages again this evening when starting from post-eight.

#6 STATE OF PLAY has picked up a cheque in each of his last five in the claiming handicap class above this since being claimed back by trainer Joe Pereira for \$13,000 at this level on November 14th. He claimed the place spot on that occasion in this class and finished third against tougher rivals on November 28th. This 18-time winner fits well against this group and will have the luxury of starting from the winningest post on the circuit. He will have Jody Jamieson back at the controls and will be one of our main players underneath.

#7 SIGHTS ON YOU was only beaten by a head to Viper when racing off the claim for high-percentage conditioner Raphael Bourassa on December 18th at Flamboro Downs. He has picked up a prize in seven of his last eight and returns to the big track, where he was fifth two back at this level. This nine-time winner will have Doug McNair aboard for the fourth time in his career and will likely be forwardly placed off the switch from post-seven. He can take another step forward for his new barn and should not be left out of the exotics.

#3 BETTOR NOTBITTER A finished seventh in the claiming handicap class above this in his latest and had missed three weeks of action going into that effort after being scratched due to sickness on December 5th. He should appreciate the drop back down in class and has consistently picked up pieces when racing at this level. This 32-time winner will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile from post-three and should get every chance to snag a decent slice.

#8 BACKSTREET GAMBLER was an impressive winner on December 17th when he sat a perfect two-hole trip to Sports Fan and then blew past that rival in the stretch to score by as much as he pleased in 1:53.3. He was under tight lines to Tyler Jones at the wire and blasted home in 26.4 off a back-half in 55.3. This son of Betting Line will now be making his third start for trainer Mike Bishop and tipped his hand to his recent crush job when he paced his final panel in 26.1 when racing off the bench two back. He gets to come right back in the same class and is hard to look past after finishing with lots in the tank last time.

#7 LAST BEACH was one that we were fond of on December 3rd but he was scratched out of that contest due to lameness. He has since come back to dominate his rivals in a qualifier on December 19th, where he won by nearly 16 lengths in 1:55.3 over a track that was one second off. He caught our eye in his latest start on November 26th when he got away seventh off the gate from the pole position in NW3 and was fourth-over in a stalled outerflow on the bend for home. This son of Somebeachsomewhere dove to the inside at the top of the lane and encountered traffic trouble before angling back to the outside, where he found his best stride after it was too late. He will be making his second start out of the barn of trainer Ben Wallace and looks like he is good to go off that recent morning prep but has hooked a tough opponent in the one above this time.

#3 HASHTAG MONEY was second to Howies Man last week at this level and was unable to stay within two lengths of that pumped-up rival but managed to hold a safe margin over the favorite Whammer Jammer to the wire. He was competing in added-money events in his prior five outings and has hit the board in four of his last six overall. This son of Sunshine Beach picks up the driving services of Jody Jamieson but is hard to back in the win position after going winless in 18 so far in his sophomore campaign. He can work out a favorable trip from post-three and can land somewhere underneath.

#4 SPORTS FAN was no match for our top selection in his latest and finished nearly six lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire after chopping out sensible fractions in the opening three panels. He went a huge mile at Western Fair in NW40000L on December 5th when he paced his mile in a sizzling 1:54.4 and that victory completed a two-race win-streak over that half-mile surface. This son of Sportswriter is seven for 17 lifetime with 10 on the board finishes but will likely have to settle for a smaller piece in this spot.

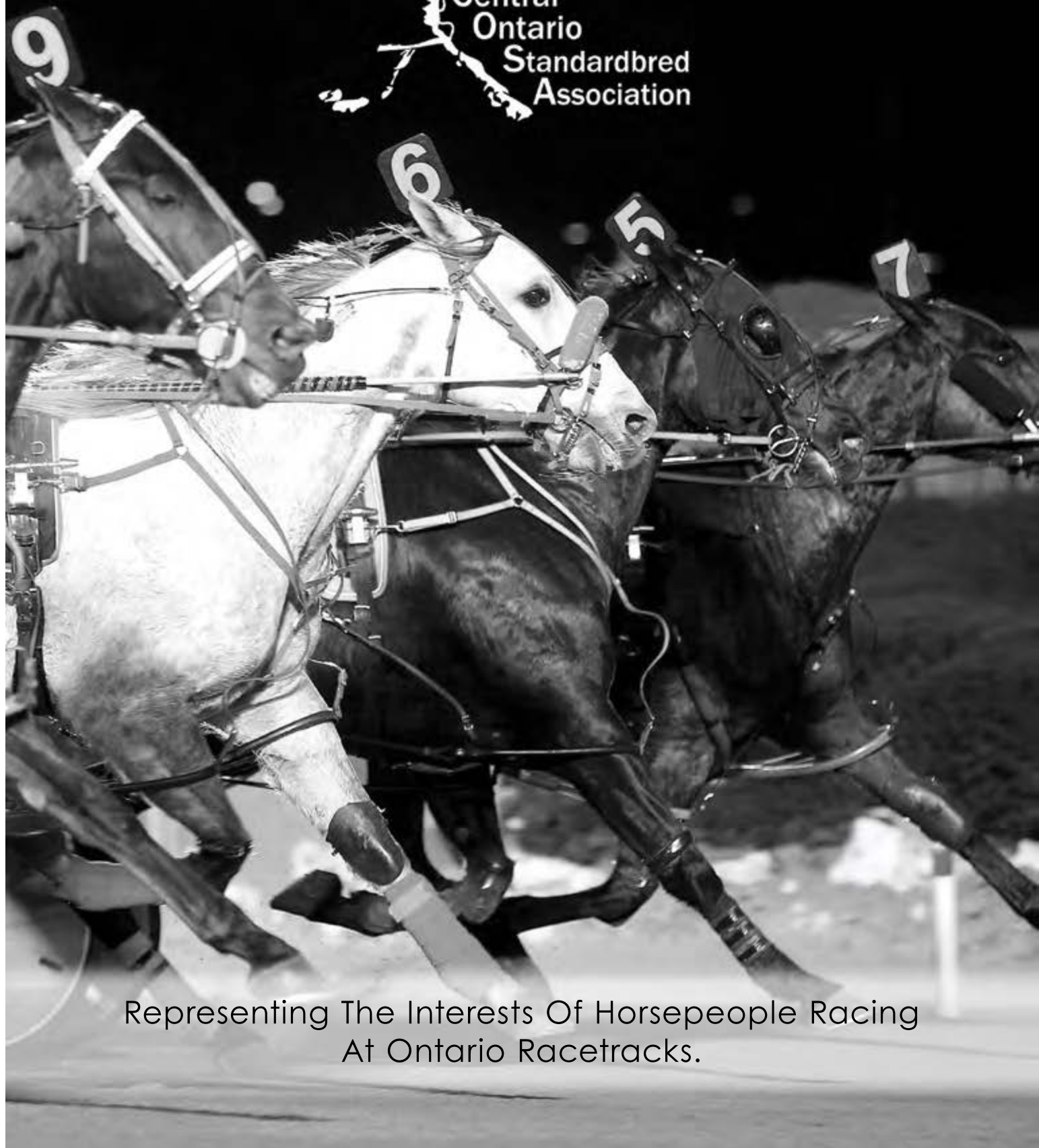

He got away fifth off the gate and was shuffled back on the bend for home before trotting his final quarter in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 57 seconds flat. This 21-time winner has hit the board in five of his last seven and only gets to come back in this classification because he will once again race for the optional claiming tag of \$65,000. He has proven to be versatile in his racing style and picks up Bob McClure in the sulky for the first time. Giving him the edge.

#6 THE LIONKING AS finished fourth at his level two weeks ago after sitting the three-hole for much of the mile and has secured that position or better in four of his five outings since relocating to this circuit. He was the runner-up in back-to-back outings in November, including just missing by a neck to the one above at this level at odds of 9/5. This 26-time winner has been in good order for trainer Boyd Wilson and will have the benefit of working from post-six in today's tilt. He was J-Mac's choice over the one above and can be right there at the wire.

#4 HP ROYAL THEO exits the same race as our top two selections and sat an inside trip in that contest before running into some traffic trouble in the stretch drive. He had to settle for sixth under the wire at odds of 3-1 but went a long way on the lead two back in this class before giving way to Itstimetogohome in the final strides to disappoint as the lukewarm favorite at 9/5. This 15-time winner will be making his fourth start back in the barn of trainer Ben Baillargeon and is among the main chances. He should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#10 PATRIARCH HANOVER got a much-needed confidence boost in his latest when dropping down to NW5100L5 and scored by more than a length in that contest as the odds-on choice. He had produced lackluster performances in his prior three at this level but that victory last time might be just what he needed to trend back in the right direction. This 16-time winner has all kinds of back-class and was a winner in the Free For All over this surface back in May. He looms as a danger but will have to overcome both a step up in classification and a tricky draw with post-10.

#6 SOUTHWIND CAESER improved a couple of positions before the wire last week in this class after getting away eighth off the switch from post-nine and was more than 15 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He was only four lengths away from winner Patriarch Hanover at the finish after trotting his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 27 seconds flat and was third to Franks Angel two back at this level. This son of Father Patrick has hit the board in three of five since shipping north of the border to join the barn of trainer Jodie Cullen and can get to the winner's circle for the first time since September if he gets activated sooner in the mile this time around.

#5 PHOENIX faded back to eighth after going an overland journey in his latest at the level above this and has now finished in that position in each of his last two. He jumped it off at the start two back but was a decent third behind Hang On Baby and The Lionking As before that. This 13-time winner will be reunited with the nation's leading driver James MacDonald, who has guided him to one victory and three on the board finishes in the five times they have been matched together. He might get over bet from post-six but is capable of giving this group all they can handle with anything close to his best.

#3 CASCADA never got a chance in his latest at Flamboro Downs when he was shuffled back to eighth before the turn for home after getting away fourth off the switch. He appeared to have trot in the stretch drive when trying to find a clear path and was a winner over this surface on November 28th in the preliminary leg of a Pop-Up Event. This 11-time winner has been no worse than fourth in his last three at Mohawk Park and will work from a favorable spot on the gate in post-three. He should not be taken lightly and is worth a look if the price is right.

#2 SO NOT COOL broke through with his first victory of the year in his 10th start of the season and he had not found the winner's circle in nearly two years prior to that score. He has hit the board in six of his last nine overall and will now step back up the class ladder to NW3000L5. This 13-time winner picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy for the first time in his career and can grab a share.

#4 SPEAKING OF ART went a long way on the lead in his latest in the claiming handicap class below this and was caught by a head at the wire by Royal Renegade. He disappointed as the 7/5 favorite in that affair and had earned a share in three of his previous four at this level. This 11-time winner was plucked out of that contest by Shayne Barrington for \$20,000 and that conditioner has opted to raise his price tag by \$3,000 when stepping up to this level. He is just one for 16 on the season but has hit the board in eight of those efforts and will now race for an outfit that has had all kinds of success with these types in the past. Giving him the nod.

#10 JULERICA advanced a couple of positions to finish fourth last week after getting away sixth off the gate and was only beaten by a neck two back at this level when he could not get past Quan Blue Chip at the wire. He will have to overcome the outermost post in today's tilt but he has had the seven-hole or worse in each of his last 13 and was sent to the early lead in nine of those contests. This 52-time winner has had incredible success racing for trainer Richard Moreau, with 18 victories and 29 on the board finishes from 38 attempts and might go back to his preferred style of racing on the front-end after taking a break from those tactics in his last three. He looms as a danger and can never be ruled out when racing for these connections.

#9 LEGAL BETTOR was sent to the lead on the backside last week and then did not let anyone get near him before scoring by a length at the finish in 1:53 flat. He has hit the board in each of his last five in this class and was claimed by trainer Carmen Auciello in his latest for \$29,000. This 22-time winner will have his price hiked by \$1,000 for today's tilt but as a result must slide out four spots on the gate to post-nine. He has repeat potential but will have to avoid a taxing trip.

#3 UNIQUE BEACH finished third at 29-1 when racing off the claim for conditioner Rick Zeron in his latest and was the runner-up to Night Club Hanover two back in the claiming handicap class below this. He has hit the board in seven of his last nine overall and might be able to work out a similar journey to his most recent effort from post-three. This 13-time winner will likely take more wagering support this time out but is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

He has earned a minor award in each of his last two since dropping down to this class and will move one spot off the rail today with post-two after having the pole position in all of his last three. This 20-time winner finds himself in another winnable spot and might benefit from racing off a helmet this time around. He figures to take the bulk of the support at the windows and can get back to victory lane for the first time since early October.

#7 OH LINA finished third at 31-1 in the Preferred at Flamboro Downs in her latest and had gotten away eighth off that gate from post-seven in that contest before rolling wide on the final turn. She has hit the board in five of her last seven at that venue and scored by a nose on November 20th on that half-mile oval. This 12-time winner will be reunited with driver Trevor Henry and that teamster has navigated her to a cheque in six of the seven times they have been paired together. She should offer value on the board and can help spice up the exotics.

#8 SHES GOT PIZAZZ has finished second in each of her last two and most recently disappointed as the 7/5 favorite in NW3000L5 when she was unable to stay with O Narutac Perfetto. She was more than five lengths back of that rival under the wire and was nearly four back of our second choice at the bottom level on December 9th. This 21-time winner might try to race from off the pace when having to work from the outermost post off the gate and can make some noise in the late stages. She is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 UNSUNG HERO comes into this Valedictory Final with a chance to sweep the series after being a dominant winner in both of the preliminary legs. He made a first-over move on the final turn in his latest and then tracked down a runaway leader before pacing away from his rivals in 1:51.1. This son of Always B Miki could not have done it any easier in his first two attempts out of the barn of trainer Chantal Mitchell and has now won seven of 20 so far in his career, with 11 on the board finishes. He is hard to look past and looks like a prime candidate to triple-up at what will likely be an even shorter price this time out.

#3 ULTRA IMAGE rallied into the show spot in the second round of the series last week and was just over four lengths back of the one above at the wire when pacing his own mile in 1:52 flat. He was mired in traffic two back when going off as the 4/5 favorite and could only salvage a fifth in that contest after blazing home in 25.4. This son of Rockin Image will now make his third start back off a layoff for trainer Rod Boyd and had missed nearly a month of action before making his first start on the circuit on December 10th. He should appreciate going up against a shorter field when the chips are down in the final and figures to get activated sooner in this mile this time around.

#2 CAMARA MOMENT hooked wheels near the top of the lane last week and ended up distanced after suffering that interference. He was trapped behind horses near the back of the pack when that mishap occurred and was third in the second leg of the series the week prior. This son of Control The Moment has won three of his last six and has switched to the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau for the final of the series. His latest result should not be held against him and he has a big chance to land on the bottom end of the exotics.

#6 JK MIKI MANTLE could not have gotten a more perfect trip scenario two back when he scored by two lengths at 3-1 after blasting up the pylons in deep stretch and then stayed along the cones again last week before unleashing his best in the stretch to pace into the place spot behind our top choice. He was never getting to that winner but should be feeling good about himself coming into this. This son of Always B Miki has won two of his last four and has hit the board in all of those efforts. He will start from the outermost post in this compact field and can pick up a slice.

This nine-time winner gamely chased the winner Tymal Riggs to the finish when trotting home in 26.4 off a back-half in 57.2 and might be handled more aggressively today after getting a flat line under his belt in his latest. He will work from the inside of the gate and got the nod from J-Mac over two others in the contest. Top call.

#10 POWER AND GRACE has won two in a row in the Preferred at Flamboro Downs and converted as the favorite in each of those contests. She has hit the board in five of her last six over that half-mile surface and will now return to Mohawk Park for the first time since June. This 45-time winner has been racing at the top of her game as of late and was victorious in this class back on May 2nd. She has enough early foot to get situated in a good spot off the gate and goes up against a group that is well within her reach.

#4 AUSSIE LOVER claimed the show spot in both of his last two at this level and has hit the board in each of his last four overall. He forged to the lead in the stretch drive of his latest but could not hold off a pair of rivals before the wire and the winner Tymal Riggs enjoyed a perfect second-over trip on his cover. This 17-time winner has been in good order for trainer Gord Remmen and should be a major factor again this week from post-four. Louis-Philippe Roy stays aboard and he can land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 O NARUTAC PERFETTO was a big time winner in NW3000L5 last week when he trotted away from his foes in the stretch to score by more than five lengths in 1:56.1. He went into that effort off a decent try in this class when he improved positions late in the mile to finish fifth at odds of 15-1. This 34-time winner has won two of his last four and had no right to get his picture taken at Western Fair on November 15th after being three-wide for much of the mile. He picks up Jody Jamieson at the controls and might get overlooked on the odds board.

#8 PARTYINTHESHADOWS is scheduled to come right back on just three days' rest and we will not know how he fared in the Hi-5 mandatory payout contest last Friday night at the time of writing this. He will have his price cut in half in today's tilt after racing for the optional claiming tag of \$50,000 in two of his last three and that is likely because he will lose his 25% allowance on that number when he turns five on January 1st. This son of Shadow Play should enjoy the reclassification and his stock only rises if he can produce a strong performance in that outing. Giving him our top honors in the penultimate race on this special Boxing Day afternoon card.

#4 MACH ART IN MOTION tried to split horses in the final strides last week and only missed by three quarters of a length at the wire in a race that was won by Midnight Mood. He had gotten away seventh off the gate from the pole position and was 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55.3 with a final quarter in 27.1. This 11-time winner will have his price tag raised by \$1,000 this evening and has hit the board in all three of his tries for trainer Joe Pereira. He picks up Travis Cullen in the sulky with J-Mac booking off to drive a Moreau pupil and can be right there at the wire.

#1 COIN FLIP exits the same race as the one above and was less than a length away from that rival when rounding out the superfecta in fourth. He got away fourth off the gate and sat an inside trip before making up ground in the lane when coming home in 27.2. This 19-time winner had hit the board in seven straight going into that effort and got to the winner's circle twice over that span. He will be making his second start off the claim for trainer Carmen Auciello and can make his presence felt against this group if the trip is sweet enough.

#9 REAL WICKED backed up to seventh after attempting a first-over bid in the Preferred ranks at Western Fair on December 20th and will now return to the claiming ranks in his second start back in the barn of trainer Michelle Sherman after that conditioner claimed him back for \$20,000 on December 12th. He has not picked up a prize in any of his last three but was a winner on November 28th in this class and should offer a decent number from the outermost post in this tilt. This 32-time winner will be reunited with driver Bob McClure and should not be ignored on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 SECOND BRUISER plunges down the class ladder to NW3000L5 after finishing seventh of eight in NW13650L5 last week and he had not raced in more than four months going into that effort. He qualified against Bulldog Hanover nearly a month before that outing and finished third to that juggernaut when pacing his own mile in 1:53.2. This winner of more than \$221,000 will now make his second start back off the bench and can give this group all they can handle if he is anywhere in the vicinity of his best. He will leave from a favorable spot on the gate and has our top billing in the finale.

#9 ILLGETMYOWN THANKS was parked out a long way before making the lead on the bend for home and opened a clear margin on his rivals in the stretch before having to settle for the place spot to Bayfield Beach. He was three lengths in arrears to that winner at the wire and blasted home in 25.4 two back at this level to finish fifth after racing from off the pace. This 12-time winner will get another crack at this class and picks up the driving services of Doug McNair for the fourth time in his career. He must overcome a difficult draw with post-nine but still looms as a danger.

#3 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER has taken on tougher competition in NW6000L5 in each of his last two and was sent to the lead in both of those outings before faded back to seventh or worse. He scored by more than three lengths when stopping the clock in 1:53.2 over a track that was one second off on December 3rd in this class and will work from post-three today after having the seven-hole or worse in all of his last three. This 20-time winner will once again likely be part of the early pace scenario and should get every chance to hit the ticket. He is not without a chance and cannot be excluded from the exotics.

#10 ITS IN THE STARS is a horse we have always been fond of and an intriguing option if you want to try to finish the card off with a bombs-away winner. He has won two of his last three at Flamboro Downs when racing from way off the pace but has also made breaks in stride in three of his last five overall. This son of Heston Blue Chip took his lifetime mark over this surface last April when he paced his mile in 1:52.4 and might enjoy getting back on the bigger track configuration at Mohawk Park. He will have Larry Small aboard for the fifth straight start and might be making some noise in the late stages at a big price.

#7 HERVEY HANOVER finished third in his latest when dropping down to the bottom condition class and got within three lengths of Typhoon Stride N at the wire after getting away sixth off the switch. He paced his back-half in 55.2 with a final quarter in 27.2 and will now step back up a notch on the class ladder. This 22-time winner has proven he can be competitive at this level in the past and can grab a share.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.

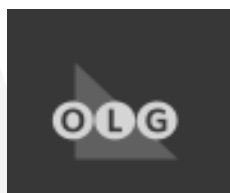
