# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

### Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

**WIN BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
**PLACE BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
**SHOW BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#7 ABSOLUTE EUPHORIA** was the easiest kind of winner in her lifetime debut when she swept the field from last and scored going away by more than three lengths under the wire. She stopped the clock in 1:58.3 over a track that was two seconds off and paced her back-half in 58.4 with a final quarter in 29.1. This daughter of Domethatagain should benefit from getting that first start under the lights and improved nicely off her pair of qualifiers in preparation for that effort. She was doing it all on her own in the late stages when under a strong hold to J-Mac and will get to race right back in NW1 but this time against foes her own age. Giving her the nod to double-up.

**#5 ROCKADELLA** was the runner-up to the one below in the first start of her career on December 17th at Flamboro Downs. She got away third off the gate from post-six and then followed the cover of the winner around the final turn before gamely chasing that rival to the wire. This daughter of Bettors Delight will now transition to the big track and races for a barn that went three-for-three on Tuesday night at The Raceway in London. She will have Trevor Henry aboard for the first time and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#3 ALLSTAR FINEST** has earned a cheque in six of her first seven and has won two of her last four, including a victory at Flamboro Downs on December 17th where she bested the one above by a length at the wire. She got away fourth off the switch and moved first-over before the bend for home before holding the one above at bay in the stretch. This daughter of Always B Miki will have Sylvain Filion at the controls and might be able to work out a favorable journey from post-three. She can hit the ticket.

**#6 TESLA POWER** will be making the first start of her career for trainer Rob Fellows and comes into this with a lone qualifier under her belt. She was five lengths in arrears to three-year-old Windsun Mojito in that morning prep and paced her own mile in 2:00 flat over a track that was one second off. This daughter of Betterthancheddar came home in 28.2 off a back-half in 59.3 and will have the luxury of starting from post-six in her first attempt under the lights. She picks up Jonathan Drury in the sulky and cannot be dismissed from the exotics.

She had won two of her last three stateside but has not raced in nearly two months prior to returning to this oval for the first time since August of last year in tonight's tilt. This 27-time winner comes into this off a decent qualifier, where she got within a length of Hes Swift at the wire, and will have Sylvain Filion aboard for the first time in a pari-mutuel event this evening. She will start from the center of the gate and has our vote of confidence on top.

**#6 KARMA SEELSTER** got situated in the two-hole behind speedster Major League N in her latest and closely attended a hot pace before having to settle for third under the wire. She has finished fourth or better in her last three at this level and will get to work from a starting spot that has had all kinds of success this season on the circuit. This 15-time winner will have Trevor Henry aboard for the second consecutive outing and will likely be a part of the early pace scenario. She is among the main challengers and can be right there at the wire.

**#1 LOCK BRIDGE** scored by open lengths on December 16th when she stopped the clock in 1:53.4 over a track that was two seconds off and will now be making her third start out of the barn of Richard Moreau after shipping up from Lexington. She did not win as easily as her backers likely expected in her debut on the circuit when she was swarmed in deep stretch but managed to hold on by half a length at the wire. This daughter of Captaintreacherous transitions to NW12500L5 and will start from the pole position. She should be feeling good about herself coming into this and can hit the ticket with a favorable journey.

**#2 TWIN B SUNKISSED** rallied from off the pace to finish second at 23-1 in her most recent effort when moving back up to this level and was just over a length away from Settn A Precedent at the wire. She was more than 15 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole in that contest and paced her back-half in 55 seconds with a final quarter in 28 flat. This 10-time winner has hit the board in each of her last three at Mohawk Park and emerged victorious in the final of a Pop-Up Series two back on December 2nd. She has been trending in the right direction and can pick up a slice.

**#1 DONT POKE THE BEAR** finally broke through with the first victory of his career on December 22nd when he was aided by a rival who made a break in stride in the stretch that appeared to be moving best of all in the late stages. He was winless in his first 34 outings prior to that score but has earned a share in each of his last 19 and has hit the board 16 times out of 24 tries this season with over \$61,000 in earnings. This son of Betterthancheddar has already proven he can be competitive at this level and getting his picture taken last time might be just what he needed to propel him to more trips to victory lane in his upcoming starts. He will be paired back with Jonathan Drury and that teamster might be able to navigate him back to the winner's circle this evening.

**#3 HASHTAG MONEY** got away fourth off the gate in a tougher installment of this class on Boxing Day and faded back to fifth in the stretch in a race that was won by Backstreet Gambler. He still paced home in 28.2 off a back-half in 57.1 and was a bang-up second to Howies Man two back at this level. This son of Sunshine Beach has been camera-shy throughout his career with just one victory from 24 attempts but has managed to hit the board in four of his last seven overall. He will be reunited with Sylvain Filion and has not been worse than third in his last four with that teamster in the driver's seat.

**#5 TALK TO ME ARTIE** has hit the board in each of his last three at Western Fair and was only a length away from Can Be A Treasure in his most recent effort in NW20000L. He will transition back to the big track for the first time since going postward in a leg of the Harvest Series in early November and was fifth in this class in his outing prior to that. This son of Artspeak will start from the center of the gate and will be reunited with driver Trevor Henry. He should offer some value on the board and is worth a look if the price is high enough.

**#2 NIGHT SHADOW** was never a factor in a leg of the Valedictory Series in his latest when sent off at odds of 91-1 but just missed by a neck two back in this class when he was caught by Emmetts Buddy at the finish. He has been second or better in three of his last four at this level and scored by more than two lengths on November 4th when he stopped the clock in career best 1:52.2. This son of Shadow Play picks up the services of a rising talent in Tyler Jones and should much prefer the company he keeps tonight in this NW2 event. He is capable of outperforming this projection but we prefer him on the bottom end of the exotics.

She had missed a week between starts going into that effort and has not missed a cheque in 16 tries in the overnight ranks this season. This 11-time winner has hit the board in four of her last six and will now make her third start back in the barn of trainer Ben Baillargeon. She will have the nation's leading driver James MacDonald back in the sulky and has repeat potential from post-five.

**#8 DABARNDAWGSWATCHIN** got away fourth off the gate in her latest and moved to the outside on the bend for home to end up second-over behind our fourth selection. She forged to the lead in the stretch but could not hold off the charge of the top two finishers and was half a length away from the one above at the wire. This 15-time winner has only missed a cheque twice in 34 outings this season and has been no worse than fourth in her last 13 overnight races overall. She had won two in a row going into her latest, including back-to-back victories in this class and will start from post-three for the fourth straight start. She can make her way back to the winner's circle with the right kind of trip but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest to do so. Trevor Henry picks up the steer.

**#1 JKS ROLLIN BABY** was the runner-up on December 17th when getting picked up by our top selection at the wire and only missed by a head in that effort after getting away fifth of seven off the gate. She went an even mile to finish fourth in her first start on the circuit two back and had not raced in over a month going into that effort. This 11-time winner has hit the board in 20 of her 29 career attempts and should benefit from racing back on a regular schedule for the second consecutive outing. She will start from another inside post position and has been progressing nicely for trainer Richard Moreau.

**#3 NEED TO BREATHE** exits the same race as the three above and sat in the two-hole for part of that mile before making a first-over bid on the turn for home. She got the lead in the stretch drive but could not hold off the three above when rounding out the superfecta, just half a length away from the winner. This son of Riggins has been no worse than fourth in all six of her starts on this circuit since shipping up from Hoosier Park to join the barn of conditioner Jodie Cullen and has not missed by much in her first three tries in the Preferred ranks. She will start from a favorable spot on the gate and can pick up another sizable slice with the right kind of trip.

He will get to come right back in the same class and will race back on a regular rotation after missing 16 days of action prior to that effort. This son of Donato Hanover was on the lead when entering the stretch on November 4th in this class and was only picked up by Villefranche As in that contest when going off as the third choice in the betting at odds of 5/2. He will have Jody Jamieson back in the sulky and we will come right back to that combination in the nightcap.

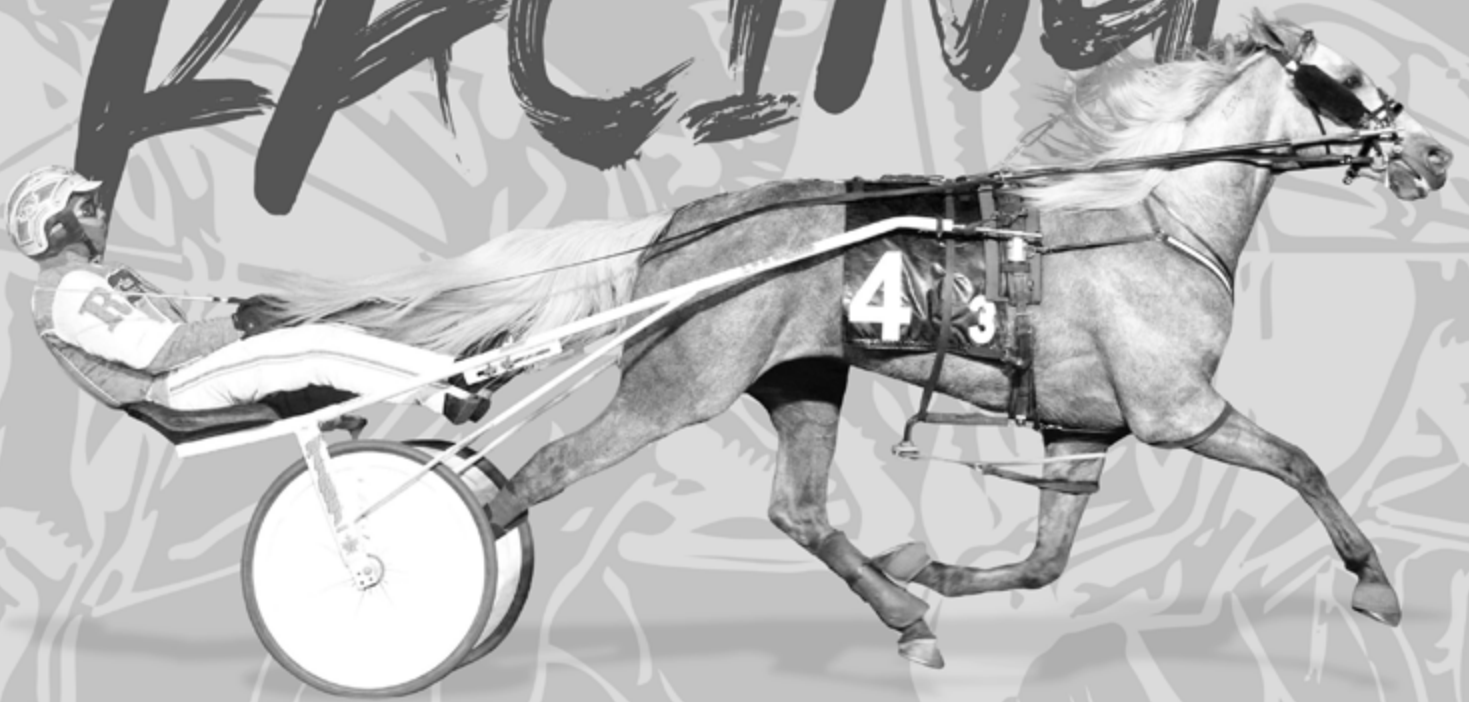
**#10 HP RUNNING MASS** was outrun in his latest when getting away last from the 10-hole in NW5000L5 and has walked away empty-handed in each of his last four. He should appreciate getting down to the bottom condition level this evening but has not raced since December 12th and will once again have to work from the outermost post. This son of Muscle Mass was a strong winner over this surface on November 7th when he stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.3 and picks up Bob McClure in the sulky. He fits well with this group and can be right there at the wire if his trip is not too taxing.

**#1 DARKANGELDESBOIS F** made a break in his latest at Flamboro Downs when going postward in the Preferred but was the runner-up two back in that class when just a length away from Power And Grace at the wire. He has been second or better in three of his last five on that half-mile oval and returns to Mohawk Park for the first time since early October. This 11-time winner should be more than competitive in this spot but might be handled conservatively in a race where a flat line is likely his top priority. He will start from the pole position and can land somewhere on the ticket.

**#5 CASCADA** picked up a minor award in fifth at 15-1 in NW3000L5 on Boxing Day and will now drop further down the class ladder to NW2000L3 this evening. He was third at 50-1 in this class on November 25th and then came right back to win three nights later in a preliminary leg of a Pop-Up Series. This 11-time winner will leave from the center of the gate and was Jonathan Drury's choice over the one below.

**#4 MUAY HANOVER** was the benefactor last Monday when our top selection suffered broken equipment in the stretch and made a break in stride. He got up by half a length at the wire at 16-1 and has now won two of his last three. This 19-time winner picks up the nation's leading driver in James MacDonald, as Jonathan Drury opted to drive his stablemate above. He should be confident coming into this and can grab a share.

### C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT: In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
