Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

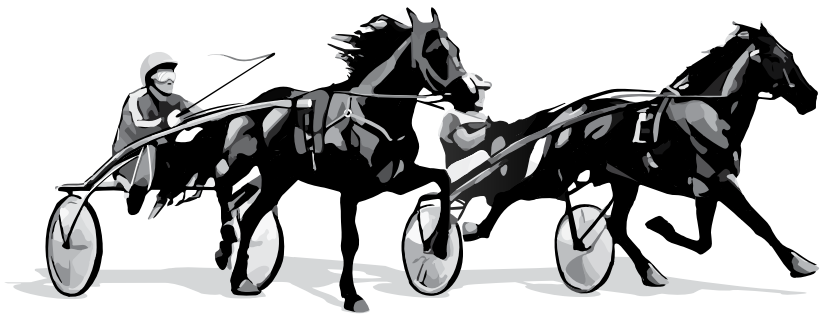
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

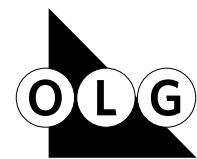
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#6 CENTURY GIGALO returns to the claiming ranks competing in lower condition races in each of his last two and most recently finished eighth in NW3000L5 in a mandatory Hi-5 event on Boxing Day. He was a front-end winner at the bottom level two weeks earlier and rounded out the superfecta in fourth the last time he went postward in this class on December 5th. This 16-time winner hit the board in 24 of 43 last season and will have the luxury of starting from post-six this evening. He will be reunited with driver Sylvain Filion and has our top honors to kick off the card.

#2 SPEAKING OF ART got away fifth off the gate last week and then made a first-over bid on the backside and battled Julerica on the bend for home before forging to the lead in the lane. He was swarmed by rivals from the backfield in the dying strides and had to settle for the show spot under the wire as the 2-1 favorite. This 11-time winner was plucked out of that contest by top trainer Richard Moreau and will have the circuit's top driver aboard for the first time in James MacDonald. He was just one for 17 last year but managed to hit the board on nine occasions and should be right there at the finish.

#5 SUNNY BO has not raced since October 23rd at Rideau Carleton but comes into this off a dominating qualifier at Mohawk Park, where he won by more than 21 lengths in 1:54 flat over a track that was one second off. He had hit the board in each of his last four at his previous venue but cracked the top three two times in his last six tries at this claiming handicap level. This 12-time winner will be making his first pari-mutuel start out of the barn of high-percentage trainer Raphael Bourassa and will start from the center of the gate. He is among the main chances and should not be taken lightly.

#4 OFFICER JONES won from way off the pace on Boxing Day in this class when he got up by half a length at the wire to light up the tote board at odds of 22-1. He has won two of his last three with that prior victory coming at Rideau Carleton on December 11th in a race where conditioner Joe Pereira shelled out \$15,000 for him. This 30-time winner will now make his third start off the claim for this outfit and will have emerging talent Tyler Jones in the sulky, who has been putting everything in play as of late. He has repeat potential but we prefer him on the bottom end of the exotics.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 HP MAMA B has spent her last three against the top trotters on the circuit and was a winner two back when she won by nearly three lengths in the Preferred at odds of 5/2. She went straight to the front in her latest and set hot fractions before fading to third in the stretch and has hit the board in each of her last five tries in the overnight ranks. This 16-time winner has been freshened-up by missing nearly a month of action and will have Scott Young at the helm for the first time. She has been second or better in her last three outings in condition races and can get back to the winner's circle in this spot. Giving her the edge on top.

#1 WHITE TIGER went a long way on the lead in NW19000L5 on December 19th but had to settle for fourth under the wire at odds of 9/5. He was a handy winner two weeks earlier when going postward in NW12000L5 and stopped the clock in 1:53.2 on that occasion as the even-money favorite. This 18-time winner hit the board in 12 of 24 last season over this surface and got the vote of confidence from James MacDonald over our fourth choice, who has won three in a row. He will start from the pole position and can be right there at the wire if he can summon his best.

#6 ITSTIMETOGOHOME has won two in a row and will move up in class again this evening after stepping up to NW19000L5 in his latest, where he held on by a neck over Resolute Bay. He has hit the board in each of his last seven and has only finished worse than fourth once in his last 12 since returning from the shelf last September. This 14-time winner has been in top form for trainer Richard Moreau and got the nod from Sylvain Filion over Run Director, who he has driven on a regular basis throughout his career. He will start from the outermost post in the contest against a compact group but can make his presence felt.

#4 LOOKS LIKE MONI has won three in a row since relocating north of the border to join the barn of conditioner Harry Poulton and looks like another solid purchase for The Stable after being acquired by that fractional ownership empire back in November. He has won by a wide margin in each of his last two and has been hammered down to even-money or less in each of his recent victories at Mohawk Park. This son of Muscle Hill loses James MacDonald to our second choice and will pick up his brother Anthony at the reins. He should be brimming with confidence but he faces another challenge with going up against tougher rivals this evening.

#1 PHOENIX was a comfortable winner in NW3000L5 on December 26th and went all the way on the lead in that contest before stopping the clock in 1:57.2. He needed that confidence boost after going winless in his previous 11 and was competing in much higher classifications last spring. This 14-time winner steps back up a notch on the class ladder but retains J-Mac in the bike, who has guided him to two victories and four on the board finishes in the last six times they were paired together. He will have to mind his manners when trying to get away cleanly from the pole position but is capable of doubling-up against this group.

#6 JACK FIRE got away eighth off the gate in NW12000L5 in his latest and advanced four positions before the wire to complete the superfecta at odds of 9-1. He was more than 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and trotted his back-half in 57.2 with a final quarter in 28.4. This 10-time winner will now be making his third start for trainer Ashleigh Hensley and will race on a regular rotation for the second consecutive outing since shipping north of the border from Hoosier Park. He also gets significant class relief this evening and starts from a post position that had all kinds of success last season.

#8 KAMERAN HANOVER did not have much of a chance last week when he got away last off the switch and was nearly 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He was only able to improve one position before the wire but had not raced in three weeks going into that effort. This 20-time winner was fourth or better in his prior two outings at that level and was a winner by a neck in this class on November 21st. He should benefit from getting back in on a regular schedule but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest.

#5 DERF HANOVER exits the same race as the two above and was just over four lengths away from winner Free Willy Hanover at the wire after getting situated in the two-hole off the gate. He managed to pick up a prize in each of his previous three efforts and was the runner-up Franks Angel in this class on December 12th. This 22-time winner will have Sylvain Filion in the driver's seat for the first time since October of 2021 and will likely get forwardly placed from the center of the gate. He is worth using in the exotics.

This 13-time winner was victorious in this class on December 19th and will be reunited with driver Sylvain Filion, who has piloted him to two victories and four top two finishes in the six times they have been paired together. He will start from the winningest post at Mohawk Park in 2022 and figures to be making a lot of noise in the late stages.

#4 BETTOR NOTBITTER A moved first-over before the bend for home when dropping back down to this level on December 26th but was unable to make any gains on the pacesetter before setting for fourth at the finish. He was more than six lengths away from the winner Big Journey at the wire but has picked up a prize in each of his last seven in this class. He has not made a trip to victory lane since September but can land somewhere on the ticket if the trip is sweet enough.

This son of Sunshine Beach had been second or better in seven of his last eight prior to that and does not look out of place against this group. He is not without a chance if he is ready to roll and should offer some value on the board.

#6 WILDRIVERBUMBLEBEE exits the same race as our top selection and was overland for much of the mile in that contest before having to settle for a smaller share in fifth at 16-1. He was outrun throughout after getting away last from the 10-hole two back in NW6000L5 but was a winner in a preliminary leg of a Pop-Up Series on November 26th. This 19-time winner will have the luxury of starting from post-six after having post-eight or worse in his last four and Tyler Jones will be back in the sulky for a second consecutive outing. He might get put into play off the switch this time around and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#2 FOREFATHER has not picked up a prize in any of his last five but will now drop back down to NW2000L3, where he was last a winner on November 5th. He scored by a wide margin on that occasion when he stopped the clock in 1:50.4 and will get to work from the inside of the gate this evening after having the seven-hole or worse in three of his last four. #6 JAYDENS PLACE has spent his last two in the claiming handicap class above this and picked up a smaller slice at that level on December 19th when he finished fifth at 63-1. He won two in a row prior to that at Flamboro Downs when racing for a price tag of \$18,000 in a condition claimer and was only beaten by a length in fourth the last time he went postward in this class on November 14th. #8 PIKACHU HANOVER returns to the races after a hiatus of more than three months and comes into this off a winning qualifier, where he bested our top choice by just over a length at the finish. He hit the board in three of his last four and had 16 top three finishes in 2022 from 27 attempts. This 27-time winner will have to overcome a difficult starting spot when racing off the bench but can be more than competitive in this spot if he gets put into play off the switch. He should not be dismissed from the exotics and is worth keeping an eye on for next time.

#2 SIZZLEN HOT HERBIE has won two of his last five in the Preferred ranks on the B-tracks and blew his rivals away on the engine two back at Western Fair when he scored by more than three lengths in 1:57.4. He was left with a lot of work to do in his latest over that half-mile surface and managed to get within a length of a pumped-up winner in Scene A Magician at the wire after getting away seventh off the gate. This 26-time winner's best performance at Mohawk Park was a second-place finish last April against similar company and he has been razor sharp as of late for driver/trainer/owner Natasha Day. He should offer some value on the board and is worth a try on top.

#1 P L OPPORTUNITY missed by a neck to Tymal Riggs on Boxing Day after sitting a perfect pocket trip behind that rival for much of the contest. She trotted home in 28.4 on the heels of a back-half in 57.4 and has been second or better in three of four since returning from a layoff of more than two months. This 13-time winner has not been worse than fourth over that span and managed to win at the highest level for trotters on this circuit back in July. She will start from the pole position and can be right there at the wire again with another favorable journey.

#8 STAY CLOSE exits the same race as the one above and made a first-over bid in that contest but was unable to get near the pacesetter on the final turn and had to settle for fifth under the wire. He was more than four lengths away from the winner Tymal Riggs at the finish but was the runner-up to that same rival two back at this level. This son of Father Patrick got the nod from James MacDonald over two others in the contest but will slide out to a more difficult starting spot with post-eight. He will need to come up with a better effort to get back to the winner's circle but cannot be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#6 TREASURED TEE went a long way on the lead in NW6000L5 in his latest but could not hold off Mr Contestant at the wire when settling for the place spot by a neck. He tried similar tactics the start prior in this class but faded back to fifth in the stretch to finish in that position for the third straight start. This 18-time winner will have the advantage of starting from post-six and will be reunited with driver Sylvain Filion, who has piloted him to one victory and three on the board finishes in the nine times they have been paired together.

#3 UNIQUE BEACH faded back to ninth last week in this class but was a decent third the week prior when rounding out the trifecta at odds of 29-1. That effort attracted the attention of top trainer Richard Moreau, who plucked him for \$22,000 in his latest and has elected to put him right back in for that same price tag this evening. This 13-time winner has hit the board in three of his last five and got the nod from Sylvain Filion this evening over two others, including his stablemate who was second at this level last time. He will leave from a favorable spot on the gate and has our top honors.

#6 QUAN BLUE CHIP was the runner-up to the one below two weeks ago after sitting in the pocket behind that rival for much of the mile. He was claimed out of that contest for \$30,000 by conditioner Cassidy Schnieder and he was a winner in a previous stint for this outfit on November 21st. This 25-time winner has hit the board in each of his last eight in this class and has racked up a trio of victories over that span. He will leave from post-six for the fifth time in six outings and retains the services of top driver James MacDonald.

#7 LEGAL BETTOR went an overland journey to be fourth last week at this level after getting away sixth from post-nine and has been popular in the claim box as of late, changing hands in four of his last five overall. He was plucked for \$30,000 in his latest by trainer Garry Merner and was a winner in this class on December 19th when he went most of the way on the lead, comfortably holding off the one above at the wire. This 22-time winner has hit the board in five of his last seven and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket with Tyler Jones at the reins. He merits consideration but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest.

#5 NIGHT CLUB HANOVER closed from off the pace to get within half a length of victory in his latest after being more than 11 lengths off the lead in eighth at the quarter pole. He paced his back-half in 56.3 with a final quarter in 28.3 and was a comfortable winner in the class below this on December 12th. This 17-time winner has hit the board in three of his last four and picks up the driving services of Trevor Henry. He will likely be making noise in the late stages and is capable of picking up a decent chunk.

#5 ESQUIRE crushed his competition at Western Fair on December 26th when he scored by four lengths as the 1/9 favorite. He has won two in a row on the B-tracks by open lengths and will now return to the big track in NW3000L5. This 33-time winner will have Tyler Borth back in the sulky when this combination will look for three in a row together at three different venues and that looks like a strong possibility against this group. He will likely have his gas pedal pressed off the gate from post-five and has our top billing in the nightcap.

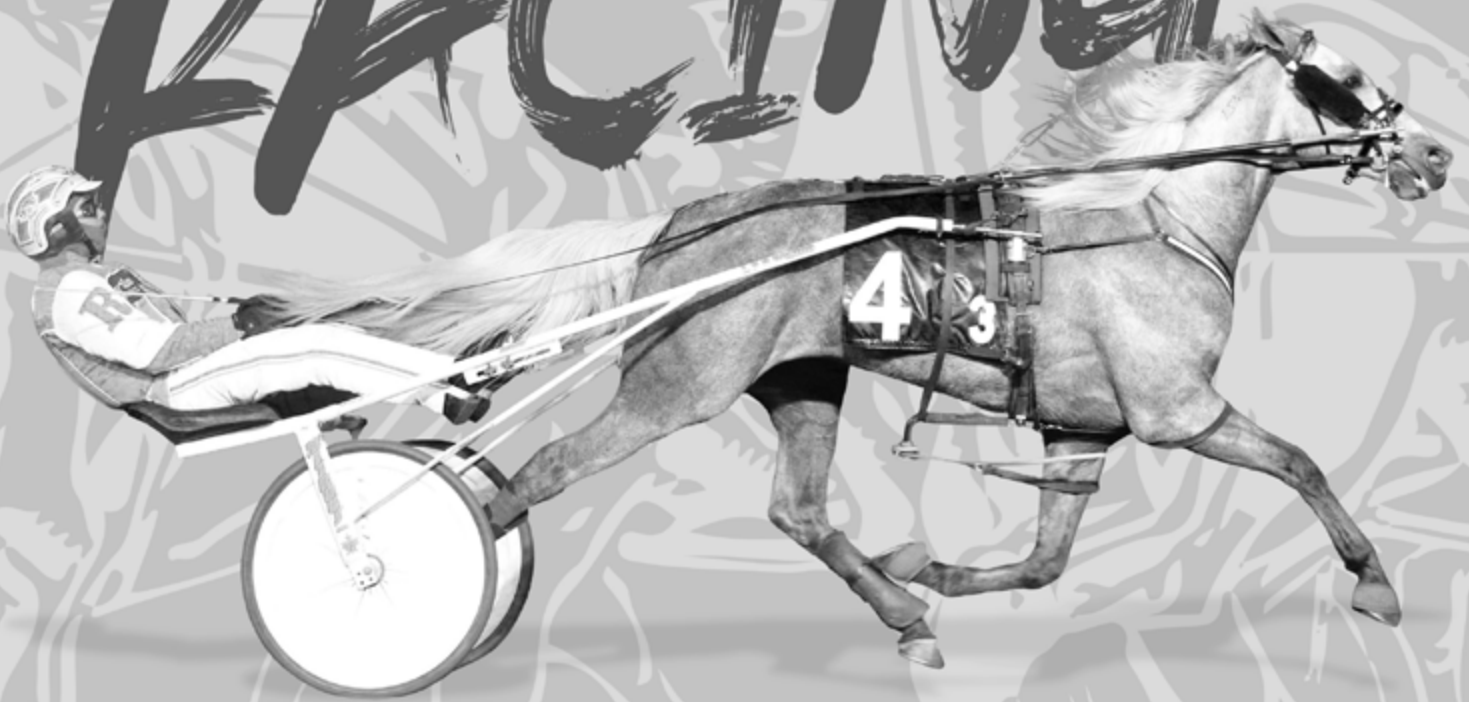
#3 SO NOT COOL was the runner-up to Phoenix last week when stepping up to this level and was just over a length away from that winner at the wire. He scored by more than a pair of lengths in the bottom condition two back and has hit the board in seven of his last 10 overall. This 13-time winner will now go postward for trainer Kyle Fellows and will be reunited with Sylvain Fillion in the sulky. He has been trending in the right direction and is among the leading chances in the finale.

#6 SHOSHIE DEO will be coming back with just one day of rest after being scheduled to go postward at Western Fair on New Year's Eve. We will not know how he fared in that NW2500L3 contest at the time of writing this but he has earned a share in four of his last five at The Raceway in London. This 21-time winner will be reunited with James MacDonald and that teamster has navigated him to a pair of second-place finishes at Mohawk Park in the past. He will start from the best position on the circuit and is worth a look if the price is right.

#2 SEVEN IRON rallied into the show spot in the Preferred at Western Fair in his latest and was just under four lengths away from a pumped-up winner in Scene A Magician at the finish. He was an impressive winner the week prior on that half-mile surface in NW6000L3 and has hit the board in each of his last four since moving to the barn of conditioner Terry Gallant. This 18-time winner has been in good form as of late and will have Trevor Henry in the sulky for the first time this evening. He can grab a share.

#1 WISHYOUDELLME advanced four positions last week at this level after getting away eighth off the switch and was just over three lengths away from winner Phoenix at the wire. He was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before trotting his back-half in 56 seconds with a final panel in 28 flat. This 18-time winner has been fourth or better in six of his last eight and can pick up another prize from the pole position.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

THE MORNING LINE reflects the track oddsmaker's estimate of what each horse's odds will be at post time. The actual odds are established by the amounts wagered by the public on each horse in the win pool.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
