# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

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All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

### Helpful facts for betting

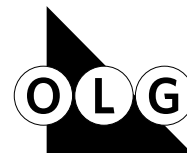
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

**WIN BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
**PLACE BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
**SHOW BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#6 STONEBRIDGE REX** rallied to be third last week in this class after getting away sixth off the gate and was overland since the half in that contest. He was spotted third-over on the bend for home and had some of the best late legs when just missing out on the place spot to the one below. This son of Control The Moment paced his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.2 and has been fourth or better in four of his last five at this level. He will be reunited with Doug McNair for tonight's tilt and can emerge victorious in the opener.

**#2 FABRIZIO N** held off the one above by the skin of teeth to maintain the place spot in his latest after sitting a perfect pocket trip for most of the mile. He has hit the board in five of his last eight in this class and typically does his best work when he is forwardly placed off the switch. This 16-time winner will have Trevor Henry aboard for the fourth straight start and has gotten along well with that teamster since he has taken over the driving duties. He will likely be pushing out for position from the inside of the gate and can be right there at the wire.

**#7 DONTPOKETHEDRAGON** finished second last week at 19-1 in the other division of this class and was just over three lengths in arrears to the streaking Sometime Somewhere at the wire. He was sixth two back at this level when he was at a major pace disadvantage to the frontrunners and won three in a row in a stint in the Preferred at Flamboro Downs before that. This 26-time winner must overcome the outermost post in the contest but should prefer the company he keeps in tonight's installment of this race. He can hit the ticket.

**#5 REAL WILLEY** exits the same race as the one above and claimed the show spot in that contest after getting away in the early two-hole. He faded back in the late stages and was two lengths behind the one above at the finish. This 18-time winner has hit the board in six of his last 10, with a pair of victories over that span, and will likely get roused off the gate tonight from post-five. He will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy and should get every chance to pick up a decent chunk.

### Race 2 Selections

### THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#4 BEACHIN LINDY** was a much-the-best winner in the opening round of the series when rolled wide off the final turn to score by a comfortable margin in 1:53.3 over a track that was one second off. He paced his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.3 and drifted out towards the grandstand in deep stretch. This 27-time winner has now won two in a row after dominating his competition in the Preferred at Western Fair on December 13th and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation this evening. He will have Austin Sorrie at the controls for the third straight start and has four victories and eight on the board finishes in the 15 times they have been paired together. Giving him the nod to triple-up and staunchly staying on this bandwagon.

**#6 LETS GET PICKLED** went a long way on the lead last week before fading back to third in deep stretch to disappoint as the 3/5 favorite. He had set reasonable fractions before tiring in the late stages but will get a chance at redemption tonight when racing back on a regular schedule. This 20-time winner will get reunited with his regular driver Doug McNair and they have teamed up for five victories and 12 on the board finishes in the 22 times they have been matched together. He might be able to go further on the front-end this time around and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#7 ARUKIDINME CABBIE** exits the race as our top selection and rallied into the place spot in the stretch after being spotted on that winner's helmet in the third-over position on the bend for home. He paced his back-half in 54.3 with a final panel in 27.2 and will now make his second attempt out of the barn of conditioner Jodie Cullen. This 13-time winner took a step forward in that most recent effort and might continue to improve this evening but will have to do so from the outermost post in the contest. He will likely be making noise in the late stages and can land somewhere on the ticket.

**#1 HUNTER HILL** got to the engine just past the quarter pole in the first leg of this series and made every call a winning one after that before scoring by more than two lengths at the wire. He converted as the 9/5 favorite in that contest and did not have much of a chance in the bottom condition in his previous outing when he raced from a long way off the pace. This 12-time winner should be confident coming into this but hooks a tougher field this time out and slides in a spot to be stuck on the rail behind the gate. He is not without a chance but is one that we prefer on the bottom end of trifecta and super this time out.

He stopped the clock in 1:52.2 over a track that was one second off and is just two starts removed from 12 straight against the best pacers on the circuit. This 23-time winner hit the board in seven of those efforts and only missed one cheque over that span, so he should be more than comfortable with an uptick to the top condition class. He should be feeling good about himself coming into this and has our edge on top.

**#2 NO FREE LUNCH** was fifth in the Preferred last week and was less than a pair of lengths away from the winner Saulsbrook Victor at the wire. He was the runner-up to that same rival two back in NW18000L5 when he was sent off as the 3/2 favorite and has hit the board in five of his last seven overall. This 11-time winner found his best stride in the latter part of 2022 and will look to carry that momentum forward into this season. He will be reunited with the circuit's top driver James MacDonald and be right there at the finish with the right kind of trip.

**#3 DESPERATE MAN** had to settle for second in this latest when he disappointed as the odds-on choice in a race where he could not get to the pacesetter Points North. He has hit the board in each of his last four and got back into the win-column on December 3rd when he dropped down to NW18500L5. This former North America Cup champion is more than capable of getting the better of this group but will likely get over bet again tonight. He looms as a major danger but we will try to be on the right side of value with the two above.

**#4 SAILBOAT HANOVER** claimed the show spot when making his debut on the circuit last week and did not miss out on the place spot by much to the one above. He will now make his second start off the claim for trainer Richard Moreau after he was plucked for \$50,000 at Yonkers at the end of November and missed a month of action prior to that most recent effort. This 17-time winner should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation but still faces deep waters when competing at a top condition level for an optional price tag of \$80,000. **#3 HARRY G** improved three positions when racing off the pace in the opening round of the series and rounded out the superfecta at 3-1 when just over five lengths away from Hunter Hill at the wire. He was a winner in the bottom condition class in his return to the circuit from the east coast on December 19th when he paced his back-half in 57 seconds flat and his final panel in 27.3. This 20-time has enjoyed success when racing out of the barn of trainer Mike Saftic, with six victories and 13 on the board finishes in the 24 attempts. **#1 SOMETIME SOMEWHERE** could not have been any more impressive when winning three in a row at Mohawk Park and has turned in strong efforts in all four of his tries since moving to the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau. He has won by more than a combined margin of nine lengths in his last three efforts and cruised to the wire in his latest in NW12000L5 when stopping the clock in 1:51.3 as the 3/5 favorite. This 20-time winner will now get a huge test when moving up the Preferred to take on the best pacers this circuit has to offer but might not have shown anything close to his full potential yet for this outfit. He should be brimming with confidence and picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy. We are sticking with him in the hopes of him completing the grand slam at what should be a decent price.

**#5 SAULSBROOK VICTOR** has won two in a row and got up by a neck to notch his first victory at the Preferred in the final installment of this race in 2022 on New Year's Eve. He was sent to the early lead in that contest before releasing the one below to the front at the halfway point and was able to squeeze his way to victory along the pylons in the dying strides. This son of Source Of Pride has never been better and gotten along splendidly with driver Austin Sorrie. He will likely be right there at the finish and has double-up potential.

**#2 SO MUCH MORE** got the lead at the halfway point in her latest and fought gamely in the stretch before settling for the show spot under the wire as the co-favorite with the one above at 9/5. She held her competition at bay two back at this level when she scored by more than a length at the wire in 1:50.2 and enjoyed another incredible season at the age of seven, where she has hit the board in 29 of 35 and added another \$427,207 to her ever-growing bankroll. This 57-time winner is the undisputed Queen of Pacing in Canada and can never be ruled out. She will start from the inside of the gate and can hit the ticket.

**#6 SINTRA** found room in the stretch after getting shuffled back in the middle stages and rounded out the superfecta when finishing just over a length away from the our second choice. He was a runner-up two back at this level and scored in a Preferred-2 on December 3rd when he was able to knife through between horses in the shadow of the wire. This 46-time winner has not missed a cheque in his last 11 outings and has only been worse than fourth on occasion over that span. He has been in top form since being acquired by The Stable and can pick up another prize this evening.

**#3 I AMA ROCKET** turned in a solid effort to be second to Hunter Hill in the first leg of the series and was just over two lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire. He had not raced in over a month going into that effort and will now be making his second start out of the barn of trainer Jodie Cullen. This 20-time winner has hit the board in each of his last three and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation. He will move out a couple of spots to get off the rail this evening with post-three and has our edge on top.

**#8 NATIONAL DEBT** returns to the races after a lengthy layoff of more than five months but comes into this off an encouraging looking qualifier where he scored by eight lengths in 1:57.3 over the five-eighths of a mile surface at Rideau Carleton. He won three of his last five before going on the shelf and hit the board in 10 of 17 in 2022. This 87-time winner gets to come back in a cozy spot in this Pop-Up Series but might need a start or two at the age of 12 before he is ready to produce his best. He will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but will be hard to beat if he is ready to roll.

**#2 JET ROCK** has claimed the show spot in each of his last four, with his three previous third-place finishes coming at Rideau Carleton. He was a winner in the top class on that five-eighths of a mile oval back in early November and will race back on a regular schedule this evening when getting a follow-up try on the big track. This 27-time winner was competing against tougher competition in NW11000L5 earlier in the season on this circuit and fits in nicely with this group. He will leave from the inside of the gate and should be in the mix throughout.

**#1 LORD ANTHONY** earned a minor award last week at odds of 7-1 and had hit the board in four straight at Flamboro Downs going into that effort. He only missed by three quarters of a length in NW60000L two back on that half-mile oval and was a winner in NW3500L3 on December 7th. This son of Sportswriter will start from the pole position and is difficult to back in the win position but can still pick up a decent chunk if his trip is sweet enough. He is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

He got up by a smaller margin in his latest when getting past race favorite Last Beach in the stretch but will now take a step up the class ladder this evening. This son of Betting Line has raced well in all of his three tries out of the barn of trainer Mike Bishop and has looked like he might have a lot more in the tank. He should offer some value in a race where a few others are sure to take support at the windows and will once again get our nod on top. Louis-Philippe Roy picks up the drive.

**#3 JK MIKI MANTLE** settled for third last week in this class as the odds-on choice at 50 cents to the dollar and has now hit the board in six straight. He only missed by a neck in the final of the Valedictory Series on December 26th and has already tasted victory in this class on December 10th when he blasted up the cones in the stretch drive. This son of Always B Miki has been in good order for trainer Harry Poulton and can rebound in a big way. He can be right there at the wire and merits respect.

**#8 HOWIES MAN** took all kinds of wagering support when getting bet down to 5/2 on December 17th in NW2 and then dominated at every call to score by nearly three lengths in 1:52 flat. He was beaten by a wide margin two back when going postward at this level but had managed to hit the board in two of his last three. This son of Shadow Play loses J-Mac to the one above but picks up a suitable replacement in Doug McNair. He has also since returned to the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

**#2 THE BOSS SAID** was sent to the lead on the backside in his latest and went a long way on the lead before getting caught by Emmets Buddy in the late stages and hooked wheels with our second choice in the dying strides but it likely did not have any impact on the outcome. This son of Huntsville has been the runner-up in each of his last two at this level and has been second or better in three of his last four overall. He will likely be pushing out for position from post-two and can pick up a sizable slice.

**#9 YOURTHEONE** rounded out the superfecta last week in this class after getting away in the two-hole from the same post he will work from tonight. He tired in the stretch when fading back to fourth but was a winner two back at this level off a similar trip. This 15-time winner has picked up a prize in 17 of his last 18 and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. ### C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
