Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 FLYING FORMATION rode a perfect pocket trip behind a pumped-up winner in Day At The Gym last week and gamely chased that rival to the wire when finishing just over a length in arrears at the wire. He was clearly the best of the rest and was more than five lengths better than the one below at the end of the mile. This son of Walner had missed three weeks of action going into that effort and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation. He will have Doug McNair at the controls for the second time in his career and will likely be leaving out in search of the lead from the center of the gate. Giving him the nod to kick off the card.

#3 DOWNSTAIRS PARTY turned in a decent effort in his first attempt over the big track and managed to get past the one below in deep stretch to claim the show spot. He was still a long way back from the one above at the wire but trotted home in 28.4 off a back-half in 57.1 after getting away fourth off the switch. This son of Kadabra had won five of his last six at Western Fair prior to that and was no worse than second over that span. He can take a step forward after getting acclimated to this level of competition and looms as a danger.

#7 R HOT TODDY has rounded out the superfecta in each of his last two since stepping up to this level and lost a position to the one above in the stretch last week after sitting in the three-hole for much of the mile. He was the easiest kind of winner in a maiden-breaking score in NW1 prior to that and has been no worse than fourth in his last nine overall. This son of Muscle Mass has gotten along well with driver Bob McClure and should land somewhere on the ticket with a favorable journey. He cannot be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#8 TALISMANO took support to the tune of 9/2 or less in each of his three efforts at Mohawk Park but could only muster one fifth out of those efforts and made two breaks in stride over that span. He has since changed hands and will now race out of the barn of trainer Mark Goddard after being away from the races for just over a month. This son of Muscle Hill is in need of a flat line and will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest. He picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy for the first time in his career and is worth a look if the price is right.

#3 SHESASHARPSHOOTER has won two in a row since returning from the bench and had missed over four months of action when she won by as much as she pleased in NW2 at odds of 8-1 on January 20th. She followed that up with another decisive score in the opening round of the series at 45 cents to the dollar and looks like a prime candidate to triple-up this evening. This daughter of Huntsville will work from another inside starting spot and has not tasted defeat since Steve Hudon took over the driving duties. She should be brimming with confidence coming into this and is hard to look past.

#5 MUSIC BOX NOISE was flying at the end of her mile last week when getting within a pair of lengths of the one above at the wire. She had gotten away last off the gate from the outermost post in the contest and was nearly 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing her back-half in 56 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.4. This daughter of Artspeak did not have much of a chance two back when getting away even worse off the switch and went a big trip first-over before that before holding off JksLifesaver by half a length at the wire to claim victory in NW2. She moves in a couple spots to the center of the gate and figures to be closer to the action this time around.

#4 ARIZONA has not been worse than second in her last four overall but disappointed as the heavy favorite in her latest at Flamboro Downs in NW3 when she got clipped by Infinity Seelster at the finish. She scored with ease on the engine at that level two back from post-eight and is five for six in her career when competing on the B-tracks. This daughter of Up The Credit set legit fractions over this surface on January 13th before giving way to Im On The Edge in the stretch and fits in nicely with this group when jumping into the second round of the Blizzard Series. She will likely be sent to the lead from post-four and will take some catching.

#2 COCKTAIL CAROL has earned a cheque in each of her last five and most recently picked up a minor award here at Mohawk Park when going postward in the first leg of this series. She was an upset winner in the final of a Pop-Up Event back in November and claimed the show spot in NW2 on January 20th. This daughter of Believeinbruiser will be reunited with driver Sylvain Fillion and can work out a favorable trip from post-two. She might be able to add some value to the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

She had gotten away sixth off the gate in a field of seven and was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before trotting her back-half in 58 seconds flat with a final quarter in 29.2. This daughter of Southwind Toscano had not raced in more than three weeks going into that effort and will now have James MacDonald calling the shots for the first time. She will be making her fourth start out of the barn of trainer Katelyn Graham since relocating north of the border and will be one of our main players underneath.

#2 BELLA CAVALLA exits the same race as the two above and was sent to the early lead in that contest before releasing our top choice after she popped the pocket on the backside. She essentially cut her own mile in second when that rival stepped away on the field and was getting leg weary near the end of the mile but managed to safely maintain the place spot under the wire. This daughter of Dover Dan has picked up a share in three of her four outings since shipping north of the border to join the camp of trainer Richard Moreau and has now hit the board in eight of 21 so far in her career. She can hit the ticket.

#4 ALCINA broke through with the first victory of her career last week when she scored by nearly two lengths in NW1 and will now make the difficult transition to NW2. She missed by less than a length two back and has been second or better in six of her last seven overall. #3 SOUTHWIND CHARDNAY was a \$50,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will be sent out for her lifetime debut by trainer Matt Bax. She has had a couple of scheduled starts wiped away due to weather but comes into this off a dominant qualifier on January 2nd, where she won by 10 lengths in 1:58.4 with a 29.1 kicker. This daughter of Resolve was wearing trotting hobbles for the first time over this surface in that morning prep and made a break in stride the first time she wore that piece of equipment at Flamboro Downs on December 17th. She made miscues in two of her three qualifiers in the summer but looked a lot smoother in her most recent spin around Mohawk Park. Giving her the nod to win at first asking.

#2 DEVILS ARCH jumped it off in the early going of his latest but was able to make a big move to the lead in the slow middle-half and had a clear margin on his rivals before getting caught by both Century Jaguar and Alcina in the stretch. He has made breaks in stride in all six of his career outings but made a strong recovery in his latest to claim the show spot and has done good work in his recent morning preps. This son of Archangel has gotten a chance of scenery after moving to the barn of conditioner Courtney Bishop and will retain Jody Jamieson in the sulky. He looks threatening but continues to be a risky proposition until he proves he can mind his manners under the lights.

#9 DAISY DAY saved ground along the cones on the turn for home and then managed to find the back of the winner Alcina in the lane and was able to trot into second at 38-1 before the wire. She was in tight quarters for much of the stretch drive and had not raced in nearly six months going into that effort. This daughter of Southwind Frank will be going postward without trotting hobbles for the second straight start and will once again have Bob McClure at the reins. She will have to overcome another outside draw but is among the chances and can land somewhere on the ticket if she can work her way into the race.

#5 DONCORLEONE is one of three in the contest that have previously gotten their picture taken and is two for 14 in his career with seven on the board finishes. He has not raced since November 11th when he turned in a lackluster performance to be sixth in NW20000L at the The Raceway in London and has since moved to the care of trainer Kyle Bossence. This son of Muscle Mass turned in a solid effort to be second in his qualifier on January 27th over this surface and is capable of getting forwardly placed from the center of the gate. He was making a first-over brush to the lead on the backside when he made that miscue and will get another crack at this class with driver/owner Trevor Henry at the reins this evening. This son of Resolve can rebound in a big way in this spot and is just one of two previous winners in the contest. He will start from the pole position and will not go down without a fight if he can stay on his gait.

#4 SENIORITA SOLO got away fourth off the gate last week and moved to the outside in the second-over position on the backside before briefly getting hindered by the rival in front of her that got funky-gaited before jumping it off. She was able to move back to the cones before making a first-over bid on the bend for home but then faded back to fourth in the stretch to disappoint as the even-money favorite. This daughter of Cornaro Dasolo went into that effort off a strong qualifying victory where she scored by four lengths and stopped the clock in 2:00.1 with a final panel in 28.4. She had Jody Jamieson in the driver's seat on that occasion and will be paired back with that teamster for this follow-up try off the bench.

#5 CRYSTAL BALLER picked up one minor award in three tries as a two-year-old when competing in the OSS Grassroots and will now return for his sophomore season off a victory in a morning prep on January 27th. She should appreciate shifting out to post-four after starting from the rail last time and gets the edge on top.

#3 GETTING EUCHRED scored by more than four lengths in the opening round of this series at 7-1, stopping the clock in 1:57.1 with a back-half in 58.1. She was able to pace her way into the pocket behind the pacesetter on the turn for home and that helped her avoid some confusion on the outside when the first-over challenger veered out into the center of the track at the top of the stretch. She was the runner-up to Littlebearcat in her last two on the big track and has been no worse than fourth in seven tries since moving back to the care of conditioner Richard Moreau. This 47-time winner will start from the pole position and will be reunited with Louis-Philippe Roy, who has guided her to three victories and 13 on the board finishes in the 18 times they have been paired together. She is among the main chances and will hopefully complete an all-Moreau exacta.

#8 CLODAM BAYAMA went a long way on the lead last week but could not fend off our top selection before the wire. She only missed by half a length at the finish and has now hit the board in eight of her last 10 overall. This 22-time winner was plucked for \$15,000 by trainer Cassidy Schneider in her latest and will have to start from the outermost post in the contest when right back in for the maximum claiming tag in the race. She will have J-Mac at the helm for the second time in her career and that teamster navigated her to victory in January of last year.

#5 MY DAY finished fourth in her latest and has rounded out the superfecta in two of her last three in this class. She has not been able to crack the top three in any of her last six but managed three minor awards over that span and has proven she can be more than competitive at this level in the past. This 12-time winner should appreciate leaving from the center of the gate and should be making noise in the late stages. She is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super but that is likely her ceiling.

She was beaten by just over two lengths in fifth in that effort and went a difficult journey two back at Western Fair after having to start from the trailing post. This 17-time winner has always done her best work on the front-end and she might have her gas pedal pressed off the gate tonight by Jonathan Drury. She is among the top contenders and can be right there at the wire.

#6 LATTE SEELSTER went a long way on the engine last week as the 4/5 favorite but gave way in the stretch when a pair of rivals came to call and had to settle for third under the wire. She could not match strides with the one below, who went on to be victorious, but did finish her mile with a broken headpole. This 11-time winner will now make her second start off the claim for trainer Isaac Waxman and has hit the board in four of her last five. She should be part of the early pace scenario again this evening and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#8 RUNAWAY HEIRESS was moving best of all in the stretch drive of her latest when she mowed down the pacesetter above and scored by more than a length at the wire. CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
