Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 MACALLAN has not raced in seven weeks but was competing against tougher competition before going back on the shelf. He earned a minor award two back when going postward in NW12000L5 and was a winner at 55 cents to the dollar the last time he raced at this level on November 28th. This 10-time winner is just five starts removed from competing in the Open and comes into this off a dominant qualifier on January 27th where he scored by seven lengths in 1:58 flat. He looks like he is ready to roll and should much prefer the company he keeps tonight. Giving him the nod to kick off the card.

#5 OKEANOS put himself in a deep hole in the early going when he made a break in stride just after the start on January 27th and was more than 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He made a huge recovery to come all the way back to win as the 3/5 favorite and cruised past his rivals in the stretch with final quarter speed of 28.1 on the heels of a back-half in 55.4. This son of E L Titan has always shown potential and might continue to step forward in his second start for trainer Francis Guillemette, who has won five of his last 13 with nine top two finishes over that span. He steps up a couple of notches on the class ladder but has proven he can be competitive at much higher levels in the past.

#9 P L OPPORTUNITY is that another that should appreciate getting class relief after spending each of her last three in NW1200L5 and had no chance in her latest after she got away last off the switch from post-10 at 50-1. She had taken support to tune of 9-1 or less in her two previous tries at that level and was the runner-up in that class on January 16th. This 13-time winner has hit the board in five of her last nine and has only missed one cheque over that span. She will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but can work her way onto the ticket if her trip is not too taxing.

#2 PUBLICITY SEEKER was handled aggressively in his latest and went all the way on the front-end before holding on by half a length at the wire at odds of 9/5. He would have likely got back to the winner's circle one start earlier if not getting stuck behind a tiring rival on the bend for home and was rapidly closing in on the winner in that effort before settling for the place spot. This 11-time winner steps up the class ladder this evening but has been trending in the right direction with three straight on the board finishes since being back in the care of conditioner Stephen Bossence. He will leave from the inside of the gate and can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 A BOY NAMED SUZZ is one that we have been fond of in each of his last three since returning to the care of trainer Shayne Barrington and has been no worse than second over that span. He was a winner at 8-1 in his first start back for this outfit on January 16th and then only missed by a nose two back at 5-1. This 55-time winner was driven more aggressively in his latest when moving to the lead on the backside and held on by a head at the wire at another juicy price of 5/2. He has five victories and two near misses in seven tries for this outfit and he has had his price tag increased by another \$2,000 this evening. Bob McClure will be in the sulky for a fourth straight outing and we are more than happy to staunchly stay on his bandwagon.

#3 NIGHT CLUB HANOVER has only been able to pick up a pair of minor awards in his last two at this level and disappointed as the favorite in two of his last three for his prior connections. He was claimed back by trainer Richard Moreau in his latest and was an easy winner the last time he went postward for this outfit on January 9th, scoring by nearly three lengths in 1:53.3. This 18-time winner had hit the board in four straight for this barn before getting claimed away on January 9th for \$28,000 and notched a pair of victories over that span. He got the vote of confidence from Sylvain Fillion over his stablemate below and can be right there at the wire.

#7 JULERICA got away in the early two-hole but was relegated to the three-hole on the backside after our top selection marched to the lead. He appeared to have pace at the head of the stretch but was denied room along the pylons by the pocket-sitter before having to angle to the outside for clearance. This 53-time winner split horses in deep stretch to get within a length of the winner and might be trending back in the right direction. #10 HP MOMENTUM made a first-over bid on the bend for home last week and then dove to the pylons for the dying strides to only miss by a head to our top choice. He has hit the board in three of his last four and was a dominant winner two back at Western Fair when he beat up on his foes in NW50000L. This son of Control The Moment will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole but races for a barn that has been white-hot as of late. He should make his presence felt at some point in the mile and is capable of picking up a sizable slice.

This son of Muscle Mass will take a significant step up the class ladder but there appeared to be lots left in the tank in his latest. He will be reunited with driver Jody Jamieson and will likely be moving forward off the switch again from post-six. Top call.

#8 SHESTHELUCKYONE was the runner-up to heavy-favorite Gigondas last week at this level and was just over a length away from that rival at the wire after sitting an inside trip. She was likely handled carefully in that outing following a break in stride two back and has hit the board in two of three since relocating north of the border to join the barn of trainer Jean Tourigny. This daughter of Father Patrick will not have to worry about the one that got the better of her last time but does face a fresh face in the class with the one above. She slides to outside of the gate for tonight's tilt but will still be one of our main player's underneath.

#5 STORM TROTTER exits the same race as the one above and rallied into the show spot on that occasion after getting away eighth off the gate from post-eight. He was more than 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before trotting his back-half in 58 seconds with a final quarter in 29 flat. This son of Muscle Mass was a winner in his first attempt at this level on December 22nd and has hit the board in three of four overall in this class. He will start from the center of the gate after having the seven-hole or worse in each of his last three and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#1 ILLUSIONAL got within half a length of winner Publicity Seeker on January 27th in NW4100L5 and had not raced in more than six weeks going into that effort. He got away seventh off the gate and was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before trotting his back-half in 56.3 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat. He had been the runner-up in his first two attempts for conditioner Brett Lester off the claim and will now return to the level where he was a winner on January 2nd for his previous connections. This 19-time winner should much prefer the company he keeps tonight and can rebound in a big way in this spot. He will start from the center of the gate and was Louis-Philippe Roy's choice over two others in the contest.

#4 JIM STRIKESITRICH swept the field last week in this class when racing off the claim for trainer Kyle Fellows and was a going-away winner when he paced away by a margin of more than three lengths at the wire. He was the last one away from the gate from the pole position and was more than 19 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 56.2 with a final panel in 28.3. This 14-time winner had disappointed as the favorite in each of his previous four but appears to have found new life for current connections. He figures to be making serious noise in the stretch and has double-up potential.

#3 PROBERTS LEGACY made up ground in the late stages to claim the show spot at 21-1 to the one above but was more than three lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire. He has hit the board in three of his last five since being claimed for \$8,500 by conditioner Marc-Andre Simoneau and was an impressive winner in his first attempt for this outfit on January 1st at Flamboro Downs. This 17-time winner has not been the most consistent type but will pick up the driving services of James MacDonald for the first time in his career. He can be in the mix throughout from post-three and is worth using in the exotics.

#9 MACHAL JORDAN plunges down the class ladder after being seventh or worse against tougher claiming competition in each of his last two. He earned a minor award in his first start back after a lengthy layoff on January 16th and will now have his price tag cut in half to \$13,000. This 31-time winner will have to overcome a tricky draw from post-nine but should relish the opportunity to face softer rivals this time out. He is hard to back in the win position but should not be dismissed from the bottom end of the exotics.

He got away seventh off the gate from post-five and was nearly 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final quarter in 28.1. This 87-time winner will be making his fourth start back off the bench and his second straight outing on a regular rotation. He picks up the driving services of James MacDonald for just the second time in his career and gets the edge on top.

#7 BETTER BE GOUDA was spotted second-over on the bend for home in his latest and did well to finish second to the odds-on choice Pointomygranson. He was just over a length away from that rival when pacing home in 28.2 off a back-half in 56.1 and will have Doug McNair back aboard for the second straight start. This 20-time winner was victorious in the fog on January 19th at Flamboro Downs and turned in a decent effort to finish fifth two back here at Mohawk Park when racing on just three days' rest. He looks like one of the top contenders in the contest and can be right there at the wire.

#2 GOLDINTHEBADLANDS has picked up a prize in three of his last four and has been fourth or better in each of his last two since transitioning to Mohawk Park from Flamboro Downs. He finished third two back at 40-1 and was fourth in his latest at 17-1 after getting forwardly placed but finished that mile with broken equipment in the form of a busted halter. This 36-time winner will start from another inside post position and was Travis Cullen's choice over our top selection. He is among the chances and should not be taken lightly.

#8 ISITFRIDAYYET finished with some vigor last week when advancing into the show spot before the wire and was four lengths back of the winner Pointomygranson at the finish. He was 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55.4 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat and will now be making his fifth straight start for trainer Brett Lester. This 31-time winner might start trending back in the right direction for his new barn but we also thought that three back when he disappointed as the lukewarm favorite by finishing sixth after a similar effort. He should not be ignored but needs to show he can string some strong efforts together again before we can get excited about putting him on top.

This 23-time winner was making his first start back in the barn of Duane Marfisi after that conditioner snagged him back for \$30,000 on January 23rd and has now hit the board in two of three attempts for this outfit. He might try to get forwardly placed off the gate this time around and gets the call on top.

#7 ARUKIDINME CABBIE was a winner in the opening round of this Pop-Up Event last week when he tore off his cover from the third-over position at the head of the lane and then paced away from his rivals in the stretch to score by nearly two lengths at the wire. He got a torturous trip in the final of another series by the same name two back and has hit the board in four of his last five since moving to the care of trainer Jodie Cullen. This 14-time winner seemed to enjoy the move back to the claiming ranks and should be feeling good about himself coming into this. He slides out a couple of spots on the gate but can double-up with a favorable journey.

#6 ROCK AND TWIST is riding a three-race win-streak and went past the two front runners last week from the three-hole after sitting in that cozy spot for much of the mile. He got up by half a length at the wire and stopped the clock in 1:53.3 at odds of 15-1. This 18-time winner was seventh in his first start back in the barn of Richard Moreau on January 5th but went into that effort off a break in stride and has since reeled off three straight victories. He should be brimming with confidence but we prefer him to occupy a spot somewhere underneath on the ticket.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
