# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#3 EMMETTS BUDDY** made up ground in the late stages after getting away seventh off the gate two weeks ago in NW16000L5 and was placed up to fourth from fifth through disqualification. He got within five lengths of the winner Backstreet Gambler at the finish and paced his back-half in 55.1 with a final quarter in 27.2. This son of In The Irons will drop back down to the level where he was a runner-up to Dontpokethedragon on February 25th and has hit the board in eight of his last 12 overall. He will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy and might be able to come out on top in the opener with a favorable journey.

**#7 SPORTS FAN** is another in the field that is dropping down from NW16000L5 and has finished sixth in each of his last two when competing at that level. He got away eighth off the switch in his latest and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 54.2 with a final quarter in 27.2. This son of Sportswriter was a winner on February 18th at 7/2 when going postward in a lifetime non-winners class and will have Doug McNair back in the bike for tonight's tilt. He should be more than competitive in this spot and can be right there at the wire.

**#8 CHEDDAR BAY** has taken on tougher rivals in NW14000L5 in each of his last two and secured a smaller slice in his latest when banging home in 26 seconds flat in a race that was won by Backstreet Gambler. He did not have much of a chance two back when getting way ninth off the switch from post-nine and will now face more palatable competition this evening. This 17-time winner was placed up to the top spot in NW8000L5 on February 25th at 15-1 when the winner interfered with another horse just before the wire and has been first or second in four of his last six. He must overcome the outermost post in the contest but does not look out of place against this group.

**#1 RESPECT OUR FLAG** got a confidence boost at Flamboro Downs last Sunday night when he went all the way on the engine in NW60000L at 35 cents to the dollar. He held a healthy margin for much of that mile before holding on by half a length at the wire in 1:54.3 on that half-mile surface and had gone up against more difficult foes in his previous two here at Mohawk Park. This 30-time winner was the runner-up in each of his last two at this level and was less than a length away from victory in both of those outings. He will start from the pole position and can pick up a decent chunk.

**THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.**

**#5 NEED TO BREATHE** was rapidly closing in on So Much More at the finish last week but came up three quarters of a length short to that Queen of Pacing in Canada, who appeared to be shut down at the wire. She was gapped out in the three-hole on the bend for home before slipping to the outside behind that winner at the top of the stretch and should appreciate facing a field that is void of that rival this evening. This 13-time winner was a strong winner in a similar scenario two back and has hit the board in 15 of 16 at Mohawk Park after joining the barn of trainer Jodie Cullen when she relocated to this circuit from Hoosier Park last November. She figures to take the bulk of the wagering support and is hard to go against.

**#2 PARISIAN BLUE CHIP** has picked up smaller shares in each of her last two and improved one position in the stretch of her latest after getting away fifth off the switch. She did not have much of a chance on March 17th after being last in the early going from the outermost post in the contest and paced home in 27.2 on the heels of a back-half in 55 seconds flat. This 28-time winner missed three weeks of action going into that effort and was an upset winner before that on February 24th. She slides down to the inside of the gate this evening and will have J-Mac back calling the shots.

**#1 INTO THE MYSTIC MOON** has won two in a row in NW16000L5 and was dominant in victory in both of those outings. She paced away from her rivals in the stretch to score by four lengths at 7/5 on March 17th and then offered a slightly lower price one week later when went all the way on the front-end. This 10-time winner will now make the steep climb back up to the F&M-Preferred ranks but should be brimming with confidence coming into this. She has returned to top form for trainer/driver Phil Hudon and merits respect on the ticket.

**#1 NULLI SECONDUS** made four starts at the age of two and had back-to-back runner-up finishes last August in races where he was the pacesetter for much of the mile. He missed by just half a length in both of those contests and will now return to the races after a layoff of more than seven months. This son of Betterthancheddar comes into this with a pair of qualifiers to his credit and scored by more than eight lengths on the morning of March 18th when he stopped the clock in 1:57.4 over a track that was one second off. He looks like he is ready to roll and might be hard to catch.

**#10 BAR DOWN JIM** did not miss the board in any of his six attempts in his rookie campaign and was an impressive winner in the second start of his career at Flamboro Downs last September. He was second best to heavy-favorite Winmebak in the final of the Harvest Series when he was sent off at 21-1 before going on the shelf and was third to Amazon Dragon in a qualifier when preparing for this return. This son of Big Jim will have to overcome a tricky draw in his first start back but will have James MacDonald in the driver's seat for the first time in his life. He will likely be making serious noise in the late stages and can threaten the one above if his trip is not too taxing.

**#5 DELIGHTFUL KISS** was scratched out of his latest scheduled start on March 18th due to sickness and picked up a minor award at this level prior to that at a price of 9-1. He was the runner-up in back-to-back tries before that and has picked up a cheque in all six of his career starts so far. This son of Bettors Delight will have Bob McClure back aboard for a second consecutive outing and he only missed by a head at 18-1 when that teamster was at the helm on February 18th. He will likely be trying to come from off the pace after not flashing any gate speed in his previous efforts but can land somewhere on the ticket if the trip is sweet enough.

**#7 INDIGENOUS HANOVER** has not raced since February 4th when finishing third in this class at odds of 10-1 and was five lengths away from winner Call Me It in that contest. He will come back to the races off a decent looking qualifier where he was second to Captains Pick and has hit the board in three of his six lifetime tries so far. This son of Lazarus N took on tougher rivals two back when going postward in the Snowshoe Series and should much prefer the company he keeps this evening. He picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy for the first time and can grab a share.

**#6 RED COIN** has won two in a row and was victorious when stepping up to this level two weeks ago after splitting horses in deep stretch. He accelerated away from his rivals in the dying strides when coming home in 27 seconds flat and has paced his final quarter in 27.2 or better in all three of his outings so far at the age of three. This son of Bettors Delight has been second or better in four of his five lifetime tries and should only be getting stronger when making his fourth start back. He will leave from a favorable spot on the gate and can triple-up against this group.

**#8 SPEAKER OF PEACE** exits the same race as the one above and disappointed as the 3/5 favorite in that contest after being spotted second-over on the turn for home. He was pushed out wide in the stretch when the foe he was following drifted out at the top of the lane and was just over a length away from the winner at the wire when settling for the place spot. This son of Artspeak turned in a valiant effort to be second two back at 6-1 on March 11th and broke his maiden in impressive fashion one week before that in NW1. He has been no worse than second in each of his last three and can continue that trend this evening.

**#9 TOUR CHAMPION** has won two in a row in NW1 and had to fight off a pesky Holy Jalapeno in the stretch on March 11th to convert as the odds-on choice at 55 cents to the dollar. He blasted home in 26.3 on the heels of a back-half in 55.3 when scoring on the engine in that contest and won by a much more comfortable margin at 21-1 two weeks prior. This son of Sunshine Beach should be brimming with confidence coming into this and has already shown he can get his picture taken when missing time between starts. He has enough early foot to overcome an outside draw and can be in the mix throughout.

**#10 LAZ** was a \$20,000 yearling purchase in the Land of Lincoln sale in Illinois that will now be sent out for the first start of his career by trainer Duane Marfisi. He was a strong winner in his lone qualifier as a two-year-old when he scored by six lengths in 1:56 flat but then went back on the bench until early this month. This son of Lazarus won by a similar margin in his most recent morning prep when getting ready to race under the lights for the first time at the age of three and has paced his final panel in an identical 27.3 in all three of his qualifiers. He will have to make his debut in a tricky spot when starting from the 10-hole against a field of previous winners in NW15000L but cannot be ruled out.

He trotted his mile in 1:54.3 to convert as the 6/5 favorite but disappointed at 50 cents to the dollar the week prior when racing off the bench. This 12-time winner is another that will be making his third start back this evening but he will have to overcome a tricky draw from post-nine. He has proven to be versatile with his racing style and can still get a major piece of this if his trip is not too taxing.

**#3 TOCCOA FALLS** is part of a nice one-two punch for trainer Per Engblom along with our top selection and finished fourth in his most recent effort after releasing the one above to the engine before the turn for home. He was unable to make any progress up the inside in the stretch but was only beaten by a neck to Itstmetogohome in the opening round of the series. This son of Trixton has been second or better in three of his last five and picks up Jody Jamieson at the controls. He can grab a share.

This other son of Bettors Delight was only half a length away from that winner at the finish and could have likely gone by whenever he pleased. He should be brave coming into this and got the vote of confidence from James MacDonald over the one below. Giving him the edge.

**#3 STEEL COWBOY** was a \$275,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will now be sent out for his lifetime debut by conditioner Amanda Fine. He is a half-brother to Bythemissal, who is 14 for 17 in his career and has never missed the board in any of those efforts when stashing away nearly \$1.2M. This son of Bettors Delight was a winner in his lone qualifier on March 16th over the one-mile surface of Spring Garden Ranch in Florida and will now race under the lights for the first time at Mohawk Park. He will have Doug McNair in the sulky and looks threatening.

**#4 NIGHTIME DANCER** claimed the show spot in an OSS Gold tilt in his lifetime debut last season and was just over two lengths away from winner Write Me A Rose in that contest. He blew up as the 4/5 favorite in his follow-up effort more than two months later and was free-wheeling on the engine before rolling into a break in stride at the top of the lane. This son of Sunshine Beach was only beaten by half a length in his lone morning prep and paced home in 27 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 56.1. This other son of Captaintreacherous has produced solid efforts in all three of his outings since returning to the races after a two-month let up and would have likely fared better than his third-place finish on March 4th if he had not run of real estate in the stretch. He should be brimming with confidence coming into this but we will hope to be on the right side of value in siding with the one above.

She picks up a familiar face in Bob McClure and should be feeling good about herself coming into this.

**#3 GIRL SCOUT COOKIE** was moving well at the end of her mile last week after getting away sixth off the switch and paced into the show spot in deep stretch to round out the trifecta at odds of 9-1. She was not beaten by much for second at the wire and paced her back-half in 55.1 with a final quarter in 27.3. This son of State Treasurer has finished third in two of her last three since entering the claiming ranks and has picked up a prize in four of her last six overall. She will start from post-three for the second straight start and can threaten if she gets put into play in the early stages.

**#8 FROMAKINGTOAQUEEN** did not have much of a chance in her latest after getting away last off the gate from post-eight and being nearly 17 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. **#1 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER** went a tough trip in the first-over position in the first leg of the New Holland Pacing Series and pressured pacesetter Ario Hanover when pacing his own middle-half of 54.3 before waiving the white flag in the stretch. He faded back to sixth in that contest and had to go postward in the Free For All in the two outings prior to that. This 23-time winner got his picture taken the last time he competed in the condition ranks and that victory came against much tougher rivals in NW26000L5. He scored by nearly two lengths at 70-1 the last time he competed at this level and will be reunited with his regular driver Jonathan Drury for tonight's tilt. Top call.

**#6 HESINCONTROL** exits the same race as the one above and is another that should appreciate getting down to softer competition after taking on tougher in each of his last four. He has finished seventh in each of his last two but was the runner-up to the one above at 11-1 in NW26000L5 on February 18th and got up by a head at 25-1 one week prior when going postward in this class. This 13-time winner had Jody Jamieson at the helm on that occasion and will have him back at the reins for the fourth time in six starts this evening. He will work from the center of the gate and has proven he can race from anywhere in recent efforts.

**#2 REAL WILLEY** has hit the board in each of his last four in this class and was most recently just a length away from winner Momas Son Byrne in third. He was sent to the lead in both of his last two before relenting on the backside to sit a favorable trip in the pocket and has earned a cheque in all of his last 11. This 18-time winner has not tasted victory in his last 12 but will likely get into another nice spot off the gate and can stick around for a decent chunk. He retains Doug McNair in the sulky and should get every chance to hit the ticket.

**#3 BETTOR THAN SPRING** was first-over for a long way last week before turning in a valiant effort to finish fourth and was alongside the one above at the wire. He was fifth two back in NW26500L5 and will now be making his third attempt on the circuit after shipping north of the border to Mohawk Park from Northfield for trainer Cory Kresier. This 42-time winner should appreciate moving in five spots on the gate to post-three and should be in the mix throughout. He fits in nicely with this group and should not be ignored.

**#4 MS QUICK SAND** converted at 80 cents to the dollar in her latest when competing in a lifetime non-winners class and paced to a new lifetime mark of 1:52.1 when fending off challengers in the stretch. She was only beaten by a neck in her circuit debut one week prior and was unable to find room along the cones until it was too late. This daughter of Always A Virgin will now transition to face seasoned racehorses at this middle condition level but might continue to improve in her third start back after a lengthy layoff for conditioner Marie Helene Dupont. She has won three of her last four with her only defeat coming by a neck over that span and got the nod from Louis-Philippe Roy over our third choice.

**#7 AHOY** was sent to the lead on the backside on March 17th in this class but then faded back to fifth before the wire at odds of 8/5 in a race that was won by Intothemysticmoon after pacing her own middle-half in 54.4. She has earned a smaller share in each of her last three and took support to the tune of 6-1 or less in prior two outings when going postward in the F&M-Preferred ranks. This 14-time winner was the runner-up to Major League N when taking on tougher rivals in NW20000L5 on February 17th but only has one victory in her 13 efforts since relocating to the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau. She figures to take support again this evening and we have mixed feelings about her chances.

**#8 SHANGHAI SEELSTER** has hit the board in each of her last two at this level and was four lengths in arrears to Intothemysticmoon on March 17th in this class. She was a winner three back as the 6/5 choice when meeting softer foes and has only been worse than third in one of her five tries for conditioner Richard Moreau so far. This daughter of Bettors Delight shifts to the outside of the gate this evening after having inside starting spots in all of her last four but has enough tactical speed to get into a decent position off the gate. She will be reunited with driver James MacDonald and he has guided her to victory in one of the three times he has been aboard.

**#3 BEACH MOMENT** has won two in a row in the F&M-Preferred at Western Fair and most recently blasted to the early lead from post-seven before holding on by a nose in a wild four-horse across finish at the wire. She has gone all the way on the engine in both of those last two on that half-mile surface and will now return to the big track, where she was seventh in first start back after a layoff of more than two months on March 10th. This 16-time winner trailed throughout in that contest and will likely show more life off the gate tonight from post-three. She will have Bob McClure in the bike and can stick around for a slice.

**#6 WOODMERE FENN** was in need of a flat line in his latest and was nearly 18 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole at odds of 7/2 in a race that was won by Lets Tie One On. He improved a pair of positions before the wire after pacing his back-half in 54.1 with a final quarter in 27.3 and had jumped it off two back when being sent off at 5/2 at this level. This 14-time winner completed a three-race win-streak when moving up the class ladder to this spot on March 4th and will have J-Mac at the controls for the fourth straight start. He will work from the center of the gate and has proven he can get past his rivals when it matters most.

**#5 P L OCTAVIUS** was the runner-up to Sun Chip in a lifetime non-winners classification on March 4th and was only a length away from that rival at the wire when pacing his own mile in 1:51.2. He has been fourth or better in each of his last four and got within a half a length of Sports Fan on February 18th at that level. This son of Bettors Delight got the nod from Bob McClure over the one below but has not raced in nearly a month coming into this. He moves in a couple of spots on the gate this evening and has been in good order for trainer Katie Huskinson.

**#3 BEYOND BETTER** appeared to be moving into third in the final strides of his latest but then made a break in stride in deep stretch to finish fifth under the wire but was placed back to sixth. He has squandered a good result in similar fashion several times in his career and will now likely be in search of a clean line when returning to NW8000L5 this evening. This 16-time winner picked up a minor award at this level two back at 3-1 and was beaten as the heavy favorite on February 18th in the class below this. He was passed over for the one above by driver Bob McClure but picks up a familiar face in Trevor Henry and is not without a chance if he can summon his best.

**#7 DR JOE** did not have much of a chance on March 18th after getting away ninth off the gate from post-seven and being more than 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He was able to advance to sixth in the stretch after pacing his back-half in 54 seconds flat with a final panel in 27.1 but was still more than four lengths away from winner Last Beach at the wire. This 10-time winner was impressive in victory on March 4th when he scored by more than two lengths in 1:52.2 and would have been no worse than second four back before getting interfered with right before the finish. He should be making noise in the late stages and can pick up a decent piece.

**#10 MAGICAL ARTHUR** only got to the winner's circle once out of 17 attempts in his sophomore season but that victory came in a division of the Somebeachsomewhere, where he got the better of Beach Glass and Stonebridge Helios. He hit the board in six of his efforts as a three-year-old and added another \$126,885 to his bankroll over the course of that campaign. This winner of more than \$343,000 comes into his aged debut with a pair of qualifiers to his credit and was a winner in both of those morning preps, most recently scoring by a nose over Warrawee Vital. He will have J-Mac calling the shots for the first time under the lights and still gets our top billing despite having to start from the outermost post in the contest.

**#5 SUN CHIP** sat a two-hole trip for much of the mile on March 18th in NW16000L5 and briefly had the lead in the stretch before claiming the show spot in a race that was won by Backstreet Gambler. He will move back down to more palatable rivals when carrying the optional price of \$50,000 this evening and was a dominant winner in this class on March 11th. This 10-time winner has tasted victory in three of his last four and has not missed the board in his last five overall. He will likely have his gas pedal pressed off the gate from post-five and looks threatening.

**#3 HUNTED HOUSE** only missed by a nose to Last Beach in his latest when trying to get up the inside of that rival in the dying strides. He has been the runner-up in three of his last four and has been a head or less away from victory in two of those outings. This grey son of Huntsville was a winner on February 11th when going postward in the class below this and has only missed a cheque in one of his six tries for trainer Harry Poulton since relocating to this circuit. He loses James MacDonald to our top selection and will have brother Anthony at the reins.

**#7 HP MOMENTUM** is the other in the contest that will go postward for the optional claiming tag of \$50,000 and has been no worse than fourth in his last four since being claimed by trainer Shayne Barrington. He made a first-over bid in his most recent effort and was four lengths away from winner Last Beach as the lukewarm favorite at 3-1. This son of Control The Moment has disappointed as the public's choice in four of his last five but can pick up another decent chunk if his trip is not too taxing from post-seven.

**#2 LETS TIE ONE ON** was impressive in victory in his circuit debut two weeks ago when he was a going away winner in this class, stopping the clock in 1:52.1 under tight lines to Travis Cullen at 12-1. He had not raced in more than three weeks going into that contest and had been racing against a tough customer in Outlaw C My Shadow in the Open at Fraser Downs before that. This 12-time winner will be making his second start out of the barn of trainer Jodie Cullen and should benefit from having that start over this surface under his belt. He is hard to go against after that most recent effort and gets the edge on top in the nightcap.

**#5 ROCKME ROLLME** was a dominant winner in NW4900L5 on March 18th and went all the way on the engine in that contest when pacing his mile in 1:52.2 as the co-favorite at even-money. He had spent his previous five in the middle condition ranks in NW14000L5 and rounded out the trifecta in that class two back at odds of 9/2 in a race that was won by Backstreet Gambler. This 22-time winner will likely get put into play off the switch again tonight when leaving from the center of the gate and might prove hard to catch. He merits respect and can be right there at the wire.

**#8 NO PLAN INTENDED** has returned to Ontario for the start of his five-year-old campaign and is without a race since November 6th when he completed a three-race win-streak in the Preferred ranks at Red Shores in Charlottetown. He won by a combined margin of 10 lengths in that trio of victories and went 12 for 33 overall at the age of four, with 24 on the board finishes and over \$142,000 in earnings. This 20-time winner will make his first attempt out of the barn of conditioner Terry Gallant and has a pair of qualifiers to his credit, holding off Mappos Lion in his most recent morning prep on March 24th. He will be reunited with Jody Jamieson and is worth using on the ticket.

**#3 FLYINGEVENBETTOR N** was a strong winner in his latest when he scored by more than three lengths in 1:52 flat as the 3/2 favorite against easier competition and got a heart-building win two back when beating up on soft rivals in NW1500L3 at Flamboro Downs on March 9th. This 13-time winner should be feeling good about himself when taking another step up the class ladder and will likely once again utilize his early foot to get forwardly placed off the gate from post-three. He can grab a share.

**#7 GOING FAST** was the runner-up to our top choice two weeks ago after moving first-over on the last turn and forged to the lead in the stretch before getting gobbled up by that rival in the late stages. He has been second or better in each of his last three and does not look out of place against this group. This son of Western Terror has hit the board in five of eight so far this season and can pick up a decent chunk with a favorable journey.

## C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
