Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

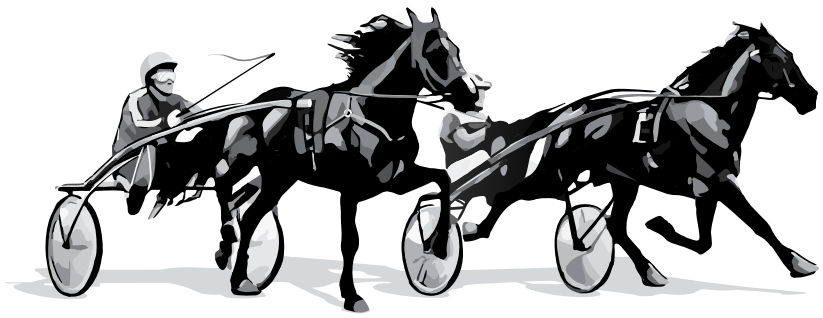
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 WATCH A PRO blasted off the wings of the gate last week to be the first to the pylons and then quickly released Jeronimo to the front before getting relegated to the three-hole on the backside. He was then jammed up behind that rival in the stretch and was stuck with nowhere to go before finishing up with what appeared to be all kinds of trot in fourth. This son of Kadabra disappointed as the odds-on choice in that event and will likely not be as willing to take a seat behind rivals in this second start of his sophomore campaign. He should be breathing fire coming into this and is hard to look past in the opener.

#3 AIRBORNE was the runner-up to Devils Arch in the first leg of this series last week and was more than four lengths in arrears to that rival at the finish. He has hit the board in each of his last two since returning to the races for this three-year-old season and was stuck behind a wall of horses for most of the stretch drive two back before claiming the show spot at 22-1. This son of Wheeling N Dealin will have Bob McClure aboard for the third consecutive outing and looms as a danger.

#6 LAVA FIELD was overland for much of the mile in his latest before finishing fifth in a race that was won by Like Chaos and disappointed as the 3/5 favorite two weeks earlier in NW1 when the same rival was victorious after going most of the way on the front-end. He was a runner-up in each of his two tries before that when competing in the maiden ranks and was just three quarters of a length away from Bar Brawl on March 9th. This son of Muscle Mass has only missed out on a cheque in two of his 10 career attempts and might benefit from going up against a compact field in tonight's tilt. He might be able to spice up the bottom end of the exotics at a price.

#1 CENTURY JAGUAR jumped it off in the early going last week and took himself out of contention before getting beaten by a wide margin in sixth. He was five lengths back of winner Bar Brawl in second when going postward in NW2 on March 23rd and has managed to hit the board in five of his eight lifetime tries so far. This son of Resolve blew up the tote board when he was a winner at first asking back in January but will have to mind his manners from a tricky starting spot for a young trotter. He can make his presence felt if he can stay on his gait but we prefer the ones above.

This daughter of Artspeak should benefit from having a flat line to her credit after making back-to-back miscues in March and blasted home in 27.2 in her morning prep on March 24th and finished third to a pair of horses that have both come back to be victorious. She loses Jonathan Drury to the entrant from the Auciello barn but picks up J-Mac at the reins and has upset potential.

#6 TWO ACROSS MARION rounded out the superfecta at 7-1 last week when finishing more than five lengths in arrears to Freestarflight and has earned a share in each of her last four overall. She was the runner-up to Lady Jess two back and has paced home in 28.3 or faster in five of her six career outings so far. This daughter of Big Jim has been forwardly placed in each of her last three and will likely try those tactics again this evening when leaving out from post-six. She should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#2 CONTROLTHEDISTANCE went one for 11 last season in her rookie campaign and earned just under \$20,000 after hitting the board in three of those efforts. She was only beaten by a neck in an OSS Grassroots event in the first start of her career last season but was a winner in her lone qualifier when getting ready for that debut. This daughter of Control The Moment did not show much in a pair of morning preps coming into her three-year-old year but has shown enough speed to be more than competitive with this group. #3 SILVER LABEL went six for 14 last season with nine top two finishes and was just shy of \$500,000 in earnings, with her signature victory coming in the OSS Super Final before rounding out the superfecta in the Breeders Crown. She will begin her aged career in this first leg of the newly minted Ontario Sired Graduate Series and comes into this off a strong qualifying win on April 8th. This 12-time winner scored by two lengths in that morning prep and stopped the clock in 1:53.3 with a final stanza in 27 seconds flat. She will have the benefit of starting from a favorable spot on the gate with post-three and has our top billing in her first start back.

#11 INTOTHEMYSTICMOON has won three of her last four and most recently converted as the odds-on choice in the top condition class when firing home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2. She was fourth at the F&M-Preferred level two back and should be dead fit coming into this with five starts over this surface already to her credit in 2023. This daughter of Artspeak claimed the show spot in her only OSS Gold appearance last September but has progressed nicely under the tutelage of driver/trainer Phil Hudon and hit the board in 19 of her 28 lifetime tries. She will have to start from a tricky spot with the trailing post but should offer some value on the board and is capable of landing underneath.

#9 VELVET STINGER was winless in five in her two-year-old campaign but then came with a vengeance at three, scoring in eight of her 14 starts and banking nearly \$260,000 along the way. She enjoyed a pair of victories in the OSS Gold ranks and got up by a nose over our top selection in the Simcoe last September when sprouted wings in the stretch, pacing home in 26 seconds flat. This daughter of Bettors Delight was a winner in her first qualifier when preparing for her return to the races but then made a miscue in her most recent morning prep on April 14th. She will have Tyler Jones at the helm for the first time and can hit the ticket if she minds her manners.

#5 GOUDAWON made five trips to the winner's circle last season and hit the board in 12 of those efforts to dwarf her earnings in her rookie campaign with over \$170,000 in purse money. She went on a four-race win-streak in the summer that culminated with a 40-1 bombs-away score in an OSS Gold tilt and then earned a minor award in the Super Final last October after being last in a field of 10 on the backside. This daughter of Betterthancheddar was under tight lines to driver Bob McClure when coming home in 27.2 off a back-half in 55.2 in her most recent qualifier and was just three lengths back of our top choice at the finish in third. She will be making her first attempt out of the barn of trainer Tom Riley and should not be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#2 ESPLOSIONE devastated his competition in NW14000L5 on April 3rd when he trotted away by more than seven lengths in 1:54 flat and was a tick away from his lifetime mark that was set in an OSS Gold tilt last May. He blasted home in 27 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 55.4 in his first start on the lasix program and has now hit the board in four of his five tries so far at the age of four. #4 MOONLIT AFFAIR was the runner-up to Big Bettor Hanover in her lifetime debut almost a year ago and then went on the shelf after a pair of vet scratches due to lameness followed that effort. She was only beaten by a nose to Valley Of Fear in her only qualifier in preparation for this return and paced home in 28 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 56.4. This daughter of Betting Line was moving best of all in the final sixteenth of that mile and has a maturity over her rivals as the only four-year-old in the contest. She will likely be making noise in the late stages and can be right there at the wire.

#10 BLUE GLAMBER went one for 12 at the age of two with that victory coming in a front-end romp at Flamboro Downs that ended up being a non-betting race due to tote problems. She hit the board in a pair of OSS Grassroots tilts and was the runner-up to Brynley Seelster in her elimination for the Battle of the Belles. This daughter of All Bets Off earned just under \$23,000 in that rookie campaign and paced her own mile in 1:56.4 when finishing fourth to Valley Of Fear in her lone qualifier in preparation for her return. She will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but has shown more than enough tactical speed to get into a favorable spot off the switch.

#3 MYOUTSIDEVOICE claimed the show spot in a race that was dominated by Pink Monster last week and was the first-over challenger to that pacesetting winner at odds of 7/2. She lost a position in the stretch when finishing nearly three lengths in arrears to that rival and has now hit the board in five of six so far in her sophomore campaign. This daughter of Thinking Out Loud has been third in two of her three attempts on the big track and cannot be faulted for finishing eighth two back as she suffered broken equipment before the start and was taken to safety to the outside of the track after getting away fourth off the gate. She will start from a favorable spot on the gate with post-three and will have Bob McClure aboard for the fourth straight outing.

He was unhurried in early going of his three-year-old debut two back and was at a major pace disadvantage in that contest before settling for third at 5/2. This son of Betterthancheddar should be confident coming into this and will now take on tougher foes in this second round of the Ontario Sired Spring Series. He got the nod from Doug McNair over our third choice and gets the edge on top.

#2 GANDOLF THE BLACK has hit the board in each of his three tries so far in his sophomore campaign and was just a length away from No Control in his latest after that rival powered past his rivals in deep stretch. He went up against a tough customer in Red Coin in his two prior efforts in NW15000L and has not been worse than third in his last five overall. This son of Shadow Play will have J-Mac back aboard for the second straight outing and should be in the mix throughout. He figures to take support from post-two and can be right there at the finish.

#7 BAR DOWN JIM exits the same race as the one above and rounded out the superfecta at 5/2 in that contest when finishing more than five lengths back of No Control. He missed the board for the first time in his career in that outing and disappointed at 60 cents to the dollar when making his first start back after a layoff of more than five months two back. This son of Big Jim was a long way back in the early going of that contest after getting away seventh from post-10 and will likely now be at his best in his second consecutive attempt on a regular rotation. He will have Sylvain Filion at the controls and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#6 SPEAKER OF PEACE made up ground in the late stages last week to get within four lengths of a dominant winner in Nighttime Dancer after being nearly 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He paced his back-half in 54.2 with a final panel in 27.3 and has never missed a cheque in any of his eight lifetime tries so far. This son of Artspeak was an impressive winner on March 4th in NW1 and will move in a spot on the gate tonight after having the seven-hole or worse in five of his last six. Scott Young picks up the steer and he should not be left off the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

He did not really have any right to win that contest after being more than 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and has now won three in a row dating back to December 8th of last year in more than impressive fashion. This son of Control The Moment should only be stronger in this follow-up effort and will work from a much more favorable spot on the gate this evening with post-four. He will likely be closer to the action this time around and is hard to look past at what figures to be a short price.

#2 NIGHTIME DANCER has turned heads in both of his tries so far at the age of three and could not have won any easier in his latest when he paced away from his foes by more than two lengths in the stretch to convert as the 6/5 favorite. He held first-time starter Ikes Dream safely at bay two back after taking all kinds of late wagering support when racing off the shelf and should be brimming with confidence coming into this. This son of Sunshine Beach has not had to face the likes of the one above yet but still merits respect in what will be his third start back after a hiatus of more than six months. He will be our main player underneath.

#6 RED COIN was likely going to be the favorite last week before getting scratched out of the contest that the one above was victorious in due to sickness. He would have likely had his hands full with the performance that rival put forth but has won each of his last three by a combined margin of more than six lengths. This son of Bettors Delight has been no worse than second in any of his efforts so far at the age of three and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. He has only raced once in nearly four weeks but can still land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 ARTSALIVE has won two in a row to kick off his sophomore season and most recently scored with ease in NW1 as the 2/5 favorite. He obliterated his competition two back at Flamboro Downs when going up against softer company and will now face much tougher foes in this second leg of the Ontario Sired Spring Series. This son of Artspeak should be feeling good about himself coming into this but will need every bit of that confidence when going up against a murderers' row in the three above. He is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

This 11-time winner crushed his rivals at this level back on December 30th and then strung together another victory in the class above this. He should benefit from having a flat under his belt and will likely try to move forward off the gate from another outside draw. Top call.

#5 MAGIC WANDA has not had much of a chance in her last two in NW5800L5 when getting away last off the gate from post-eight in each of those contests and most recently improved a pair of positions before the wire in a race that was won by Aussie Lover. She finished second in back-to-back efforts at this level in February and should benefit from sliding in a few spots on the gate for tonight's tilt. This daughter of Kadabra has been camera-shy throughout her career with just six victories from 98 attempts but has managed to hit the board 44 times over that span. She comes into this off vet scratch due to sickness on April 7th but can make her presence felt with the right kind of trip.

#6 HIGH GEAR NO FEAR went all the way on the front-end at Northfield Park on February 28th in NW2500L4 and has since shipped north of the border to Mohawk Park for trainer Cory Kreiser. He has not raced in more than a month coming into this but reeled off victories in his first four tires over this surface back in 2020. This 14-time winner has got to the winner's circle in two of his 10 tries for this outfit and will have Sylvain Filion calling the shots for the first time. He does not look out of place against this group and should be included on the bottom end of the exotics.

#7 SOUTHWIND CAESER has picked up a minor award in one of his last three since dropping down to this level and that came two starts ago when he was just over four lengths away from winner Shes Got Pizazz in fourth. He has failed to hit the board in seven tries so far this season and might benefit from being freshened-up by getting a few weeks off coming into this. This son of Father Patrick is hard to back as a win candidate but will likely be making noise in the late stages and can pick up a share.

She hit the board in 16 of her 26 appearances last year and has had a pair of tune-ups in the mornings in preparation for this effort. She was most recently just three quarters of a length back of Velvet Stinger at the wire when pacing her own mile in 1:57.1 and should appreciate coming back in a softer spot than what she was accustomed to in all of her most recent outings. This daughter of Bettors Delight might need a start or two before she is ready to produce her best but can still be right there at the wire.

#4 BETTER BE DONNA N is another that should appreciate getting class relief after competing in NW16100L5 in each of her last four. She did not have much of a chance in her most recent effort at that level when getting shuffled back to last after getting away seventh off the switch at odds of 7/2 and completed the superfecta in fourth in all three of her prior tries. This 33-time winner was the runner-up to Style For A Mile when she went postward in NW8700L5 on February 24th and races for a barn that has been heating up as of late. She will be reunited with her regular driver Jonathan Drury and is among the main chances.

#8 SETTN A PRECEDENT is an interesting option after missing nearly a month of action and will be making her first start under the care of conditioner Kyle Bossence this evening. She changed hands after her most recent outing in this class on March 10th and earned a cheque in her last two attempts at this level. This 15-time winner was last victorious in NW3550L5 on February 4th when she converted as the even-money favorite and comes into this off a decent qualifier on April 8th. She should not be overlooked and is worth using in the exotics.

She did not miss a cheque in any of those efforts, with four on the board finishes and a victory on March 10th when she ran away from her foes on the front-end. This 12-time winner paced away by two lengths after getting a two-hole trip against similar company on February 10th and will likely be looking to ambush the field off the switch from the outermost post in the contest. She is more than capable of emerging victorious if her trip is not too taxing and has our top billing against this group.

#7 SWEET SANDY LOU came from a long way off the pace to only get beaten by three quarters of a length in third last week and has hit the board in each of her last two since entering the claiming ranks. She was 16 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing her back-half in 55.3 with a final panel in 27.4 and will now race for a price tag of \$35,000 for the third straight start. This daughter of Sweet Lou will likely have to overcome a similar journey this time out when drawing back on the outside of the gate with post-seven but has been knocking at the door as of late in this class. She will have Trevor Henry back at the controls and can be right there at the finish.

#2 COME ROLL WITH held on by a neck last week in this class after getting swarmed from every direction in deep stretch and has now won two of her last three at this level. She disappointed as the 3/5 favorite two back when she faded back to third in the late stages but has managed to hit the board in four of her last six overall. This daughter of Roll With Joe was plucked out of her latest for \$35,000 by trainer Brett Lester and will have part-owner Louis-Philippe Roy at the helm tonight. THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#6 STONEBRIDGE DRAMA was second best to a pumped-up winner in Mystifying in NW1850L3 last week and was just over a length away from that rival under the wire at odds of 16-1. She faded back to eighth after getting spotted in the two-hole against a tougher field two back in a race that was dominated by Silent Crossing and missed a week between starts going into her most recent effort. This 29-time winner was victorious over this surface on February 24th when she stopped the clock in 1:55.1 at 4-1 and appears to have met another group that she can get the better of. She will likely try to get forwardly placed from post-six and gets our top honors in the nightcap.

#9 DARKRSHADEOFFALE N missed by a neck to Come Out And Play in her latest at Flamboro Downs when disappointing as the odds-on favorite in NW3500L3 but had a difficult trip in that contest when stuck in the first-over position for most of the mile. She eventually got past the pacesetter but was unable to hold off the rival that she provided cover for and will now return to the big track in a class where she has picked up a prize in each of her last nine. This 27-time winner picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy for the first time but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest. She can be right there at the wire if her trip is sweet enough.

#4 BROKEN was second to Cox Im Special on April 1st at Flamboro Downs and was a winner two back over that half-mile surface when she scored by two lengths in NW1500L3 at odds of 6-1. She returns to Mohawk Park for the first time since September of last year and will have top driver James MacDonald aboard for the first time after trainer Todd Ratchford has called his own number in all of her last seven. This daughter of Somebeachsomewhere might be able to make some noise against this group if she can summon her best and should offer a decent price on the board. She can spice up the exotics at a price.

#7 CHELSIS CHOICE was just one for 24 last season but had seven runner-up finishes over that span and managed to hit the board on nine occasions in that four-year-old campaign. She comes into this after a layoff of more than four months but has prepared for this return to the races with a pair of decent qualifiers. This daughter of Big Jim was under tight lines to Bob McClure in the stretch drive on the morning of April 8th and paced home in 27.1 off a back-half in 55.3. That teamster elected to pilot her over our second choice and she should not be underestimated.

#5 A BLACK DIAMOND was just over a length away from Greystone Treasure when completing the exacta behind that rival at Flamboro Downs on April 2nd after getting forwardly placed from post-eight to secure a two-hole trip. She has been fourth or better in three of her four outings since being claimed by top trainer Richard Moreau and will return to the same class where she completed the superfecta at 11-1 on March 24th. This 13-time winner will be reunited with driver Sylvain Filion and can pick up a piece.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
