# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

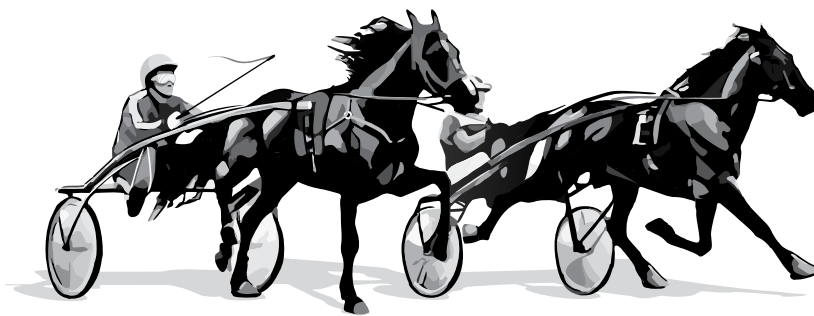
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

### Helpful facts for betting

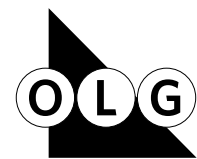
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

- WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
- PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
- SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

## Race 1 Selections

## THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

**#5 IKES DREAM** did not have much to offer in his latest when he got away fifth off the gate at this level and finished in that position under the wire in a race that was won by a well-meant winner in Laz. He went a long way on the lead at 24-1 two back when going postward in the opening round of the Ontario Sired Spring Series and was just over a length away from No Control when fading back to third at the finish. This son of Bettors Delight produced a solid effort to be second to Nighttime Dancer in his lifetime debut on April 1st and now resurfaces on the lasix program after getting a week off between starts. He will have Doug McNair in the driver's seat for the first time and has our nod on top in the opener.

**#7 TWIN B NATION** was a \$300,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will now be sent out for the first start of his career by trainer Luc Blais. He comes into this with a pair of qualifiers to his credit and was most recently under tight lines to the wire when coming from off the pace to finish second on April 21st. This son of American Ideal blasted home in 27 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 54.4 and was a winner in his first morning prep one week earlier. He might be ready to roll at first asking but races for an outfit that usually shows their best in their second or third attempt.

**#8 SPORTY JEWELS** was a \$60,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be making his lifetime debut for conditioner Anthony Beaton. He is another that will be making his first start under the lights after getting two morning preps under his belt and paced home in 27.3 or quicker in both of those qualifiers. This son of Sportswriter was third to the one above on April 14th and then came his back-half in 55.3 in his latest when finishing sixth in a race that was won by Verdun. He got the nod from J-Mac over another in the contest and is capable of hitting the ticket.

**#2 STEEL COWBOY** was funky-gaited on the lead in the first start of his career on April 1st and drifted out to the center of the racetrack on the bend for home before fading back to third under the wire. He was beaten by more than seven lengths in that contest and now returns to the races nearly a month later with a new pilot in the form of Jody Jamieson, who opted off our top selection. This half-brother to Bythemissal was a \$275,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg and might rebound with a much better performance this time out. He is worth keeping an eye on but might need to get this outing back under his feet before he is ready for his best.

He will have to overcome an outside draw with post-nine but that starting spot might help him mind his manners in the early going. Giving him the edge.

This 11-time winner moves back down to a favorable starting spot with post-four and might be given his marching orders off the gate this time around. He has been second or better in nine of his 12 tries for trainer Richard Moreau and can get back into the win-column when going up against a compact field this evening.

**#1 RON** went forward off the gate in his latest and secured the early pocket behind Cold Creek Queso but could only watch that rival pace away in the stretch. He rounded out the exacta at 21-1 behind that short-priced winner and was a length better than the one above at the wire. This son of Sportswriter only had one victory in 19 attempts last season but hit the board on nine occasions and banked over \$212,000. He was most notably the fourth-place finisher in the North America Cup and looms as a danger tonight, especially if he can work out a similar trip as last time.

**#3 DREAMFAIR ARNIE B** was moving best of all in the late stages last week after getting away last off the switch from post-seven and 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He accelerated into fourth before the wire at odds of 33-1 and paced his back-half in 54 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.4. This other son of Sportswriter has rounded out the superfecta in each of two efforts so far at the age of four and will not have as far to come this evening when only going up against four other rivals. He will likely make his presence felt in the lane and will get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

This son of Betterthancheddar was an impressive winner in his lifetime debut eight nights earlier at Georgian Downs, where he made a big move on the backside to get into contention and scored by half a length at the wire in 1:56.1. He will now get a follow-up try on the big track and once again gets our top honors at what will hopefully be an inflated price.

**#5 BETTOR BEA TERROR** exits the same race as the one above and disappointed as the favorite in that contest after going off at odds of 3/2. He was at the same pace disadvantage as the one above and was stacked up third-over on the bend for home before not being able to make up much ground in the stretch drive. This son of Bettors Delight blazed home in 26.1 to finish fourth on April 15th in his sophomore debut and has hit the board in eight of his 14 career attempts. He will try to break through with the first victory of his career tonight and is among the main chances.

**#3 BETTOR B SIRIUS** had the best legs in the late stages on April 21st in a contest that was won by Day Trader and managed to get within a length of that favorite at the wire at odds of 24-1. He got away in the early pocket from the pole position and was shuffled back to fifth on the turn for home before angling to the outside to get past rivals with vigor before the wire. This other son of Bettors Delight has hit the board in six of his 11 lifetime tries and has only missed a cheque in a couple of those efforts. He should be in the mix throughout but will offer only a fraction of the price this time out.

He held off Bayfield Beach by half a length at the wire when stopping the clock in 1:51.4 and will now slide down to the inside of the gate when moving up to the middle condition ranks. This 22-time winner has proven he can be more than competitive in tougher spots than this but does hook a tricky group of horses for this level. He will be making his second straight outing on a regular rotation and should be in the mix throughout.

**#3 CENTURY HEINEKEN** was outrun in the Free For All in his latest and was beaten by a wide margin when finishing last of a field of seven in that contest. He finished within a couple of lengths of Nautical Hanover in fifth the week prior at that level and was third when making his first start in over four months in a Preferred-2 on April 8th. This 11-time winner should appreciate getting significant class relief this evening when dropping down to NW16900L5 and will be reunited with driver Doug McNair. He will start from a favorable spot on the gate and should get every chance to hit the ticket.

**#1 SOMETIME SOMEWHERE** is another that has been taking on tougher competition in each of his last two and will drop back down to the condition class after only picking up one minor award over those two outings. He has earned a cheque in 15 of his 17 outings for top trainer Richard Moreau and was only beaten by a neck to Roll With The Flow the last time he went postward at this level on February 18th. This 21-time winner might be able to work out a decent trip from the pole position and is worth using on the bottom end of exotics.

He shaved two seconds off his lifetime mark when stopping the clock in 1:52.1 with a 26.4 kicker and had not raced in nearly six months going into that effort. This son of Stay Hungry has hit the board in five of his eight career outings so far and will get to come right back in this class tonight. He has missed another week of action going into this effort but looks like a prime candidate to double-up at what will likely be a short price.

**#7 GUNG HO** was one for 11 as a rookie and hit the board six times on his way to earning just under \$65,000. He broke his maiden in a soft spot over this surface at 35 cents to the dollar and followed that up by making the final of the Metro Stakes but then finished eighth in the final at odds of 111-1. This son of Captaintreacherous was the runner-up in each of his morning preps when getting ready for the first start of his three-year-old campaign and will now race on lasix for the first time in his career. He looms as a danger and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#5 DAY TRADER** was a strong winner in NW1 last week when he coasted to the wire in 1:54.4 as the 1/2 favorite. He was given some reminders on the backside after clearing to the lead but then paced his back-half in 56.2 with a final quarter in 27.3. This other son of Stay Hungry was the runner-up in his first start off the shelf two back when blasting home in 26.3 and should be primed for his best now with a pair of efforts to his credit at the age of three. He will make the difficult transition upwards to NW2 but retains driver Doug McNair in the sulky.

**#2 RED COIN** was overland for much of the mile before settling for fourth at 2-1 in this class in his latest and was just over a length away from winner Nytro J at the finish. He paced home in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2 and was in need of a flat line in that contest after jumping it off in the second round of the Ontario Sired Spring Series eight nights earlier. This son of Bettors Delight loses J-Mac to our top selection and will pick up Trevor Henry in the driver's seat for the first time. He should benefit from getting a flat line to his credit and secure a sizable slice with a decent trip.

He has won two of his last three and did not have any chance two starts ago when he got away last off the gate in the Free For All. This 13-time winner has been second or better in 10 of his last 16 dating back to October 21st of last year and should be feeling good about himself coming into this. He will likely give up a fitness advantage to the one above but looms as the main danger.

**#5 SO MUCH MORE** was a dominant winner at 25 cents to the dollar when getting back against her own kind in the F&M-Free For All on April 15th and will now have to go back to facing the boys in this Preferred-2 event. She got the better of the best male pacers on the circuit in the top class on February 25th and was just one tick off her lifetime mark in that contest when stepping her mile in 1:49.3. This 61-time winner has been no worse than second in seven of her 10 tries so far this season and went over \$1.3M in career earnings in this seven-year-old campaign. She is the Queen of Pacing in Canada and should be able to land somewhere on the ticket.

**#2 MOMAS SON BYRNE** continues to raise his game for trainer Carmen Auciello and most recently claimed the show spot in the Free For All last week at odds of 28-1. He went a huge trip on the engine on April 8th when going coast-to-coast in this class and has now hit the board in four of his last five overall. This 13-time winner might push out from post-two to be part of the early pace scenario and gave our top choice the cold shoulder the last time he competed at this level. He is capable of outperforming this projection but we prefer on the bottom end of the trifecta and super this evening.

He has been second or better in his last three tries at this level and was claimed for \$35,000 in that most recent effort by trainer Brett Lester. This 12-time winner will have Louis-Philippe Roy calling the shots for the first time and that teamster chose to drive him over our top selection. He will likely not go down without a fight and merits respect.

**#6 THE LEGEND HANOVER** could not have been a more impressive winner on April 15th when he devastated his foes by six lengths in this class and paced to a new lifetime mark of 1:50.3. He completed a four-race win-streak in that outing and had a combined winning margin of nearly 39 lengths in those efforts. This son of Somebeachsomewhere had a healthy lead on his foes for much of the contest last week but then drifted out in the stretch when he got leg weary and faded back to fourth under the wire at 30 cents to the dollar. He will be reunited with driver Doug McNair and has rebound potential.

**#8 JJ TOMMY** made a first-over bid on the spin for home last week and got within half a length of the our second choice at the wire after that rival was able to scoot up the cones from the pocket. He has hit the board in five straight since being claimed for \$15,000 by conditioner Jean-Francois Maguire and was a winner in each of his first three tries for this barn. This son of Tobago Cays will have to work from the outermost post in the contest this evening but can pick up a decent chunk if his trip is not too taxing.

This son of Huntsville should relish the opportunity to get down to NW1500L3 this evening and got the nod from Bob McClure over two others in the contest. He can hit the ticket.

**#6 ALLUNEDISFAITH N** made a first-over challenge against Codename Cigar Box last week before fading back to fourth at nearly 43-1 and has not been able to finish better than sixth in his first two attempts on the circuit. ## C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-bis.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race in which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
