Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 ADARE CASTLE will have an opportunity to make a clean sweep of the newly minted OSS Graduate Series after scoring in each of the first three legs and was a determined winner in her latest when got past a stubborn rival in the one below. She outsprinted that foe when sizzling home in 26.3 and managed to exact some revenge on the one that went past her for Super Final glory last October. This 17-time winner has converted as the odds-on choice in each of her last two after offering 9/5 in her aged debut on April 14th and will likely take the bulk of the support again when the chips are down this evening. She is hard to go against and gets the nod on top to kick off the card.

#2 MISCHIEVOUS ROSE was handled aggressively last week when she kept driving into the first turn from post-seven and got to the lead when the field straightened out on the backside. She held court on the engine until the one above collared her in deep stretch and has not been worse than fourth in each of her three outings so far at the age of four. This daughter of Muscle Mass has hit the board in 18 of her 27 career attempts and is quickly approaching \$450,000 in earnings. She has proven to be versatile in her racing style and can make her presence felt from any position in this compact field of six.

#5 SAFE CONDUCT got away in the three-hole in his latest and maintained that position to claim the show spot under the wire at odds of 13-1. He has been fourth or better in his last two after making a miscue at the start in his first start of his aged career. This son of Archangel brought his best when it mattered most at the end of the season last year when he captured the Super Final last October and might be able to come up with a similar performance this evening when the stakes are higher. He figures to be making noise in the stretch and should get every chance to hit the ticket.

#1 ESPLOSIONE had to settle for the bottom end of the superfecta last week after getting away fifth off the switch but was the runner-up to our top selection in each of two previous legs. He was a dominant winner in NW14000L5 on April 3rd when he scored by more than seven lengths in 1:54 flat and has hit the board in six of eight so far this season. This son of Kadabra might get activated sooner in the mile this time around and is more than capable of finishing on the bottom end of the exotics. He can grab a share.

#10 BAR DOWN JIM suffered interference on the first turn of the final of the Ontario Sired Spring Series and lost significant ground when he was bodychecked when rivals to his outside came together. He was then stuck on the outside and was parked-out for the entire mile before turning in a valiant effort to be third at 26-1. He has picked up a prize in all of his four tries so far as a three-year-old and was only beaten by three quarters of a length to longshot winner Northern Cardinal in his sophomore debut. This son of Big Jim has hit the board in eight of 10 in his career and should appreciate getting back down to NW1. He retains Sylvain Filion in the sulky but will have to overcome a tricky draw with post-10.

#1 COLD CREEK GUERERO gamely chased the odds-on favorite Ikes Dream to the finish last week after sitting in a loose pocket behind that rival for the duration of the mile. #2 SAULSBROOK VICTOR got back to the winner's circle on April 22nd when he went straight to the lead from post-six and held court on the engine through reasonable splits before powering home in 26.4 to score by more than a pair of lengths under the wire. He has won three of his last five in this class and has hit the board in 12 of his last 13 overall with a total of eight victories over that span. This 16-time winner is less than \$20,000 away from his total earnings for all of 2022 with \$143,520 already banked this year and shown a lot more tactical speed after being known as a closer in the early parts of his career. He will likely be pushing off the gate from post-two and has a big chance to repeat.

#3 WHEELS ON FIRE is putting together another strong campaign at the age of eight and has hit the board in all 10 of his appearances so far this season with over \$100,000 being added to his bankroll. He has had to settle for the place spot in each of his last two but was a determined winner three back when he got the better of the one above in the dying strides after sitting in the pocket for much of the mile. This 47-time winner might be able to work out a similar trip scenario this evening from post-three and is the logical choice to complete the exacta.

#1 SO MUCH MORE put another victory against the boys on her resume last week when she held on by a head in the Preferred-2 and has now won three of her last four. She scored as an overwhelming favorite in those two prior victories against her own kind but was a winner at this level on February 25th when she was just a tick off her lifetime mark when pacing her mile in 1:49.3. This 62-time winner has once again proclaimed her dominance as the Queen of Pacing in Canada and should be confident when taking a step up the class ladder against the opposite sex this evening. She will have rail control and can hit the ticket.

#5 NAUTICAL HANOVER was hammered down at the windows two back when being sent off as the 3/2 favorite and converted on that promise when he held on by a nose after going all the way on the engine in 1:50.4. He was then forgotten about on the odds board in his latest when he offered nearly 6-1 at post-time but was never a factor at any point in the mile. This son of Captaintreacherous has won four of his last six overall and was more than impressive when he completed a clean sweep of the New Holland Pacing Series. He should be utilized on the bottom end of exotics but it might be a good idea to monitor the tote board to best gauge his chances.

#9 NIGHTIME DANCER did not come forward with any authority off a second-over trip in the final of the Ontario Sired Spring Series on April 22nd and had to settle for the bottom spot of the superfecta in fourth at 6-1. He lost his cover just before the top of the stretch and could not find the gear he demonstrated the week prior when he paced into the place spot behind No Control with a final quarter in 26.2 after being first-over for a long way. This son of Sunshine Beach might benefit from getting a week off between outings after going big miles in each of his first three starts of his sophomore campaign and driver Jody Jamieson sticks with him over two others in the contest. He will have to overcome a tricky starting spot with post-nine but still gets our top honors when getting back to the overnight ranks.

#3 GANDOLF THE BLACK exits the same race as the one above and emerged with the place spot in that added-money event when getting within a pair of lengths of heavy-favorite No Control. He followed the cover of the one above in the third-over position for much of the journey and got past that rival with ease in the stretch. This son of Shadow Play has been second or better in each of his last four and has hit the board in eight of his 11 career attempts. He has returned to the races in good order for trainer Dominic Gladu and might be able to work some magic with the right kind of trip.

#4 NYTRO J was a strong winner in this class on April 22nd when he moved to the lead on the backside and then held a comfortable margin the rest of the way before holding his rivals at bay by a length as the 9/5 favorite. He took that support after he finished with vigor to get within three quarters of a length to Gentleonmymind one week prior and was shuffled back in that contest after blasting to the engine off the gate from post-eight. This son of Big Jim will be making his third start back after missing his entire four-year-old season and can continue to make progress for conditioner Jack Moiseyev. He is another that has been off for a week between outings but is among the main chances.

#8 GUNG HO was rushed to the lead off the switch from post-seven last week and then released the odds-on favorite Redwood Hanover to the front on the backside. He sat a pocket trip the rest of the way before pacing his own mile in 1:52.1 and was two lengths better than third-place finisher Profundo under the wire. This son of Captaintreacheraus has three siblings that have earned more than \$350,000 and might take a step forward when making his second start back after a lengthy layoff. He loses Jody Jamieson to our top selection but picks up a suitable replacement in Louis-Philippe Roy.

#1 THE LEGEND HANOVER rebounded his way to the victory lane last week when he went all the way on the front-end to score by more than a length at the finish in 1:51.3. He once again drifted to the center of the track in the stretch drive before returning 6/5 as the second choice and went off at that inflated number after fading back to fourth in the late stages at 30 cents to the dollar the week before. This son of Somebeachsomewhere rhymed off four in a row before that by a combined margin of nearly 39 lengths and paced to his lifetime mark in his second try off the claim for high-percentage trainer Isaac Waxman when transitioning to the big track in this class on April 15th. He will have Doug McNair back at the controls for an encore performance and is hard to look past.

#3 DRAGON ENERGY sat in a loose pocket behind the one above for the duration of the mile in his latest and could only get within a pair of lengths of that rival at the finish, despite banging home in 26.4. He disappointed as the 6/5 favorite in that contest and the money will surely flow in the other direction tonight after the way things panned out last time. This 12-time winner has been second or better in six of his last seven overall and will now be making his second attempt off the claim for trainer Brett Lester. He will likely have to play second fiddle again this evening and can round out what will be a chalky exacta.

#2 DOC HOUSTON was one that we tried on top last week at 15-1 but was never in contention after getting away sixth off the gate and was 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He was still seven lengths in arrears to our top selection after pacing his back-half in 55 seconds flat with a final panel in 26.1 and might be closer to the action this time around when getting another chance in this class. This son of Sportswriter picks up the driving services of Sylvain Filion for the first time in his career and can make a better account of himself tonight. He can add some value to the bottom end of the exotics.

#6 JJ TOMMY had to settle for fourth last week after trying to make forward progress on the rim but could only get as far as third before losing a position again in the lane. He was the runner-up to our second choice two back in a race where our top selection shortened stride in the stretch and was a winner in each of his first three outings of the claim for trainer Jean-Francois Maguire. This son of Tabago Cays had hit the board in five straight going into his latest and should appreciate sliding in a couple of spots to the center of the gate for tonight's tilt. He can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

#1 SINTRA has not raced in three months but is just one start removed from spending nine of his last 10 in the Preferred ranks and notched a victory at that level back on December 3rd when he split horses in the dying strides to get the better of So Much More. He returns to the races off a decent qualifier on April 28th and was put on hold for much of that mile before firing home in 26.3 to be third to Acapulco Sunburn with Anthony MacDonald in the bike. This 46-time winner will be reunited with brother James this evening and gets to come back in a soft spot in this NW8650L5. He will start from the pole position and can come out on top in this mandatory Hi-5 event.

#2 REAL WILLEY is another that should appreciate getting some class relief after going up against tougher competition in all of his last 16 and was a winner the last time he did not compete in the middle condition ranks on December 3rd when scored by a length in 1:54.1 over a track that was one second off. He has picked up a prize in 13 of his last 15 overall and will have Doug McNair back at the reins for tonight's tilt. This 18-time winner will likely flash his early speed from the inside of the gate and can be dangerous if he can get loose on the lead or can work out a pocket trip. He can be right there at the wire.

#12 NO PLAN INTENDED has been no worse than second in his last two tries in the Preferred at The Raceway in London and was fought off Ideal Perception by a nose in that class on April 24th. He turned in a gutsy performance in his latest before coming up a head short to Cheddar Bay at the wire and has earned a cheque in all five of his efforts so far this season. This 21-time winner returns to the class where he made up ground in the late stages to finish fifth on April 15th and will be reunited with Jody Jamieson in the sulky. He will have to overcome a difficult starting spot in the second-tier but cannot be left out of the exotic wagers.

#3 ARMOR SEELSTER has finished sixth in each of his last two in the class above this and earned a small share in the final of the New Holland Pacing Series before that. He is still winless in 12 attempts in 2023 but has managed to hit the board on four occasions and has only missed three cheques over that span. This son of Bettors Delight will get down to the lowest level that he has seen in a long time but will have to contend with several others that are dropping down in classification. He fits in nicely with this group and should get every chance to pick up a decent chunk.

#6 BEYOND BETTER blew up at 45 cents to the dollar last week when he made a break in stride and had taken all that support when moving up to this level after devastating his foes the week before in NW4000L5. He catapulted off his cover on that occasion before pacing away by nearly five lengths under the wire and stopped the clock in 1:51.4. This 17-time winner will get a chance at redemption tonight when once again leaving from the center of the gate but loses J-Mac to our top selection and will have Austin Sorrie calling the shots. He will provide an opportunity to take back some value for those that supported him last time but a lesser share might be more likely when racing off a miscue.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
