Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



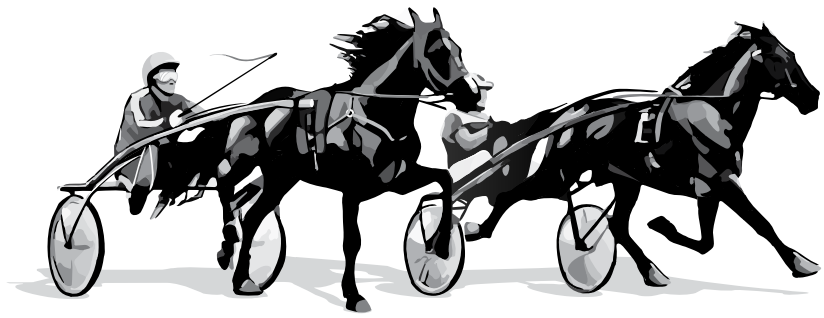
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

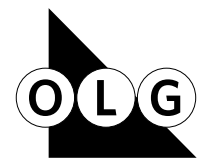
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 ARIO HANOVER turned in a big effort to score by more than four lengths in a middle condition class last week and equaled his lifetime mark of 1:49.4 in the process to convert as the 7/5 favorite. He had walked away empty-handed for three consecutive outings before that after missing a few weeks of action when he was gelded and will now take a big step up the class ladder to the Preferred. This son of Captaintreacherous should be confident coming into this and draws a favorable spot on the gate with post-three. He will likely get overlooked on the odds board and is one that we are willing to take a whirl on to kick off the card.

#8 POINTS NORTH did not have much of a chance in his latest when he took on a tough installment of the Free For All and was shuffled back to last on the bend for home after staying on the cones in sixth. He was beaten by nearly five lengths to an upset winner in Nautical Hanover and had not raced in more than a month going into that effort. This 39-time winner had picked up a prize in his 10 previous starts and was last victorious on April 29th in NW16900L5. He will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald and can be right there at the wire.

#5 WARRAWEE VITAL has rounded out the superfecta in each of his last two and had to work from a tricky starting spot in each of his last three since coming back to the races after a forced vacation. He has not tried to go to early lead in any of those efforts following getting scratched by the judges on April 29th and should appreciate working from the center of the gate this evening against a palatable group in the Preferred. This 21-time winner might try to return to his best racing style this evening and should be in the mix throughout. He is more than capable of coming out on top and should and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#7 CODENAME CIGAR BOX exits the same race as the one above and went a big mile in that NW23500L5 contest to be second to Century Heineken, who has been hampered with post-10 this evening. He made a first-over bid on the final turn and kept inching in on that winner to the wire before coming up just head short of victory. This 26-time winner was impressive in victory two starts ago when he dominated his foes in NW14000L5 and scored by nearly two lengths while pacing his mile in 1:49.4. He has hit the board in three of his last five and appears to be trending back in the right direction for Team Cullen.

#5 FASHION FRENZIE likely needed his last start when he returned off the bench to make his five-year-old debut and still went a long way on the lead before giving way to the odds-on favorite below in the dying strides. He only missed by a nose at odds of 2-1 and went into that effort off a winning qualifier 10 days earlier. This 18-time winner won seven of nine last season and is just over \$35,000 shy of \$1M in lifetime earnings. He can take a big step forward with a race now under his belt and can go the distance for the victory this time out. Top call.

#2 LOGAN PARK has been on quite a roll in 2023 after winning five of his six and has not been worse than second in any of those outings. He was the first-over challenger to the one above last week and wore that rival down in the late stages before getting his nose in front at the finish. This 17-time winner would have had a clear fitness advantage over that foe going into that start and his only defeat this season came in a spot when he was not racing back on a regular rotation. He has not raced in 18 days coming into this and might have a harder time hauling that one down this evening.

#3 PIKACHU HANOVER has won three in a row while climbing back up the class ladder and was most recently a front-end winner in NW21500L5 at 90 cents to the dollar. He has shown versatility over that win-streak and scored from the first-over position two starts ago when he kept trotting hard through the wire to stop the clock in 1:52.3, which is just three ticks away from his lifetime best. This 33-time winner has been off for the same timeframe as the two above but should be brimming with confidence coming into this. He loses Doug McNair to the one above but picks up a suitable replacement in Scott Zeron.

#7 ONEY HALL has been no worse than second in each of his last three and was sidelined for a few weeks following a vet scratch due to sickness before his second-place finish to Safe Conduct in NW14500L5 a couple of starts ago. He looked a lot more like his old self when he took down a Preferred-2 in his most recent outing and made a first-over move on the final turn of that contest before getting past the pacesetter in the stretch. This 30-time winner trotted his mile in 1:53.3 and has now hit the board in seven of his last 10. He will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

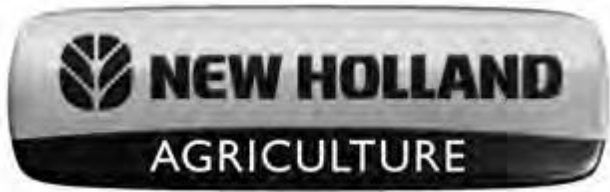

This son of Bettors Delight has hit the board in each of his three attempts in the condition ranks this season and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. He will start from the center of the gate and can get back to the winner's circle in this NW2 event. Giving him the nod.

#7 NIGHTIME DANCER was sent to the engine on the backside on June 6th and then kept rolling on the front-end to score an easy victory in a division of the OSS Grassroots at odds of 2-1. He took on tough rivals in a couple of efforts before that in this class and had to go up against the likes of No Control, Ace of Aces and Reign Supreme. This son of Sunshine Beach has been victorious in three of his eight starts so far as a sophomore and has been second or better in four of those efforts. He loses Jody Jamieson to our fourth choice and picks up the driving services of Yannick Gingras.

#3 DAY TRADER completed the superfecta at nearly 40-1 on June 3rd when he was fourth to Stockade Seelster in his division of the Somebeachsomewhere and had missed three weeks of action going into that effort after being scratched due to sickness on May 19th. He was picked up by a head in the dying strides by the one below in this class on May 13th and has now been credited with back-to-back victories to kick off his sophomore campaign after being placed up to the victory on April 15th in a race where he originally had to settle for the place spot. This son of Stay Hungry should much prefer the company he keeps tonight and should be in the mix throughout. He can hit the ticket.

#9 BROOKDALE MIKI B has spent each of his last two competing in Pennsylvania in their Sire Stakes program and most recently took wagering support to the tune of 7/2 in a Stallion Series event but was beaten by a wide margin in a race that was won by Hungry Man. He has since shipped back north of the border and will go postward over a surface where he has won two of his last three, besting both our first and third choice in those victories. This son of Always B Miki has not raced in nearly three weeks and will have to overcome a tricky starting spot with the nine-hole. He got the nod from driver Jody Jamieson and will likely be making noise in the stretch.

#2 RON should appreciate getting down to a lifetime non-winners classification after finishing fifth in NW14000L5 last week in a race that was dominated by Ario Hanover. He had not raced in nearly three weeks going in to that effort after being disqualified back to seventh from fifth in the in the final of the Charles Juravinski Memorial Cup at Flamboro Downs on May 21st and had hit the board in each of his last three tries in Ontario Sired Graduate Series, including a third-place finish in the final. This son of Sportswriter has a maturity edge over the ones below and banked more than \$212,000 last season despite going just one for 19 in the win-column. He was fourth in the North America Cup last year and has one of his best chances to get back to victory lane for the first time since May of 2021.

#4 AHI SUNSHINE was put into play on June 6th in an OSS Grassroots tilt and scored by as much as he pleased after opening a wide margin on his rivals on the bend for home. He scored by nearly seven lengths at the wire while pacing to a new lifetime mark of 1:51.1 and offered 5/2 to his backers. This son of Sunshine Beach was not able to make much of an impact when going postward in the class below this in his two prior efforts but did have to go up against some difficult rivals in those contests. He won five of 10 last season and should now be feeling much better about himself after getting back to victory lane last time out.

#6 WHATCHULOOKIN AT was only able to improve one spot in his division of the Somebeachsomewhere after getting away seventh off the gate on June 3rd and was nearly eight lengths behind Redwood Hanover at the finish. He kept driving to the lead from post-eight in the SBOA before that and got picked up by a trio of strong rivals in the stretch to round out the superfecta at odds of 16-1. This son of Hes Watching has won four of 10 in his career and has hit the board in six of those efforts. He was a winner the last time he went postward in a condition race and might be handled more aggressively this evening when working from the center of the gate.

#5 HUNGRY MAN earned a cheque in his North America Cup elimination last week when he finished fifth in a race that was won by Fulton. He was seven lengths in arrears to that winner at the wire after getting away eighth off the gate and held off a pair of rivals at the finish to claim a minor award. This son of Stay Hungry was a strong winner in the Stallion Series at Harrah's Philly on May 28th and went all the way on the engine in that contest before stopping the clock in 1:49 flat. He has five top two finishes in 16 lifetime tries and should be able to make his presence felt when competing in an overnight event.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 BELLA BELLINI was winless in three going into her elimination for this stakes event but looked a lot more like the horse we remember from last season when she blew past Adare Castle in the stretch to score by more than three lengths going away. She blasted home in 26.3 to convert as the 1/5 favorite and had taken on male competition in her two previous efforts. This 21-time winner is hard to go against when she faces her own kind and should have confidence back when going postward in a race that she had to settle for third in last season as the 6/5 favorite. She will start from the center of the gate and will likely double-up at the shortest of prices.

#4 WARRAWEE XENIA was first-over against Raised By Lindy for most of her elimination last week and appeared content to stay on the outside in that position before finishing fourth in a race where the top five advanced to the final. She was just over three lengths in arrears to that eventual winner under the wire at odds of 2-1 and moving best of all in the final sixteenth of a mile one week earlier in her division of the Miss Versatility. This 10-time winner will be making her third start after missing a few weeks after a vet scratch due to sickness and won six in a row here at Mohawk Park around this time last year. She will be our main player underneath.

#3 RAISED BY LINDY exits the same race as the one above and went all the way on the engine in that contest before equalling her lifetime mark of 1:51.1. She had to settle for third to Adare Castle the week prior in the Miss Versatility and was a winner of four of 12 last season, including the Eleganimage over this surface, and had eight on the board finishes on her way to baking nearly \$460,000. This 10-time winner should be ready to produce her best when making her third start back after a layoff of nearly seven months and will likely once again have her gas pedal pressed off the gate. She should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#1 REFINED got within half a length of the one above last week after flipping off her cover from the second-over position at the head of the stretch and blasted home in 26.3 on the heels of a back-half in 54 seconds flat. She was impressive in victory in each of her two prior efforts at Scioto Downs in Ohio and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation after missing more than three weeks going into her latest. This 33-time winner will start from the same post position she had last week and can take down a significant slice if she can work out a similar journey. She should not be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#1 STOCKADE SEELSTER got situated in the pocket behind Its My Show in his elimination for the North America Cup but could not stay with that rival in the stretch before having to settle for third under the wire. He was unable to hold off Save America for the place spot despite pacing his own mile in 1:48.3 and was not lucky enough to be one of the two third-place finishers that drew into the final. This son of State Treasurer was a winner in his division of the Somebeachsomewhere the week prior and is now just under \$5,000 shy of \$1M in career earnings. He was a dominant force in the OSS as a two-year-old around these parts and proved he can compete against open company when he took down the Metro last September. Giving him the edge to come out on top in this NA Cup consolation event.

#6 HUNGRY ANGEL BOY got away in the three-hole last week from the pole position and stayed on the cones in that elimination that was won with ease by Confederate. He angled off the backs of horses in the stretch and had to wait for clearance before pacing hard into third to round out the trifecta at odds of 61-1. This son of Stay Hungry fired home in 26.3 off a back-half in 54 seconds flat and has been third in all three of his efforts so far as a sophomore. He was a winner over this surface last season in a preliminary leg of the Dream Maker and was Todd McCarthy's choice over another the contest.

#8 EL REY rallied into fourth last week in the NA Cup elimination that was won by Fulton and had a lot of work to do in the late stages after getting away seventh off the switch from post-eight. He was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.1 with a final panel in 26.3 and was hammered down to 8/5 favoritism in his division of the Somebeachsomewhere one week earlier. This son of Captaintreacherous is winless in three this season after going five for 12 last year but should be more than competitive against this group. He might get activated sooner in the mile this time out and is among the main chances.

#5 JUST BET IT ALL was breathing down the neck of our second choice for third in their elimination on June 10th and was another in the contest that had to shake loose in the stretch before making forward progress. He was moving well under the wire when getting within four lengths of a wrapped-up winner in Confederate and paced his own mile in 1:49.3 with a 26.2 kicker. This son of Betting Line has not finished worse than fourth in any of his five outings as a sophomore and will have this circuit's leading driver James MacDonald back aboard this evening. He will start from the center of the gate and merits consideration.

#4 LINEDRIVE HANOVER was left with a lot of work to do last week in the Free For All after getting away eighth off the gate from post-eight and was more than 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He stormed home to be third and was only beaten by three quarters of a length after pacing his back-half in 52.3 with a final panel in 26.2. This 11-time winner had not raced in more than 11 months going into that effort and will likely be handled more aggressively from post-four in his second try off the bench. He should attract a lot of attention on the odds board but still gets the edge on top.

#9 ALLYWAG HANOVER exits the same race as the one above is another that needed his latest effort after returning from a seven-month hiatus but was still put into play in that outing after leaving hard from post-five. He sat the pocket behind Billy Clyde for much of the mile and faded back to fourth in the lane to get beat by more than two lengths under the wire to a surprise winner in Nautical Hanover. This 24-time winner was victorious in six of 13 last season and hit the board in all of those outings on his way to banking over \$500,000 in the aged pacing category that was dominated by Bulldog Hanover. He is just over \$11,000 shy of \$1.8M in lifetime earnings and that milestone is well within reach this evening in his second start back.

#5 ABUCKABETT HANOVER was an impressive winner in his first start back as a five-year-old on May 27th at the Meadowlands in the Open and paced to a new lifetime mark of 1:48.3 in that contest after not racing for more than six months. He went just one for 14 in the first season of his aged career last year and hit the board in four of those outings on his way to adding another \$246,438 to his bankroll. This 13-time winner has missed another three weeks of action coming into this but did produce a strong qualifier in preparation for this race last weekend in New Jersey, where he scored by seven lengths in 1:51 flat. He will start from the center of the gate and merits respect.

#6 TATTOO ARTIST did not get off to the flying start that many were expecting from him this season when he faded back to last in the opening round of the Borgata at Yonkers at just 25 cents to the dollar back in March but then rebounded with a dominant score one week later over a sloppy track. He was not able to muster a finish better than fourth in the subsequent three legs of that series and then had to settle for third in the consolation for that event before going back on the shelf for a month. This 32-time winner has been no worse than second in two tries since then and paced his mile in 1:48.2 when winning by open lengths in NW2000L5 at Harrah's Philly six days ago. He will be making his third consecutive start on the lasix program and should appreciate getting back on a track where he has enjoyed tremendous success.

#4 GRACE HILL has been electric in going four-for-four in her five-year-old campaign and was the easiest kind of winner last week in her elimination for the Roses Are Red. She was under tight lines to the finish before tripping the wire in 1:50.1 and was untouchable in F&M-Open events in her three previous outings at Scioto Downs despite having to work from outside draws in each of those efforts. This 23-time winner enjoyed the biggest victory of her career last fall at this venue when she captured the Breeders Crown and has won four of five when Doug McNair is calling the shots. She should be brimming with confidence coming into this and is once again hard to look past.

#2 TREACHEROUS DRAGON has transitioned nicely against older horses after a successful sophomore campaign that saw her emerge victorious in prestigious events like the Jugette and both the Fan Hanover and Breeders Crown here at Mohawk Park. She went nine for 15 over that season with 12 on the board finishes and stashed away another \$872,800 in the process. This 14-time winner was the runner-up in each of her first four starts of her aged career and raced remarkably well in the Betsy Ross at Harrah's Philly on May 28th when she only missed by a nose to Max Contract. She managed to get back to the winner's circle last week in her elimination for this race and shaved three ticks off her lifetime mark that was set over this surface last October. Dexter Dunn will be aboard for the second straight start and she looms as a danger.

#5 SO MUCH MORE was unable to get near our top choice after moving first-over on the turn for home in her latest and only briefly poked her head into second before losing a couple of positions in the stretch to round out the superfecta at 4-1. She had to overcome adversity to convert as the heavy-favorite in the Forest City over the half-mile surface at The Raceway in London prior to that and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation. This 64-time winner has won seven of 15 this season and has only been worse than second on five occasions after frequently having to take on male competition on this oval. She is the Queen of Pacing in Canada and can hit the ticket with the right kind of trip.

#3 AMAZING DREAM N was sent to the early lead last week before releasing our top selection to the front and sat in the two-hole the rest of the way before maintaining that position in second under the wire. She has been no worse than fourth in any of her eight attempts at the age of seven and was caught behind horses for much of the stretch drive of the Betsy Ross before only getting beat by three quarters of a length. This 30-time winner went all the way on the lead at 5/2 in the final of the Matchmaker at Yonkers on April 24th and will get to work from a much more favorable spot on the gate this time from post-three. She might be able to navigate another favorable journey and can continue her cheque-getting ways.

#5 CONFEDERATE had the luxury going postward in what appeared to be the softest of the four Pepsi North America Cup eliminations and was hammered down to 1/9 on the odds board before toying with his rivals on the front-end. He was under no urging to the wire when stopping the clock in 1:48.4 and had his ear plugs still in when he came back to his picture taken. This son of Sweet Lou should benefit from having an easy go of things one week ago and unleashed an incredible late kick to be victorious in his first start as a sophomore on May 27th at the Meadowlands. He might go back to trying to race off a helmet when the chips are down tonight and has been at his best when that strategy is deployed. Giving him our top billing in one of the deepest looking fields this race has seen in a very long time.

#2 ITS MY SHOW is a perfect five-for-five as a sophomore and produced a dazzling performance in his latest when he scored by more than two lengths in his elimination for this race. He pushed out for the early lead from the pole position and maintained a comfortable margin before firing home in 26.2 on the heels of a back-half in 53 seconds flat. This other son of Sweet Lou has elevated his game to a whole new level after going winless in eight at the age of two and is now just shy of \$150,000 in career earnings. He should be oozing confidence coming into this and will likely be looking to get forwardly placed again from another inside draw.

#9 SAVE AMERICA was stuck in the three-hole for most of the mile before angling to the outside with pace in the stretch last week and managed to get past Stockade Seelster in the dying strides to punch his ticket to the final. He was just over two lengths in arrears to the one above under the wire at odds of 4-1 and blew his competition away in a Stallion Series event at Harrah's Philly in Pennsylvania before that in his first start as a gelding. This son of Captaintreacherous paced his mile in a blistering 1:48.1 over that five-eighths of a mile surface and was the odds-on choice in the Metro Stakes last season here at Mohawk Park before having to settle for second. He has hit the board in five of six of his outings over this surface and can build off that latest performance if he can avoid a taxing journey from a tricky draw.

#6 VOUCHEFALAS put in some ugly steps on the first turn in his latest before briefly breaking stride and had to be gathered up to settle into fifth after making that miscue when he was driving towards the lead. He then had to go on the attack in the first-over position before picking up the cover of Christchurch and was not able to get past that rival in the stretch when coming up just a head short at the finish as the 1/2 favorite. This son of Lazarus N paced his mile in 1:48.4 despite that first turn mishap and was a perfect three-for-three this season before that after dominating his competition in the NJSS. He should take wagering support off that visually impressive performance but we prefer him for a smaller share.

This daughter of Captaintreacherous has hit the board in nine of her last 10 over this surface and has racked up four victories over that span. She picks up the driving services of Dexter Dunn and should make her presence felt at some point in the mile.

#9 INTOTHEMYSTICMOON was the runner-up to Western Wish ast week in this class and briefly got the lead in the lane before getting run down by that rival, who will have to work from the 10-hole this evening. She did not draw much better with post-nine and has hit the board in seven of 14 this season and last tasted victory in this class on April 8th. This 11-time winner has only been shut out from a cheque a pair of times this year and has proven to be versatile in her racing style. She can grab a share.

#10 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER made up ground in deeps stretch last week in NW23500L5 and was just over two lengths away from a game winner in Century Heineken when picking up a smaller share in fifth under the wire. He had gotten away seventh off the gate from post-five and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.2 with a final panel in 26.2. This 25-time winner has spent two of his last four in the Free For All and has been victorious the last three times he has raced at his level. He will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole but that might see him going off a bigger price than he should be. Giving him the edge on top of this mandatory payout Hi-5 event to close out the card.

#12 THE GREEK FREAK exits the same race as the one above and was left with a lot of work to do in that NW23500L5 contest after getting away ninth off the gate from post-nine. He was more than 15 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and was backed up to last before the turn for home when he was fifth-over in the outer flow. This 11-time winner was able to improve a pair of positions before the wire when pacing home in 26.1 on the heels of a back-half in 53.1 and will now drop back down a notch on the class ladder. He was a strong winner when converting as the odds-on choice when moving up the ranks in his prior two efforts but will have to overcome another tricky draw from the second-tier with post-12. J-Mac stays aboard.

#6 CADILLAC BAYAMA raced from off the pace in his latest when he got away ninth off the gate from post-nine and was 16 lengths off the lead at the quarter marker. He managed to get past five rivals in the lane to round out the superfecta at odds of nearly 8-1 but was still more than eight lengths in arrears of a pumped-up winner in Ario Hanover. This 15-time winner has picked up a prize in four of his last five and is just three starts removed from going postward in a Preferred-2, He will work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park this time around and is worth a look if the price is right.

#3 SINTRA was second-best to Ario Hanover at this level last week and secured the early pocket in that contest when he released Beyond Better to the front on the first turn. He angled off that pacesetter's back in the stretch but was no match for the winner, who went on to score by a wide margin. This 46-time winner has been no worse than fourth in five of his last six since returning from a hiatus of a few months and will have Mark MacDonald at the reins for the first time after brother James booked off to pilot our second choice. He gets one of the best draws for the top contenders in this dash and should be in the mix throughout.

#8 LAWLESS SHADOW got back into the win-column two back when he blew his rivals away on the front-end in NW8000L5 and scored by nearly five lengths at the wire. He stepped that mile in 1:49 flat and since stepped back up to NW23500L5 but was unable to stick around for a slice after getting forwardly placed off the gate. This 10-time winner should appreciate finding middle-ground between those two classes this evening but will shift out to the outside of the gate with post-eight. He can pick up a piece but will have to avoid a taxing journey.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

- Pick Pools**
- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
 - If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
 - A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
 - Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
 - Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
