Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

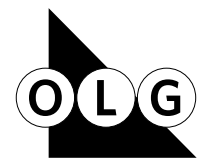
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

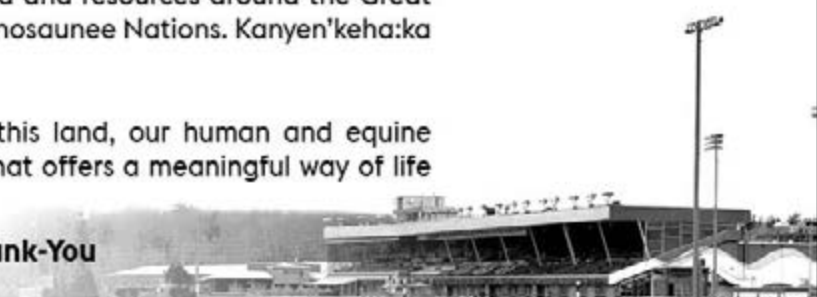

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 FEAR THE CRUSH had the benefit of chasing a hot pace when she swept past her rivals in the stretch on July 17th and shaved more than three seconds off her lifetime mark when stopping the clock in 1:51.1. She was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing her back-half in 55.1 with a final quarter in 27.3. This daughter of Fear The Dragon scored in similar fashion in each of her prior three outings at Grand River Raceway and has hit the board in 14 of her 17 career attempts. She picks up the driving services of Trevor Henry with J-Mac opting for the one below and can extend her streak to five if there is more pace to chase.

#3 MOLLOP HANOVER made a break in stride in a division of the PASS at Pocono Downs and was beaten by a wide margin in seventh at odds of 34-1. She paced to the lead on the backside over this surface in this class before that and paced her own middle-half in 55.3 before fading back to fourth at 2-1 in a race that was won by Front Page Story. This daughter of Betting Line was a winner against tougher rivals on May 26th and paced to her lifetime best at this level two weeks prior. She will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald and looks threatening.

#6 TWIST LITTLE GIRL N exits the same race as our top selection and was the one that chopped out the suicidal fractions on the front-end in that contest when she set the opening three panels in 26.1, 53.4 and 1:22.3. She faded back to sixth in the stretch at odds of 7/2 and got caught up in traffic 10 nights earlier when making her North American debut for trainer Carmen Auciello. This New Zealand bred will start from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and picks up Doug McNair in the sulky for the first time in a pari-mutuel race. She has rebound potential and is worth a look if the price is right.

#4 HORIZONTAL left hard from post-eight last week and came around the one above before releasing that rival back to the front before the halfway point. She closely attended hot fractions before getting past the pacesetter at the wire to earn a minor award in fifth. This daughter of Always B Miki was bet down to favoritism in that contest and was a winner in both of her qualifiers when preparing for her sophomore debut. She will be making her second attempt out of the barn of trainer Luc Blais after being purchased by Determination and will likely be looking for a softer trip this time out.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 LEGENDARY HANOVER was the easiest kind of winner on July 7th after marching to the lead on the backside and scored by more than three lengths when stopping the clock in 1:54.2. He banged home in 27.1 off a back-half in 56.1 and was an impressive winner in his most recent qualifier on June 24th when getting ready for that debut. This son of Huntsville fired off his final panel in 26.2 or faster in each of his two morning preps and was a \$260,000 yearling purchase that is a half-brother to Linedrive Hanover. He has been off for three weeks coming into this but will start from a favorable spot on the gate and is hard to look past.

#2 SUPPLEMENTAL FEE produced a strong effort of his own when he marched away from his rivals in the lane on July 18th and won by three lengths at the wire after making a first-over move on the bend for home. He paced his back-half in 54.4 with a final quarter in 27.2 and has been third or better in his two career attempts so far. This son of Courtly Choice loses James MacDonald to the one above but picks up a suitable replacement in Doug McNair. He will start from the inside of the gate and will be our main player underneath.

This 34-time winner is just seven starts removed from a victory at that level and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation this evening after missing a week between starts last time out. She should be more than competitive against this group and might try to get forwardly placed from post-seven.

#4 GOUDAWON did not have much of a chance in her latest when she got away eighth off the gate from post-nine and was more than 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. She made up significant ground before the wire to finish fourth and paced her back-half in 54.4 with a final quarter in 27.2. This daughter of Betterthancheddar has been no worse than fourth in her last seven overall and has hit the board in six of 12 since moving to the barn of Tom Riley for her four-year-old campaign. She should enjoy sliding down to a favorable spot on the gate and will likely get activated sooner in the mile this time out.

#3 BEYOND THE SEA exits the same race as our second choice and was spotted on that rival's cover before backing up to finish seventh in a field of nine under the wire. This 13-time winner has been trending in the right direction for Team Hensley and can benefit from another inside draw with post-two. He is not without a chance with the right kind of trip and should not be dismissed from any of the exotics.

This son of Betting Line paced home in 27.2 on the heels of a back-half in 55.3 and got to the wire first in his lifetime debut on July 7th but was disqualified after he improved his position by leaving the racecourse. He might get handled more aggressively off the gate this evening when having to leave from post-10 and he should offer a chance to take back some value for those that supported him last time out.

#2 CHIVALRY SEELSTER has taken on OSS Gold rivals in each of his two lifetime tries and was never able to get into contention in his most recent effort after getting away eighth off the gate from post-seven. He was put into play off the gate in the first start of his career and was able to sit the two-hole for much of that mile before fading back to sixth under the wire at odds of 8-1. This son of State Treasurer should appreciate getting down to the maiden ranks and will have Sylvain Filion at the controls for the first time. He should also enjoy getting to work from the inside of the gate and will likely take heavy support at the windows.

#5 FAST LOUIE was a \$25,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Kevin Benn. He is a half-brother to Easy To Please, who is 14 for 56 in her career with over \$400,000 in the bank, and has a couple of other siblings that have each made over \$100,000. This son of Sweet Lou comes into this off a pair of qualifiers and was a runner-up to Wicked Prince at Kawartha Downs on July 8th when his trainer called his own number in the bike. He then went all the way on the engine in a morning prep over this surface on July 21st with Sylvain Filion at the helm but that teamster has booked off in favor of the one above. Bob McClure picks up the steer and he is worth a look if the price is right.

#4 TOTALLY TOXIC was unable to come forward after making a wide move in his lifetime debut on July 18th and faded back to last under the wire at odds of 5/2. He went into that effort off a strong qualifying performance where he won by more than a length in 1:55.4 and dropped nearly three seconds from his morning prep that occurred just six days earlier. This son of Courtly Choice has rebound potential and should offer a bigger number on the odds board tonight. He should not be taken lightly and is worth including on the bottom end of the exotics.

#5 SILVER LABEL went a long way on the lead in the Haughton at the Meadowlands on July 15th and chopped out legit fractions in that stakes event before fading back to third under the wire. She paced her own mile in 1:48.1 and turned in a huge effort in the Perfect Sting two weeks prior when she won from the first-over position with ease after starting from second-tier. This 17-time winner was the runner-up in the Roses Are Red at this venue before that and is five for 10 so far in her aged career with nine on the board finishes. She is just over \$5,000 shy of \$1.1M in lifetime earnings and should surpass that mark in style this evening. Giving her the nod and expecting a price of the shortest variety.

#6 DABARNDAWGSWATCHIN got away in the three-hole in this class last week and made a first-over bid on the bend for home before nearly getting on even terms with So Much More. She was never able to get past Canada's Pacing Queen before the wire and was half a length away from the victory at the wire. This 17-time winner has been the runner-up in each of her last three and has hit the board in 11 of 14 this season. She will now have to face another juggernaut in the form of the one above and will likely have to be the bridesmaid once again.

#4 WESTERN WISH exits the same race as the one above and got situated behind So Much More in the pocket in that contest. She tried to make up ground along the pylons in the stretch but had to settle for third when she completed the trifecta at odds of 16-1. This 20-time winner has hit the board in four of her last five and was last victorious in NW20000L5 on June 9th. She will likely try to once again utilize her early foot to get situated in a favorable spot off the gate and looks like a logical choice to finish underneath the two above.

#1 PARISIAN BLUE CHIP had to settle for a minor award last week when stepping back up to this level and made up throughout the mile after getting away sixth off the gate. She got within a few lengths of winner So Much More at the wire and paced her back-half in 53.3 with a final panel in 26.2. This 30-time winner goes up against another tough group this evening but will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald, who has been aboard for each of her last six victories. She can grab a share.

#2 MAJOR LEAGUE N should have her confidence back after notching back-to-back victories on the B-tracks and most recently captured the top condition class at Grand River Raceway after rocketing to the early lead from post-eight. She secured a reasonable second panel before holding on by a nose at the finish at odds of 6-1 and won by wider margin 6 nights earlier at Georgian Downs in NW3500L3. This 32-time winner should be feeling good about herself when getting back on the big track and should appreciate an inside draw in tonight's tilt. She will likely try to run them off their feet and might be able to take this group gate-to-wire.

#8 POWERED BY MACH was a lights-out winner last week after she marched to the lead on the backside and scored by a length at the wire. She paced her way to a new lifetime mark of 1:49.4 and offered 16-1 to her backers. She had hit the board in each of her prior three and has not been worse than third since relocating to this circuit to join the barn of trainer Carmen Auciello. This 19-time winner has been in good order as of late and will not go down without a fight if she can replicate her latest. She can be right there at the wire and merits respect.

#1 SILENT CROSSING exits the same race as the one above and was second-best to that rival when rounding out the exacta at odds of 6-1. She went to the early lead before releasing that foe to the front and was strong in victory two back when she stopped the clock in 1:51.2 in NW4300L5. This 10-time winner will slide down to the pole position and will likely push out for a favorable spot in the early going. She should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket and cannot be left out of the exotics.

#7 FLIGHT CREW N made a first-over bid in NW14000L5 in her North American debut on July 21st but faded back to sixth before the wire at odds of nearly 8-1. She stepped her own mile in 1:50.3 and should benefit from getting her feet wet in a pari-mutuel start over this surface. This New Zealand bred made a break in stride in her most recent qualifier on July 4th but was just over a few lengths away from Prohibition Legal one week earlier. She should appreciate getting significant class relief and might be able to step up with a better performance.

#4 SAULSBROOK OLYMPIA disappointed as the even-money favorite last week and was only able to advance to fifth after getting away seventh off the gate. She emerged victorious two back when landing in that same spot off the switch and paced her back-half in 53.3 with a final quarter in 26.4. This 20-time winner should present an opportunity to take back some value for those that supported her last time out but loses driver Jody Jamieson to the one above. She picks up a familiar face in Scott Young and should be making noise in the late stages.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

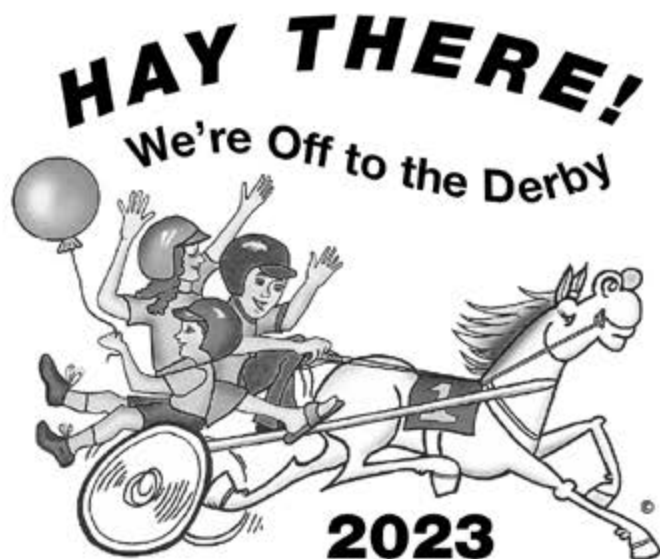
The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
