Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

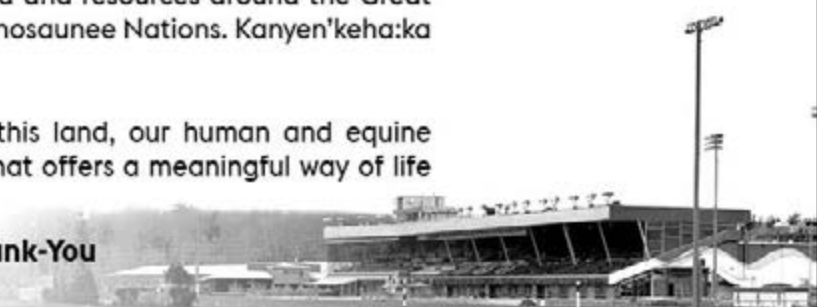

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 REIGNING JADE disappointed as the even-money favorite last week and went a long way on the lead in that second round of this series before she faded back to third under the wire. She chopped out reasonable splits before pacing her mile in 1:52.4 but was two lengths in arrears to Odds On Platinum at the finish. This daughter of Captaintreacherous could not have looked any better in her lifetime debut nine days earlier and went coast-to-coast in that contest before stopping the clock in 1:52.2. She does not have to face either of the rivals that got the better of her last time out and can rebound in a big way when the chips are down against a compact field in the final this evening. Giving her the nod to kick off the card but expecting the shortest of prices.

#3 ELODIE HANOVER took support to the tune of 5/2 in the first leg of this event on July 25th and elected to stay on the cones in the three-hole on the spin for home in a race where the one above was a dominant winner on the engine. She initially looked for room on the inside of rivals in the lane but then angled off the back of the pocket-sitter before coming forward with some pace in the dying strides. This daughter of Betting Line had to settle for third under the wire but banged home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 55.1. She has hit the board in all three of her lifetime tries so far and is one of three in the contest that have already tasted victory. Tyler Borth will be calling the shots for the first time and she looms as the main danger.

#4 STONEBRIDGE HALO got away eighth off the gate in her lifetime debut last week and was more than 16 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before improving one position before the wire. She paced her back-half in 53.4 with a final quarter in 26.1 but was still six lengths behind our top selection when crossing the wire in seventh. This daughter of Captain Crunch was an easy winner in her final qualifier on July 21st and got the nod from driver Louis-Philippe Roy over the one above. She might take a significant step forward in this follow-up outing and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#1 STAYING WITH EMILY has picked up a minor award in each of the first two rounds of this series and most recently finished fourth at odds of 44-1. She managed to advance a couple of spots in that contest after getting away sixth off the switch and was nearly six lengths back our top selection two starts ago when getting sent off at a much smaller number on the board. This daughter of Stay Hungry found the winner's circle in the second start of her career when she bested a NW5000 event by stepping her mile in 1:53.2 and might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position. She will have Tyler Jones at the helm for the second straight start and can continue her trend of rounding out the superfecta.

#3 WHAT AN ANGEL was never a factor in the Stanley Dancer at the Meadowlands on July 15th and was beaten by a wide margin at 92-1 in that stakes contest that was won by Oh Well. His best result over the last few months was a third-place finish in his elimination for the Goodtimes on June 9th and he was able to negotiate a lesser share in the final of that prestigious event after getting forwardly placed at 75-1. This son of Archangel has been sent off at long odds in each of his last six when going up against tough competition and should appreciate making the transition to the OSS Grassroots for the first time in his career. He was last victorious in NW2 on April 27th when he stopped the clock in 1:54.4 and something similar to that effort might see him return to the winner's circle.

#6 NEW RULES was second-best to The Great Reset in the final of the Dream Of Glory at Hanover Raceway on August 5th. He sat a perfect two-hole trip behind that rival before getting within a length of victory at the finish and could not have been a more dominant winner in his elimination when he scored by more than five lengths and has hit the board in eight of his last nine overall. This son of Looklikeeachpndale will have the luxury of leaving from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and will likely flash his early foot off the switch. He is more than capable of taking this group gate-to-wire and figures to be right there at the wire.

#5 DOWE DEALIN AND WHY is winless in seven with only one on the board finish at the age of three after having four top two finishes last season in as many starts and more than \$138,000 in earnings while primarily competing at the OSS Gold level. He has had issued starting on his gait as a sophomore and most recently made a break in stride in a lifetime non-winners condition on August 1st when he was sent off at odds of 12-1. This son of Wheeling N Dealin might benefit from getting in against softer competition at the Grassroots level and turned in a decent effort to be second to Forbidden Trade in a qualifier on August 12th. He might offer some value on the board and is not without a chance.

#7 KINNDER THINKTWICE converted as the 6/5 favorite in his latest in NW2 and scored by half a length in that contest after losing his cover on the final turn to become the first-over challenger. He methodically worked his way to the lead and then held off a late challenge from The Great Emotion and has been no worse than second in each of his last three. This other son of Wheeling N Dealin claimed the show spot to our second choice the last time he went postward at this level and was charted with broken equipment in that contest. He should be feeling good about himself coming into this and can pick up a decent chunk with a favorable journey.

#1 LEGENDARY HANOVER is a perfect two-for-two to kick off this career and took down the first leg of this series with ease when he paced away from his rivals in the stretch before stopping the clock in 1:52.1. He was under tight lines to the wire in each of those efforts and offered a small return to his backers in both of those victories. This son of Huntsville is a half-brother to Linedrive Hanover and will pick up the driving services of Bob McClure when looking to make a clean sweep of the series this evening. He has done everything right so far and gets the edge over the one below.

#5 REMEMBER THE ALAMO unleashed an incredible late kick to win from an improbable spot in the second round of this event last week when making the first start of his career. He got away fifth off the gate and was more than 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.3 with final quarter speed of 25.2. This son of Captaintreacherous got up by a nose in the nick of time at odds of 12-1 and was the runner-up in both of his most recent qualifiers when preparing for that effort. He was a \$300,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg and looms as the danger in a race that will likely come down to a two-horse affair. Phil Hudon picks up the steer.

#4 CUPID SHUFFLE had picked up a smaller share in both of the preliminary legs of this series and was only three quarters of a length away from the one above last week when having to settle for fourth at odds of 10-1. He was the early leader in the contest before getting relegated to the pocket on the backside and had every chance to run down the pacesetter in the stretch but never could get past that rival. This son of Sweet Lou has been put into play at the start of each of his last two but did uncork a nice late rally to be third in his lifetime debut after getting away sixth. He looks like a logical choice to complete the trifecta.

#3 MINETT exits the same race as the two above and finished fifth in that contest after getting away in the early two-hole from post-six. He had hit the board in each of his prior three efforts and was hammered down to 55 cents to the dollar in his lifetime debut but was no match for Do Better, who has remained undefeated through the first five starts of his career. This son of Always B Miki picks up the driving services of Trevor Henry and can be in the mix throughout. He can grab a share.

#8 BEYOND BETTER is one that we are willing to come right back to after he got up for the victory by a neck in NW9200L5 last week after getting away sixth off the switch. He was nearly 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.3 with a final panel in 26.3 and cruised past his rivals in the late stages under minimal urging. This 19-time winner will now take a step up the class ladder to NW14000L5 and has proven he can be more than competitive at this level in the past. He will have Louis-Philippe Roy back aboard for an encore performance and has repeat potential.

#6 SAULSBROOK VICTOR pushed out from the pole position in his latest and went a long way on the lead before getting picked up by Uncle Shank A in the dying strides. He fought gamely to the wire when he blasted home in 26.3 off a back-half in 54.3 and was clearly the best of the rest when finishing more than two lengths clear of Fabrizio N in third. This 16-time winner is just two starts removed from competing in the Free For All and has notched three victories at that level over the course of the season. He makes a slight step back up in competition but can be right there at the wire if he can build off his most recent outing.

#9 CODENAME CIGAR BOX has picked up a minor award in each of his last two and will get some class relief this evening after being just over three lengths back of Carbine in his latest, who has already come back to be a strong winner in the Free For All. He has picked up a cheque in 18 of his last 19 overall and was victorious at this level on June 3rd when he moved to the lead on the backside after getting away third off the gate. This 26-time winner has been hampered with post-nine for tonight's tilt but has more than enough tactical speed to get away in a favorable spot off the gate. He is among the chances and can hit the ticket.

#7 NO FREE LUNCH was only able to muster a sixth-place finish last week in NW25100 when he was sent off as the 5/2 favorite and was just over three lengths away from winner Powertrain at the finish when pacing his own mile in 1:49.2. He was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before stepping his back-half in 53 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.2 and will step down another notch on the class ladder for the third consecutive start. This 12-time winner picks up Anthony MacDonalD in the sulky and will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile. He can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

#2 BETTORHOLDONTIGHT came from a long way off the pace to claim the show spot to heavy-favorite Leave It To Leo last week and was still more than four lengths in arrears to that rival under the wire when rounding out the trifecta at odds of 5-1. He got away eighth off the gate and was nearly 16 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half 54.3 with a final quarter in 27 seconds flat and went a similar journey the week prior before finishing sixth while losing a shoe. This son of Bettors Delight appeared to be on his way to victory three starts ago at his level when he made an untimely break in a stride and has hit the board in four of seven since moving to the barn of trainer Cliff Maguire. He should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation and is our clear choice on top.

#5 BETTOR THAN PRIDE was a strong winner in NW1 on August 1st when he scored by more than three lengths and offered 5-1 to his backers. He shaved more than three seconds off his lifetime mark when he paced his mile in 1:51.3 and was handled aggressively throughout that contest in what was his first attempt over the big track since December of last year. This son of Betterthancheddar will take a step upward in class this evening but can be more than competitive against this group if he can replicate his most recent effort. He will have Tyler Jones back aboard for an encore performance and can be right there at the finish.

#9 CONTROL THE GOLD came from a long way out of it last week to finish fourth to Leave It To Leo and completed the superfecta at odds of nearly 51-1. He had gotten away ninth off the switch from post-seven and was 18 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 54.2 with a final quarter in 26.4. This son of Control The Moment will be making his fourth start back after a layoff of more than eight months and will have Sylvain Filion calling the shots for the first time. He will have to overcome a tricky draw from the nine-hole but can land somewhere on the ticket if his trip is not too taxing.

#1 BETTOR ON ICE finished fourth at Grand River Raceway in a division of the Prospect Series in his latest and has had to settle for lesser shares in each of his last three when competing in the Ontario program. He reeled off three straight victories before that and went all the way on the lead in NW5000L here at Mohawk Park on June 20th. This son of All Bets Off has been second or better in four of his seven appearances since making the first start of his career back in May and does not look out of place against this group. He will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy and might be able to work out a cozy trip when working with rail control.

This son of Resolve has won each of his last two over this surface and trotted to his lifetime best clocking of 1:53.2 in an OSS Grassroots tilt at this venue on June 23rd. He has hit the board in 12 of his 16 career attempts and will have Tyler Borth in the driver's seat for the first time.

#3 DWS POINT MAN came up with a much better effort in his latest when he was second to Derf Hanover in an overnight affair but was then scratched out of his next scheduled start due to sickness and has missed more than three weeks of action coming into this. He had not hit the board in his four prior outings as a sophomore but enjoyed tremendous success at the age of two when he went five for 10 with over \$245,000 in earnings. This son of My Mvp appeared to have been trending back in the right direction but likely gives up a significant fitness advantage to the one above this evening. He looms as a danger and it is likely worth keeping an eye on his pre-race appearance.

#2 BUSTING WITH PRIDE is winless in 10 this season but has four runner-up finishes and has hit the board in 10 of his 19 lifetime tries. He did not have much of a chance in any of his last three when he was left with a lot of work to do after getting away eighth or worse off the gate from outside draws. He will have Trevor Henry back in the bike for a second straight start and that teamster has guided him to all three of his career victories.

She was plucked for that price by trainer Joe Pereira one week earlier and was second-best to Ahoy on that occasion when she completed the exacta at odds of 3-1. This 10-time winner has hit the board in seven of her last nine and has racked up three victories over that span. She should enjoy getting back down to more palatable rivals and will have Sylvain Filion at the helm for the second time in her career.

#7 CHELSIS CHOICE has walked away empty-handed in each of her last four but turned in a strong effort to be second to Sweet Amira in a lifetime non-winners condition on June 16th, where she paced her own mile in 1:50.4. She has been camera-shy over the last couple of seasons with just one victory from 37 attempts but has managed to hit the board 14 times over that span. This daughter of Big Jim will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy and has a pair of third-place finishes in the five times they have been matched together. She is worth using on the bottom end of the exotics.

#3 EMMETTS BUDDY is one that we are willing to come back to after he got back to the winner's circle in NW9200L5 last week and was just one tick away from his career best clocking that was set about a month ago. He steps back up the class ladder to NW14000L5 but has been an impressive winner in two of his last four and has hit the board in 10 of 18 so far this season. This 12-time winner will have Tyler Borth calling the shots for the fourth consecutive start and will likely be put into play off the gate again tonight when working from a favorable draw with post-three. He has been in top form as of late and we are not willing to jump off his bandwagon. Giving him the nod in the nightcap.

#4 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER got away fourth off the switch in NW25100L5 in his latest and stayed on the cones before fading back to seventh in the lane. He has walked away empty-handed in each of his last two when going up against tougher rivals and will now find middle ground in NW14000L5 after scoring in NW9400L5 three starts ago. He got off the schneid the week before when he scored by a head with one final lunge before the wire in a lifetime non-winners condition and has now hit the board in each of his last five overall. This son of Sportswriter will work from another inside draw but faces a tougher group this time out when taking a step upwards in class. He can grab a share.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
