For Marge Szigeti, home truly is where the horses are.

There was never any doubt, really, as to where the native of Ridgeway, Ontario, would eventually end up at some point in her life.

Raised on a farm in the southwestern part of the province, Szigeti figured it was only a question of when she would make her way to a racetrack backstretch. The answer came nearly 50 years ago.

"I've always loved horses," started Szigeti, who was gifted two ponies by her parents when she was six. "Ridgeway, which is considered Fort Erie now, had a big tie to the horses, so working at the racetrack was my summer job throughout high school. I started out with [trainer] Buddy Carter. I worked at the track for two years and went back to school. I missed it when I wasn't there because I loved the atmosphere and being around the horses."

She kept those same feelings after she started working for the Coca-Cola company.

After working Monday to Friday at her full-time job, Szigeti was back on familiar ground, namely, the backstretch, where she would groom the horses on weekends.

It's something she did faithfully over the 37 years she was employed at Coca-Cola. When Szigeti retired, she gave herself the only gift she wanted: more time with the horses. "My vacation times were always spent at the track," she recalled with a laugh. "In 2017, I left the company and I decided to give myself a retirement job. And I love it."

Szigeti, who worked in the Woodbine barn of veteran conditioner John Charalambous, started working for trainer Ted Holder last year. Early mornings, late nights, hot or cold, rain or shine, the Woodbine backstretch is everywhere Szigeti wants to be. After all, it's where the horses are.

"Just taking caring of them is a big joy for me. You develop such a wonderful connection with all of them." What makes this current group special?

"They're wonderful. There are two I'd like to take home with me as riding horses and then there's one, Hobbie Class, who I just want to take home as a mascot. She came in so tiny. I didn't tie her up when I was doing the stalls. She would just follow me around the stall when I was cleaning it. I call her "My Little Puppy Dog" or "Precious." She's just such a sweetheart. She's always happy."

Just like her doting groom.

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

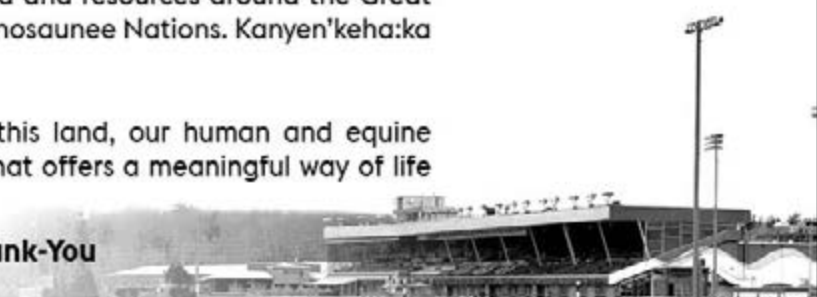

#6 BUSY MAKING MONI never saw the pylons after getting away sixth from post-eight and kept grinding away on the outside before winning a battle for the show spot under the wire. He fought gamely in the late stages and edged out Warrawee Yes for the bottom spot on the trifecta at odds of 66-1. This son of International Moni lost a shoe during that contest and has now hit the board in three straight. He has produced a decent campaign with nearly \$68,000 made from 27 starts in his first season of racing and he will be reunited with driver Bob McClure for tonight's tilt. Giving him the edge in the opener.

#3 MADE OF MAGIC exits the same race as the one above and got away fourth off the switch before getting jammed up along the inside in the stretch drive. He faded back to eighth at odds of 14-1 but had won four in a row in the classes below this. This son of Lookslikeeachpndale won all three of his tries in NW2 before stepping up to this level and will be reunited with James MacDonald, who guided him to a dominant score in the slop on August 24th. He will likely have his gas pedal pressed off the switch and can be in the mix throughout.

#4 TAILGATE BUZZ blasted off the wings of the gate from post-seven in NW8000L5 last week and had a clear lead when he tripped the opening marker in 26.4 but then was taken to the safety lane when he made a miscue. He ended up being distanced from his rivals at odds of 30-1 and finished seventh two starts ago in this class after getting away eighth off the switch from post-seven. This son of Bar Hopping will be making his third attempt out of the barn of conditioner Carmen Auciello after relocating to this circuit from The Meadows and will have Louis-Philippe Roy calling the shots for the second time. He will race for the optional price tag of \$50,000 and is worth a look if the price is right.

#5 PROUD TO BE LINDY will take a step up the class ladder after crushing her competition in NW2 on September 15th when she scored by more than seventh lengths in a new lifetime mark of 1:55 flat. She converted as the odds-on favorite on that occasion and has hit the board in each of her last five at that level, with a pair of victories over that span. This daughter of Muscle Hill was sixth in her only previous try in this lifetime non-winners condition but has more than double the career earnings of anyone else in the contest with over \$186,000 in the bank.

#5 DEALIN WITH DEWEY has spent each of his last two in NW14000L5 and got away fourth in his latest before finishing seventh behind a wall of horses in seventh at odds of 31-1. He produced a solid effort to complete the superfecta at 33-1 in a Preferred-2 at this venue on September 4th and was a strong winner in a class with the same name at Grand River Raceway before that. This son of Wheeling N Dealin should appreciate getting to drop down another notch on the class ladder and he got the nod from driver Louis-Philippe Roy over the one below.

#6 ALL WRAPPED UP exits the same race as the one above and was just half a length back of that rival when finishing eighth under the wire at 16-1. He drops back down to the level where he was victorious two starts ago as the even-money favorite and has been second or better in four of his last six attempts in this class. This 24-time winner was passed over by Louis-Philippe Roy for the one above but will have Tyler Borth at reins for the fifth time in seven outings. He looms as a danger and will be one of our main players underneath.

#7 GIGONDAS got away fourth off the gate at 95 cents to the dollar last week and elected to stay on the pylons before getting into all kinds of traffic trouble in the stretch. He had to angle his way to the far outside to get around a wide line of horses and trotted forward in fourth when he finally had clearance after it was much too late. This son of Trixton has picked up a cheque in each of his last four and will be getting a third straight chance at this class. He will likely be looking to get forwardly placed from post-seven and will likely make his presence felt throughout.

#8 ROWLEN exits the same race as the one above and was only three quarters of a length away from winner Mikey Mass at the finish. She had the luxury of getting a pocket ride behind Derf Hanover for much of the mile and forged her way to the front in the stretch before getting clipped by the late legs of Mikey Mass. This daughter of Johnny William has just four victories from 52 appearances over the last couple of seasons but has hit the board 20 times over that span. She will be reunited with top driver James MacDonald and she has hit the board in each of the three previous times that they have been paired together.

#9 RIGHTEOUS RESOLVE only missed by a head to Bond in the Eleganimage final last week and fought gamely in the stretch drive after getting a two-hole trip for much of the mile. She got back into the win-column for the first time in seven outings before that when she went all the way on the lead in her elimination for that signature stakes event but has managed to hit the board in all nine of her efforts as a sophomore. This 10-time winner will have to overcome a tricky spot on the gate from post-nine when getting back to the OSS Gold ranks but figures to be looking for the early lead because she has made front by the quarter pole in each of her last four. She figures to take significant support and has our top honors.

#1 CLIMB THE POLE was charted with an equipment break in stride after she made a miscue when her trotting hobbles broke after the start in her elimination for the Eleganimage. Her win-streak was snapped at four when she was beaten by a wide margin in last and had trotted her way to a new lifetime mark of 1:52 flat just two weeks earlier. This daughter of Kadabra has hit the board in five of six since joining Team Jamieson in July and has won seven of 11 as a sophomore on her way to banking more than \$286,000. She can rebound in a big way when getting back into the Ontario program and looms as a major danger.

#2 BARONESS HILL finished fourth in the final of the Eleganimage last week and was just over two lengths away from winner Bond when she completed the superfecta at odds of 82-1. She had hit the board in eight straight before that but has not tasted victory since striking OSS Gold for the first time back on June 13th. This other daughter of Kadaba has been knocking on the door since then and will get to leave from another inside starting spot with post-two. She might be able to work out another favorable journey and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#8 BELIEVE U ME has been competing in the Kentucky Commonwealth Series in each of her last five and scored in back-to-back outings by a combined margin of four lengths before having to settle for third in the final on September 18th as the odds-on favorite. She was no worse than fourth in her three attempts at this level as a sophomore and was within four lengths of winner Mass Hysteria at Rideau Carleton on July 16th. This daughter of Muscle Mass scored in one of her two outings in the OSS Gold ranks as a rookie and will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy. She is just shy of \$95,000 in earnings this season and should not be left off the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

#3 MACHIN A TRICK got away ninth off the switch from post-eight last week and was more than 19 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before making a late rally for fourth at odds of 8-1. He blasted home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 54.1 and only missed by a nose to Military Secret the week prior, who has been the winner in each of his three outings. This 27-time winner will not have to worry about that rival this evening when sliding down to post-three after being discounted by \$2,000 and will also be reunited with driver Bob McClure, who has piloted him to six victories in the past. He will be doing his best work when it matters most and is our clear choice on top.

#5 MACH ART IN MOTION was second-best to Military Secret last week, albeit he was more than three lengths in arrears at the wire when he rounded out the exacta at odds of nearly 6-1. He has not been worse than fourth in each of his last four in this class and has paced home in 27.3 or faster in each of those efforts. This 14-time winner has hit the board in 11 of his 23 outings this season and will appreciate starting on the center of the gate when offered back for the price tag of \$13,000 for the fifth straight start. He will be our main player underneath.

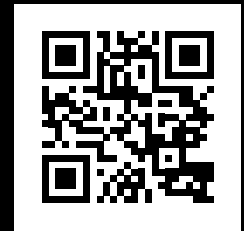
#9 MACH IMPACT has claimed the show spot in each of his last two and was only beaten by a length to Military Secret before that when he was the runner-up at odds of 26-1. He reeled-off three straight victories at Georgian Downs in August and has only missed one cheque in his last 18 overall. This 34-time winner must shift to the outside of the gate this evening after his price tag has been increased by \$2,000 but has enough tactical speed to get himself into a decent spot off the gate. He has 18 top three finishes in 27 tries this season and can continue that trend of hitting the ticket.

#7 DEVILS PEAK earned a minor award in his latest when he finished fifth at 33-1 and was within six lengths of winner Military Secret. He had changed hands after each of his previous three and has won five of his last eight when going postward on the B-tracks. This 29-time winner will get paired back with driver Jody Jamieson for the second straight start and has picked up a prize in each of his two tries out of the barn of trainer Joe Pereira. He is worth utilizing on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

#2 PATRIARCH HANOVER has disappointed as the favorite in each of his last three since dropping down to this level and was most recently two lengths in arrears to winner Truffles Too, who has notched back-to-back victories. He had to settle for fourth when he made a first-over bid against that rival two starts ago at 80 cents to the dollar and could not stay with Hp Mama B before that after having the early lead. This 20-time winner will not have to worry about either of those rivals this evening and might try to push out for early position from post-two. He has hit the board in 19 of his 28 starts at the age of six and will once again have Doug McNair giving the commands. Top call.

#1 SPARTAN GENERAL exits the same race as the one above and sat eighth for much of that journey before making a spirited stretch rally to be third at odds of 4-1. He was only half a length away from the place spot after trotting home in 27 seconds flat off a back-half in 54.2 and has hit the board in three of his last four in this class. This 17-time winner got up for the victory at this level on August 21st when he returned odds of 2-1 to his backers and will likely be making noise in deep stretch again tonight. He will start from the pole position and can be right there at the wire.

#4 MIKEY MASS got up for the victory by three quarters of a length at odds of 3-1 when he dropped down to the level below this last week and was more than 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole after getting away sixth off the switch. He stepped his back-half in 55.3 with a final quarter in 27.2 and will now step back up to this class in what will be his third start back after a layoff of more than a year. This 10-time winner enjoyed back-to-back victories under similar circumstances in May of last year and should offer some value on the board when going up against the likes of the two above. He should not be underestimated and is worth a look if the price is right.

#6 WHITE TIGER sparked an upset at 12-1 when he emerged victorious in this class on September 19th and fired home in 27.2 off a back-half in 56.3 after getting away sixth off the gate. He has won two of his last three but has missed a week between starts. This 22-time winner will have the luxury of starting from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and has scored in each of his last two when leading driver James MacDonald is aboard. He can make his presence felt with the right type of trip scenario and should not be dismissed from the exotics.

He dove back to the inside in deep stretch and trotted his own mile in 1:52 flat with a 27.3 kicker. This son of My Mvp only has one victory in his 10 starts at the age of three but has hit the board eight times on his way to adding more than \$278,000 to his bankroll. He has been no worse than second in his three attempts in the OSS Gold ranks this season and should benefit from getting back in with restricted company this evening.

#9 OSCEOLA exits the same race as the one above and faded back to seventh at 66-1 after sitting an inside trip. He was six lengths in arrears to the winner and went a long way on the lead in his elimination before having to settle for fourth to that same rival at 12-1. This son of Muscle Mass got his picture taken at this level on August 25th when he scored by more than two lengths in 1:53.3 at 30 cents to the dollar and has hit the board in six of 11 in his sophomore campaign. He will be making his third consecutive appearance on the lasix program and might try to ambush the field off the gate from post-nine.

#3 GHOSTLY CASPER was second-best to Southwind Coors in a lifetime non-winners condition last week and was able to maintain his position in the pocket after releasing that foe to the front on the backside. He rounded out the exacta as the definitive second choice at odds of 2-1 and wore trotting hoppers for that effort after making a break in stride nine nights earlier in his elimination for the Canadian Trotting Classic. This son of Resolve will go back to racing without that piece of equipment again this evening and will have Tyler Borth at the reins for the second straight start. #5 ALL GAS NO BRAKES was a strong winner at The Meadows on September 16th when he scored by two lengths and tripped the wire in 1:54.2. He was making his first attempt for The Stable after being acquired by that entity in early September and has since relocated north of the border to now race out of the barn of trainer Dominic Gladu. This 14-time winner has hit the board in five of his 14 tries as a four-year-old and will likely be looking to get forwardly placed from the center of the gate. He will have top teamster James MacDonald in the driver's seat for the first time and is an obvious top contender.

#6 VICTOR INVICTUS exits the same race as our top selection and was also a long way out of it in the early going before showing vigor in the stretch to pick up a minor award in fifth. He was just over three lengths back of winner Mikey Mass after coming home in 27.3 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2 and has picked up a piece in each of his last four. This son of Kadabra has been camera-shy over the last couple of seasons with just two victories from 73 attempts but has managed to hit the board 24 times over that span. #3 HIGHLANDBEACHSBEST had missed over a month of action when he went postward in NW9500L5 on September 23rd and was overland for much of his journey before he faded back to last in a field of 10 that was topped by Wind Blown. He was second to Powertrain in his qualifier eight days earlier when preparing for that return and paced his own mile in 1:53.3 with a 26.4 kicker. This son of Somebeachsomewhere should benefit from getting that latest start under his belt and will appreciate getting down to a much more palatable spot on the class ladder. He will have Louis-Philippe Roy in the sulky for the third time in his career and is worth a whirl on top.

#9 THATLL BE SPORTY produced a solid effort to get within three lengths of winner Arties Ideal last week and blasted home in 27.2 off a back-half in 55 seconds flat. He walked away empty-handed in his two prior appearances but only missed by the same margin on August 5th when also claiming the place spot behind Dr Joe when racing off the bench. This 12-time winner had Sylvain Fillion aboard for both of those runner-up finishes and ended up in that position or better in four of the five times that he has been at the helm. He will have to overcome a tricky draw from post-nine in tonight's tilt but is more than capable of getting his first victory of the season against this group.

#8 HES SWIFT has finished fourth in each of his last two and chopped out hot fractions on the engine in his latest before getting tired in the lane. He paced his own mile in 1:52 flat in both of those outings and it was a couple of steps in the right direction after finishing eighth or worse in his prior four appearances. This 10-time winner has only gotten his picture taken twice in 57 attempts over the last couple of seasons but has managed to hit the board 17 times over that span. He will have leading driver James MacDonald calling the shots for the fourth time in his career and is not without a chance.

#4 GRAND POOBAH picked up a lesser share in fifth last week and has earned a cheque in five of his last seven overall. He was a winner on August 14th when he converted off a two-hole trip at 19-1 and stopped the clock in 1:51.3 on that occasion. This 11-time winner is another that hits the board with frequency and has 63 top three finishes in his 186 lifetime tries. He will start from a favorable spot on the gate with post-four and can pick up a slice.

#7 LOGAN PARK was a lights-out winner in the Free For All on Mohawk Million night and gave race-favorite Fashion Frenzie the cold shoulder on the backside before trotting away from his rivals to score by nearly three lengths in a sizzling 1:50.4, which was just a tick away from his lifetime best. He was unable to make any impact in an added-distance stakes event at Yonkers after getting away ninth off the gate from post-eight two weeks earlier and was placed up to fifth from sixth via disqualification in the Maple Leaf Trot before that. This 20-time winner has racked-up seven victories and 10 top two finishes in 11 attempts at this level as a five-year-old and appears to be back at the top of his game for trainer Kyle Fellows. He will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest but is not one that we are willing to side against.

#1 AMIGO VOLO exits the same race as the one above and moved to the outside in the second-over position before flipping three-wide but could not get near that winner when having to settle for third as the 9/5 second choice in the betting. He had missed a week of action between starts going into that effort after being a vet scratch on September 15th and has hit the board in each of his last six. This 29-time winner will now make his debut out of the barn of trainer Meg Crone and will have Louis-Philippe Roy in the driver's seat for the first time. He has banked nearly \$2.3M in his career and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation.

#4 ONEY HALL was sent to the early lead last week before releasing our top choice to the engine and then managed to maintain his position over the one above when locking down the place spot by a comfortable margin at odds of 6-1. He has been second or better in six of his last seven and was victorious in a Preferred-2 on September 4th when he stepped his mile in 1:52.1. This 33-time winner has been in top form for conditioner Chantal Mitchell and will be reunited with driver Paul MacDonell, who guided him to victory in NW8000L5 at the end of July. He figures to get put into play from post-four and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#2 ADARE CASTLE got within a length of Mms Dream in the Miss Versatility at the Delaware Country Fair on September 21st and has not missed out on a cheque in any of her 16 starts at the age of four. She rounded out the trifecta behind Fashion Frenzie and Perfetto at 6-1 in this class on August 7th and has added more than \$187,000 to her lifetime earnings this season. This 20-time winner has proven she can be competitive against the best trotters on the grounds and retains the driving services of James MacDonald. She can grab a share.

#9 ST LADS BEAT IT got up by a head at odds of 2-1 in NW1620L3 at Grand River Raceway in his latest and was first-over a long way in the contest after having to take a tuck in the four-hole from post-seven. He has made three trips to victory lane in nine attempts since returning north of the border to race under the care of trainer Lori LePage in the summer and has hit the board in five of those efforts. This 20-time winner will return to the claiming ranks when getting back on this surface for the first time since November of 2021 and will have Jody Jamieson in the bike for the fourth time in his career. His connections knew that he would have to work from an outside draw when being entered for the maximum price tag of \$35,000 and is worth taking a shot at what figures to be a decent price.

#8 CHANGE STRIDE N chopped out legit fractions in the opening three panels two weeks ago in this class but could not hold off Jm Jack Of Hearts at the finish. He only missed by a head at the wire at odds of 2-1 and scored by half a length when utilizing off the pace tactics the week before after getting away eighth off the switch from post-nine. This 46-time winner has been second or better in three of his last four but has missed a week between starts coming into this. He has had his price tag increased by \$1,000 for tonight's tilt and will likely be looking to get forwardly placed again from post-eight.

#5 FROWNIES MIRACLE was the pacesetter on September 12th in this class when the one above scored from a long way off the pace and faded back to fourth after tripping the first three markers in 25.4, 54.3 and 1:23.2. He had hit the board in four straight prior to that and enjoyed back-to-back open length victories at Georgian Downs in August. This 12-time winner was plucked for \$25,000 out of his most recent effort by trainer Shayne Barrington and will race for a price that has been hiked by \$1,000 this evening. He will have Tyler Borth at the helm for the third time and hit the board in each of the previous two times they have been paired together.

#3 MILITARY SECRET has won four of his last five in the claiming handicap class below and most recently paced away from his rivals in the stretch to score by more than three lengths. He tripped the wire in 1:50.4 and has now changed hands after each of his last two. This 23-time winner was snagged by trainer Michelle Sherman for \$14,000 and will now race for an increased price \$25,000 when taking on tougher rivals in tonight's tilt. He will have James MacDonald in the driver's seat and has been guided to victory by that top teamster on two occasions in the past.

#7 WILCAT ROCKY had some of the best late legs in NW3501L3 at Flamboro Downs on September 19th but had to settle for fourth after getting away last off the gate in that six-horse affair. He was nearly eight lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 56.2 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat and has picked up a cheque in each of his last five overall. This 12-time winner missed by only a nose to Buggy Maguire three starts ago and last tasted victory when he went all the way on the lead in NW1695L3 at Georgian Downs on August 1st. He will have Travis Cullen at the helm for the second time in his career and was an easy winner the last time they were matched together. Giving him our top honors in the nightcap and hoping for value.

#9 SUN CHIP has hit the board in each of his last two at Kawartha Downs but disappointed at 45 cents to the dollar in his latest after getting parked out in the first-over position for the duration of the mile. He had to settle for third in a race that was won by Mighty Mach but only missed by half a length to Disneyman the week prior. This 11-time winner will now make his third start back after missing nearly four months of action and will get reunited with driver Bob McClure when getting back on the big track. He will likely get put into play off the gate from post-nine and can be right there at the finish.

#5 PUNCHESINBUNCHES was never able to make an impact as the 6/5 favorite in NW2 at Grand River Raceway on September 15th and was also unable to deliver at 50 cents to the dollar the week before after being in the pocket for most of the mile. This 12-time winner has hit the board in three of his last five since going on the shelf for nearly three months and has only missed out on getting a cheque once in his 22 lifetime tries. He will be making his first attempt on the larger track configuration at Mohawk Park and is among the top contenders if he can summon his best.

#2 JOE DIMAGIO got the better of our second choice on September 23rd at Kawartha Downs when he was second-best to Mighty Mach at odds of 5/2. He had not gone postward in nearly five months prior to that effort and finished third to Ahi Sunshine eight days earlier to prepare for that return to the races. This son of Custard The Dragon was taking on tougher rivals in his last few tries over this surface back in April and will be making his second attempt under the care of conditioner Kyle Fellows. He got the nod from Sylvain Filion over two others in the contest and should not be dismissed.

#8 ALLY FLIGHT was fourth in his latest when racing for a price tag of \$27,000 in the top claiming handicap class on the circuit and was second in three consecutive outings at Kawartha Downs before making the transition to Mohawk Park. He was claimed for just \$8,000 by Kevin Enman on July 8th and has picked up a cheque in four of his seven tries for that conditioner. This 10-time winner picks up the driving services of Louis-Philippe Roy for the second time in his career and can pick up a slice with a decent trip. He is worth using on the bottom end of the exotics.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
