Sintra



The classy veteran pacer Sintra is hanging up his harness after a racing career that saw him score 48 wins, \$1.6 million in earnings and a mark of 1:47.2.

Woodbine Mohawk Park has been the home track for Sintra since he made his qualifying debut in June of 2015.

After just a few starts at age two, Sintra broke his maiden on May 12, 2016, to launch an impressive six-race win streak for co-owner and trainer Dave Menary. Sintra went on to win multiple Ontario Sires Stakes Gold events and the Summertime Pacing Series during that three-year-old campaign.

Sintra moved up to face Grand Circuit company regularly at age four, capturing the Graduate Series Final in July of 2017 at The Meadowlands.

Later that season, Sintra delivered his most memorable performance on the evening of September 2, 2017 at Mohawk Park. Partnering with his regular driver Jody Jamieson, Sintra came charging up the inside to overtake all rivals and win the \$615,000 Canadian Pacing Derby.

Sintra added to his trophy collection in June of 2018 with a victory in the Mohawk Gold Cup. He would continue that season to battle the sports best.

The start of 2019 saw Sintra win six of eight starts before an injury ended his season. Any doubts that the son of Mach Three could return to top form were put to bed in January of 2020, as he returned to win five races in a row.

Through the uncertain times of 2020, Sintra bounced around to various tracks in North America. Still battling, he posted a respectable fourth-place finish in that year's Canadian Pacing Derby. Through 2021 and the first half of 2022, Sintra raced regularly at Mohawk Park for trainer Menary.

In July of 2022, Sintra was purchased by TheStable.ca and quickly created a magical moment for his new connections, winning the prestigious Gold Cup and Saucer the next month in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island.

Following a victory on September 25, 2023, at Grand River Raceway, TheStable.ca decided it was time for Sintra to call it a career.

With the retirement decision made, Anthony MacDonald of TheStable.ca immediately reached out to the pacer's long-time trainer Dave Menary to reunite Sintra with the Menary family.

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

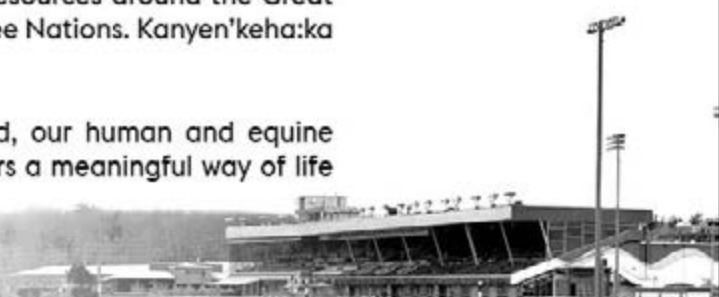

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 NOTHINGBUTADREAMER has won four in a row and most recently gamely held on by a nose over Ricardo in the opening round of this series after being sent off at 55 cents to the dollar. He stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.4 and was a decisive winner in the final of a Pop-Up Series more than two weeks before that. This son of Muscle Mass scored with ease in both of the previous preliminary legs of that added-money event and is now nine for 26 in his career, with 13 on the board finishes over that span. He should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation and is yet again hard to look past.

#7 IM ABOVE AVERAGE exits the same race as the one above and sat in the three-hole for much of that mile before rounding out the superfecta in fourth at nearly 13-1. He went a big trip nine nights earlier when he issued a stiff challenge to race-favorite Ricardo in the stretch despite being parked the route and was clearly the best of the rest when finishing just over two lengths in arrears to that rival at 18-1. This other son of Muscle Mass has only gotten his picture taken once from 26 lifetime tries but has seven top three finishes from 20 outings as a sophomore. He will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy and looms as a danger.

#1 CENTURY JAGUAR was sent to the early lead from post-seven in the other division of the first leg of this series last week and zipped through the opening quarter in 27.3 before releasing the one below to the engine. He was then relegated back to third on the spin for home when Stonebridge Bomber sprinted to the front and by the time he was able to get back to the outside that winner was long gone. This son of Resolve did well to get within a length of that winner at the wire and has now been second or better in four of his last five overall. He will slide down to the pole position and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 LOOKSLIKAGOODFELLA exits the same race as the one above and took support to the tune of 2-1 in that contest but had no answers for Stonebridge Bomber when that rival came to call on the final turn. He faded back to fifth in the stretch and was beaten by more than 10 lengths when having to settle for a lesser share. This son of Looklikeeachpndale was fourth when he went postward in a lifetime non-winners condition just five nights earlier and was last victorious in NW2 on September 22nd. He has rebound potential and should offer an opportunity to take back some value for those that supported him last time out.

He got away eighth off the switch from post-four after making a break behind the gate the week prior and was more than 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.1 with a final panel in 26 seconds flat. This son of Betterthancheddar is still a maiden through 13 career attempts but has hit the board in each of his two tries with Tyler Borth in the sulky and that teamster opts to stick with him tonight over Dows Up. He will likely be making noise when it matters most and hopefully he can get past them all this time around.

#2 FULL HORSE exits the same race as the one above and got away in the three-hole in that contest before making a first-over bid on the spin for home. He forged his way to the front in the stretch and kicked home in 27 seconds flat off a back-half in 55.1 while keeping our top selection safely at bay at the finish. This son of Bettors Delight has been second or better in each of his last four and won two in a row back in July before he went on the shelf for nearly four months. He has hit the board in seven of his 10 lifetime tries and once again looms as a major danger.

#6 SANS SOUCI had to settle for third by just over a length to the one above last week and rounded out the trifecta at odds of 4-1. He was second-over on the final turn and flipped three-wide in the stretch but did not come forward with enough authority to pick up the victory. This son of Hes Watching has managed to hit the board in each of his last four and was an impressive winner when he broke his maiden on September 28th. He will shift off the rail to the winningest post at Mohawk Park and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket. Jonathan Drury picks up the steer.

#4 LEAVE IT TO LUTHER made a splash in his return to this circuit in his latest when he seized victory in the first leg of this series and came from a long way off the pace to do so. He brushed past his rivals in the dying strides when he blasted home in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2 and got up by a neck in a mini-upset at odds of nearly 7-1. This son of Betterthancheddar has been fourth or better in each of his last nine and has six top two finishes over that span. He will have top driver James MacDonald back aboard for an encore performance and has repeat potential.

He was within a couple of lengths of the winner below at the wire and was climbing over top of his rivals for much of the stretch drive. This son of Racing Hill squandered a pocket-trip two starts ago when he made a break in stride when trying to angle to outside in the final eighth of a mile and should benefit from having a flat line under his belt this evening. He will be making his third attempt under the care of conditioner Anthony Montini and will have Jody Jamieson up for the third time in four starts.

#6 MAMBA blasted to the front from post-eight in his latest and quickly released Ikes Dream to the front in a quarter that was set in 25.4. He was relegated to third on the backside and was pinned in the three-hole on the bend for home but was able to angle to the outside for clearance when the pocket-sitter popped out. This son of Sweet Lou paced past his foes to score by a comfortable length at the finish and has not been second or better in each of his last four. He will be making his second start out of the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau and will have J-Mac back at the helm for an encore performance.

#4 DUPREE HANOVER moved to the outside on the final turn after sitting fourth for most of the mile last week and made his way to the show spot before the wire after. He completed the trifecta at 10-1 in a race that was won by his stablemate above and he likely went into that contest at a fitness disadvantage after not racing in more than a month going into that effort. This son of Stay Hungry is another that will be making his follow-up try under the care of conditioner Richard Moreau and had won six in a row in Pennsylvania before making the trek north to this circuit. He will benefit from racing back on a regular schedule and is among the top contenders.

#1 STOP THE SHOOTIN exits the same race as the three above and came from off the pace to be third in that dash after getting away seventh off the switch. He was eight lengths off the lead at the opening marker and paced his back-half in 54.3 with a final panel in 27 seconds flat and was just a length away from the winner under the wire. This son of Hes Watching has been the runner-up in four of his last six and should appreciate getting another crack at this lifetime non-winners conditioner after spending each of his previous five in NW15650L5. He might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position and should be included in all of the exotic wagers.

#9 FUNATTHEBEACH N has competed in a Preferred-2 or higher in all of his prior 11 outings at Mohawk Park and had picked up a piece in five of his last eight over this surface. He has a couple of runner-up finishes over that span and is just five starts removed from rounding out the exacta behind Tattoo Artist at 43-1 in the Free For All on September 23rd. This 43-time winner will now plunge down in competition when he goes postward in NW20000L5 this evening but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest. He has more than enough tactical speed to get forwardly placed off the gate and has proven to be versatile in his racing style throughout his career and gets the nod on top.

#2 NAUTICAL HANOVER has hit the board in each of his last three and most recently had to settle for second to Wind Blown in NW15500L5 when that rival sparked an upset at odds of 15-1. He was just a length away from that rival when he completed the exacta at 5/2 and was closer to victory two starts ago at this level when he was third to Sometime Somewhere at more than 14-1. This 13-time winner has been trending back in the right direction for trainer Ben Baillargeon and has gotten along well with rising talent Tyler Borth in both of his last two. He will work from the inside of the gate and will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile.

#8 SAULSBROOK VICTOR exits the same race as the one above and was sent off at nearly 10-1 in that contest but had to settle for fifth after looming large in the late stages. He was just over a length away from the a longer-priced winner in Wind Blown and paced his back-half in 54.2 with a final panel in 26.3. This 18-time winner converted at 30 cents to the dollar in the class below this two starts ago and was just over a couple of lengths away from winner Roll With The Flow at this level on October 21st. He started to find his best form around this time last season and should not be taken lightly.

#5 CODENAME CIGAR BOX was sent off at 4-1 or less in each of his last two in the class below this but could only muster one fourth-place finish between those two efforts. He came up flat-footed in his latest before finishing eighth in a race won by his stablemate Bee Two Bee but was the runner-up in back-to-back outings in NW8000L5 in October. This 26-time winner might benefit from missing a week between starts and might rebound in a big way. He should offer some value on the board and will have options off the switch when working form post-five.

#8 HANGOVER HILL has won two in a row and was impressive in victory in both of those outings after getting into all kinds of traffic trouble as the 3/5 odds-on choice in his lifetime debut on October 12th. He was the easiest kind of winner on November 4th when he stopped the clock in 1:54.2 and had missed a few weeks of action going into that effort. This son of Bettors Delight overcame the dreaded 10-hole in his latest and was shut down under the wire when he came in a tick quicker than his previous victory. He should be brimming with confidence when taking the leap upwards to NW2 and is hard to go against at what will once again be a price of the shortest variety.

#1 STRAPPER HANOVER was one we were fond of November 4th when he went a long way on the lead from post-nine but disappointed as the 6/5 favorite when he faded back to fifth under the wire in a race that was topped by Speaker Of Peace. He has since gotten a bravening trip in his latest at the level above this and appeared to have all kinds of pace in the stretch when stuck in a blind switch before finding room along the pylons in the dying strides. This son of Stay Hungry had gotten away fifth off the gate in that contest and was shuffled back to last before blasting home in 27.2 off a back-half in 53.3. He gives up a maturity edge to the one above but has more experience with more than double the career starts and should offer a better price on the board, too.

#2 BROOKDALE JOHNNY has spent each of his last six in the higher earnings version of this class and was fourth or better in three of those appearances. He also finished in that position the last time he competed at this level and has picked up a prize in 10 of his last 14 overall. This son of Rockin In Heaven is winless in 25 tries as a sophomore but has managed to hit the board in 15 of his 35 career attempts. He will once again work from the inside of the gate and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 GRITTY stepped up to the class above this in his latest and went an overland journey before finishing seventh at 33-1. He was a strong winner in NW1 before that and was second or better in three straight prior to his most recent effort. This son of Heston Blue Chip will race on lasix for the first time and will appreciate finding middle ground at this level. He will work from the center of the gate and can walk away with a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

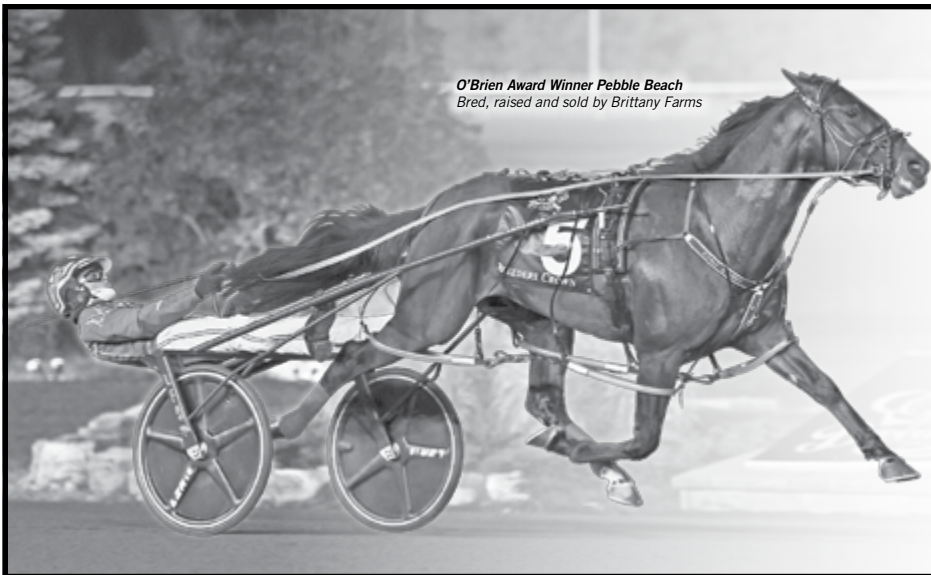

#4 RICARDO fought gamely to the wire last week when he came up a head short to odds-on choice Nothingbutadreamer and completed the exacta as a decisive second favorite at 5/2. He won three of his last five going into that effort and will not have to worry about the rival that got the better of him that time around. This son of Resolve has hit the board in eight of his 15 career attempts since making his lifetime debut last May and got the nod from Doug McNair over the one below, who he piloted to victory in the other division of the first leg of this series. He will likely have his gas pedal pressed off the switch from post-four and looks like the clear one to beat.

#2 STONEBRIDGE BOMBER got away sixth off the gate in his latest but then made a big brush to the lead on the spin for home and opened up a wide margin on his foes before holding on by three quarters of a length at the finish. He trotted his own middle-half in 56.1 after taking all kinds of late action to go off as the 3/5 favorite and had been going up against tougher rivals in a tricky lifetime non-winners condition in his prior three efforts. This son of Muscle Mass will be making his third start out of the barn of trainer Aaron Byron but loses driver Doug McNair to the one above. He picks up a suitable replacement in Louis-Philippe Roy and will be our main player underneath.

#5 CACTUSTOTHECLOUDS exits the same race as our top selection and was nearly four lengths in arrears to that rival in third after getting away fifth off the gate. He stepped to the outside on the turn for home and completed the trifecta at odds of 7-1. This son of Alarm Detector has hit the board in all of his last 11 and has a flat line to his credit after making a miscue on November 2nd. He will have Trevor Henry back aboard for a follow-up try and will have options at the start when working from the center of the gate.

#1 CONNOR is another that was in need of a clean line in his latest after he jumped it off two starts ago in a preliminary leg of a Pop-Up Series. He had missed more than three weeks of action when he earned a minor award at 32-1 in his latest and came home in 27.2 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2. This son of My Mvp might get handled more aggressively this evening but will have to mind his manners when working from a tricky spot on the gate for a young trotter with the pole position. He might be able to help spice up the bottom end of the exotics and is capable of picking up another slice.

#2 CONTROL THE GOLD was an impressive winner in his latest after he marched to the lead on the backside and then paced away from his rivals in the stretch to score by more than four lengths under the wire as the 4/5 favorite. He stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.3 when getting to victory lane for the first time in 14 tries as a sophomore and will get to come right back in the same class tonight. This son of Control The Moment will be making his fourth start under the care of top conditioner Richard Moreau and will likely once again get hammered down to favoritism at the windows. He slides in four spots to post-two and will likely go on the attack in the early going again tonight.

#10 BETTORHOLDONTIGHT came from a long way off the pace to be third in the other division of this class last week and was nearly 14 lengths off the lead at the opening marker. He was overland for much of the mile before blasting home in 27.3 on the heels of a back-half in 54.4 and completed the trifecta at 5-1 in a race that was won by Come On Artie. This son of Bettors Delight has managed to stay on his gait in each of his last two after making back-to-back miscues but will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole. He will likely be making noise in the stretch and is one of our main players underneath.

#9 URIEL BLUE CHIP transitioned to this classification in his latest after taking down three of his previous four in a Pop-Up Series and took support to the tune of 3/2 before finishing more than five lengths back of our top selection in third. He has missed a week between starts going into that effort and scored with ease two back when he equalled his lifetime best clocking of 1:52.2 in the final of that added-money event. This other son of Bettors Delight will be reunited with driver Jody Jamieson and he should be more acclimated to this level competition. He is another that has been hampered with an outside draw but can still be in the mix throughout.

#3 THATLL BE TIGER exits the same race as the one above and was left with a lot of work to do in that effort when he got away last off the gate from post-10 and was nearly 16 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He was able to improve a few spots in the stretch by sprinting home in 26.2 as a 24-1 longshot and took a lot more support one week earlier when he claimed the show spot at 5-1. This son of Tigerama is just two starts removed from blowing up the tote board at 18-1 at this venue and should much prefer his starting spot this evening when he slides down to post-four. He picks up the driving services of Scott Young for the first time and should not be excluded from the bottom end of the exotics.

#5 THE MOMENT AROSE was scratched out of the first leg of this Harvest Series last week due to sickness and will now go postward for the first time since a third-place finish to Uriel Blue Chip in the final of a Pop-Up Event on October 27th. He was nearly seven lengths behind that rival when he rounded out the trifecta at odds of 8/5 on that occasion and won each of the previous two preliminary rounds of that series at even-money or less. This son of Control The Moment should appreciate getting down to the center of the gate for tonight's tilt and has proven he can be versatile in his racing style. He can get the better of this group if he is ready to roll after missing three weeks of action and gets the edge on top.

#1 ARIZONA JACKSON went a long way on the lead in his latest but faded back to third in deep stretch after getting swarmed in the late stages and was just under two lengths behind winner Full horse at the finish. He disappointed as the 3/2 favorite in that first attempt over this surface and had been second or better in all six of his previous career outings at Rideau Carleton before that. This son of Betterthancheddar had not raced in 19 days going into that most recent defeat and can take a step forward when racing back on a regular rotation. He will work from the pole position after having the eight-hole last time out and can be right there at the wire.

#8 D A JIMINY CRICKET finished alongside the one above last week when he rounded out the superfecta in fourth at nearly 14-1 and saw his three-race win-streak snapped in that effort. He gutted-out the victory by a head two back at The Raceway in London and took down the final of the Autumn Series before that at Flamboro Downs at odds of 2-1 when he stepped his mile in 1:56 flat on that half-mile oval. This son of Big Jim has hit the board in nine of his 13 attempts as a sophomore and has only missed one cheque over that span. He will have Bob McClure back aboard for a follow-up steer but will have to overcome the outermost post on the contest.

#3 NOVA SCOTIA STRONG was one we tried last week at 9-1 but he did not have much of a chance after he was taken back to last from post-nine and was more than 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He improved a couple of spots before the wire and was in need of a flat line after jumping it off in NW2 at this venue one week earlier. He hit the board in all three rounds of the Autumn Series at Flamboro Downs before that and was just a length away from the one above when he had to settle for second at 60 cents to the dollar in the final of that added-money event. He will have his trainer Tyler Moore back in the bike and he has upset potential.

#3 EMMETTS BUDDY was never able to get into contention last week when he disappointed as the even-money favorite and had to settle for fourth at the finish in a race that was won by Poseidon Seelster. He was nearly 10 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 53.4 with a final panel in 26.3 and got his picture taken in back-to-back Preferred tilts going into that effort. This 18-time winner has been second or better in eight of his last 10 and should benefit from sliding in five spots on the gate to post-three. He will likely get activated much sooner in the mile this time around and can rebound his way to victory lane.

#7 POSEIDON SEELSTER emerged victorious in his latest when he stepped back up to the level and sat in the three-hole for most of the mile. He angled off the cones from that spot in the lane and came forward with authority before getting past a stubborn Points North in deep stretch. This 15-time winner tripped the wire in a season's best 1:49 flat and has now hit the board in five of his last six. He should be feeling good about himself coming into this and once again looms as a danger.

#4 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE exits the same race as the two above and claimed the show spot at 8-1 after sitting an inside trip for the duration of the journey. He was more than four lengths behind the one above at the finish but has hit the board in each of his last seven, with three of those appearances coming at the Preferred level. This 18-time winner is just two starts removed from a victory in the top condition class and should be more than competitive with this group. He will have options off the gate from post-four and can hit the ticket.

#8 ROLL EM has won each of his last two in Charlottetown and gutted-out a victory in the Premier's Cup Final on October 8th when he paced his mile in 1:54 over a surface that was two seconds off on that half-mile oval. He has since shipped to Ontario to race out of the barn of trainer Paige Austin and will have James MacDonald calling the shots for the first time. This 27-time winner has won nine of 18 this season and has hit the board 14 times over that span. He might need to get a start under his feet after missing over a month of action but is worth keeping a close eye on for next time.

#2 BACKSTREET GAMBLER was trying to make late gains on the inside before the rail got shut off on him last week in NW15500L5 but still finished up nicely when coming in sixth under the wire. He was taken back to last off the gate from post-nine at odds of 81-1 and stepped his back-half in 53.4 with a final quarter in 26.4. This son of Betting Line had not raced in nearly six months going into that effort and will now get to drop down a notch on the class ladder when coming back on a regular rotation. He will also slide down to the inside of the gate with post-two and is our best bet of the night.

#5 WHICHWAYTOTHEBEACH went an adventurous journey in his latest when he was stuck three-wide for a long way after he was unable to step around rivals when trying to move to the lead on the backside. He ended up fading back to fourth at 35 cents to the dollar and should benefit from getting that start under his belt after he missed more than a month of action following a DNF at Yonkers on October 10th. This 16-time winner will appreciate getting another crack in this class and will likely offer an opportunity to take back some value for those that supported him last time out. He has rebound potential but we much prefer the one above.

#3 LEGION SEELSTER has been known to get difficult trips and last week in this class was no exception when he was stuck in the first-over position for most of the mile. He was in between rivals when the one above moved three-wide on the backside and did well to stick around for a minor award in fifth. This 21-time winner was second-best to Saulsbrook Victor two back at this level and had not raced in three weeks before that outing. He will likely benefit from getting a softer trip this time out and is not without a chance if he ends up in the right spot.

#7 RESPECT OUR FLAG exits the same race as the two above and was only beaten by half a length to Uncle Shank A in the contest after racing from off the pace. He fired home in 27.2 on the heels of a back-half in 55.1 and has been the runner-up in each of his last three. This 34-time winner has not missed the board in any of his last five overall and was last victorious in the class below this on October 21st. He has proven to be versatile in his racing style and will likely be heard from at some point in the mile.

#4 ACAPULCO SUNBURN ran out of racetrack last week when finding his best stride in the late stages and was at a pace disadvantage in that contest after getting away seventh off the switch from post-six. He was more than 10 lengths off the lead at the opening marker before he stepped his back-half in 54.2 with a final quarter in 26.3 and did not have the liveliest of cover on the spin for home in the third-over position. This son of Big Jim was an impressive winner two starts ago in NW5100L5 and has hit the board in each of his last four. He will be making his fourth start under the care of conditioner Kyle Fellows and has our top honors in this Hi-5 mandatory payout event.
#6 STORMALONG was sent to the early lead from post-six on November 4th in this class but released Kaptain Karlos to the front on the backside before going back out on the attack at the top of the final turn. He forged to the lead in mid-stretch but could not match strides with Woodmere Fenn in the dying strides and had to settle for second as the 3/2 favorite. This son of Stay Hungry had not raced in nearly two months going into that effort and will now make his follow-up try out of the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau. He has missed another week between outings but will be reunited with driver Doug McNair, who piloted him to a victory in a preliminary leg of the Dream Maker in the second start of his career in August of 2022.
#3 COME ON ARTIE was impressive in victory in NW2 last week when he strided away by open lengths in deep stretch and stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:51.3. He banged home in 27.2 on the heels of a back-half in 54.4 and has hit the board in each of his last nine when racing under the care of conditioner Brett Lester. This 10-time winner has gotten his picture taken five times over that span and will have Louis-Philippe Roy back at the helm for tonight's tilt. He will have to raise his game once again when taking a step up the class ladder but does not look out of place against this group.
#10 SUN CHIP was the runner-up to Jabberwocky in NW4000L5 on November 11th but was over three lengths in arrears to that rival when he paced his own mile in 1:50.3 at odds of 12-1. He has hit the board in six of his last seven since returning to the races after a hiatus of nearly four months and did not have much of a chance the way the dash panned out the last time he went postward at this level on October 28th. This 11-time winner has been hampered with the dreaded 10-hole but will have Travis Cullen back giving the commands and they have teamed up for three victories together in the past. He looks like one that can add some serious value to the ticket and should be utilized in all of the exotics.
#2 BEACH TOUR front-stepped his way to victory last week at odds of 8-1 and has been third in each of his last three in this class since Trevor Henry took over the driving duties. He got jammed up behind horses in his first attempt at this level on October 14th and was an impressive off the pace winner in NW2 before that. This son of Sunshine Beach will leave from post-two for the third consecutive start but will likely not offer as much value on the board this time out. He should be able to work out a favorable journey and can secure a slice.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

Table with columns: RACE11, PACE, 1 MILE NW15500L5CD, PURSE: \$24,000. Includes race details for Wind Blown, Nautical Hanover, Lawless Shadow, etc.

Table with columns: RACE12, PACE, 1 MILE W02-4RL-CD, PURSE: \$21,000. Includes race details for Beach Tour, Boozer, Acapulco Sunburn, etc.

Table with columns: HORSES WITH FASTER QUARTERS, WHO WAS HOT - DRIVERS, WHO WAS HOT - TRAINERS. Includes lists of horses and drivers with their respective records and win prices.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

PLEASE NOTE:

In the unlikely event that bets can not be combined into a host track's pools before the end of a race, Federal Regulations require that such bets must be refunded. Refunding bets at some sites can affect odds and payouts at the remaining sites.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
