Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

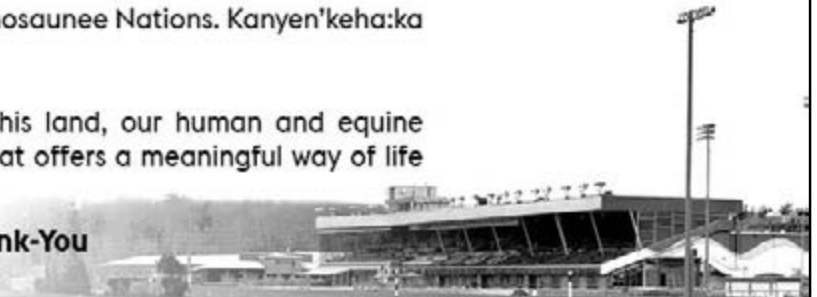

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 ACAPULCO SUNBURN got up by three quarters of a length last week to convert as the favorite in a Jackpot Hi-5 mandatory payout event and stopped the clock in 1:52.1 with a 27.3 kicker. He has hit the board in five straight and has racked-up a pair of victories in his last three. This son of Big Jim will be making his fifth start out of the barn of trainer Kyle Fellows and eight of his 10 career victories have come with James MacDonald in the sulky. He should enjoy getting another crack at this class and looks like a prime candidate to double-up.

#7 BOOZER exits the same race as the one above and did well to get away seventh off the switch from the second trailing spot in post-12 but ended up fourth-over when he moved to the outside on the backstretch. He was nine lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his second-half 55.2 with a final panel in 27.1 and nearly got within a couple of lengths of the one above when he rounded out the superfecta at 17-1. This 11-time winner was second or better in his previous two outings and will get his nose back on the gate from post-seven after tricky draws in both of his last two. He picks up Jonathan Drury in the sulky for the first time and looms as a danger.

#6 KOPI LUWAK is three for 15 in his sophomore season with five top two finishes and \$118,500 in earnings. He finished fourth in his elimination for the North America Cup at this venue back in June and then had to work from the dreaded 10-hole in the consolation for that prestigious stakes event. This son of Stay Hungry has since spent his last 11 starts stateside in Kentucky and has been second or better in his three most recent efforts at Cumberland Run. He will now race under the care of top conditioner Richard Moreau and compete on lasix for the first time in his career. Doug McNair will be at the helm for the first time and he should get every chance to hit the ticket from post-six.

#10 HURRIKANE CHEYENNE claimed the show spot on November 4th when he stepped up to this level and rounded out the trifecta at 8-1 behind Woodmere Fenn and Stormalong. He was no worse than second in his previous five outings and has made two trips to the winner's circle in his five attempts for trainer Richard Moreau. This son of Always B Miki has missed three weeks between starts and will have to overcome the outermost post but has proven to be versatile in his racing style. He can grab a share.

He held on by a head over the one below on November 11th and then followed that up with a more comfortable score last week. This 10-time winner should be brimming with confidence after making five consecutive trips to victory lane and will surely get hammered down at the widows when the chips are down. He will likely be looking to get to the lead before the midway point and will be tough to beat.

#5 RICARDO appeared to be moving comfortably on the lead on the spin for home last week but made an untimely break in stride to blow up as the 2/5 favorite. He ended up being distanced in fifth in a field of six but pushed the one above to the brink the week prior when he only missed by a head at the wire as the definitive second choice at 5/2. This son of Resolve has won three of his last seven and will likely once again have his gas pedal pressed off the switch when working from the center of the gate. He can rebound in a big way and will be our main player underneath.

#1 IM ABOVE AVERAGE exits the same race as our top selection and rounded out the exacta behind that rival at 14-1 after stepping around a tired pocket-sitter on the final turn. He has been the runner-up in two of his last three and has earned a cheque in all of his four overall. This son of Muscle Mass is just one for 27 in his career but has managed to hit the board in eight of 21 so far at the age of three. He will have Jody Jamieson calling the shots for the first time and can work out a favorable journey from the pole position.

#3 LOOKSLIKAGOODFELLA took support to the tune of 2-1 in the first leg of this series but faded back to fight in the stretch and was beaten by more than 10 lengths after getting to the lead at the midway point. He has since rebounded with a decent effort to be third last week when racing from off the pace and came home in 28.2 on the heels of a back-half in 57.2. This son of Lookslikeachpndale completed the trifecta at 17-1 and will get to work from a favorable spot on the gate from post-three. He should once again offer some value on the board and is worth using on the bottom end of the exotics.

#7 FUNATTHEBEACH N got away fourth off the gate from post-nine last week and elected to stay on the pylons on the backside. He tried to edge to the outside for clearance at the top of the stretch but ended up in a blind switch before shaking loose in deep stretch. This 43-time winner was climbing over rivals before pacing forward for third and should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation after missing a week between starts last time out. He drops down another notch on the class ladder and should be breathing fire coming into this.

#1 WHICHWAYTOTHEBEACH could not have been a more dominant winner in his latest when he went all the way on the engine in NW8000L5 before scoring by more than three lengths in 1:50.3. He chopped out legit fractions throughout in that contest when he converted as the 1/2 favorite and went an adventurous journey the week before at that level when got stuck three-wide for a long way before finishing fourth at an even shorter price. This 17-time winner will be making his third start back since missing a month of action after not finishing a race at Yonkers on October 10th as the 6/5 choice of the betting public and should not mind the step upwards in competition. He will likely push out for position with rail control and has never missed the board in four tries with Sylvain Filion at the controls.

#6 LAWLESS SHADOW exits the same race as our top choice and got away in the three-hole before making a first-over bid on the bend for home. He was never able to get alongside the eventual winner Saulsbrook Victor but kept fighting to the finish when getting beaten by less than two lengths in fifth. This 15-time winner drops back down to the level where he went a long way on the lead two starts ago and rounded out the trifecta at 8-1 in that contest that was won by Wind Blown. He had hit the board in six straight going in his most recent effort and will likely be moving forward off the switch from the winningest post at Mohawk Park.

#2 MOMAS SON BYRNE disappointed as the even-money favorite on November 11th when he dropped down to this class and could only muster a seventh-place finish. after getting away third off the gate from post-seven. He was only beaten by three quarters of a length when he finished fourth in NW22750L5 the week before and was a dominant winner in NW8000L5 three starts ago. This 17-time winner will be reunited with his regular driver Jonathan Drury and has rebound potential. He has gotten a week off between appearances and should offer an opportunity to take back some value for those that supported him last time.

This 21-time winner produced a winning qualifier on the morning of November 17th and stepped his mile in 1:55.1 when he scored by a trio of lengths over Raptors Won. He should enjoy making his return at the bottom level and will be reunited with driver Doug McNair, who has guided him to seven victories and 13 on the board finishes in the 23 times they have been paired together.

#1 MIGHTY MACH has hit the board in four of his last five but disappointed as the even-money favorite in his latest when he got picked up in the dying strides by Illgetmyown Thanks. He took that support after surging past his rivals for the victory nine nights earlier and paced his way to a new lifetime mark of 1:52 flat in that outing. This 18-time winner has not missed a cheque since joining the camp of Tom Riley in mid-October and has been getting along well with driver Trevor Henry. He will have options off the gate when working from the pole position and looks threatening.

#4 FOREFATHER has only mustered one cheque in his last six and that came when he earned a minor award by finishing fifth in a lifetime non-winners condition while racing for an optional price tag of \$50,000. He returned 7-1 to his backers when he got up by a neck in the final strides at that level at the end of September and will get down to a soft spot when racing on just four nights' rest this evening. This 12-time winner fits in nicely with this group and will likely be making noise when it matters most. He can hit the ticket.

#6 TORONTO claimed the show spot at 3-1 in this class last Monday night and has finished fourth or better in three of his last four. He will get to work from post-six for the second straight start and had the eight-hole or worse in eight of his previous nine efforts. This 12-time winner has hit the board in 10 of his 32 attempts this season and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. He might be able to work out a decent trip and pick up a decent chunk.

#9 SPEAKER OF PEACE was only beaten by three quarters of a length to heavy-favorite Control The Gold in his latest and rounded out the trifecta at 11-1. He blew up the tote board two weeks earlier when he got up by half a length in the lower earnings version of this class at odds of 17-1. This son of Artspeak should benefit from racing back on a regular rotation in his third start back off layoff of nearly four months and will have Bob McClure back aboard for a follow-up steer. He will have to overcome a tricky draw with post-nine but has paced home in 27.3 in each of his last two and can be right there at the wire.

#1 URIEL BLUE CHIP exits the same race as the one above and was overland for much of that mile before having to settle for fourth at the finish. He was more than six lengths in arrears to Control The Gold under the wire and was also beaten by a healthy margin to that same rival the week before when he claimed the show spot from the pole position. This son of Bettors Delight has won three of his last six and was a dominant winner in the final of a Pop-Up Series on October 27th. He has hit the board in seven of his 14 career attempts since making his lifetime debut in May and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#2 THATLL BE TIGER finished sixth in his latest at 20-1 and was within a couple of lengths of the one above under the wire. He did not have much of a chance two starts ago when he got away last off the switch from post-10 and improved a few spots when he blasted home in 26.2 off a back-half in 53.4. This son of Tigerama completed the trifecta at 5-1 when he stepped up to this class and was a winner three weeks prior when he lit up the odds board at 18-1 in NW1500L3. He will leave from another inside starting spot and can pick up a slice.

#9 LEAVE IT TO LUTHER is the only one that can sweep this Harvest Series after scoring from off the pace in both of the preliminary legs. He got away sixth off the gate and moved to the outside on the turn for home before being pushed wide on the final turn. This son of Betterthancheddar sailed past his rivals in deep stretch and came from further back one week earlier when he fired home in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2. He is a perfect two-to-two with leading driver James MacDonald aboard and can triple-up but will not be anything close to the price he offered in his last two.

#5 ARIZONA JACKSON got away in the three-hole from the pole position last week and stayed on the cones on the backside before being able to angle to the outside for clearance in the stretch. He paced away from his rivals in deep stretch and paced his mile in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.4 at 75 cents to the dollar. This other son of Betterthancheddar disappointed as the 3/2 favorite in his circuit debut on November 11th but had not raced nearly three weeks going into that effort. He has won five of his eight lifetime tries and has not missed the board in any of those efforts. Jonathan Drury will be at the helm for the third consecutive start and he looms as a major danger.

#8 FULL HORSE exits the same race as our top choice and was sent to the lead on the backside in that contest as the 4/5 favorite but faded back to third in deep stretch. He was a length away from the winner and scored by a shorter margin the week before in 1:53.1 with a 27 flat kicker. This son of Bettors Delight will be making his fourth start back after a lengthy layoff and has hit the board in eight of 11 as a sophomore. He might revert back to racing off a helmet this evening and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#3 CHEDDAR DUHARAS was gapped to the gate from post-seven last week but was then put into play when he kept driving to the lead in the opening quarter and made front before the field straightened out on the backside. He was then relegated to the pocket when the one above came to call but could not get past that rival in the stretch after edging his way to the outside. This gelding faded back to fifth under the wire at odds of 9/2 and only missed by half a length the week prior when he raced from a long way off the pace. He is still a maiden through 14 appearances but has hit the board five times over that span and has upset potential.

#5 MAMBA could not convert at 55 cents to the dollar last week when he was unable to get past a determined winner in Donttouchmytruck. He only missed by a neck at the wire and made a splash on the circuit the week prior when he scored at 6-1 in this class in his first start for top trainer Richard Moreau. This son of Sweet Lou has not been worse than second in any of his last five and will likely be moving forward off the gate again this week when moving in another spot to post-five. He figures to take significant support on the odds board and can get back to the winner's circle.

#1 DUPREE HANOVER exits the same two races as his stablemate above and finished third in both of those contests at odds of 10-1. He sat in the three-hole for most of the mile in his latest before pacing home in 27.1 off a back-half in 54.4 but was nearly four lengths behind the winner at the wire. This son of Stay Hungry won six in a row in Pennsylvania before he relocated to this circuit to race under the care of conditioner Richard Moreau and will have Doug McNair at the reins for the third time. He will work from the pole position and will be one of our main players underneath.

#7 IKES DREAM was used hard in the early going on November 11th when he kept driving to the lead from post-seven and tripped the opening marker in 25.4. He then immediately released Magical Arthur to the front but then popped the pocket on the spin for home but tired in deep stretch after briefly putting his nose in front. This son of Bettors Delight faded back to sixth at the finish and but enjoyed back-to-back victories in the class below this in October. He will have to overcome another outside draw and might be in need of a softer journey this time out.

#6 BROOKDALE MIKI was scratched out of his most recent scheduled start due to sickness but made a nice rally for fourth at 18-1 on October 28th at the level below this. He could not make his presence felt on October 21st when he faded back to eighth after trying a wide move on the swing for home but has picked up a prize in five of his last six overall. This son of Always B Miki will have the luxury of working from the best starting spot at Mohawk Park and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. He should offer a sizable number on the board and is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

#4 SAULSBROOK VICTOR has won two of his last three and was handled aggressively last week when he went all the way on the front-end in NW20000L5 at 12-1. He raced better than advertised two back when he was at a pace disadvantage and has been trending in the right direction for trainer Ron MacDonald. This 19-time winner started to find his best form around this time last year and won four in a row at this level when the weather got colder. He slides down to a favorable spot on the gate with post-four after having the eight-hole in each of his last two and should be confident coming into this. Giving him the nod on top and hoping for value.

#6 POSEIDON SEELSTER could not get past our fourth choice in the most recent installment of this class and got within a head of that determined winner when he completed the exacta at odds of 9/5. He was able to ride along in the pocket for much of that mile and sailed past his rivals from the three-hole the week before when he stopped the clock in 1:49 flat at 9/2. This 15-time winner has been second or better in each of his last three and has hit the board in six of his last seven overall. He will get to start from post-six for the third time in four starts and figures to make his presence felt throughout.

#1 EMMETTS BUDDY has disappointed as the even-money favorite in both of his last two at this level and was much closer to the action last week before having to settle for the show spot. He was within two lengths of a game-winner in Points North at the wire and paced his own mile in 1:50.2 after he made a first-over bid on the spin for home. This 18-time winner has been second or better in eight of his last 11 and will have rail control this evening. He has rebound potential but we prefer him in the underneath position this time around.

#2 POINTS NORTH went all the way on the engine from the six-hole last week and set legit fractions throughout before fending off our second choice at the finish. He paced his mile in 1:50 flat and has been no worse than second in each of his last two. This 42-time winner has earned a cheque in nine of his last 10 and has hit the board in 19 of his 39 tries this season. He appears to be back at the top of his game for conditioner Carmen Auciello and has been getting along well with driver Sylvain Filion.

#1 HUNGRY TO SUCCEED is another that has shipped north of the border to this circuit to race under the care of top conditioner Richard Moreau. He has spent most of his three-year-old season in Kentucky and has hit the board in four of his last seven. This son of Stay Hungry has not raced in nearly three weeks but should not mind the company he keeps in this NW2 event. He will have Doug McNair calling the shots for the first time and gets the edge on top.

#2 GRITTY went a long way on the lead in the lower earnings version of this class last week but could not hold off a short-priced winner in Hangover Hill at the finish. He was only beaten by half a length under the wire and paced his own mile in 1:52.3. This son of Heston Blue Chip notched his first victory as a sophomore in NW1 on October 28th and should benefit from making his second start on lasix this evening. He should be in the mix throughout and looks threatening.

#10 BROOKDALE JOHNNY exits the same race as the one above and was in a loose pocket behind that rival for much of the mile but could not close the gap on that rival before the wire when having to settle for third at 13-1. He was just over two lengths in arrears to winner Hangover Hill at the wire and will now have to shift out to the dreaded 10-hole for tonight's tilt. This son of Rockin In Heaven does not look out of place against this group but is winless in 26 attempts so far at the age of three. He has hit the board in 16 of his 36 lifetime tries and can hit the ticket if his trip is not too taxing.

#3 BETTOR B SIRIUS would have picked up a prize for the third straight start if he was not placed back to eighth from fifth in his latest. He was disqualified for gaining an unfair advantage by going inside a pylon in the stretch but turned in decent performances in his previous two outings when he was fourth or better. This son of Bettors Delight will get to work from post-three for the fourth time in six appearances and figures to make his presence felt at some point in the mile. He can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

#9 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER has walked away empty-handed in both of his last two and was not able to advance from seventh in his latest in NW2000L5 but did make up ground before the wire. He was 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 54.4 with a final quarter in 27.2. This 28-time winner will now take a steep drop down the class ladder to NW800L5 and was victorious the last time he raced at this level on October 7th. He will likely get put into play off the switch from post-nine and can come out on top in the nightcap. Austin Sorrie picks up the steer.

#7 LEGION SEELSTER was taken back off the gate last week and was more than 11 lengths off the engine at the opening marker before stepping home in 27.4 on the heels of a back-half in 54.3. He likely benefited from that softer journey after getting difficult trips in his previous two outings and was a runner-up to Saulsbrook Victor in this class on November 4th. This 21-time winner has picked up a prize in eight of his last nine and will likely get activated sooner in the mile this time out. He picks up the driving services of Tyler Borth and will be one of our main players underneath.

#3 RESPECT OUR FLAG exits the same race as the one above and was also a long way out of it in the early stages when he got away ninth off the switch from post-seven and was 15 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He improved a few spots before the finish when pacing his back-half in 54.4 with a final panel in 27.4 and was the runner-up in his previous two attempts at this level. This 34-time winner had hit the board in five straight before his most recent effort and will likely be closer to the action this time out. He should get every chance to hit the ticket and should not be excluded from any of the exotic wagers.

#4 I AMA ROCKET went an overland journey before finishing fifth at this level last week at odds of nearly 7-1 and will now make his second start back in the barn of Richard Moreau after that top conditioner snagged him back for \$35,000 on November 13th. He will be given another chance in this class when racing for the optional tag of \$45,000 and will get to slide down to a better spot on the gate with post-four after having the nine-hole or worse in each of his last three. This 35-time winner fits in nicely with this group but might take more support than we are willing to get behind. He can still pick up a sizable slice and is worth using on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

#1 HESINCONTROL got a heart-building victory in NW1750L3 on November 13th and offered better than 2-1 to his backers in that soft spot. He has hit the board in each of his last two at that level and might keep trending in the right direction when stepping up a couple of notches on the class ladder. This 16-time winner retains Bob McClure in the sulky and might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position. He can grab a share.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
