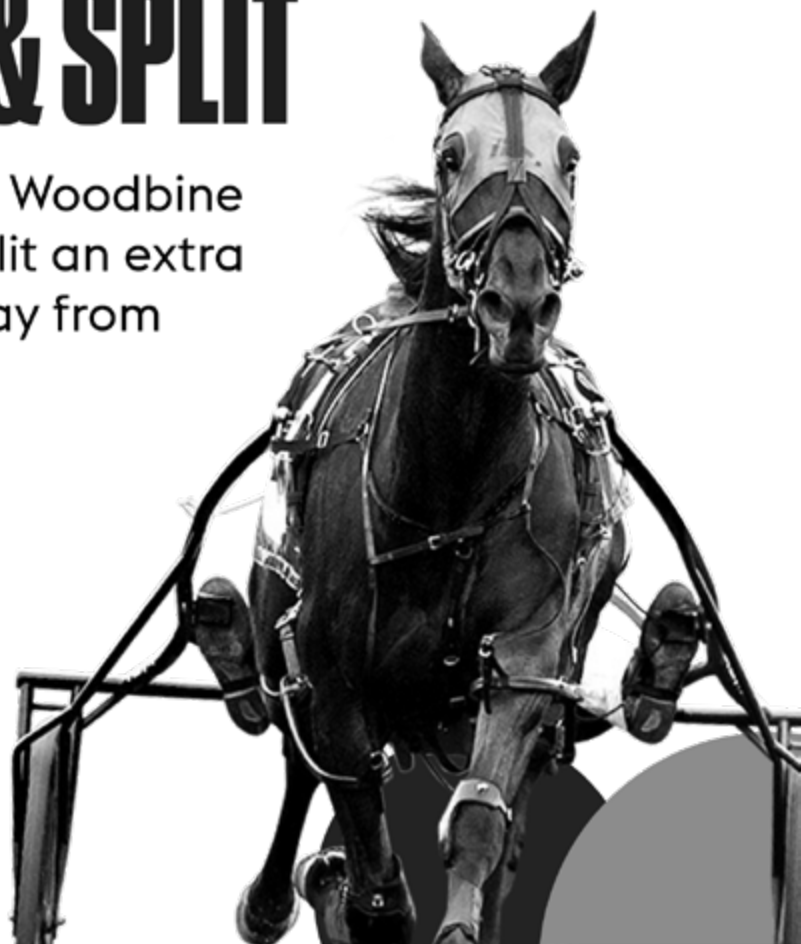

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



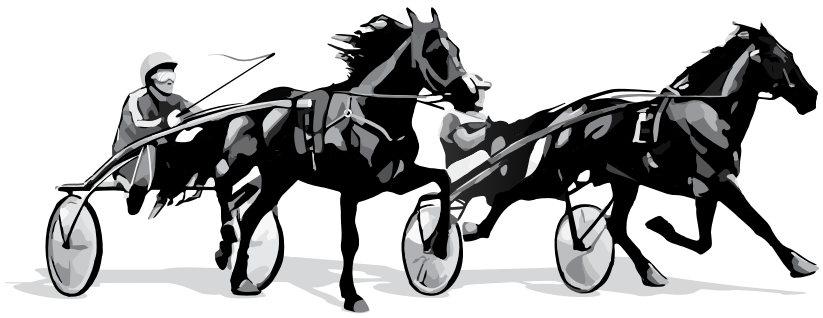
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

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All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 MAMBA got away fourth off the gate last week before getting shuffled back to seventh on the bend for home and appeared to have pace in behind rivals in the early part of the stretch drive. He had to settle for a minor award in fifth at 7-1 after he paced home in 27.2 off a back-half in 56.1 and had not raced in seven weeks prior to that effort after he was scratched due to sickness on January 20th. This son of Sweet Lou will be making his second attempt under the care of conditioner Blake MacIntosh and has hit the board in eight of his last 13 overall. He will have Sylvain Filion aboard for a follow-up steer and can take a step forward when getting back on a regular rotation. Giving him a whirl to kick off the card and hoping for value.

#5 CABOT BEACH was taken back to eighth off the switch on March 2nd and was more than 10 lengths off the lead at the opening marker. He improved to third before the finish in a dash topped by Stormalong and stepped his back-half in 53.2 with a final quarter in 26.3. This son of Captaintreacherous was victorious in the class below this two weeks earlier and has picked up a prize in 13 straight. He has hit the board in four of his last six since shipping to Ontario to race out of the barn top trainer Richard Moreau and was J-Mac's choice over two others in the contest.

#3 SPEAKER OF PEACE was second-best to the one below last week after he made a first-over bid from fifth before the final turn. He kept grinding away in that position but could never get to the pacesetter before having to settle for the bottom spot of the exacta at 3-1. This son of Artspeak is just two starts removed from winning five in a row and completed an impressive sweep of the Snowshoe Series on February 9th when he stopped the clock in a season's best 1:51.4. He has been second or better in 11 of his last 12 overall and once again looms as a danger.

#2 NAZARE exits the same race as the one above and delivered on a 4/5 promise in that contest after he marched to the front on the backside. He held a comfortable margin the rest of the way and kept that rival safely at bay when he scored by a length in 1:53 flat. This other son of Sweet Lou has not been worse than third in each of his last six since relocating north of the border to race under the care of conditioner Dave Menary and has five top two finishes over that span. He was passed over by James MacDonald in favor of our second choice and will have Phil Hudon back between the wheels.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#7 POSEIDON SEELSTER was only beaten by a neck to Soaring Now in a Preferred-2 on March 2nd and has hit the board in each of his last three at long odds when going postward in that top pacing class. He hung tough in the first-over position in both of his outings before his most recent effort and will now get to face softer company in this first leg of the New Holland Pacing Series. This 17-time winner has hit the board in five of his last seven and enjoyed back-to-back victories in NW14000L5 in January. He will likely try to ambush his rivals from the outermost post in the contest and is our clear choice on top.

#4 THE LONGEST YARD rallied for second last week in NW27000L5 and was three lengths in arrears to Sometime Somewhere when he rounded out the exacta at 12-1. He was shuffled to the back of the bus at the head of the lane after getting away fourth off the gate and had to angle out around a wall of horses before he was able to find clearance on the outside. This 13-time winner was victorious off the bench in NW16000L5 on February 17th and blew up the tote board at nearly 41-1 on that occasion. He will have Jody Jamieson at the helm for a follow-up drive and will be one of our main players underneath.

#6 CENTURY HEINEKEN exits the same race as our top choice and faded back to eighth in the late stages after getting away fourth off the gate. He was a game winner the week before in NW15000L5 and held on by a head over Code Cracker after he brushed to the lead on the backside. This 16-time winner has earned a cheque in 10 of his last 12 overall and will have the luxury of leaving from post-six. He might have his gas pedal pressed off the switch and can be in the mix throughout.

#5 FRANKIE FRANKIE has not raced since mid-November and has relocated north of the border since then to now race out of the barn of trainer Blake MacIntosh. He has a pair of qualifiers under his belt and most recently got within a length of Uncle Shank A at the wire when he banged home in 26.3 on the heels of a back-half in 54.1. This son of Tellitlikeitis paced his own mile in 1:51.3 and emerged victorious in his morning prep one week earlier in a more moderate 1:54.1. He has 12 top two finishes from 30 lifetime tries and will have Sylvain Filion calling the shots for the first time.

This 11-time winner has lit the lamp in two of his last four and should appreciate sliding down to post-three after having the eight-hole or worse in each of his last three. He might be sent on a front-end mission this time around and will be hard to catch.

#2 WHICHWAYTOTHEBEACH was scratched out of his most recent scheduled start on February 24th due to sickness and will now return to the races after missing more than a month of action. He scored by nearly two lengths in NW14000L5 two weeks earlier and was just a tick away from his lifetime mark when he stopped the clock in 1:49.2 at more than 6-1. This 19-time winner has been second or better in each of his last three and has not been beaten by more than a neck over that span. He might need to get one under his belt before he is ready to produce his best but might not need that to end up with a big piece of this.

#1 UNCLE SHANK A has not raced since December 9th when he was ninth in NW16000L5 at 80-1 and walked away empty-handed in each of his last two before going on the shelf. He was last victorious in NW8000L5 on November 11th when he tripped the wire in 1:51.2 and recently equalled that clocking in a winning qualifier where he made every call a winning one. This 19-time winner blasted home in 26.3 off a back-half in 54.1 in that morning prep and got within half a length of Wheels On Fire one week earlier. He got the nod from leading driver James MacDonald over three others in the contest and should get every chance to hit the ticket with rail control.

#6 JILLIBY DYNAMITE A was a front-end winner at Pocono Downs on March 9th in NW17500L5 and converted at 80 cents to the dollar when he stepped his mile in 1:52.2 over a sloppy track that was graded one second off. He has lit the lamp in two of his last four when competing south of the border and has since relocated back to this circuit to race under the care of conditioner Meg Crone. This son of Captaintreacherous was victorious for this outfit at this venue in NW9100L5 on January 27th at 65 cents to the dollar and tripped the timer in 1:52.3 on a surface that had a one second variant. He will have Tyler Borth at the controls for the second time and can grab a share.

He is part of a strong one-two punch for conditioner Kyle Fellows in this contest and can make his presence felt when working from the center of the gate.

#4 B STONEY was forwardly placed last week when he secured the two-hole to Head Honcho and was in a loose pocket for most of the mile before getting picked up for the place spot by Order One To Go. He did not have much of a chance the week before when he was at a pace disadvantage after he got away eighth off the gate and will now make his third consecutive appearance in this class for the price tag of \$32,000. This 13-time winner will likely benefit from getting roused off the switch again this evening and has been in good order as of late for trainer Mark Winacott. He can hit the ticket.

#8 I AMA ROCKET exits the same race as the one above and finished seventh in that contest after getting backed-up to ninth on the final turn. He claimed the show spot one week prior when he took support to the tune of 5/2 and has earned a cheque in five of his last six. This 35-time winner has had his price tag slashed by \$5,000 this evening but that will only see him move in one spot on the gate to post-eight. He might be able to summon a better effort this time around and should not be taken lightly.

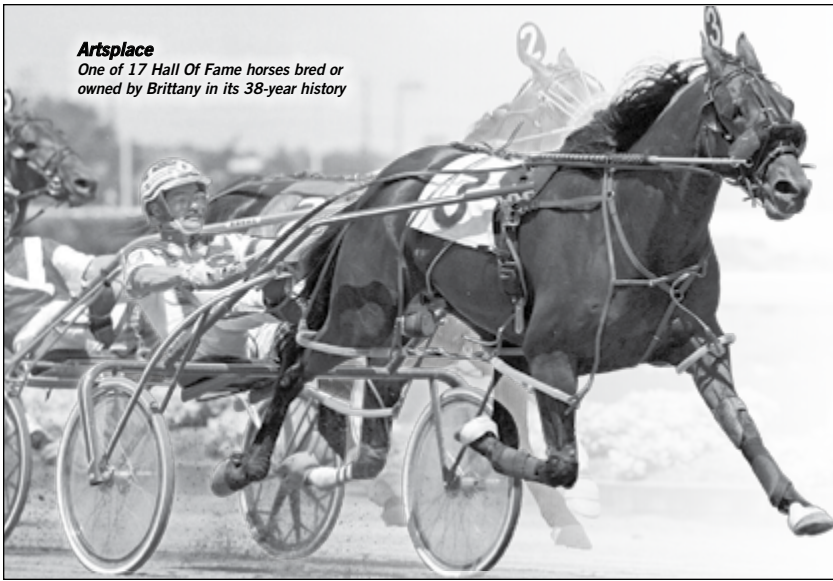

This 44-time winner will step back up a notch on the class ladder but will have leading driver James MacDonald back aboard for an encore performance. He can benefit from moving in a few spots on the gate and can be right there at the wire.

#8 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE exits the same race as our top selection and followed the eventual winner Sometime Somewhere on the rim before he lost that cover when that rival accelerated to the lead. He advanced as far as second before he faded back to fourth under the wire and went postward in a Preferred-2 or higher in each of his previous five. This 20-time winner has picked up a prize in six of his last seven but will have to start from post-eight for the third consecutive outing. He might get activated sooner in the mile this time around and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#4 CODE CRACKER has earned a cheque in eight of his last nine and was most recently just four lengths back of Sometime Somewhere in NW27000L5. He was only beaten by a head to Century Heinken in NW15000L5 on February 17th and was dominant in victory the week before that in NW8000L5 when he stopped the clock in 1:52.3 as the 8/5 second choice in the betting. This 13-time winner slides in another two spots on the gate and races for a barn that has won three of their last six at the time of writing this. He might be able to navigate a favorable journey and should not be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

He paced his back-half in 55.3 with a final quarter in 27.3 and had not raced in nearly a month after being a vet scratch due to sickness at the Meadowlands on February 24th. This son of American Ideal will be making his second try out of the barn of trainer Victor Puddy and will move in a few spots with Tyler Borth back between the wheels. He can take another step forward when getting on a regular schedule and figures to be brave.

#10 BROOKDALE JOHNNY exits the same race as the three above and got parked the route in that contest after getting away eighth off the gate from the same dreadful draw he has this evening. This 18-time winner is just one effort removed from four straight starts in the Preferred ranks and will plummet down to NW8000L5 for tonight's tilt. He was dominant in victory the last time he got down to this level near the end of October and he has our vote of confidence to bounce back in a big way this evening.

#2 BEE TWO BEE made a first-over bid from fourth when he dropped down to this class in his latest but could not get near pacesetter Points North before he had to settle for fourth as the slight third choice in the betting at odds of 2-1. He came from a long way off the pace to grab a lesser share in fifth at the level above this the week prior and hit the board in his two previous tries in this spot. This 25-time winner will be reunited with driver Travis Cullen and will be looking to get off the schneid this season after going winless in his last 16 overall. He will work from the inside of the gate and looms as a danger.

#1 TWIN B POWERBALL sat in a loose pocket to a pumped-up Points North last week and was more than three lengths in arrears to that rival when he completed the exacta at odds of 9-1. He was also able to sit an inside trip the week before when he rounded out the superfecta at a shorter number and has hit the board in six of his last 10 since returning from a hiatus of more than eight months. This 11-time winner will likely try to push out for early position with rail control and should not be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#7 ROCKME ROLLME exits the same race as the two above and had to settle for a minor award in that dash when he was fifth at 19-1. He can benefit from racing back on a regular rotation and had hit the board in his previous two attempts at this level. This 26-time winner will have Tyler Borth aboard for the sixth time in his career and might be handled more aggressively off the gate from post-seven this time around. He can pick up a decent chunk if his trip is not too taxing and figures to offer some value on the tote board.

Race 10 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#8 ARTSALIVE disappointed as the 9/5 favorite at Flamboro Downs in NW3 on March 7th but had not raced in more than five months going into that contest. He was within three lengths of winner High Voltage Deo at the finish and went into that effort of a winning qualifier at that venue, where he scored by nearly 15 lengths in 1:57.2. This son of Artspeak will now make the transition back to the big track and went postward on this surface when he was eighth in the OSS Grassroots Final at this venue last October. He has hit the board in eight of his 23 lifetime tries and got the nod from Doug McNair. Giving him the edge in the nightcap.

#6 SHREDDAR went a long way on the lead last week before only getting picked up by a neck to Call Me It and finished third two weeks prior but was placed back to last for committing a pylon violation on the final turn. He had to qualify before that after he made back-to-back miscues in early February but finished off last season on a four-race win-streak. This son of Betterthancheddar will have the advantage of leaving from post-six and will have Jody Jamieson back aboard for the second straight start. He will likely be part of the early pace scenario once again and can be right there at the finish.

#5 HOLY JALAPENO exits the same race as the one above and rounded out the superfecta at nearly 40-1 in that tilt after sitting in the four-hole for much of the mile. He has picked up a prize in three of his last five and is just four starts removed from a runner-up finish to Sporty Bob at a big number on February 3rd. This other son of Betterthancheddar is just three for 36 so far in his career but has managed to hit the board 12 times over that span. He will slide in a few spots to the center of the gate and has been getting along well with driver Trevor Henry.

#2 CHEDDAR DUHARAS got up for the victory in the class below this on March 2nd and returned 7/5 to his backers as the definitive second choice in the betting. He has been fourth or better in his last three after missing more than a month of action following a vet scratch due to sickness and has banged home in 27 seconds flat in two of those efforts. This gelding will step up a notch on the class ladder this evening but will get to leave from another inside draw and should be confident coming into this. He can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

#10 TARQUINUS HANOVER might have been the winner at the level below this last week if he did not drift out to the outside fence in the stretch. He only missed by half a length to the pocket-sitter Mr Andreychuk as the 9/5 favorite and has hit the board in each of his last two. This son of Captaintreacherous will have to leave from a dreadful draw with post-10 and was passed over by Doug McNair in favor of our top selection. He picks up the driving services of Sylvain Filion for the first time and should not be excluded from the bottom end of the exotics.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

PLEASE NOTE:

In the unlikely event that bets can not be combined into a host track's pools before the end of a race, Federal Regulations require that such bets must be refunded. Refunding bets at some sites can affect odds and payouts at the remaining sites.

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Pari-mutuel wagering and drug control services are provided under the supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, an agency of Agriculture and the Minister of Agriculture. All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the Pari-Mutuel Betting Regulations. RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and messages on our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEWY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.

Purse payments for all Ontario racetracks will be distributed exclusively to Canadian residents through Electronic Fund Transfer (direct deposit), as of April 1, 2024.

All owners, trainers and drivers that have yet to register for EFT payments through Standardbred Canada will be required to sign-up in advance of April 1, 2024.
All completed applications must be received by March 1, 2024.
