Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



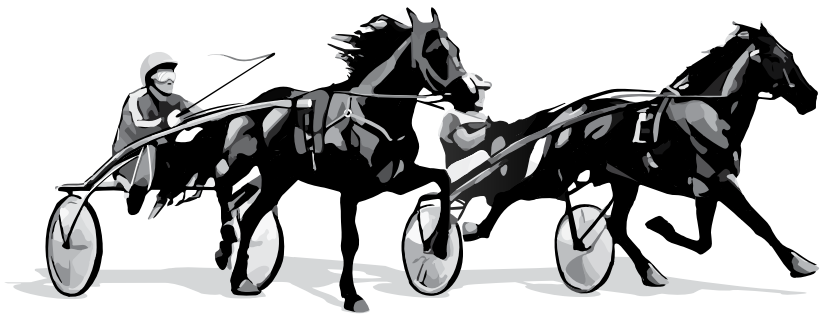
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

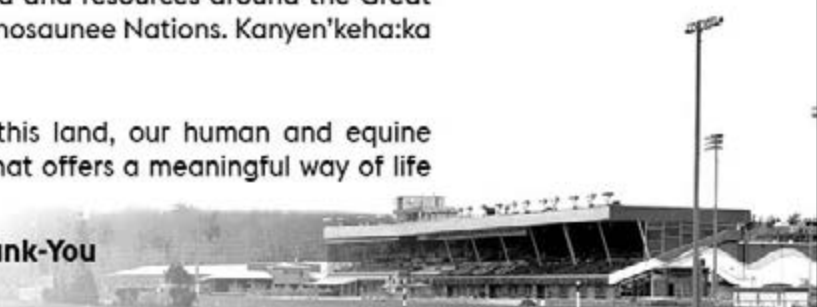

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 SHES BEER LEAGUE won five of her 23 starts last season and hit the board in 10 of those outings on her way to earning more than \$60,000. She returns to the races after a hiatus of more than four months and was victorious in her first qualifier on March 22nd when she stormed home in 27.3 of a back-half in 57.4. This daughter of Angus Hall got past Buckhead Ridge in deep stretch and that rival has already come back to be a winner. She followed that up with a decent morning prep two weeks later against a solid group and looks like she is ready to roll off the bench. Bob McClure picks up the steer and she is worth a whirl in the opener.

#1 DONATOVER took support to the tune of 8-1 last week in NW5950L5 but was never a factor after getting an overland trip from post-eight. He finished eighth by a wide margin in a race that was topped by Mister Magic and will now drop back down to the class where he claimed the show spot two starts ago. This 41-time winner rounded out the trifecta at 7-1 on that occasion but is still winless this season through 12 attempts and only has three on the board finishes. He should relish the opportunity to get back down to this spot and he will slide down to the pole position when getting Sylvain Filion back between the wheels.

#9 MAGNIFICENT SEVEN exits the same race as the one above and had to settle for a minor award in that tilt after getting away seventh off the switch. He is just four starts removed from back-to-back runner-up finishes in this class but did disappoint as the 3/5 favorite on February 16th when he could not hold off Royal Leaf in the late stages. This 18-time winner has hit the board in 47 of his 97 lifetime tries and got the vote of confidence from driver Tyler Borth. He will have to overcome a tricky draw from post-nine and can hit the ticket.

#3 MASTER GRAND marched to the lead on the backside last week after getting away in the three-hole and then quickly opened a healthy margin before getting leg weary in the lane. He faded back to third under the wire after he crawled home in 31.1. This son of Muscle Mass has been fourth or better in his last three attempts at Mohawk Park and will have Doug McNair giving the commands for the third straight start. This son of Angus Hall will start from a favorable spot on the gate and will likely try to get forwardly placed. He can grab a share.

#3 WRITE ME A ROSE was the easiest kind of winner last week after he brushed to the front on the backside and then cruised to the wire to deliver as the 6/5 favorite. He tripped the timer in 1:50.4 with a 26.3 kicker and had not raced in three weeks going into that effort after he was only beaten by a neck to Strengthfromabove at the Meadowlands in his sophomore debut. This son of Sportswriter can take another step forward when getting back on a regular rotation and is just over \$12,000 shy of \$400,000 in lifetime earnings. He will have Doug McNair aboard for an encore performance and is our clear choice on top.

#4 WHATCHULOOKIN AT disappointed at 60 cents to the dollar on March 30th at the Meadowlands when he was picked up by Adam Crocker A. He had set a hot tempo on the engine before he got picked up in the dying strides and will now be making his second start back following a layoff of more than three months. This son of Hes Watching will be making his first attempt under the care of conditioner Dave Menary and will have top teamster James MacDonald calling the shots for the first time. He will also be making a follow-up try on the lasix program and looms as a danger.

#5 NO CONTROL went four-for-eight last season and hit the board in seven of those outings on his way to more than \$90,000 in earnings. He swept through the Ontario Sired Spring Series when racing off the bench around this time last year but was placed back on the shelf in July following a couple of top three finishes at the OSS Gold level. This son of Control The Moment crushed his rivals in his most recent qualifier when he won by more than four lengths in 1:52.3 on the morning of April 1st but faces tougher competition out of the gates in his four-year-old campaign. He can still make his presence felt throughout and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#6 SPEAKER OF PEACE could only muster a minor award in fifth last week after being spotted in the second-over position on the bend for home. He was six lengths in arrears to our top selection at the finish but has hit the board in 15 of his last 18 overall. This son of Artspeak has enjoyed a successful start to his aged career with five victories and more than \$80,000 already in the bank this season. He will start from the outermost post in this compact field that packs a powerful punch and can pick up a slice if his trip is sweet enough.

#2 GIAS SURREAL took on the boys in the New Holland Pacing Series in two of her last three and was just over two lengths away from victory in the final of that added-money event despite finishing eighth in a field of 10. She was second-best to the one below eight nights earlier in this class and has earned a cheque in 11 of her last 14 overall. This 35-time winner will be reunited with driver Bob McClure and will likely be pushing forward off the gate from another inside draw. She should offer a fair price on the tote board and our call to come out on top.

#1 SETTN A PRECEDENT got away third off the gate last week and stayed on the cones before she faded back to seventh under the wire. She has finished in that position in each of her last two but was scored by two lengths at this level on March 22nd when she blasted home in 25.4 on the heels of a back-half in 54 flat over a surface that was two seconds off. This 21-time winner will have J-Mac back between the wheels this evening and that teamster has guided her to seven victories in the past. She might be able to work out a cozy trip from the pole position and should not be underestimated.

#10 WILDCAT STAR has competed in the F&M-Preferred ranks in each of her last three and was no worse than fourth in that trio of outings. She most recently rounded out the superfecta at more than 19-1 in a race that was topped by heavy-favorite Tells On A Roll and was just a length away from Style For A Mile in third two starts ago. This 10-time winner has picked up a prize in 12 of his last 13 and notched a victory at this level back in the middle of January. She will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole this time around but is in with an obvious chance if her trip is not too taxing.

#9 WESTERN WISH exits the same race as the one above and was alongside that rival at the wire having to settle for a lesser share in fourth. She only missed by half a length two weeks earlier when she rounded out the exacta behind Style For a Mile at 5/2 in a F&M-Preferred-2 and has hit the board in six of her last seven. This 25-time winner has enjoyed a resurgence for conditioner Carmen Auciello as of late and has been getting along well with driver Tyler Jones. She is another that will have to leave from a tricky spot on the gate and that is likely all that stands in her way from posting another successful result.

He was picked up from behind by both of those rivals and was within a couple of lengths of winner Duprees Hanover at the finish. This 44-time winner also claimed the show spot in the Preferred three starts ago when going up against the streaking Taurasi and will get another crack at the class where he was only beaten by half a length to Jabberwocky before that. He will work from the pole position and looks threatening.

#4 ARIO HANOVER did not have much of a chance in his latest when he dropped down to this level and got away seventh off the gate from post-nine. He was shuffled back to last on the final turn before he moved to the outside of the racetrack at the head of the lane and was able to improve a couple of spots before the wire when he blasted home in 26.2 on the heels of a back-half in 54.2. This son of Captaintreacherous will be getting a follow-up try in this class after racing in NW22000L5 off the bench on March 30th and can take a big step forward in his third start back following a layoff of more than eight months. He will slide down to a favorable spot on the gate and is among the chances.

#2 MR IBIZA N was left with a lot of work to do on March 30th in this class and was nearly 13 lengths off the lead at the midway point before he paced his back-half in 53 seconds flat with a final quarter in 26.1. He was just over two lengths away from winner American History when he completed the superfecta at 15-1 and appeared to be handled conservatively two weeks earlier when he had missed some time after a break in stride three starts ago. This son of Sunshine Beach will leave from the inside of the gate and will have Sylvain giving the commands. He might be able to help spice up the bottom end of the exotics.

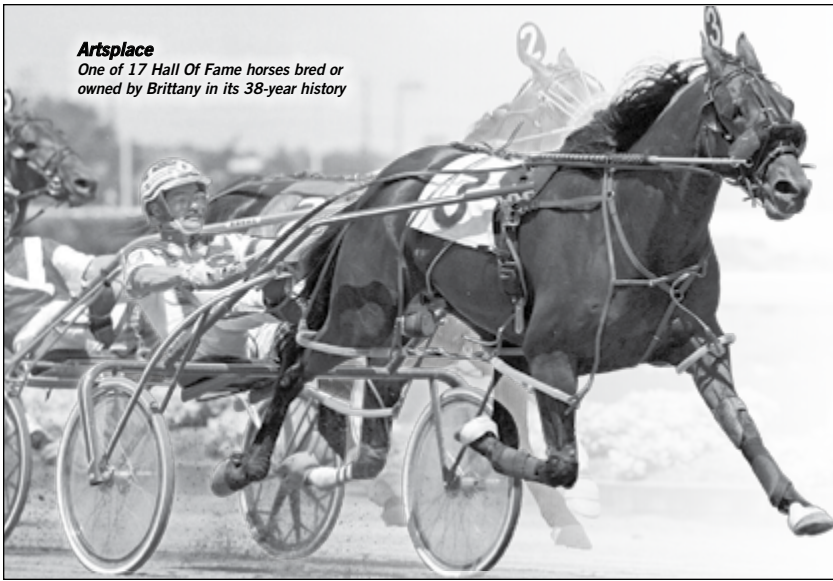

#7 KELE KELE has spent each of her last four against tougher competition in NW14000L5 or higher and will now drop back down to the level where she was second-best to Wildcat Star on March 1st. She was more than four lengths in arrears to that rival when she completed the exacta at odds of 3-1 and has picked up a prize in six of her last eight since relocating north of the border to race out of the barn of trainer Kyle Fellows. This daughter of So Surreal will have to work from post-seven for the third straight start but has enough early foot to get forwardly placed off the switch. She will likely be handled more aggressively this time out and can be right there at the finish.

#3 GLENBORO was unable to find room along the pylons until it was too late last week when she was only half a length back of Alabama Hannah at the finish. She rounded out the exacta at 9/2 after getting a perfect pocket trip for the duration of her journey and had missed a week between outings after she faded back to sixth on March 22nd after being sent to the early lead from post-10. This daughter of All Bets Off has not gotten away worse than second in her last nine overall and that tactical speed has been her best asset when hitting the board in six of her last nine. She will move in a couple of spots on the gate and figures to be in the mix throughout.

#2 IRIS SEELSTER exits the same race as the one above and was the first-over challenger in that contest after she landed in the three-hole off the switch. She was not able to get on even terms with winner Alabama Hannah before having to settle for the show spot at 5/2 but did finish her mile with a broken murphy blind. This daughter of Bettors Delight has hit the board in each of her last three and will get to come right back in this class because she will once again carry the optional claiming tag of \$50,000. She might be able to work out a favorable trip from an inside draw and cannot be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#1 DONT FREAK OUT did not have any chance when he got away ninth off the gate in the class above this last week and was more than 15 lengths off the lead at the midway point after going off at nearly 22-1 on the tote board. He has hit the board in three of his last four at this level and has been second or better in five of his last eight overall since making his sophomore debut for Team Spence. #2 CONTROL HEAVEN disappointed as the even-money favorite last week after he worked hard to get to the front in the early stages and was unable to hold off the late legs of pocket-sitter The Longest Yard in deep stretch. He was just over a length away from that rival when he paced his own mile in 1:50.4 and just held on to the place spot over the one below. This 14-time winner will be making his third attempt out of the barn of trainer Dave Menary and figures to make his presence felt throughout when working from the inside of the gate.

#10 LETS TIE ONE ON was not able to get into his best gear until it was too late in his most recent effort and just missed out on second to the one above when he blasted home in 26 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 53.3. He has taken on tougher rivals in the class above this in two of his last three and has hit the board in three of his last four at this level. This 16-time winner picks up the driving services of Brett MacDonald with Travis Cullen opting for his stablemate and will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole this time out. CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

In the unlikely event that bets can not be combined into a host track's pools before the end of a race, Federal Regulations require that such bets must be refunded. Refunding bets at some sites can affect odds and payouts at the remaining sites.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and messages on our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
