Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

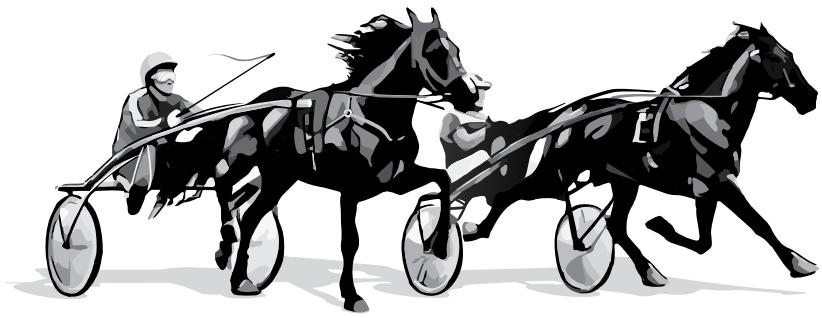
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 CLASSIC MAGIC finished fourth when taking on tougher rivals in NW4000L5 in her latest and was just over four lengths away from winner Kruse On Dover when she completed the superfecta at 19-1. She was shut out in back-to-back efforts before that but could not have been more dominant in victory in NW2000L5 on March 15th when she won by a wide margin as the even-money favorite. This daughter of Kadabra trotted her way to a new lifetime mark of 1:55.3 on that occasion and should once again enjoy getting class relief in this spot. She will leave from post-three after having the seven-hole in each of her last two and gets our nod to kick off the card.

#2 ER NORMA crushed her competition in this class last week when she scored by nearly six lengths in 1:58.2 over a track that was one second off. She converted as the 3/2 favorite and has been second or better in her last two since making a break in stride three starts ago. This daughter of Muscle Massive has hit the board in six of 12 so far this season and gets to come right back in for another crack at this class. She should appreciate sliding down to post-two and has repeat potential.

#5 TALISMANO issued a stiff challenge to the one above from the first-over position in his latest before he made a break in stride to take himself out of contention. He went a long way on the lead one week earlier before only getting caught by Lion On Landon in the shadow of the wire but has been camera-shy throughout his career with just two victories from 49 career attempts. This son of Muscle Hill has hit the board 12 times over that span and might fare better off the switch when getting back on the center of the gate. He has rebound potential and should not be left out of the exotics.

#6 TYMAL TAROT exits the same race as the two above and never saw the pylons in that contest after he got away seventh off the switch from post-nine. He was able to improve a couple of spots before the finish to earn a minor award in fifth and has picked up a prize in all of his last four. This son Kadabra has only lit the lamp in four of his 69 career attempts but has 21 top three finishes. He should relish the opportunity of leaving from the winningest post on the circuit and will have Tyler Borth back at the controls. He might play a bigger role in the early stages this time around and can pick up a decent chunk.

#5 PARISIAN BLUE CHIP moved to the lead on the backside last week and then held court until deep into the stretch when she faded back to fifth under the wire. She paced her own middle-half in 56.3 before she shortened stride to disappoint as the 8/5 favorite and had taken on tougher competition in each of her previous four, where she only managed to pick up one lesser share. This 33-time winner takes another tumble down the class ladder to NW4000L5 and was last victorious at the level above this on February 23rd. She has only gotten her picture taken three times in 46 starts over the last couple of seasons but has 14 on the board finishes over that span. Jonathan Drury stays aboard and she can come out on top against this group.

#3 BETTER BE DONNA N has been fourth or better in each of her last three since making the transition to this class and most recently completed the exacta behind stablemate Flight Crew N at odds of 5-1. She went a long way on the engine two starts ago before having to settle for the show spot and appears to be rounding back into form for conditioner Carmen Auciello. This 35-time winner picks up James MacDonald in the sulky and will likely get forwardly placed from another favorable spot on the gate with post-three. She should be in the mix throughout and can be right there at the finish.

#8 BUTTERFLY KISSES moved up to the class above this in her latest and faded back to last after being overland for part of that journey. She has won all of her last three at this level and only gets to drop back down to this spot because her optional claiming tag has been slashed in half to \$25,000. This 22-time winner will have to overcome a tricky draw from post-eight but fits in nicely with this group. She figures to offer some value on the board and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#6 TWIN B TIPSTER finished third at 7/2 last week after making a first-over move from fifth and was just half a length away from our second choice at the finish. She was left with a lot of work to do in her prior two outings when she got away last off the gate from post-nine or worse and has paced home with sub-28 second speed in five of her last seven. This 18-time winner will have Sylvain Fillion back aboard for a follow-up steer and he has piloted her to four victories in the past. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and should be included in the trifecta and super.

#6 CAPTAIN WANIA was second-best to Convoy Hall in the opening round of this series last week, albeit he was three lengths in arrears to that rival at the finish. He completed the exacta at 16-1 behind that overwhelming favorite and has been second or better in three of her last four. This son of Resolve turned a corner in early March when he enjoyed back-to-back victories in NW1 and should appreciate getting away from the one that beat him last time. He will start from the outermost post in the contest in this compact field of six and is hard to go against.

#1 THE CANAM BANKER was nearly five lengths behind the one above at the wire last week when he finished third at 27-1 in the first leg of this added-money event. He has hit the board in each of his last two and had to go up against the juggernaut that is Convoy Hall in both of those outings. This son of The Bank was an impressive winner in his lifetime debut last season but has not found the winner's circle in his nine subsequent efforts. He will work from the pole position and looks like the logical choice to round out the exacta.

#2 SLAYIN THEDAY AWAY exits the same race as the two above but did not have much of a chance in that contest when he got away last off the gate and was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He improved one spot before the wire to earn a minor award in fifth but was still a long way back of a wrapped-up winner in Convoy Hall. This son of Muscle Mass had won three of his last four at Flamboro Downs going into that effort and was only beaten by a head in NW2 on that half-mile oval three starts ago. He will slide down to the inside of the gate with post-two and might be handled more aggressively in a follow-up outing on the big track.

#3 HP MUSICAL ALARM scored by nearly three lengths at Flamboro Downs in NW1 in his latest when he made his first start out of the barn of trainer Darryl Laver. He went into that effort off a break in stride at 25 cents to the dollar the week before and he seemed to benefit from the addition of trotting hobbles. This son of Alarm Detector has lit the lamp in two of his last three and claimed the show spot at this venue on March 7th. He should be confident when returning to the larger track configuration of Mohawk Park and can grab a share.

He was spotted on second-over behind live cover on the backside and then paced his back-half in 57 seconds flat with a final quarter in 29.1 while facing a strong headwind in the stretch. This son of All Bets Off has now won three in a row and paced his way to his lifetime mark of 1:52.4 two starts ago when he doubled-up in NW2. He should be oozing confidence and can extend his streak to four in this follow-up round of the Ontario Sired Spring Series.

#2 CHALK HANOVER disappointed as the 2/5 favorite in his latest and put in some ugly steps on the final turn before having to settle for fourth in a race that was easily taken by the one below. He was an impressive winner 11 nights earlier when he got up by a neck over Timely Bet in NW1, who came back to be victorious at that level in his subsequent appearance. This son of Bettors Delight will be dangerous if comes back to that winning effort and did not appear to be a fan of the conditions in his most recent outing. He will offer an opportunity to take back value for those that supported him last time and might rebound in a big way.

#8 GIGITYGIGITYGIGTY exits the same race as the one above and was strong in victory on the front-end in that tilt when he made every call a winning one at 9/2. He has lit the lamp in each of his last two by a combined margin of nearly seven lengths and stopped the clock in 1:54.2 when he broke his maiden on April 5th in NW1. This son of Sportswriter has been getting along well with driver Tyler Borth but loses him to our top choice, who he also owns part of. He picks up a suitable replacement in Jody Jamieson and might try to ambush his rivals off the gate from post-eight.

#5 MAX PATRICK has picked up a lesser share in both of his two tries as a sophomore and was just over seven lengths back of winner Four By Four last week when he completed the superfecta at 43-1. He was fifth to the one above in NW1 before that at just 7/2 on the odds board and managed to hit the board in six of his 13 tries in his two-year-old campaign. This other son of Sportswriter will have Bob McClure aboard for a follow-up steer and might be able to work out a favorable trip when starting from post-five for the third time in four starts. He can pick up a piece.

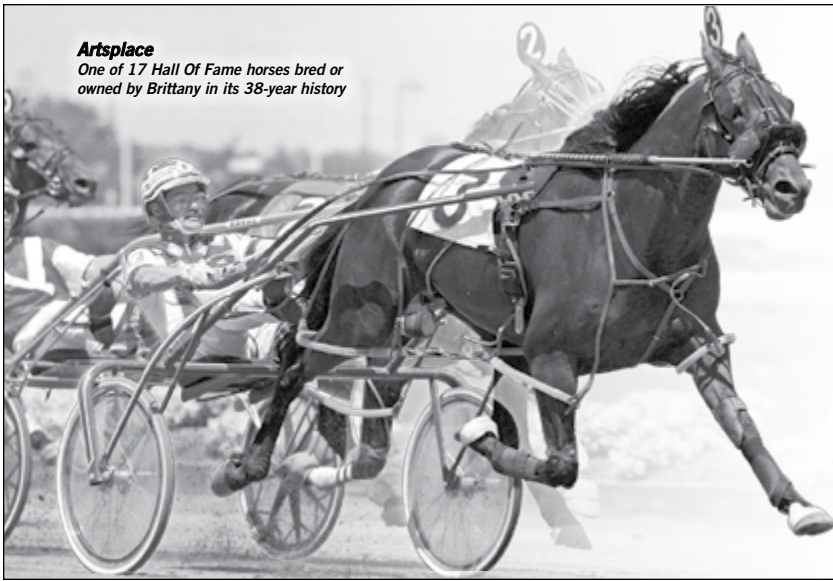

He will move in a couple of spots on the gate and will have Trevor Henry at the reins for the third consecutive appearance.

#1 EPIC DREAMER jumped it off behind the gate in the class above this last week and was never able to get back into contention before finishing ninth at 21-1. He drops back down to the level where he was only beaten by a neck in second to Hey Ralphie on March 30th and should appreciate getting back down to this spot. This son of Dover Dan will have leading driver James MacDonald in the sulky for the third straight start and will slide back down to the pole position after having the nine-hole last time out. He can be in the mix throughout and can land somewhere on the ticket if he minds his manners.

#3 MUNK was fourth to Mister Magic on April 5th at the level above this and was just over five lengths in arrears to that rival when he rounded out the superfecta at 7-1. He made a miscue four nights earlier in an even tougher spot and will now drop back down to the class where he was only beaten by a head to Cleveland Massimo on March 22nd. #4 GHOSTLY CASPER refused to lose last week when he came from off the pace to run down the one below before the wire. He got up by three quarters of a length at 6-1 in that four-year-old debut and trotted home in 28.1 off a back-half in 56.3. This son of Resolve had not raced in more than nearly six months going into that effort and hit the board in nine of 17 last year with more than \$400,000 in earnings. He notched three victories in the OSS Gold ranks as a sophomore, including the Super Final last October, and has been second or better in four of his five outings with Tyler Borth giving the commands.

#3 LIKE CHAOS disappointed at 55 cents to the dollar in his latest when he could not fend off the one above before the wire. He has been the runner-up in each of his last two but enjoyed back-to-back victories before that. This son of Lookslikeeachpndale has hit the board in five of his 10 tries at the age of four and continues to get along well with driver Trevor Henry. He will likely be prominent throughout from post-three and figures to offer a significantly better price this time around.

#8 TUSCAN PRINCE claimed the show spot behind the two above last week and was just three lengths in arrears from the winner after getting away fourth off the switch from post-two. He had not raced since he was second-best to our top choice in the OSS Super Final last October and hit the board in seven of 13 as a three-year-old, while stashing away more than \$240,000. This son of Kadabra should benefit from getting that start under his feet but will shift out to the outermost post in the contest with post-eight. He can utilize his early foot to get into a decent spot off the switch and is not without a chance.

#7 OSCEOLA went three for 13 in his sophomore campaign and hit the board in seven of those efforts on his way to earning more than \$263,000. He won his first two starts off the bench last year in the SBOA and his other victory came at the OSS Gold level later in the season in August. This son of Muscle Mass comes into this off a strong qualifying win on April 15th and trotted his mile in 1:56 flat while scoring by more than eight lengths over Salem Seelster in that morning prep. He looks like he is ready to roll off the bench but gives up a fitness edge to ones above in a race that is rich with talent.

#6 SORCHA SEELSTER hit the board in both of her outings at the age of two and was all the rage in an OSS Grassroots tilt last August when she got hammered down to 90 cents to the dollar. She had to settle for second by a neck to Make Out With Me in that dash after she drifted out in the stretch but paced her own mile in 1:52.2 in just the second start of her career. This daughter of All Bets Off took that support because she flew home in 26.3 on the heels of a back-half in 54.4 in her lifetime debut six nights earlier and will likely take the bulk of the betting again tonight after a strong qualifying victory in 1:54.3 with a 26.1 kicker on the morning of April 8th. She will get to work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and is our clear choice on top at figures to be a very short price.

#7 LADYTARIO was fourth as the 9/5 favorite last week after she challenged the pacesetter Mikis Duchess from the first-over position on the spin for home. She was more than six lengths in arrears to that rival under the wire and had not raced in nearly eight months going into that effort. This daughter of Bettors Delight should benefit from getting that effort under her feet and was third in her lifetime debut last season when she paced her own mile in 1:55.1 in a race that was won by Coco Jo Jo. She can take a step forward off her latest but will have her hands full going up against the one above.

#8 P L RINCHENIA went winless in eight tries as a rookie but finished off that campaign with a second-place finish to Quite Beachy in NW1 after taking wagering support to the tune of 5-1. She was sent off at nearly double that price or more in all of her previous outings and earned cheques in half of those appearances. This other daughter of Bettors Delight was fourth to our top pick in a qualifier on April 8th but was nine lengths behind that rival despite coming home in 27.1 off a back-half in 56 seconds flat. She was passed over by J-Mac in favor of an entrant from the McIntosh barn and picks up the driving services of Tyler Borth.

#10 SUNTAN CITY has picks up a prize in all four of her tries at the age of three so far and claimed the show spot in back-to-back efforts off the bench in March. She faded back to fifth after making an outside move in her latest and now resurfaces on the lasix program just over two weeks later. This daughter of Sunshine Beach will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole but has enough tactical speed to get into a decent position off the gate. She can grab a share.

He made a big recovery to be the runner-up to a long gone winner in Warraweeforlaura and got within five lengths of that rival when he rounded out the exacta at more than 12-1. This son of Stag Party has been second in four of his last five but did manage to get his nose on the wire first on March 14th in NW3 at Flamboro Downs on March 14th. He can come out on top this time around but will need a clean trip to do so. Giving him a whirl.

#9 TAMWORTH BOY was third to a dominant winner in Four By Four in his latest and was more than five lengths in arrears to that rival when he completed the trifecta at 4-1. He disappointed as the favorite in each of his two previous efforts but managed to claim the place spot in both of those outings. This son of All Bets Off was impressive when he won at first asking on March 15th and stopped the clock in 1:54.2 when he returned better than 3-1 to his backers. He will likely flash early foot from a tricky draw with post-nine and looms as a danger.

#7 TRICKY MCWICKY took a ton of support last week when he was hammered down to 6/5 favoritism when having J-Mac at the controls in the opening round of this series but could not get within four lengths of winner Four By Four after getting away seventh off the switch. He was 11 lengths off the lead at the midway point and paced his back-half in 56.2 with a final quarter in 28.1 but had to settle for the bottom end of the exacta. This son of McWicked has hit the board in seven of 10 in his first season of racing and has not been worse than fourth in any of those efforts. He will be reunited with his regular driver Scott Young and should not be underestimated.

#1 GREAT BET hit the board in five of seven last season and notched two victories on his way to earning more than \$25,000. He was a winner at first asking from post-seven at Grand River Raceway last July and then got his picture taken two starts later in an OSS Grassroots tilt at Kawartha Downs. This other son of All Bets Off has a pair of qualifiers to his credit and was most recently third to Coco Jo Jo on the morning of April 15th. He paced his own mile in 1:55.3 and will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald when racing off the bench.

She should be feeling good about herself coming into this and can repeat in this follow-up leg of the Canadian Graduate Series.

#5 POWDER PLAY was one we were fond of last week at 3-1 and raced well in defeat after she did a lot of the heavy-lifting for the one above in the first-over position. She was beaten by less than a length at the wire and has not missed the board in any of her last four. This daughter of Sportswriter was last victorious in a lifetime non-winners condition on March 15th and has been racing at the top of her game as of late for trainer Meg Crone. She has been getting along well with driver Jody Jamieson and can once again be right there at the finish.

#1 ONE LAST WISH won six of 16 last season and hit the board nine times on her way to banking more than \$410,000 in her sophomore campaign. She won five times at the OSS Gold level, including the Super Final last October when she stopped the clock in 1:51.4 and returned 6-1 to her supporters. This daughter of Bettors Delight has not raced since that championship event but has a pair of morning preps under her belt, including a victory on April 12th when she scored by more than a pair of lengths in 1:57.2 over a track that was two seconds off. She might need a start or two to get back into the swing of things but can still land somewhere on the ticket.

#4 MIST AMBER finished fourth last week and was just over a length away from victory when she completed the superfecta at 15-1. She notched her first victory of the season on March 22nd when she scored by three quarters of a length in NW8000L5. This daughter of Betterthancheddar tripped the timer in 1:55.1 with a 26.4 kicker and has not been worse than fourth in her last four. She had 14 top-two finishes from 29 tries last season and continues to do good things with Trevor Henry at the helm.

#4 MIKKI SIXX could not have been an easier winner in NW15000L on April 5th when she was on cruise control in the stretch before crushing her rivals by five lengths in 1:53.2 with a 27.2 kicker. She converted at just five cents to the dollar in that first start under the care of conditioner Gregg McNair and is a perfect three-for-three to kick off her career. This daughter of Always B Miki has not had to show anything close to her best yet and will only take a slight step up the class ladder to NW2. She will likely go off at the shortest of prices once again but is impossible to go against.

#3 KISS MY CHEEK went one-for-six as a rookie last season and hit the board in three of those efforts while making more than \$18,000. She notched her lone victory in one of her two attempts in condition races last August and stopped the clock in 1:53.1. This daughter of McWicked only missed a cheque in one of those efforts when she took on OSS Gold rivals at nearly 60-1 and comes into her sophomore debut with a pair of qualifiers to her credit. She blasted home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 55.2 when finishing third to Sorcha Seelster in her most recent morning prep and will be one of our main players underneath.

#7 DISTANT LOVER went three-for-three to kick off her career last season and scored by a combined margin of nine lengths over the course of those preliminary legs of the Prospect Series. She disappointed as the heavy favorite in the championship event of that lower tier of the OSS last September when she had to work from the trailing post at Grand River and has been on the shelf for more than six months coming into this. This daughter of Betterthancheddar has been a strong winner in both of her qualifiers over the last couple of weeks and will now compete on the big track for the first time under the lights. She must overcome the outermost post in the contest but will have leading driver James MacDonald calling the shots.

#5 CHEESE PARTY went one for 10 last year in her rookie campaign and hit the board in 10 of those appearances on her way to banking more than \$90,000. She was a bombs-away winner at 50-1 in the Battle of the Belles on Industry Day when she got up by a head in that signature stakes event. This other daughter of Betterthancheddar comes out of the same qualifier as our second choice and was just ahead of that rival at the finish when she was second to Sorcha Seelster. She will start from the center of the gate and can pick up a slice.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#1 LITTLEBEARCAT rallied from off the pace to be third last week after she got away last off the gate from post-nine in a race that was easily taken by the frontrunning favorite Big Diamond. She was nearly 15 lengths off the lead at the opening marker and rounded out the trifecta at 8-1. This 24-time winner has not missed a cheque in her last seven overall and has hit the board in three of those outings. She will have Doug McNair and will slide down to the pole position after having the nine-hole last time out. Giving her the edge in the nightcap.

#2 TAKEYOURBREATHAWAY was left with a lot of work to do when she got away ninth off the switch in NW4700L5 on April 5th and made a late break in stride in that contest where she was sent off at odds of 50-1. She hit the board in three straight at Flamboro Downs prior to that and has five top three finishes from eight outings this season. This 23-time winner should appreciate dropping down a notch on the class ladder and will work from an inside draw after having tricky starting spots in each of her last two. She figures to offer a sizable number on the board and has upset potential.

#6 DARKRSHADEOFFALE N exits the same race as our top selection and was overland for much of that mile before moving into the place spot in deep stretch. She was still more than two lengths in arrears to the winner Big Diamond but added some serious value to the ticket when she rounded out the exacta at nearly 38-1. This 34-time winner will have Jonathan Drury aboard for a follow-up steer and will have the luxury of leaving from post-six this time around. She will likely be making noise when it matters most and can once again hit the ticket.

#7 SWEET LOVING picked up a lesser share at 34-1 when taking on tougher rivals last week but was more than eight lengths back of winner Flight Crew N at the wire. She should appreciate getting down to face a softer bunch this evening but did disappoint as the 1/9 favorite on March 21st when she could not hold off Fated Fire in a condition claiming event. This daughter of Sweet Lou fits in nicely with this group but was passed over by Travis Cullen in favor of the one below. Trevor Henry picks up the steer and she will likely make her presence felt at some point in the mile.

#3 ALLSTAR FINEST was handled aggressively in the early stages of her latest when she rocketed to the lead from post-eight and then closely attended legit fractions on the backside when race-favorite Big Diamond came around to take control. She faded back to fifth at the finish at 21-1 but is just two starts removed from only getting beaten by a neck in NW4000L5. This daughter of Betterthancheddar will slide down to post-three for tonight's tilt and might benefit from getting a softer trip. She retains Travis Cullen in the sulky and should not be dismissed.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and messages on our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEWY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
