# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

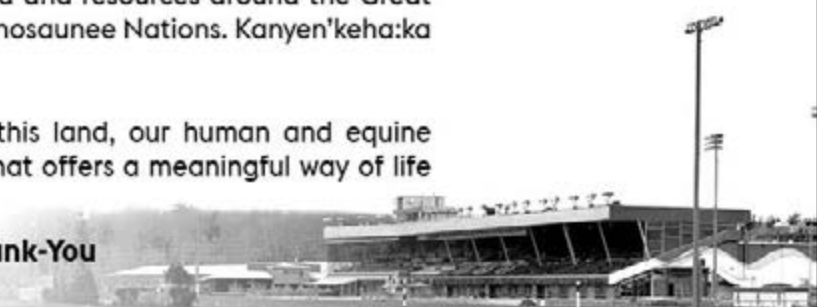

**Race 1 Selections**

**THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.**

**#5 NIJINSKY** went one for 10 last year as a rookie but hit the board six times on his way to earning just under \$100,000. His lone victory came in NW1 last August but he hit the board in three of his five tries at the OSS Gold level and blasted home in 25.4 on the heels of a back-half in 54 seconds flat to be fourth in his elimination for the Breeders Crown at Hoosier Park to conclude that campaign. This son of Bettors Delight paced home in that split on three occasions and will now tackle a condition event for the second time in his career when making his first attempt as a three-year-old. He was a runner-up to both Funtime Bayama and Legendary Hanover, respectively, in a pair of qualifiers in preparation for his return to the races and will likely offer a price of the shortest variety to kick off the card.

**#3 LOUS WORLD** could not have been an easier winner last week when he cruised to an open lengths score in NW1 and returned 2-1 to his backers as the clear second choice in the wagering. He got away fourth off the switch and brushed to the lead on the spin for home before quickly opening a wide margin in the early part of the stretch drive. This son of Sweet Lou was wrapped-up when he tripped the timer in 1:52.2 with a 26.4 kicker and will make the difficult transition upwards to NW2 in his second start back after a layoff of more than seven months. He should be confident coming into this and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#1 WARRAWEEFORLAURA** has won four of his last five and most recently rebounded his way back to the winner's circle in the final of the Ontario Sired Spring Series on April 27th. He left hard from post-seven to secure a pocket trip behind Your Party and had a ringside seat for a battle that ensued on the engine before sailing past his rivals in the stretch. This son of All Bets Off stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:51.4 and has not missed the board in any of his six tries as a sophomore. He has missed a week between outings but can land somewhere on the ticket when getting back to an overnight event.

**#7 CHALK HANOVER** exits the same race as the one above and rallied from off the pace to round out the exacta at odds of 9-1. He was more than 10 lengths off the lead at the midway point and stepped his back-half in 55.2 with a final quarter in 28.1. This other son of Bettors Delight was fourth or better in all three legs of the Ontario Sired Spring Series after breaking his maiden in his sophomore debut on April 1st in NW1 and retains leading driver James MacDonald when competing in NW2 for the first time. He will likely need fractions to run at but should not be left off the bottom end of the trifecta or super.

**#9 COMMAND** took support to the tune of 9/5 in a Preferred-2 on April 27th and went a long way on the lead in that contest before fading back to seventh under the wire. He took that action at the windows after he got cemented on the pylons in this class the week prior in his circuit debut when he disappointed as the 2-1 favorite and blew his competition away in a qualifier just five days before that. This son of Captaintreacherous scored by more than six lengths in that morning prep when he stopped the clock in 1:52.1 and should much prefer the company he keeps when getting back down against more palatable foes in his third attempt under the care of conditioner Marie Helene Dupont. He will have Sylvain Filion between the wheels for a third straight start and has our top honors against this group.

**#8 JABBERWOCKY** has gone postward in the Preferred ranks in each of his last three and was only beaten by a neck to Emmetts Buddy on April 13th when he completed the exacta at odds of 8-1. He has hit the board in seven of his last 11 and was second-best to Saulsbrook Victor in his most recent try at this level, albeit he was nearly four lengths in arrears to that rival at the finish. This 11-time winner has not raced in a few weeks and his last two victories came at the level below this. His stock rises if he blasts off the wings of the gate from post-eight but he typically does his best work when racing on a regular rotation.

**#10 CONTROL HEAVEN** was a lights-out winner in NW15500L5 last week when racing off the claim for high-percentage trainer Malik Smith and he held a healthy margin throughout before pacing his mile in a season's best clocking of 1:50.2. He has won his last two by a combined margin of more than seven lengths and will now take a steep climb up the class ladder to the top condition level. This 16-time winner will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole this time around and will have Jody Jamieson giving the commands for the first time. He should be brimming with confidence and tripling-up is not out of the question.

**#7 THE LONGEST YARD** was taken back to seventh off the switch in the Preferred-2 last week and was eighth at the head of the stretch before getting past a couple of rivals in the late stages. He was still more than four lengths back of winner Saulsbrook Victor after he paced home in 26.2 off a back-half in 53 seconds flat but was fourth or better in three of his previous four when going postward in the condition ranks. This 14-time winner was passed over by Louis-Philippe Roy in favor of our second choice but picks up a familiar face in Jonathan Drury. He will have options off the gate from post-seven and can pick up a decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

**#5 LEGENDARY HANOVER** won six of nine in his two-year-old campaign and only finished out of the top two on one occasion while banking more than \$400,000. He was unbeaten through the first six outings of his career and scored by a combined margin of 18 lengths during that win-streak before falling to defeat for the first time as the even-money favorite in the final of the Metro Pace. This son of Huntsville missed nearly a month of action before finishing second in his elimination for the Breeders Crown but finished ninth in the final after getting used hard from post-nine in the early stages. He comes into his sophomore debut with a 1:50.2 qualifying score to his credit and blasted home in 25.4 or faster in both of his recent morning preps. Giving him top billing but he figures to have all of the wagering tilted in his direction.

**#8 SOUTHWIND SAMBUCCA** was on the verge of taking over command in the first turn last week after moving forward with authority off the gate from post-seven but self-destructed when he made a break in stride. He was distanced from his foes the rest of the way before finishing last of nine at odds of 2-1 and took that support because he was dominant in victory the week prior when he equalled his lifetime mark of 1:50.4. This son of American Ideal has hit the board in five of his last eight since he relocated north of the border to race out of the barn of trainer Victor Puddy. He will be reunited with driver Trevor Henry and looks like a logical choice to complete the exacta.

**#4 NAZARE** went forward off the gate from post-10 in his latest but had to take a tuck in fourth after briefly being stacked-up three-wide on the first turn. He elected to stay on the pylons on the backside and was cemented on the inside on the bend for home before rallying for third at 6-1. This son of Sweet Lou has hit the board in 10 of his last 12 since he shipped north of the border to race back under the care of conditioner Dave Menary and has lit the lamp twice over that span. He was Louis-Philippe Roy's choice over the one above and should appreciate getting major post-relief with the four-hole.

**#7 KOPI LUWAK** came from a long way off the pace to be third in this class last week and was more than 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole after he got away last from post-nine. He paced his back-half in 52.3 with a final panel in 26.1 and has now been fourth or better in four of his last six. This son of Stay Hungry will move in a couple of spots on the gate after having to work from the nine-hole in each of his last two and will have Doug McNair back at the controls after getting the nod over Saulsbrook Ian. He might be closer to the action this time around and is worth including on the bottom end of the exotics.

**#5 WILLYS HOME RUN** cruised to victory in the elimination this stakes event last week and came from off the pace to deliver as the odds-on choice at 1/5 in that sophomore debut. She tripped the timer in 1:56.1 with final quarter speed of 26.3 and had not raced in nearly seven months going into that effort. This daughter of Archangel was a perfect six-for-six at the OSS Gold level last season and has not missed the board in any of her 11 lifetime tries. She should benefit from getting her latest effort under her feet and is hard to look past at what will surely be a price of the shortest variety.

**#6 P L RAINBOW DASH** exits the same race as the one above and followed that rival around the racetrack in seventh but had to settle for a minor award in fifth at 10-1. She was just over four lengths behind that short-priced winner when she trotted her back-half in 55.3 and only had one morning prep under her belt that came more than three weeks before that return to the races. This daughter of Resolve capped off her rookie season with a clean sweep of the Harvest Series last October and was third best in the OSS Super Final before that after getting away second from the pole position. She can raise her game significantly in this spot and will be our main player underneath.

**#3 R LIZA** advanced to the final of this stakes event in style when she scored by nearly three lengths in her elimination and lowered her lifetime best clocking by three ticks when she stopped the clock in 1:55.4. She got away third with rail control in that dash and then dusted her rivals from the first-over position by trotting her back-half in 55.2 with a final quarter in 27.2. This daughter of Muscle Mass has only finished out of the top two on two occasions and two of those performances came when she made breaks in stride in the early stages. She came out on top in three of her first four tries at the age of two and might be in store for similar success out of the gates in her sophomore campaign.

**#1 LOVE THOSE LEGS** comes out of the same elimination as the one above and chopped-out the first three panels before the one above came to call on the final turn. She was unable to stay with that rival in the lane but was clearly the best of the rest when finishing more than five lengths ahead of No Need For Alarm in third. This daughter of Kadabra returned nearly 3-1 to her backers when she emerged victorious in her first start as a three-year-old in NW1 on April 18th and can benefit from racing back on a regular rotation. She will have Chris Christoforou calling the shots this evening because Louis-Philippe Roy is obligated to drive his charge and she can pick up a slice.

**#4 PASS LINE** converted at 45 cents to the dollar last week after she slingshotted off her cover from the second-over position and she was shut down long before she crossed the wire in 1:51.1. She prepped for that sophomore debut with a pair of qualifiers at the Meadowlands and has now won 11 of 14 in her career, never missing the board in any of those efforts. This daughter of All Bets Off only tasted defeat once in the OSS Gold ranks last season and is just over \$5,000 shy of \$700,000 in lifetime earnings. She will be reunited with Louis-Philippe Roy and he guided her to four victories in her first five starts as a rookie.

**#5 ITS A LOVE THING** was left with a lot of work to do in her elimination and was nearly 12 lengths off the lead at the opening marker after getting away seventh off the switch. She was third-over on the spin for home and had to settle for second to the one below, despite blazing home in 25.3 on the heels of a back-half in 52.2. This daughter of Bettors Delight came home in that same split in her lone qualifier one week earlier and retains the services of leading driver James MacDonald. She figures to be activated much sooner in the mile this time around and looks like the biggest threat to her stablemate above.

**#6 SORCHA SEELSTER** exits the same race as the one above and did not advance in the first-over position until it mattered most in the stretch drive. She forged past the frontrunners and then kept our second choice at bay by half a length under the wire and has not finished worse than second in any of her three attempts as a sophomore. This other daughter of All Bets Off should appreciate working from the winningest post at Mohawk Park after having the eight-hole in each of her last two and will likely make her presence felt in the late stages. She continues to make good progress for trainer John Pentland and can hit the ticket.

**#9 LIGHTNING LIZZIE** produced a valiant effort to be second to our top pick last week and never got a breather in the first three panels before only getting beaten by less than a length to that odds-on choice in the betting. She paced her own mile in 1:51.2 and still managed to pace home in 27.1 after she had to make multiple moves in the early stages. This daughter of Betterthancheddar was a perfect three-for-three to begin her career before that defeat and can be dangerous if she can work out an easier trip. She must overcome a tricky draw from post-nine and the bottom end of the exotics is likely her ceiling. Brett MacDonald picks up the steer.

**#4 CONVOY HALL** is a perfect six-for-six to kick off his career and did not appear to break a sweat in any of those victories. He has scored by a combined margin of more than 28 lengths during his win-streak and most recently trotted his way to a new lifetime mark of 1:55.2 when he took down the final of the Ontario Sired Spring Series as the 1/9 favorite. This son of Muscle Mass will now get his first major test when facing the toughest field he has seen so far but certainly appears to be up to the challenge. He will likely offer a better price than he has gone off at in any of his prior efforts and we are not willing to jump off his bandwagon just yet.

**#7 WILLOWTIME** got his picture taken in four of his five appearances last year as a rookie and might have been perfect in that campaign if he did not make a break in stride on the lead at the head of the stretch in an OSS Gold tilt last September. He rebounded his way to the winner's circle in the Super Final a couple of weeks later and banked more than \$355,000 at the age of two. This son of Looklikeeachpndale jumped it off on a sloppy track in his first qualifier this season but then put the trotting hobbles back in a third morning prep on May 3rd and won by as much as he pleased in 1:54.3 with a 27.2 kicker. He will likely not go down without a fight but gives up a fitness edge to the one above.

**#6 WHAT ABOUT ELMO** only tasted victory in one of his nine attempts last season but hit the board in five of those efforts when he stashed away just under \$90,000. He was no worse than third in each of his last five appearances and claimed the show spot to the one above at 31-1 last October. This son of Il Sogno Dream was on the improve when he got deeper into that two-year-old campaign and posted a couple of strong qualifying wins at Spring Garden Ranch in Florida when getting ready for his return to the races. He has gotten along well with driver Tyler Jones and might be able to help spice things up at a price.

**#9 GRIFF** was three-for-seven last season and only missed a couple of cheques on his way to earning \$223,200. He made a miscue in an OSS Grassroots contest in his lifetime debut but then won two in a row after that and struck gold for the first time in early September. This other son of Muscle Mass earned a minor award in the Mohawk Million and finished his season off by being the runner-up to our second choice in the Super Final. He will be reunited with J-Mac for this SBOA stakes event but must leave from a tricky spot on the gate with post-nine.

**#3 FUNTIME BAYAMA** pushed out for the early pocket in his sophomore debut last week and then moved to the lead on the backside before pacing away from his rivals in the lane. He was shut down in the dying strides before he tripped the timer in 1:51.2 and still managed to fire home in 25.4 off a back-half in 55 seconds flat. This son of Hes Watching won each of his first four attempts with Sylvain Filion at the reins last season but then disappointed as the 1/9 favorite in the OSS Super Final in his final start at the age of two. He looks like he is back at the top of his game for top trainer Richard Moreau and can take another step forward when the chips are down in the final.

**#5 STONEBRIDGE THRILL** was moving best of all in the late stages of his elimination but was at a major pace disadvantage in that mile when he got away last off the gate from post-three. He was more than nine lengths off the lead at the opening marker in a race that was stolen on the front-end by Enforcer and got within a length of that rival in second after he paced his back-half in 55.3 with a final panel in 26 seconds flat. This son of Bettors Delight came home one tick quicker the week prior when having more work to do in a lifetime non-winners condition and will likely have a lot more pace to chase this evening. He has hit the board in six of his 10 career attempts and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#10 STORM SHADOW** blasted to the early lead last week before he released our top selection to the front on the backside before going back on the attack out of the pocket on the bend for home. He was not able to go with that rival in the stretch but still managed to secure third at odds of 9/2. This other son of Bettors Delight had not raced in more than six months going into that effort and has now hit the board in nine of his 12 lifetime tries with nearly \$380,000 in earnings. He should benefit from getting that effort under his feet but now must overcome the dreaded 10-hole this evening.

**#6 UNRIVALED HANOVER** exits the same race as the one above and was the one that split him and the favorite when he managed to get within a length of the winner at the wire. He rounded out the exacta at 29-1 after sitting a cozy trip in the three-hole for most of the mile but would not have likely got so close to our first choice if he was not geared down at the finish. This colt has been no worse than second in eight of his nine starts in his career and was only beaten by a head in the OSS Grassroots Final last September after being a mainstay in that tier of the Ontario program. He will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and is worth utilizing on the bottom end of the exotics.

**#7 SINATRA HANOVER** had four top-two finishes in seven starts last season and enjoyed back-to-back victories in the OSS Grassroots in August. He was stuck behind a wall of horses in his semi-final last September and was climbing over foes in the lane but missed out on getting to the championship event. This son of Bettors Delight had to take on a couple of tough groups in his two qualifiers and appeared well-within himself in his most recent morning prep when he finished 13 lengths in arrears to Legendary Hanover. He stepped his own mile in 1:53.2 and got the nod from Tyler Borth over the one below.

**#3 PRICE CONTROL** has hit the board in all four of his attempts as a sophomore and was in tight quarters in the dying strides last week when he got up for the place by the slimmest of margins over the one below. He rallied from a long way off the pace to be third in the final of the Ontario Sired Spring Series the week prior and only got caught by half a length by Max Patrick in the second round of that series when he completed the exacta at 34-1. This son of Control The Moment should appreciate leaving from post-three after having the eight-hole or worse in his last two but loses Tyler Borth to the one above. He will be reunited with driver Sylvain Filion and looms a danger.

**#1 WATCHING SUNSET** exits the same race as the one above and was nosed out for second by that rival at the wire. He moved three-wide around his stalled cover on the turn for home and might have fared better if he did not get steppy in the early part of the stretch drive. This son of Hes Watching was impressive in victory on April 25th when scored by more than two expanding lengths and stopped the clock in 1:52.2 with a 26.3 kicker. He will once again work from the pole position and can be in the mix throughout.

**#4 ONYX BOVINO** was overland for much of the mile last week in his sophomore debut and was the best of the rest in a race that was dominated by Lous World. He did well to nearly get within a few lengths of that rival and paced home in 26.2 off a back-half in 54.2. This other son of Bettors Delight went into that effort off a strong qualifying performance on April 26th and can take a step forward with that effort under his belt. He will have Louis-Philippe Roy aboard for a follow-up steer and is not without a chance.

**#6 LINEDRIVE HANOVER** set suicidal fractions in the final of the Borgata Pacing Series at Yonkers and battled Desperate Man around the racetrack before fading back to seventh under the wire. He won three of his four preliminary legs and was no worse than second in any of those efforts. This son of Betting Line has since shipped north of the border to return to the care of conditioner Tony Beaton and will race on this surface for the first time since September of last year. He has missed nearly three weeks between outings but will have the luxury of leaving from post-six when he gets reunited with top teamster James MacDonald. Giving him the edge.

**#2 TAURASI** had his win-streak snapped at nine when he finished third in the Wizard Invitational at Miami Valley in Ohio last week and was three lengths in arrears to Carbine when he rounded out the trifecta as the second choice in the betting at 8/5. He has shipped back north of the border to once again compete out of the barn of top trainer Richard Moreau after that jaunt stateside and has not tasted defeat in any of his last nine here at Mohawk Park. This 19-time winner will be reunited with driver Doug McNair and has been nothing short of electric around these parts. It will likely come down to a two-horse affair between our top two selections and he can be right there at the finish.

**#7 EMMETTS BUDDY** powered past his foes in the late stages of a Preferred-2 on April 27th and delivered as the 3/5 odds-on choice when he stopped the clock in 1:50.3. He has won two of his three attempts as a five-year-old and his only defeat over that span came at the hooves of the one above when he bested him by three quarters of a length in this class on April 20th. This 21-time winner had a stellar campaign last year when he hit the board in 22 of his 36 attempts to bank over \$224,000 and has continued that success into this season. He has been racing at the top of this game for conditioner Mike Kwietniowski and can hit the ticket.

**#5 SAULSBROOK VICTOR** got back into the win-column in a Preferred-2 last week when he scored by three parts of a length and tripped the timer in a lifetime mark equalling 1:49.2 with a 26.4 kicker. He has been no worse than second in his last two at that level but now must take on tougher rivals in the top pacing class on the circuit. This son of Source Of Pride went over the \$500,000 lifetime earnings milestone in that most recent victory but a lesser share is likely his ceiling this evening. He should be included on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

This son of Captaintreacherous will not have to worry about the one that beat him last time and will once again work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park. He looks primed for a big effort this evening and looms as a major danger.

**#8 RON** has disappointed as the favorite in each of his last two in this class and was overland for much of the mile in his latest before having to settle for the show spot at 5/2. He briefly made front in the lane two back in a Hi-5 mandatory payout event but was gobbled up by American History in deep stretch and had to settle for second at 95 cents to the dollar. This son of Sportswriter is winless through six tries this season and has been known to be camera-shy in his career with eight victories from 63 attempts. He has hit the board 33 times over that span and adding to that total is likely in the cards for him tonight.

**#2 ROCKABILLY REBEL N** was unable to get into the race last time out when the fractions were sensible on the engine and had to settle for sixth despite blasting home in 25.3 off a back-half in 53.2. He was only beaten by three quarters of a length two starts ago when he also stormed home from off the pace and has earned a cheque in 11 of his last 13 overall. This 17-time winner will have Sylvain Filion back between the wheels after Doug McNair opted for our top selection and will likely be at the mercy of what happens up front. He can grab a share.

**#2 SERGEANT SLAUGHTER** has won two in a row since being freshened-up for three months and scored by a combined margin of more than 12 lengths over those two dominant scores. He held a healthy margin throughout last week here at Mohawk Park and lowered his lifetime mark by more than three seconds when he stopped the clock in 1:51.2. This son of Big Jim will get another crack at this class and has now hit the board in four of his five tries since moving to the care of conditioner Jodie Cullen. He figures to be brimming with confidence and can make it three in a row.

**#6 TARQUINUS HANOVER** looked like the only one that might be able to issue a challenge to the one above in his latest but made an untimely break in stride when moving out of the pocket and then scattered the field behind him. It likely did not have an impact on who the winner would be but did cause a mess for the underneath finishers and was placed back to eighth after initially claiming the show sit at 3-1. This son of Captaintreacherous walked away empty-handed in his previous three attempts in the class above this but got his picture taken at this level on March 23rd. He fits in nicely with this group but must mind his manners to have any chance.

**#10 BETTHEBEACH YANKEE** was deemed to have broken equipment before the start last week when he lost a shoe before the word go and ended up being a pari-mutuel refund. He got away seventh off the gate and was nearly 13 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before pacing his back-half in 55.3 with a final panel in 27.3. This son of Betting Line won two in a row before that in softer spots and has now been stymied with the outermost post for tonight's tilt. He might be able to make some noise when it matters most and is worth including in the underneath positions.

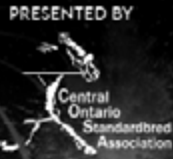

**#5 KAPTAIN KARLOS** is winless through 15 attempts this season but has hit the board in 11 of those efforts and by all rights has raced too good to not have his picture taken yet in 2024. He was the runner-up to Do Better in his latest when he was sent off as the 7/5 favorite and just got clipped by Always A Thrill two starts ago when he paced his own mile in 1:50.2. This son of Captaintreacherous is just three for 43 in his career but has 26 top three finishes over that span. His tactical speed usually puts him in a favorable position and we are hoping he can get off the schneid in this spot.

**#7 CHAIN GANG** disappointed as the 3/2 favorite in his elimination for the SBOA last week and was unable to issue a serious challenge to Enforcer after he vacated the pylons to go on the attack in the first-over position from third. He could only get as far as second before he faded back to last in the stretch but can take a step forward tonight after getting that outing under his feet. This son of Bettors Delight will transition to a lifetime non-winners condition class and he got the nod from J-Mac over his stablemate below. He can rebound with a better effort in this spot but will give the edge to the one above.

**#9 LEAVE IT TO LEO** was third to Saulsbrook Ian at this level last week and was just over a length away from that rival when he completed the trifecta at odds of 7/2. He had not gone postward since September 9th of last season when he came out on top of his OSS Grassroots Semi-Final but was then scratched out of the championship event due to sickness. This other son of Bettors Delight lit the lamp in six of his eight tries at the age of three and has a maturity edge over his stablemate above. He picks up the driving services of Tyler Borth and only post-nine stands in his way of another positive result.

**#3 BOB LOBLAW** will make his much-awaited return to the races after an absence of nearly two years. He only made a trio of starts at the age of three but paced to his lifetime mark of 1:50.3 in his elimination for the SBOA before having to settle for a minor award in the final. This son of Sunshine Beach blew up the tote board at 37-1 in the OSS Super Final at the age of two and has three on the board finishes from 15 career attempts with over \$250,000 in earnings. He has one of the best names in all of harness racing but he might need a couple of starts under his belt to get back in the swing of things.

**#2 SMOKESTACK** delivered as the even-money favorite in a condition claimer on May 2nd here at Mohawk Park and has been a dominant winner in each of his last three since moving to the barn of trainer Brett Lester. He is riding a three-race win-streak as he produced a gutsy effort for conditioner/driver Braiden Reibeling at Western Fair on April 22nd and will now take on much tougher rivals this evening. This son of Sweet Lou should be oozing confidence but he faces a tall order to get on the business-end of this dash. He can pick up a prize but a smaller one is most likely.

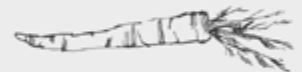

### CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

#### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

**FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMENDMENT**

In the unlikely event prices are posted based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must stop paying those prices as soon as the error is discovered. The corrected prices will then be calculated and paid, including the correction of all account-based wagers. This change in the Regulations reflects existing standards in the United States.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

In the unlikely event that bets can not be combined into a host track's pools before the end of a race, Federal Regulations require that such bets must be refunded. Refunding bets at some sites can affect odds and payouts at the remaining sites.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

### SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEWY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
