Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



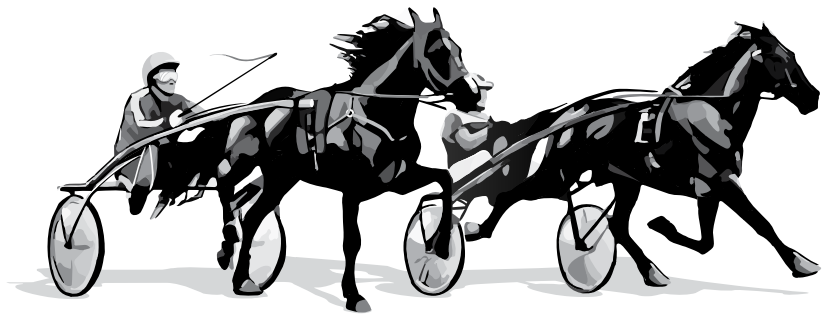
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#10 DRAGONONTHEBEACH was fourth in the Camluck Classic at The Raceway in London and was just over three lengths in arrears to odds-on favorite Hellabalou at the finish. He also earned a minor award by finishing fifth in this class on May 25th and was lights-out in victory before that when he tripped the timer in 1:49.2 in the top condition class. This 13-time winner blasted home in 26 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 53.1 and will be reunited with driver Tim Tetrick but must overcome the dreaded 10-hole. He has proven to be versatile in his racing style and gets our nod to kickoff the card.

#3 WRITE ME A ROSE got away fourth off the gate in this class last week and stayed on the cones before being within four lengths of AbuckabettHanover in sixth at 32-1. He paced his own mile in 1:50.2 over a track that was one second off and rallied for a lesser share the week before at the level below this when he fired home in 25.4 on the heels of a back-half in 53.2. This 10-time winner is just two starts removed from a dominant victory in NW23500L5 when he converted as the even-money favorite and will have Andrew McCarthy aboard for a follow-up steer. He moves out one spot on the gate to post-three and can be right there at the wire.

#8 WHEELS ON FIRE secured a pocket trip behind a pumped-up Saulsbrook Victor in his latest and was clearly the best of the rest when more than two lengths clear of Livinthebeachlife in third. He got his picture taken for the first time this season two starts ago when he tripped the wire in 1:49.3 in NW14200L5 and has been second or better in each of his last three. This 48-time winner has taken some time to find his best stride after being sidelined following an accident in the Mohawk Gold Cup on this night last year but has looked a lot more like his old self in recent efforts. He will likely try to get forwardly placed from an outside draw and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#4 CONTROL HEAVEN has been fourth in each of his last two in the Preferred ranks after he sparked an upset from post-10 in the top condition class on May 18th. He went all the way on the lead before holding on by a head at 16-1 and has scored in two of his last five since getting claimed for \$38,000 by high-percentage trainer Malik Smith. This 17-time winner will have options off the gate from post-four and will have Dexter Dunn at the controls for the third time in his career. He should not be left out of the exotics in what appears to be a very competitive dash to kick off the card.

#3 LOGAN PARK has lit the lamp in three of his four appearances this season and scored by a combined margin of more than 10 lengths in those victories. His only defeat over that span came when he could not hold off Gaines Hanover as the 1/5 favorite on May 13th after sitting in the three-hole in the early stages but has been electric on the front-end in his last two since then. This 27-time winner has gotten his picture taken in eight of his last 10 overall and has been a dominant force in the top trotting class around these parts for over a year. He will likely flash his early foot from the same starting spot he had last time out and is hard to look past.

#2 LEXUS KODY has won five of his last six at the Meadowlands and was only beaten by a head in his most recent effort over that one-mile oval when Benjamin Hanover got past him out of the pocket. He stepped his way to his lifetime mark of 1:50 flat on March 30th and will now return north of the border to the venue where he spent 16 of his first 18 career attempts. This 21-time winner is just under \$16,000 shy of \$500,000 in lifetime earnings but has not raced in nearly a month coming into this. He gives up a fitness and home field advantage to the one above but will still be one of our main players underneath.

#5 FASHION FRENZIE sat a two-hole trip to our top selection last week but could not stay with that rival before he lost a position in the stretch to finish third. He still managed to trot home in 26.3 when stepping his own mile in 1:52 flat but was three ticks quicker two weeks earlier when he beat up on a field that was void of that foe. This 25-time winner delivered at 60 cents to the dollar on that occasion and will now be making his fourth start off the shelf after a layoff of more than six months. He is just over \$14,000 shy of \$1.2M in earnings and has rebound potential.

#1 OSCEOLA has won three in a row in the Canadian Graduate Series and trotted to a new lifetime mark of 1:52.1 when the chips were down in the final of that added-money event on June 1st. His only defeat at the age of four came when he was racing off the bench on April 19th and he was only a length away from Ghostly Casper in second after suffering interference in the stretch. This son of Muscle Mass is off to a great start in his aged career but now must take on tougher competition when venturing into deeper waters in the Open trotting ranks. He loses Doug McNair to our top pick and picks up the driving services of Trevor Henry.

#6 BLUEMEA KISS catapulted out of the pocket in NW8000L5 last week and then marched away from her rivals when running up the score by nearly six lengths at the wire at odds of 5-1. She sizzled her way to a new lifetime mark of 1:50.1 with a 27.2 kicker and came home one tick faster the week prior when she won off a similar trip in the class below that. This daughter of Heston Blue Chip will take another step up the class ladder but is a perfect two-for-two since being freshened-up for nearly a month. She loses Jody Jamieson to Powder Play and will have Dexter Dunn between the wheels for the first time. Getting back on her bandwagon and hoping for another sizable number.

#7 HUNTRESS was moving well at the end of her mile in her latest after she got away last off the gate from post-10 and was nearly 15 lengths off the lead at the opening marker. She improved to sixth in the stretch after she stepped home in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 53.1 and likely needed a braving effort after setting torturous fractions on the engine when racing off a layoff of more than two months on May 31st. This 32-time winner will slide in a few spots on the gate to the seven-hole and figures to be more lively in the early stages this time around. She will likely have plenty of admirers and looks threatening.

#1 ANGOSTURA HANOVER was first-over for a long way last week after getting away sixth off the switch from post-nine and eventually got past pacesetter Gias Surreal but had to settle for the show spot in a race where Shes Got It All rode the cones to victory. She disappointed as the lukewarm favorite in that dash but has hit the board in four of her last five and rallied nicely to be fourth two back after she was taken back to last from the dreaded 10-hole. This daughter of Betting Line slides back down to the pole position and has hit the board in 13 of her 17 tries this season. She can be closer to the action in the early going this evening and figures to get every chance to hit the ticket.

#4 STYLE FOR A MILE exits the same race as the two above and stayed put in the three-hole in that contest before she skimmed the pylons to be second to longshot winner Shes Got It All. She has hit the board in each of her last two since dropping back down to this level and is just seven starts removed from a victory in a Preferred-2. This 15-time winner was victorious in this class in the middle of February and will get to move out three spots off the rail for tonight's tilt. She will likely get forwardly placed and can be in the mix throughout.

#6 FAST LOUIE tried his luck in the Somebeachsomewhere on June 1st and was in a loose pocket to winner Funtime Bayama for much of that mile before having to settle for the show spot when Legendary Hanover emerged to be second. He paced his own mile in 1:49.4 when he rounded out the trifecta at 49-1 and was riding a two-race win-streak going into that effort. This son of Sweet Lou has hit the board in four of his five efforts as a sophomore and will now get back to more palatable company in this lifetime none-winners condition. He will work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and will have Yannick Gingras aboard for a follow-up steer.

#9 TROPHY TAKER was fourth in his division of the Somebeachsomewhere and was five lengths behind a pumped-up Nijinsky when he stepped his own mile in 1:50 flat with final quarter speed of 26.2. He sparked an upset at 10-1 in an OSS Gold event one week earlier and has nine top-two finishes in his 15 career attempts. This son of All Bets Off will be making his third attempt under the care of conditioner Dave Menary and has been getting along well with leading driver James MacDonald shipping back to this circuit. He must overcome a tricky draw from post-nine but looms as a major danger.

#3 WARRAWEEFORLAURA was third in this class on June 1st when he completed the trifecta at 2-1 and was within a couple of lengths of winner Kopi Luwak at the wire. He has hit the board in eight of his nine appearances as a sophomore and was fourth at 12-1 in an OSS Gold tilt two starts ago. This other son of All Bets Off is just a few starts removed from taking down the final of the Ontario Sired Spring Series and will work from another favorable draw with post-three. He will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile and cannot be left out of the exotic wagers.

#8 KAPTAIN KARLOS is winless in 20 starts this season but has hit the board in 14 of those efforts and has been the runner-up in nine of his last 13. He most recently locked down the show spot in this class on Monday night and once again fits in nicely at this level. This son of Captaintreachorous has been camera-shy throughout his career with just three victories from 48 attempts but has managed to hit the board 29 times over that span. He has enough early foot to get forwardly placed from the eight-hole and picks up Dexter Dunn in the sulky for the first time.

#6 M MS DREAM cruised to victory in her elimination at 45 cents to the dollar last week after making a move to the lead on the backside and is now a perfect four-for-four to kick off her five-year-old season. She went over \$1.5M in career earnings in that victory and refused to lose in the Miss Versatility over this surface on June 1st when she got her head in front of our third choice in the final steps. This 29-time winner will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and will race on a regular rotation for the second straight start. She will likely offer a price of the shortest variety and is hard to go against.

#8 WARRAWEE XENIA was taken back to last off the gate from post-four in her latest and trailed throughout in fifth in a race where all five entrants would advance to the final. She was at a major pace disadvantage when the halfway marker was tripped in just 58 seconds flat and appeared to have trot at the end of her mile the week before when managed to get within a couple of lengths of the one above in third at nearly 34-1 in the Miss Versatility. This 10-time winner should benefit from getting a couple of starts under her belt after being scratched out of her scheduled five-year-old debut on May 20th due to sickness. She has not tasted victory in her last 21 outings overall but has lit the lamp eight times over this surface and can take a big step forward off her latest.

#5 CALL ME GOO opened a wide margin on the spin for home last week after throwing a 27.1 third quarter at her rival but appeared to get tired in the dying strides when the one below got within half a length at the wire. She has gotten soft at the end of her mile in each of her last three but came out on top in two of those efforts and has won five of her last six overall. This 19-time winner can benefit from starting on the center of the gate after having the rail last time out and figures to have her gas pedal pressed off the switch. She had every chance to get the better of our top pick two starts ago and will likely have to settle for a spot underneath again tonight.

#4 REFINED exits the same race as the two above and was cutting into that margin of the winner in the shadow of the wire when that rival got tired in the late stages. She was half a length away from victory at the wire and had won two in a row at Scioto Downs going into that effort. This 39-time winner has been second or better in each of her last four and is the defending champion of this signature event after she sparked an upset at 7-1 by getting the better of Bella Bellini on this night last year. She has hit the board in five of the six times she has been paired with Doug McNair and figures to make her presence felt at some point in the mile.

#3 MIRAGE HANOVER just missed out on punching his ticket to the Pepsi North America Cup last week when he finished alongside Captain Luke and was a solid fourth at 6-1 after having the difficult task of being first-over against Legendary Hanover. He was no worse than second in his first two appearances at the age of three at Meadowlands and hit the board in seven of nine last season while making over \$220,000. This son of Bettors Delight will be making his fourth start out of the barn of trainer Jake Leamon and will once again have Tim Tetrick between the wheels. He gets to work from a favorable draw in post-three and looks like the logical choice to take down this consolation event.

#6 CLEVER CODY is an intriguing option after he jumped it off behind the gate in his NA Cup elimination and was distanced throughout after taking support to the tune of 7-1. He dominated his competition in both of his starts in OHSS this season and delivered at 30 cents to the dollar at Northfield Park on June 1st when he went coast-to-coast from the pole position in 1:52 flat. This son of The Panderosa was put into play through hot early fractions over this surface on May 18th when he hooked Legendary Hanover in a lifetime non-winners condition but ended up being a pari-mutuel refund when finishing eighth because of a broken martingale before the start. He will be reunited with Sylvain Filion, who piloted him to a third-place finish in the Metro Pace last September, and can be right there at the wire if he minds his manners.

#7 ITS SATURDAY NIGHT is another that just missed out on advancing to the final last week when he was fourth to Nijinsky in his elimination but was a slim margin away from Total Stranger in third. He was in tight quarters with that rival in the dying strides and was charted with interference but in the opinion of the judges neither horse was at fault, so no placing was necessary. He has yet to find the winner's circle in five tries this year but has hit the board three times and has only missed out on a top-three finish in two of his 12 career attempts. He should much prefer the company he keeps tonight and is among the main chances.

#4 NUMBER CRUNCHER earned a minor award in his elimination by finishing fifth and was overland for part of that mile before being within three lengths of winner Funtime Bayama at the wire. He slingshotted off his cover in the second-over position the week before in NW2 when getting his feet over this surface and scored by five lengths when he tripped the timer in 1:50.3 with a final quarter in 26.3. This son of Captain Crunch will be reunited with driver Scott Zeron and will likely be making noise when it matters most. He can pick up a decent chunk.

#6 HIGHLAND KISMET could not have done it any easier in his elimination last week when he was on cruise control to the wire in 1:54 flat after making a first-over bid on the final turn. He blasted home in 27.2 off a back-half in 54.4 and is now three-for-four since making his lifetime debut at the beginning of May. This son of Father Patrick announced his presence with authority in that effort when he scored by a comfortable margin at 1/5 in that NW1 event and then set his current lifetime mark of 1:53.1 on May 30th when ran up the score on his foes in the class above that. He does not have the experience or accolades of some of his competition in this Goodtimes Final but has been an absolute juggernaut and should keep on rolling at will likely be the shortest of prices.

#3 PRIVATE ACCESS exits the same race as the one above and rounded out the exacta at 16-1 in that contest when he was inching-in on that rival in deep stretch. He has hit the board in each of his last two after not having any chance in his sophomore debut on May 13th and blew up the tote board at 19-1 in his elimination for the Breeders Crown at Hoosier Park last October. This son of Muscle Hill ended up finishing fourth in the final of that championship event and should be ready to show his best in his fourth start back after a hiatus of more than seven months. He should be brave coming into this and will be our main player underneath.

#5 TOP MAST surged past rivals in the final strides last week and got up by a head after sitting in the three-hole for most of the mile. He stopped the clock in 1:53.4 in just his second start of his three-year-old season and went a big trip to be fourth from post-ten in a lifetime non-winners condition when racing off the shelf two starts ago. This son of Walner has now hit the board in eight of his 12 lifetime tries and is just shy of \$170,000 in earnings. He can benefit from starting on the center of the gate this time around and should be included in the exotics.

#1 PICK POCKET exits the same race as the one above and was picked up by that rival in the last step after he forged to a brief lead from the pocket in the shadow of the wire. He has been second or better in each of his last two and will get back on a regular rotation this evening after being scratched out of a scheduled outing at the Meadowlands on May 31st. This other son of Walner has 11 top-three finishes from 16 career attempts and might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position. He will have J-Mac aboard for a follow-up steer and can grab a share.

#8 OAKWOOD ARDAN IR has won three in a row since getting freshened-up for a couple of months and has only tasted defeat once since relocating to North America from Great Britain. He only missed by a neck in that lone defeat this season and was left with a lot of work to do before making a wide move on the spin for home. This 18-time winner paced his way to a new lifetime mark of 1:48 flat on May 18th at the Meadowlands and flashed home in 25.3 on the heels of a back-half in 52.4 after moving first-up from fourth. He was not under any urging in the stretch drive of that effort and is our clear choice on top when making his first start north of the border in this strong installment of the Mohawk Gold Cup.

#3 ABUCKABETT HANOVER returned 8-1 to his backers when he captured the Preferred by a pair of lengths last week and stopped the clock in 1:49.3 over a track that was one second off. He had to make multiple moves in that contest before powering past foes in the stretch and will get back on a regular schedule this evening after missing a few weeks going into that effort. This 16-time winner will also get significant post-relief when working from post-three and is one of two millionaires in the dash with over \$1.3M in earnings. He figures to be in the mix throughout and will be one of our main players underneath.

#2 BONNIPRINCLOUIS N closed like a freight train to emerge victorious in his North American debut on May 31st in an Open Handicap at The Meadows and was a going away winner when he tripped the timer in 1:50.1 on that five-eighths of a mile surface. He came his back-half in 54.1 and blazed home in 26.1 when offering better than 3-1 to his supporters. This 13-time winner has hit the board in 25 of his 60 career attempts and will be making his second start out of the barn of trainer Ron Burke after making the trek from Australia. He will have Dave Miller at the helm for an encore performance and is worth a look if the price is right.

#5 TAURASI had won 11 in a row over this surface before having to settle for the show spot last week at 70 cents to the dollar. He mixed it up with our top selection in the early stages of that contest and then got down into the pylons when he faced pressure from Buzzsaw Russ on the bend for home. This 21-time winner stayed up for third after a lengthy inquiry and will now slide in a few spots to the center of the gate after having the seven-hole or worse in each of his last two. He has rebound potential but a smaller share might be his ceiling this time out.

#6 MY GIRL EJ went a huge trip in her elimination last week and made multiple moves through hot panels before gamely holding off the late charge of the one below, who was able to watch all kinds of early action develop in front of her. She popped the pocket on the swing for home and opened a clear margin before having to dig deep in the dying strides to stop the clock in 1:50.1. This daughter of Sweet Lou earned her first victory of the season in two attempts and has now finished in the top-two in 13 of her 15 lifetime tries. She captured the Breeders Crown with ease last October and looks primed to add more hardware to her trophy cabinet.

#5 GEOCENTRIC missed by a head to the one above after sitting fourth for most of the mile last week and was able to watch several lead changes take place before making her move to the outside on the final turn. She disappointed as the 3/5 favorite but went most of the way on the lead in a division of the PASS a few weeks earlier when she delivered at a shorter price in 1:51.1 at The Meadows over a five-eighths of a mile surface that was two seconds off. This 10-time winner got her picture taken in each of her first nine career attempts before first tasting defeat in the final of the Breeders Crown in her final start at age of two and is now just under \$1,000 shy of \$600,000 in earnings. She looms as the obvious danger and will take plenty of support on the tote board.

#1 ITS A LOVE THING looked like a winner coming off the last turn when she tore off her cover from the third-over position and was four-wide at the top of the stretch before setting her sights on the lead. She had to settle for second when Canigetalouploup was able to go from last to first without ever having to leave the pylons and was nearly two lengths behind that rival at the finish. This daughter of Bettors Delight had won two in a row prior to that and has not been worse than second in any of her appearances as a sophomore. She captured the Shes A Great Lady at this venue last year and all eight of her victories have come over this surface.

#9 CAVIART BELLE exits the same race as the one above and disappointed at 90 cents to the dollar in that dash after being spotted on second-over cover. She came up flat-footed in the stretch but still managed to make the final by finishing fifth. This daughter of Captain Treacherous came home in 25.4 when she scored off the bench on May 18th at the Meadowlands in an overnight affair and finished off her rookie campaign with back-to-back victories in the Kindergarten and the Three Diamonds. She will offer an opportunity to take back some serious value for those that supported her last time but will have to overcome a tricky draw from post-nine.

#4 TWIN B JOE FRESH could not have done it any easier last week when she scored by more than four lengths in 1:50.4 and was wrapped-up early in the stretch by part-owner Dexter Dunn. She did that after getting steppy in the second-over position on the backside and those steps likely came from her hobbles being extended for that effort. This 21-time winner has won by a combined margin of 11 lengths in her last two after not delivering at even-money against male competition in her aged debut on May 19th at Harrah's Philly. She recently went over \$1.5M in career earnings and is not one that we are willing to side against in the Roses Are Red.

#6 SYLVIA HANOVER claimed the place spot to the one below after being sent off as the even-money favorite in her elimination and was nearly two lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire. She marched up confidently in the first-over position from fourth but was never able to issue a serious challenge when pacing home in 27.1 off a back-half in 54.2. This 18-time winner has not had her picture taken yet at the age of four but was the boss of her division in each of her first two years of racing. She is the reigning horse of the year in Canada and could not have gotten a better draw when getting to work from the winningest post on her home track.

#3 ALWAYS B NAUGHTY exits the same race as the one above and sped through fractions in that contest before scoring by nearly a pair of lengths in 1:49.3. She held a healthy margin throughout before returning 5/2 to her backers and is now 11 for 27 in her career with 23 on the board finishes. This daughter of Always B Miki will move in a couple of spots on the gate and will have Louis-Philippe Roy aboard for an encore performance. She will likely not be able to get an uncontested lead this time around when the chips are down but should not be taken lightly.

#2 SILVER LABEL was used hard in the early stages after she got stretched-out by Grace Hill until just before the midway marker and then had no choice but to release our top pick to the engine. She could not stay with that rival in the stretch and faded back to fifth, where she was beaten by more than 10 lengths, but that was still enough to punch her ticket to the final of this signature stakes event. This 22-time winner was no worse than second in the top pacing class for mares on this circuit in each of her first three starts as a five-year-old and will be reunited with driver Scott Zeron, who guided her to three victories last season. She has rebound potential but a lesser share is likely her ceiling.

#4 NIJINSKY has come into his own at the age of three and is a perfect four-for-four this season after he would not be denied at 25 cents to the dollar in his elimination last week. He appeared to be throttled down when initially making the lead in the lane but had to be asked for a little more when Storm Shadow shot up the cones in the deep stretch. This son of Bettors Delight would not let the one below get near him in the late stages in the Somebeachsomewhere on June 1st and sizzled to the wire in 1:49 flat with a 26.2 kicker. He was just one-for-10 as a two-year-old but hit the board six times and has raised his game to a whole new level as a sophomore. Giving him the edge in one of the most competitive installments of this race in recent memory.

#5 CAPTAINS QUARTERS rebounded his way to victory in his latest after disappointing as the 4/5 favorite the week before when he could not put a dent in the margin held by the one above in the Somebeachsomewhere. He was spotted perfectly on second-over cover in his recent effort and cruised to the finish in 1:49.1 with final quarter speed of 26.4. This son of Captaintreachorous offered 3/2 to his backers as the second-choice in the wagering and peaked at the right time last season when he was an impressive winner in the Metro Pace. He has never missed the board in any of his eight lifetime tries and looms as the logical danger with two-time NA Cup winner Jody Jamieson aboard.

#6 FUNTIME BAYAMA has not done much wrong this season when winning four of his five starts and was second in his only defeat that came at the hooves of our top pick in an OSS Gold event on May 25th. He grinded down Legendary Hanover out of the pocket last week and would not be denied when he got up by a head as the even-money favorite. This son of Hes Watching never let that rival get near him when he had a pace advantage in the Somebeachsomewhere on June 1st and stepped his way to his lifetime mark of 1:49.1 on that occasion. He is eight-for-10 in the win-column when Sylvain Filion is calling the shots and he will have the luxury of leaving from post-six.

#8 LEGENDARY HANOVER exits the same race as the one above and covered that rival up in the two-hole when he marched to the lead from third on backstretch. He has had to play second-fiddle to that rival in each of his last two but was electric in his first two outings at the age of three and tripped the timer in 1:48.3 when dominating a lifetime non-winners condition on May 18th. This son of Huntsville has only finished out of the top two once in his 13 career attempts but not winning his elimination might prove costly, as he must now overcome an outside draw with the eight-hole. He is not without a chance but we prefer the above three under the circumstances tonight.

He improved a spot before the wire before finishing in a dead-heat for seventh and has spent all of his last nine against tougher competition. This 12-time winner was dominant in victory in the class above this on April 20th and had a comfortable margin throughout that dash before he stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:50 flat. He will be reunited with driver Dave Miller and they teamed-up to get their picture taken back in October of 2022 in NW2. Top call.

#7 RESPECT OUR FLAG has spent his last five outings in NW14150L5 or higher classes and has picked up a prize in three of those efforts. He was placed up to fifth in his latest after being sent off at odds of 29-1 but shared third with The Longest Yard at 15-1 on May 25th when going postward at that level. This 38-time winner was victorious against similar company on May 4th and races for a barn that have won eight of their last 15 at the time of writing this. He got the nod from Travis Cullen over his stablemate and can be right there at the finish.

#4 MAPPOS LION returns to Ontario after getting a couple of starts under his feet at Truro Raceway in Nova Scotia. He was second in both of those efforts and will now get back on the big track in his third start back after a hiatus of more than a year. This 22-time winner's lone victory last season came in this class and he dominated his rivals from post-nine in that dash before pacing his mile in 1:51.4 over a track that was one second off. He might need a start or two at this venue before he is ready to go that type of speed again but is more than capable of making his presence felt against this group when back in the barn of Hall of Famer Paul MacDonell.

#3 JACK PANIC was overland for part of the mile after he got away fifth off the gate from post-eight when dropping down to this class last week and did well to stay on for third in a race where Codename Cigar Box ran up the score on his rivals. He was more than eight lengths in arrears from the winner at the wire but stepped his own mile in 1:51.3 with a 27.2 kicker on a track that had a variant of one second. This son of Sportswriter has earned a cheque in nine of his last 10 and should appreciate sliding down to post-three after having the eight-hole in each of his last two. He will get another crack at this class and should be included on the bottom end of the exotics.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot HI-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot HI-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot HI-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot HI-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot HI-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

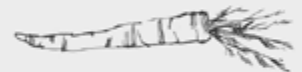
Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
