# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



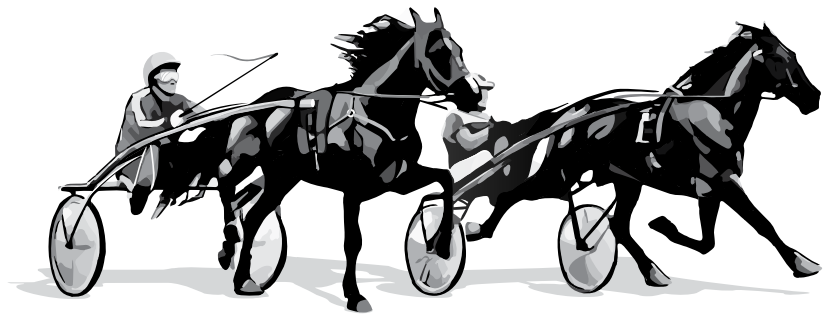
### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the Television or in-field on the Tote Board before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the Television or Tote Board (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

### Helpful facts for betting

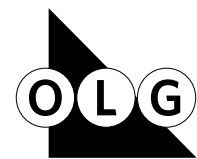
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

- WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
- PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
- SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

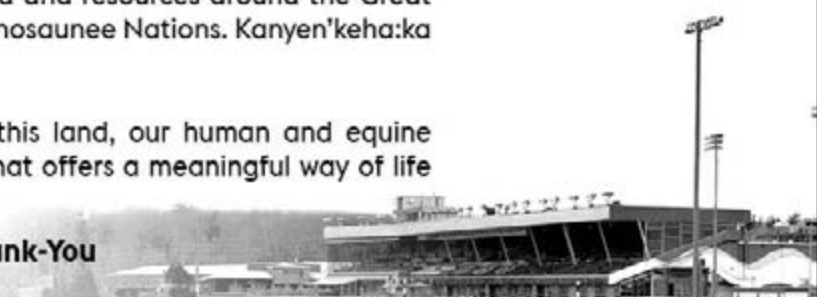

**Race 1 Selections**

**THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.**

**#1 LOOKATMEGOAMIGO** did not have much of a chance in his lifetime debut on June 21st when he got away eighth off the gate from post-nine and was more than 13 lengths off the lead at the midway point. He was at a significant pace disadvantage in that mile and did not leave the cones until the stretch drive when he was able to improve to fifth before the wire. This son of Muscle Mass trotted home in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 56.4 and will now slide down to the pole position when making a follow-up try under the lights. He races for a barn that typically brings their best in their second or third outing and has our call to take down the opener on the card.

**#2 ALL VALLEY** is a homebred for Al Libfeld that will be making the first start of his career for trainer Matt Bax. He is a half-brother to New Legacy, who has 24 victories and more than \$200,000 in his career. This son of Walner comes into this with one qualifier to his credit and was not asked to step forward until midway down the stretch after sitting fifth for most of his journey. He trotted his back-half in 58.4 with a final quarter in 28.1 and be right there at the finish if he progresses off that effort.

**#3 LMC WAGON WHEEL** exits the same race as our top selection and was nearly three lengths better than that rival under the wire when he rounded out the trifecta at 39-1. He was a long way back of the top-two finishers, who hit the wire together, but did manage to trot his final panel in 27.2 off a back-half in 57 seconds flat. This son of Wheeling N Dealin had a couple of qualifiers under his belt going into that lifetime debut and will work from the same starting spot from post-three after getting some real race experience under his belt. He might get handled more aggressively this time around and can land somewhere on the ticket.

**#8 SIESTA SANDMAN** was a \$6,500 yearling purchase at Hoosier that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by conditioner Ashley Duford. This son of Dont Letem will now try his luck on the big track and will have Tyler Borth calling the shots. He should offer a big number on the tote board and might be able to help spice things up underneath.

He was unable to come back forward again in the stretch and had to settle for the bottom spot of the superfecta at odds of 6-1. This 25-time winner is just two starts removed from spending seven of his last nine in the Preferred ranks and was victorious the last time he went postward in this class on April 22nd. He gets reunited with his regular driver Doug McNair and has our top honors in this spot.

**#2 HP MAMA B** was fourth in a division of the Miss Versatility in her latest and was sent to the lead on the backside after getting away third off the switch. She trotted her own middle-half in 56 seconds flat before getting leg weary in the lane and was sixth of 10 in the Armbro Flight at this venue before that. This 22-time winner earned a cheque in three of her last four since making a break in stride as the odds-on favorite in the class below this on May 20th. She appears to be trending back in the right direction for trainer Benoit Baillargeon and looms as a danger.

**#6 ADARE CASTLE** went all the way on the engine in the class below this last week to deliver as the 1/9 favorite and held off a late charge of Dealin With Dewey when she stopped the clock in 1:53.2. She only held on by half a length at the finish but there was a larger margin back to the third-place finisher Bella Cavalla. This 21-time winner was more than a length behind the one above in the Armbro Flight when coming in eighth under the wire but can benefit greatly from a heart-building victory in her latest. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and has repeat potential.

**#4 TYMAL RIGGS** converted as the 1/2 favorite in his latest and sustained a long first-over bid in that tilt before he forged his way to the lead in the lane. He scored by more than a comfortable length under the wire and has now won three in a row dating back to a May 19th victory at Flamboro Downs. This 19-time winner must step up in classification but will have Bob McClure aboard for an encore performance. He should be brimming with confidence and can pick up a decent chunk.

**#8 DEUCE HANOVER** got airborne in deep stretch and almost overcame what appeared to be an insurmountable margin when he got within a nose of the winner Olaf Du Lac. He catapulted off his cover at the head of the stretch and blasted home in 26.4 on the heels of a back-half in 55.1. This son of Bettors Delight rounded out the exacta at 14-1 but will likely only offer a fraction of that number on the tote board this evening. He has been trending in the right direction for trainer Shawn Steacy and gets the edge on top.

**#9 BARSTOOL MOUNTAIN** blew up as the favorite in each of his last two and was distanced from his rivals in both of those efforts after being sent off at odds of 3/2 or less. He took that support after he was third in his sophomore debut on May 17th but has not finished any better than that position in his five lifetime tries. This son of Sunshine Beach made another miscue in a qualifier on June 18th but then went coast-to-coast from post-five in his most recent morning prep when he tripped the timer in 1:54 flat. He will likely have a flat line as his top priority but is more than capable of coming out on top if he minds his manners.

**#2 GANSBAAI** disappointed as the 2-1 favorite on June 18th and tried to come from off the pace on that occasion after getting away seventh off the switch. He was more than 10 lengths off the lead at the midway marker and improved to third in the stretch after flashing final quarter speed of 27.2 off a back-half in 56 seconds flat. This son of Downbytheseaside was the runner-up at 22-1 at Yonkers seven nights earlier and has now missed a week between outings coming into this. He slides in a few spots on the gate and can land somewhere on the ticket.

**#7 SMILES FOR MILES** has been sent off at 2-1 or less in each of his first two starts to begin his career but has only been able to muster one lesser share between those two appearances. He was green behind the gate on June 18th and gave his rivals a head start before getting away last off the switch from post-seven but paced his back-half in 54.4 with a final panel in 27.1 to secure fourth under the wire. This son of McWicked then made a first-over bid from the three-hole in his latest but crawled home in 31 seconds flat while getting beaten by a wide margin in eighth. He has rebound potential and is worth keeping an eye on.

This 19-time winner will have his price tag increased by another \$2,000 this evening and has more than enough early foot to overcome post-eight. He will have Jody Jamieson aboard for a follow-up steer and can double-up.

**#7 MAINTENANCE MAN** exits the same race as the one above and was the runner-up to that rival after he held the lead into the final turn. He had no answers for the strong strides of that rival but was clearly the best of the rest when he kept all of his other foes at bay before the wire. This 15-time winner has been second-best in each of his last two at this level and has not missed the board in his last six in this class. He will be reunited with driver Doug McNair and will be one of our main players underneath.

**#6 CAPTAIN FIREBALL** jumped it just after the start in his latest and was never able to get back into contention before getting distanced from his rivals. He has spent each of his last two in the top claiming handicap class on this circuit and will now drop back down to this level in his third try off the claim for conditioner Corey Giles. This 23-time winner will be offered for \$2,000 less than he was plucked for on June 4th and is just five starts removed from a victory in this class. He was passed over by J-Mac in favor of the one below and will be reunited with Louis-Phillippe Roy, who guided him to get his picture taken back in the middle of March.

He got the nod from Doug McNair over the one below and looms as a major danger.

**#10 ARTFUL DODGER** was a \$15,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be making the first start of his career for trainer Dan Lagace. He comes into this with a couple of morning preps to his credit and was just over a length away from The Hitman Heart in his most recent trip around this track. This son of Green Manalishi S trotted his back-half in 59.4 with a final quarter in 28.2 in that effort but will have to overcome the dreaded 10-hole. He picks up top teamster James MacDonald in the sulky and goes postward for a barn that typically sends them ready to roll.

**#7 NIGHT PHANTOM** was a \$30,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will now be sent out for his lifetime debut by conditioner Mike Keeling. He was third to Chicago Hall in his only qualifier but was not asked to do much in the late stages when finishing nearly eight lengths in arrears to that rival. **Race 10 Selections**

**THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.**

**#2 ARCHIMEDES** was moving well at the end of his mile last week when he advanced to fourth after getting away last off the gate from post-four. He was 11 lengths off the lead at the opening marker before trotting his back-half in 57 seconds flat with a final quarter in 27.4 and rounded out the superfecta at nearly 37-1. This son of Kadabra shared third with Cool Clifford in this class on June 11th and now has a flat line to his credit after making a miscue when he was challenging for the lead at Grand River Raceway two starts ago. He will start from an inside draw and can get the better of this group with the right kind of trip.

**#1 MACALLAN** returned to the races after a hiatus of more than two months in his latest and got away fifth off the gate before fading back to seventh when taking on tougher foes in NW8600L5. He will now plunge down to the bottom condition class and will benefit from getting that latest effort under his feet. This 14-time winner cruised to a victory of nearly five lengths the last time he raced at this level in December of last year and should much prefer the company he keeps tonight. He might get handled more aggressively this time out and can be right there at the finish.

**#6 NORTHERN CHARLOTTE** won five of 19 last season and hit the board in eight of those efforts on her way to banking nearly \$70,000. She went on the shelf last December after she made breaks in stride in two of her last three starts at the age of three but got around this surface cleanly in both of her qualifiers in preparation for this return to action. This daughter of Muscle Mass dominated her rivals in a qualifier on June 18th when she won by more than nine lengths in 1:55.1 and might be ready to roll in her first try back. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and is not without a chance.

**#10 ESPLOSIONE** stepped up in class in his latest and had to settle for seventh and was charted with broken equipment after having issues with a knee boot. He will drop back down to a spot similar to where he was when he delivered at 55 cents to the dollar 10 nights earlier but did that from post-three and will now shift out to the dreaded 10-hole. This 11-time winner will be reunited with driver Trevor Henry and will likely be making noise when it matters most. He should not be left out of the exotics and is not a bad option if he offers a fair price.

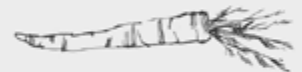
**#9 JOKIC** got hammered down to 6/5 favoritism last week and got an overland trip after getting away ninth off the switch from the six-hole. He was stuck third-over in a stalled outer flow and had to roll wide on the final turn before getting into the show spot before the wire. This son of Cantab Hall just held onto that spot over our top selection and now has a flat line under his belt after making back-to-back breaks in stride in June. ### CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

### SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot HI-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot HI-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot HI-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot HI-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

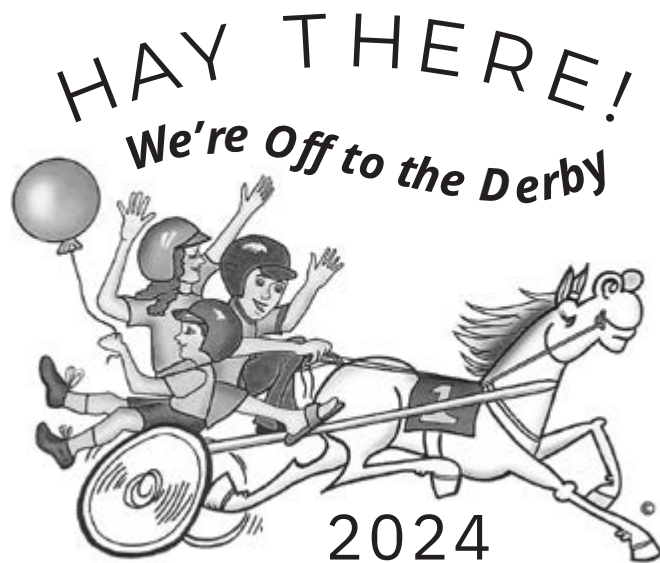
The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot HI-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
