Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

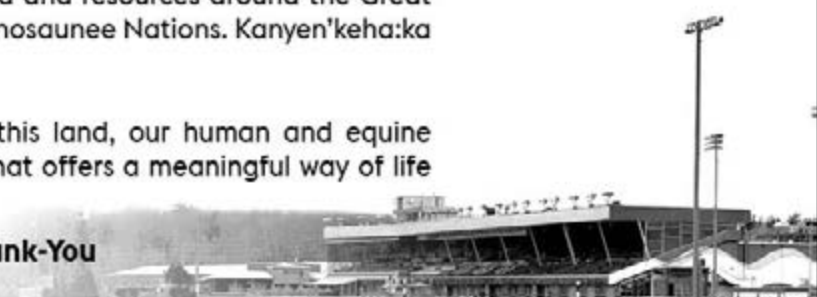

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#3 MAPPOS LION did not have much of a chance on July 6th when he got away last off the gate from post-nine and was 12 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He improved a couple of spots before the wire to finish seventh at 44-1 and paced his back-half in 54.2 with a final panel in 27 seconds flat. This 22-time winner had missed more than a month of action before that and was the runner-up in a couple of tries at Truro Raceway in Nova Scotia before returning to Ontario to race under the care of conditioner/driver Paul MacDonell. He has been lightly raced over the last couple of seasons but has made his way up to the Open ranks in the past on the circuit. Expecting him to be put into play when racing back on more of a regular schedule and getting a much better starting spot with post-three.

#5 RON has disappointed as the favorite in each of his last two and had the sea part in front of him last week in the stretch after he rode the pylons for much of the mile. He did not have to alter his course at all but was no match for the late strides of Roll With The Flow and had to settle for second at 2-1. This son of Sportswriter is winless in 15 this season but has seven on the board finishes and has only missed a cheque in three of those efforts. He continues to get along well with driver Trevor Henry and has produced a top-three finish in each of his last eight times they have been paired together.

#2 BOSTON BOUND was the runner-up race-favorite Points North in NW4250L5 in his latest and was nearly five lengths in arrears to that class-dropping rival when he rounded out the exacta at 8-1. He has been second or better in each of his last five and went all the way on the engine for the victory in a Preferred-2 at Grand River Raceway two starts ago. This 10-time winner must take on a tougher group this evening but has been racing at the top of his game for trainer Helene Marie Dupont. He figures to be in the mix throughout from post-two and can hit the ticket.

#1 HAIL CHRISTIAN N needed his trip around the track last week when he was taken back to eighth off the switch from post-four in this class and advanced one position before the finish. He had not raced in six months going into that effort and paced his own mile in 1:51.2 after winning his most recent qualifier in 1:52.2 with a 26.3 kicker 11 days earlier. This 25-time winner will be reunited with James MacDonald and that top teamster piloted him to victory in this class on January 6th. They have teamed up for a pair of victories in the six times they have been paired together and should not be ignored from the pole position.

#3 POINTS NORTH got a big boost to his confidence last week when he dropped down to NW4250L5 and went back to being handled aggressively on his way to an easy score as the even-money favorite. He ran his rivals off their feet when he paced his own middle-half in 54.1 and won by nearly five lengths when he stopped the clock in 1:50 flat. This 46-time winner earned a cheque in just one of his five outings before that and was sixth at 8/5 in his latest at this level on July 6th. He comes right back on just four days of rest and is just \$2,122 away from the \$1M in career earnings milestone. Hoping he gets there in style by doubling-up.

#5 SOMETIME SOMEWHERE got away ninth off the gate in NW14900L5 last week and was nearly 14 lengths off the pacesetter at the midway point. He was stacked-up third-over behind a stalled outer flow and followed his cover three-wide on the spin for home before picking up a lesser share in fifth. This 28-time winner paced home in 26.4 off a back-half in 54.2 and will now drop back down to the class where he raced from off the pace to be second on July 6th. He will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald and he has piloted him to six victories in the past.

#4 DUPREE HANOVER has been shut out in each of his last three and has not been able to muster a finish better than eighth in NW20000L5 in his last couple of outings. He was third to Taurasi in the Preferred on May 25th and hit the board in back-to-back tries in the lower tier of that class earlier in the spring. This son of Stay Hungry plunges down to NW9000L5 and took his rivals gate-to-wire at 40 cents to the dollar the last time he raced at this level in February. He might wake-up to a better effort this evening and cannot be ruled out.

#7 ORDER ONE TO GO has won three in a row and four of his last five but will now once again move out of a claiming handicap to NW9000L5 where he will carry the optional tag of \$50,000. He was eighth on June 15th when trying this uptick in class but he took support to the tune of 9-1 and was taken back to ninth off the gate from post-nine. This 16-time winner has changed in each of his last two and will now race off the claim for conditioner Corey Giles. He loses J-Mac to our second choice and will have Louis-Philippe Roy calling the shots for the first time.

This daughter of Heston Blue Chip must move back up a notch on the class ladder but blazed her way to her lifetime mark of 1:50.1 when trouncing her foes in this spot on June 7th. She will have James MacDonald aboard for an encore performance and is among the chances.

#5 POWDER PLAY exits the same race as the one above and disappointed as the 8/5 favorite in that dash after she continued to drive to the lead from post-seven in the early stages. She touched down on the engine on the backside and held a healthy margin on her rivals into the lane but got leg weary in deep stretch when giving way to the one above. He paced to that identical mile time two weeks earlier when he went most of the way on the engine to score by a comfortable margin at the level below this and should appreciate making the transition back to a lifetime non-winners condition. This son of Stay Hungry has hit the board in six of his last 16 and will have Doug McNair back between the wheels. He will start from the center of the gate for the fifth straight start and looks like a logical choice to round out the trifecta.

#7 REIGN SUPREME has not missed the board in his last four and only missed out on victory by a neck in two of those efforts when having to settle for the place spot. He was third to our second selection two back when he was in the pocket behind Storm Shadow for much of the mile and completed the trifecta at odds of 24-1. This son of Control The Moment has been sent to the early lead in all of his three but has proven to be versatile in his racing style throughout his career. He will have Bob McClure back in the bike after Doug McNair opted for the one above and can pick up another piece.

#8 ST LADS CRIMINAL is one that we are willing to come right back to after he had to settle for second to Unrivald Hanover as the 3/5 favorite in his debut on the big track on July 6th. He was 11 lengths off the lead at the opening marker after he got away seventh off the gate from post-seven and ended up third-over on the swing for home. This 11-time winner did not get much help from the horse he was following and gamely chased the winner to the wire with final quarter speed of 27.1 off a back-half in 54.2. He had won 11 of his previous 12 before that and can get back to his winning ways in this spot but must overcome another tricky draw with post-eight.

#3 BOLD SPIRIT has spent each of his last two in the class above this and earned a minor award in both of those outings. He rounded out the superfecta at 77-1 in his latest when being just over five lengths in arrears to Chain Gang and will drop back down to the class where he was a back-to-back winner in June. This son of Stay Hungry has only missed one cheque in 10 tries since moving to the care of conditioner Chantal Mitchell this season and will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy, who guided him to a couple of top-two finishes in his first two attempts on this circuit. He has a significant post position advantage over the one above and looms as an obvious danger.

#2 LOUS WORLD has not raced in more than a couple of weeks when he faded back to third at this level last week and failed to deliver on a 1/5 promise. He marched straight to the lead from post-six and set reasonable fractions before getting picked up by Best Night Ever and the one below but can take a step forward when getting back on a regular rotation. This son of Sweet Lou is just one for 17 in his career but has 10 on the board finishes and has had an affinity for the show spot with eight third-place finishes. He slides in four spots on the gate and will likely make his presence felt throughout.

#7 PREMIER FIRST STAR exits the same race as the one above and was gapped out in the three-hole on the final turn before surging up the inside of that rival in the stretch. He only missed by a neck to Best Night Ever at odds of 23-1 and has been second by that margin or less in two of his last three at this level. This other son of Stay Hungry moves out a spot on the gate to post-eight but has been trending in the right direction for trainer Tony Beaton. He can pick up another decent chunk if he can avoid a taxing trip and is worth including on the bottom end of the exotics.

This daughter of Bettors Delight was the runner-up to the one above in the first leg of this season-long series and earned a minor award in the Fan Hanover by finishing fifth in that prestigious steaks event. She must overcome the outermost post in the contest but has been racing at the top of her game for trainer Dr. Ian Moore. Using underneath.

#5 GREATEST PLEASURE paced away from her rivals in the late stages of the Kin Pace Final as the second choice in the betting and went all the way on the engine for a more than comfortable score at the shortest price possible in her elimination. She was a strong runner-up to the one above in the most recent OSS Gold leg at Rideau Carleton and has been victorious in four of her last six overall. This other daughter of Bettors Delight will go back on the lasix program this evening and will get to work from the center of the gate. She should be brimming with confidence and can hit the ticket.

#2 PASS LINE is just one-for-eight this season after going 10 for 13 as a rookie and won five of her six tries at this level in that campaign, including the Super Final last October. She has not been able to muster a finish better than fourth in the first two OSS Gold legs in 2024 but was second to entry mate Seaside Diva in the Nadia Lobel at Scioto Downs in Ohio two starts ago. This 11-time winner paced her own middle-half in 55.4 before tiring in the stretch of her division of the Jerry Silverman Memorial in her latest and will now make her third straight start on lasix when returning north of the border to the care of conditioner Dave Menary. She picks up Doug McNair in the sulky and should not be dismissed from the bottom end of the exotics.

She rallied from last to be third in her first try in the Preferred on July 5th and will now drop back down to the spot where she has a couple of recent victories. This daughter of Captive Audience has hit the board in each of her last three at this level and will surely be making noise when it matters most when having to leave from the eight-hole. She does her best work when she has some pace to chase and should get every chance to make her way onto the ticket.

#5 STYLE FOR A MILE exits the same race as the two above and trailed throughout in the contest after she was sent off as the longest shot on the board at 65-1. She picked up a lesser share in fifth the week prior and disappointed as the 4/5 favorite in the class above this on June 22nd. This 15-time winner took that support after she was the runner-up in back-to-back tries at this level and has hit the board in five straight in this spot. She might fly under the radar on the tote board and is worth a look if the price is right.

He should relish the opportunity to once again face restricted company in the Ontario program and should have his way with this group at what will surely be the shortest of prices.

#6 STORM SHADOW could not hold off a determined Leave It To Leo last week in a lifetime non-winners condition and completed a chalky exacta as the definitive second choice in the betting at 6/5. He was second to the one above in their elimination for the North America Cup when she snuck up the cones in the late stages and has not finished worse than that spot in either of the first two OSS Gold legs this season. This son of Bettors Delight has hit the board in six of eight as a sophomore and blew up the tote board at 32-1 when he sparked an upset in the OSS Super Final at the age of two last fall. He will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and will be our main player underneath.

#5 WIKIPEDIA has hit the board in five straight after finishing ninth in the first OSS Gold dash of the season, where the one below emerged victorious at odds of 10-1. He just missed to the one above in the most recent installment of that season-long series at Rideau Carleton and got within a nose of that rival when he rounded out the exacta at 13-1. This son of McWicked has been in good order as of late for Anthony Beaton and is one of four in the dash for that conditioner. He will have Travis Cullen aboard for a follow-up steer and should be included on the bottom end of the exotics.

#9 TROPHY TAKER has not raced in nearly a month after being scratched out of a scheduled start on July 6th due to lameness. He was the clear second choice in the betting in an OSS Gold affair at Rideau Carleton before that but faded back to fifth under the wire after he could not fend off the first-over charge from our second choice. #5 WRITE ME A ROSE did not have much of a chance in his latest when he got away last off the gate in a field of six in the Preferred and was nearly 10 lengths off the lead at the midway point. He rallied to fourth in the stretch when he paced home in 26 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 52.2 and had hit the board in three straight in those ranks before that. This 11-time winner was impressive in victory on NA Cup night when he tripped the timer in a new lifetime mark of 1:49.4 and has hit the board in 10 of his 14 attempts this season. He will likely be handled more aggressively when getting back to a condition race and converted as the even-money favorite against similar company on May 25th.

#4 BLUE HUNT exits the same race as the one above and went similar journeys in each of his last two when competing in that top pacing class on the circuit. He was able to maintain third when making a first-over move from that position in his latest but faded back to last two outings ago when trying the same tactics. This son of Huntsville delivered as the 2-1 favorite in NW22500L5 on June 22nd and will be reunited with his winning driver on that occasion with Ed Hensley picking up the steer. He showed he was capable of displaying incredible speed when he stopped the clock in 1:47.4 back in late May and should get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#7 STOCKADE SEELSTER returned to action last week after a hiatus of nearly eight months and was sent off at odds of 6-1 in NW24750L5 before getting away sixth off the gate from post-eight. He tried to rush to the lead on the backside but could only get to the flank of race-favorite Codename Cigar Box before fading back to fourth in the stretch. This 15-time winner will once again have to face off with that rival but also a quartet of pacers dropping down from the Preferred and our top pick who has been taking on tougher opponents stateside. He can take a step forward in his second start back after a long layoff and will have Louis-Philippe Roy calling the shots for the first time.

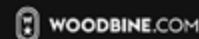

#7 BATTLE WITH DESIRE was running over top of her rivals in deep stretch after being hemmed-in on the pylons on the final turn and was just over a length away from victory in a contest that was topped by Bluemea Kiss. She rounded out the superfecta at odds of 15-1 and was impressive in victory when she scored in her first start for trainer Des Tackoor in a claiming handicap event on July 4th. This 18-time winner completed a three-race win-streak on that occasion and will now get another crack at this class without having to carry the optional price tag of \$25,000. She shifts out a spot on the gate but will have Bob McClure back aboard for a follow-up drive and is one of our plays of the night.

#2 ZEBS BREAKING DAWN got away eighth off the gate in her latest but was relegated to last on the backstretch when she moved to the outside and got stuck behind non-advancing cover. She was then taken wide by a drifting rival in the stretch and was not able to find forward momentum until it was too late. This daughter of Hes Watching walked away empty-handed when having to settle for sixth but paced her back-half in 54.1 with a final quarter in 27 seconds flat. She hit the board in each of her previous three at this level and will have Louis-Philippe Roy back between the wheels in her third start under the care of conditioner Brett Lester.

#4 WATCH HER DEWITT exits the same race as the two above and claimed the show spot in that contest after shaking loose in the lane. She completed the trifecta at 20-1 after sitting an inside trip for much of the mile and is just two starts removed from a five-race win-streak. This 14-time winner has hit the board in 15 of her last 19 overall and has racked-up 12 victories over that span. She continues to do good things for the combination of trainer Shayne Barrington and driver Trevor Henry and can pick up another decent chunk with the right kind of trip.

#6 TWIN B TIPSTER has spent each of her last two in the class above this and was the runner-up to Settn A Precedent at 33-1 at that level on June 22nd. She was third to the one above in her latest attempt in this spot and has hit the board in three of her last five. This 18-time winner has not gotten her picture taken in 17 tries this season but is trending in the right direction for conditioner Gabby Sasso. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and will make her third consecutive appearance with Travis Cullen at the reins.

#3 DRAGONONTHEBEACH was one we were fond of at 33-1 on July 6th but he was taken back to seventh off the switch from post-seven and did not make a forward move until the late stages. He got within four lengths of winner P L Ozzy when he settled for the bottom spot of the superfecta and will now drop down another notch on the class ladder after spending his previous four efforts in a Preferred-2 or higher. This 13-time winner was strong in victory in NW25000L5 on May 11th and slides in four spots on the gate to the three-hole. He should be brave coming into this and figures to get handled more aggressively in this Hi-5 mandatory payout event. Louis-Philippe Roy picks up the steer.

#8 AMERICAN HISTORY was left with a lot of work to do in his last two when getting away eighth off the gate and being 11 lengths or more off the lead at the midway marker. He managed to secure a smaller share in fourth two starts ago in a Preferred-2 but was only beaten by three quarters of a length to Blue Hunt on June 22nd at the level above this. This 45-time winner should appreciate getting back down to the spot where he was determined in victory on June 15th and that also happened to be a mandatory payout situation for the Hi-5. He might get activated sooner in the mile like he did on that occasion and looms as a major danger.

#4 WHATCHULOOKIN AT as third in the class above this last week and overlaid for much of that mile before finding himself just over five lengths in arrears to a pumped-up winner in Codename Cigar Box. He has spent all of his last five at that level or higher and will drop down to the spot where he surged past rivals in deep stretch on his way to a 1:50.1 score on June 1st. This son of Hes Watching should appreciate getting class-relief and will start from post-five for the second straight start. He picks up Jonathan Drury in the bike and completes a strong one-two punch for trainer Dave Menary.

#5 WHEELS ON FIRE exits the same race as the one above and finished sixth of nine in that dash after getting an inside trip. He has been shut out in each of his last three when taking on tougher but did manage to claim the place spot to Saulsbrook Victor in a Preferred-2 on June 1st when he sat in a loose pocket for the duration of the mile. This 48-time winner notched his lone victory of the season in this class on May 25th and will be leaving from the center of the gate. He will have Sylvain Filion in the sulky and might come out firing from post-five.

#11 POSEIDON SEELSTER has spent 11 of his last 12 in a Preferred-2 or higher and has only missed a cheque in two of those dashes. He has hit the board in four of his last seven in the top pacing class on the circuit and was a solid third in the Camluck Classic at the Raceway in London on May 31st. This 18-time winner has been in good order for conditioner Don Lindsey but must start from a dreaded starting spot on the second-tier with post-12. He should have every chance against this group if he can work out a reasonable trip but that might be a tall order from back there.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

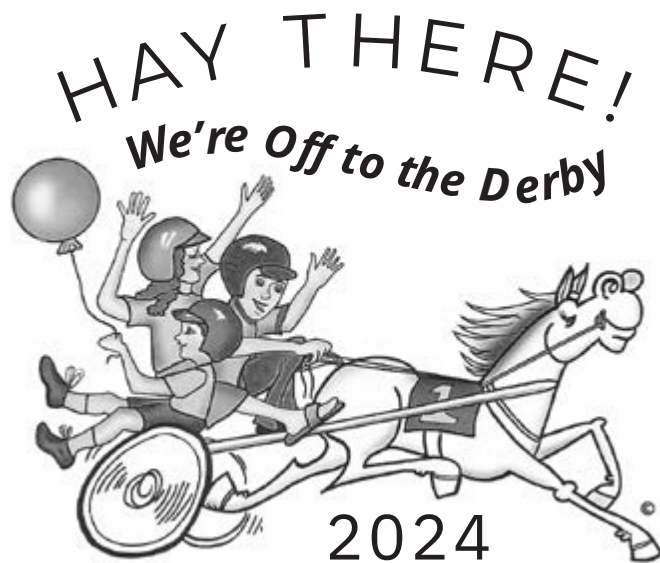
ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
