Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
|----------|---------------------|---|
| Win | U U U | Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds. |
| Place | U U | Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show. |
| Show | U | Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs. |

Exotic multiple-horse bets

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
|----------------------------------|---------------------|---|
| Exacta* | U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds. |
| Daily double | U U U U U | Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races. |
| Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6 | U U U U U U | Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager. |
| Triactor* | U U U U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses. |
| Superfecta* | U U U U U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible. |

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 TALL DARK LADY is a homebred for James Avritt that will be sent out for her lifetime debut by trainer Gregg McNair after being scratched out of an OSS Gold event due to sickness on July 16th. She is a half-sister to Tall Dark Stranger (19, \$2,365,549, 1:47.1) and a full-sibling to Total Stranger (3, \$152,588, 1:49). This daughter of Bettors Delight went a long way on the lead in her lone morning prep on July 5th but was hauled down by Duchess Deo in the dying strides, who has since finished second in both of her first two career attempts. She will start from the center of the gate in this NW1 event and gets the nod on top in the opener.

#3 NIGHT DANCER got away fifth off the gate in an OSS Grassroots event at Kawartha Downs and was shuffled back to seventh on the backside before finding a seam in the stretch to finish third. She rounded out the trifecta at odds of 9-1 and appeared to have pace when racing up on the heels of a rival in deep stretch. This daughter of Dancin Lou stepped her own mile in 1:55.3 and dropped more than three seconds from her lifetime debut where she was fourth in a division of the Prospect Series. She will have Jody Jamieson calling the shots for the first time when getting on the big track and looks threatening.

#7 MAI TIDE was spotted second-over in an OSS Grassroots tilt here at Mohawk Park in the first start of her career on July 9th but was unable to advance from that spot and lost a couple of positions before finishing seventh under the wire. She was only beaten by a head in her most recent qualifier on June 21st and paced her own mile in 1:55.4 with a 27.1 kicker in a race that was topped by Barb Lahey. This daughter of McWicked will have Bob McClure at the controls this time around and he opted to drive her over Wicked Spark. She can take a step forward and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#1 STONE SAWYER has been fourth in all three of her career attempts so far and was nearly five lengths in arrears from winner Tricky McWicky in an OSS Grassroots affair at Kawartha Downs in her latest. This other daughter of McWicked will be reunited with driver Travis Cullen and might be able to navigate a favorable journey from the pole position. She can grab a share.

He was stacked-up on fourth-over cover on the swing for home and improved a couple of spots to be sixth after he trotted home in 28.2 off a back-half in 57.2. This son of Green Manalishi S was third in his qualifier one week earlier when trotting his final panel two ticks quicker and can benefit from getting some real race experience under his belt. He must overcome a tricky draw from post-eight but gets the edge on top in what appears to be a wide open dash.

#9 DARKNESS COOKS outran his odds at 36-1 when he managed to lock down the show spot in NW1 event on July 18th after being sent to the early lead from the dreaded 10-hole. He was just over two lengths in arrears from winner Royal Life and his connections thought enough of him to give him a try at the OSS Gold level before that. This other son of Green Manalishi S has been trending in the right direction for the hot barn of trainer Blake MacIntosh and should not mind making the transition to the Grassroots. He continues to draw poorly with his third consecutive nine-hole or worse but merits respect off his latest.

#2 BANK ON LUCAS exits the same race as the one above and sat fourth for much of that mile before trying to squeeze up the inside of rivals in the lane. He left the course when going inside a couple of pylons when room did not present itself and was placed back to seventh from sixth. This son of The Bank raced better than advertised in that contest and will have J-Mac aboard for a follow-up steer after that top teamster chose him over the one below. He is worth a look if the price is right.

#4 CENTURY LEGION broke stride before the start of a NW1 event on July 23rd and was distanced throughout at odds of 9-1. He has now made miscues in three of his four lifetime tries and disappointed as the 8/5 favorite in an OSS Grassroots affair in the only pari-mutuel race where he was able to mind his manners. This son of Trixton has done good work in the mornings and will have Anthony MacDonald at the helm this time around, who guided him to a second-place finish in a qualifier on July 5th. He is a risky proposition but is not without a chance if he stays on the trot.

He made a big recovery to be second and was four lengths in arrears to winner Day. This son of Muscle Mass trotted his back-half in 55.4 with a final panel in 27.1 over a track that was one second off and will have Bob McClure for a follow-up drive after trainer Mark Etsell called his own number in both of his qualifiers. He will once again start from the center of the gate and might be tough to beat if he minds his manners.

#7 P L SPENCER gutted-out a victory last week in NW1 and rebuffed the challenge of Tregaron in the lane before scoring by three quarters of a length at the wire. He stopped the clock in 1:57.2 with a 27.4 kicker and returned 2-1 to his backers after he blew up as the even-money favorite in the first leg of the OSS Grassroots. This son of Resolve has gotten around this surface two seconds quicker than any of his rivals in this dash and will likely once again have his gas pedal pressed off the switch from post-seven. He looms as the obvious danger and merits respect.

#6 GUCCI GUCCI GOO tracked Go Blue from a loose pocket in NW1 on July 12th and maintained his position in the stretch when he was unable to get near the winner. He clung to the place spot over the one below at the finish and completed the exacta as the definitive second choice in the betting at 2-1. This son of Green Manalishi S will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and will likely get forwardly placed in what will be his third career appearance. He can be in the mix throughout and should not be left out of the exotics.

#9 LITTLE ARROW just missed getting past the one above for second in his lifetime debut when competing in the opening round of this season-long series. He blasted home in 27.4 on the heels of a back-half in 58 seconds flat and then got hammered down to 8/5 favoritism in a follow-up try in NW1 but got an overland trip before making a break in stride. This son of Wheeling N Dealin must overcome the outermost post in the contest but might be able to rebound with a better result. He should offer an opportunity to take back value for those that supported him last time and should not be ignored in the underneath positions.

#4 HIDE THE WICK exits the same race as the one above and was left with a lot of work to do in that lifetime debut after he was taken back to eighth off the gate from post-seven. He was more than 14 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and stepped his back-half in 55 seconds with final panel speed of 27 flat. This son of McWicked managed to get up alongside our second choice at the wire and rounded out the superfecta in fourth at 37-1. He can benefit from getting that real race experience under his belt and should not be taken lightly.

#9 IMA PERFECT CHOICE has had to take on difficult opponents in each of his first two career attempts and was most recently sixth to Allstar Maniac in NW1 last week after being gapped to that rival's cover on the bend for home. He was more than four lengths in arrears from the winner at the wire after pacing home in 26.4 and had not raced in over a month going into that effort. This son of Courtly Choice ws fourth to Power Code in his lifetime debut on June 21st and that foe has since taken down a couple of divisions of the NJSS at the Meadowlands. He must overcome a tricky draw from post-nine but is worth utilizing in the exotics.

This daughter of Muscle Mass came home in 28 flat or better in each of her two morning preps and will have the luxury of leaving from post-six this time around. She is a full-sister to Snowpiercer (10, \$305,361. 1:53.4) and a half-sibling to Killer Instinct (39, \$431,174, 1:53.1) and we hope she can rebound with a better performance this evening.

#3 ROYAL SAUCE was sent to the lead at the midway marker of a OSS Grassroots affair on July 16th and held court into the stretch before getting picked up by odds-on favorite Foxy Amee. She was just a length in arrears to that rival when she completed the exacta at odds of 3-1 and dropped more than a second off her mile time from two weeks earlier when making the first start of her career. This other daughter of Muscle Mass will once again leave from a favorable draw with post-three and might prove tough to catch if she deploys the same tactic. She is an obvious threat and figures to take support on the tote board.

#8 RICH GIRL has hit the board in each of her last two and only missed by a neck to Cheeky Lass in the first leg of the OSS Grassroots in her latest. She went a long way on the lead in NW1 before that and was only half a length away from victory as the 8/5 favorite when getting picked up by both Entertain Me and Stovid. She is the second foal out of Southwind Alice, who had 15 wins and more than \$110,000 in earnings in 98 lifetime appearances. This daughter of Archangel got jammed-up behind rivals in her lone qualifier on July 19th and raced better than advertised when finishing fourth in 2:00.1. She will probably offer a sizable number on the board and is worth keeping an eye on.

#4 TRICKY TRISH made a break in stride in the first start of her career on July 5th but still managed to trot home in 28.3 off a back-half in 57.3 on a track that was one second off. She then had an adventurous journey before having to settle for a minor award in fifth at 33-1 in an OSS Grassroots tilt on July 16th but comes into this off a vet scratch due to sickness. This daughter of Trixton will move a few spots off the rail to the four-hole and will have driver Tyler Borth calling the shots for the first time. She can take a step forward after getting a flat line to her credit and is worth using on the ticket.

#7 MS KIRSI rallied for third after getting away seventh off the switch in an OSS Grassroots affair on July 16th and was seven lengths behind a heavily-backed winner in Foxy Ameer. She rounded out the trifecta at odds of 23-1 but took more support in her lifetime debut 11 nights earlier when she jumped it off just after the start. This daughter of Muscle Mass can benefit from having a clean line under her belt and can pick up a decent chunk if she can work her way into the race from post-seven. She should not be left off the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

She picked up a smaller share in the Tompkins-Geers nearly three weeks earlier and was third in her lifetime debut on June 21st. This daughter of Green Manalishi S has been getting along well with driver Doug McNair and has enough early foot to get forwardly placed from the outermost post in the contest. She should be confident coming into this and has repeat potential.

#2 CHEEKY LASS held on by a neck in her division of the OSS Grassroots on July 16th and blew up the tote board at nearly 20-1 in the process. She followed the live cover of Wells Fargo on the backside and then swept past that rival for the lead at the top of the stretch. This daughter of Muscle Mass stopped the clock in 1:59.1 with a 28.2 kicker and was a solid second to Grand Reserve in her qualifier before that. She will slide down to the inside of the gate with post-two and can be right there at the finish.

#6 CORE RESOLVE exits the same race as the one above and secured the early pocket in that dash but elected to stay on the cones and then got shuffled back to seventh before being stuck behind rivals in the early part of the stretch drive. She had to settle for a minor award in fifth after she stepped home in 28.1 off a back-half in 58 seconds flat and finished one spot better in her lifetime debut 11 days prior when trainer Matt Bax called his own number in the bike. This daughter of Resolve will have J-Mac aboard for a follow-up steer and will likely be handled more aggressively this time around. She cannot be dismissed.

#5 JS SHESREALSPECIAL stayed flat for a fourth-place finish in the first leg of the OSS Grassroots when she added trotting hobbles to her wardrobe on July 16th. She was three lengths away from our top choice at the wire and completed the superfecta at odds of 25-1. This other daughter of Muscle Mass made a break in stride in her lifetime debut before that and will have Tyler Borth at the helm for a follow-up try after Doug McNair opted for our top pick.

He only improved one spot before the finish but was placed up to sixth after he stepped home in 28.1 on the heels of a back-half in 57.2. This son of Green Manalishi S made a break in stride in each of his first two qualifiers and has managed to stay flat since the addition of trotting hobbles. He slides down to the inside of the gate with post-two and is one of our top plays of the evening.

#10 WENDELL BLUE CHIP has picked up lesser shares in each of his first two career attempts and was most recently fourth to P L Spencer in NW1 last week. He moved to the outside on the final turn and got within three lengths of that well-meant winner when he stepped his own mile in 1:58 flat. This other son of Green Manalishi S will have Doug McNair aboard for a follow-up steer but must overcome the dreaded 10-hole. He fits in nicely with this group and merits respect.

#8 GRAVENHURST disappointed as the 8/5 favorite in NW1 on July 18th after was sent to the lead on the backside and trotted his own middle-half in 59 seconds flat. He took that support on the tote board after he claimed the show spot in the OSS Gold ranks nine nights earlier and has not been worse than fourth in any of his three career attempts. This son of Muscle Mass should appreciate making the transition to the Grassroots and has already demonstrated versatility in his racing style. He will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile and is among the top contenders.

#3 THE GOVERNOR rallied for third when making his lifetime debut in the first leg of this season-long series and a long way back in sixth in the early stages of that mile when more than 12 lengths off the pace at the quarter pole. He trotted his back-half in 56.3 with a final panel in 27.3 and can benefit from getting that real race experience under his belt. This other son of Muscle Mass will work from another favorable spot on the gate with post-three and will likely be making noise when it matters most. He can pick up a slice.

He was victorious two starts ago at Georgian Downs at just 10 cents to the dollar and has hit the board in five straight since getting claimed by trainer Rene Bourassa. This son of Sunshine Beach has been in good order as of late and was Jody Jamieson's choice over our third selection. He can be right there at the finish.

#8 BRING YOUR FIRE exits the same race as the one above and was sent to the early lead from post-eight in that dash before getting covered up by a short-priced winner in Heresthatmanagain. He rode along in the two-hole the rest of the way and got within three quarters of a length of that rival when he rounded out the exacta at 26-1. This son of Bettors Delight is just three for 63 in his career but has hit the board 17 times over that span and overcame this same tricky starting spot in his latest. He will have Trevor Henry back between the wheels and figures to get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 WISK KEY K faced an uphill battle last week when he got away ninth off the gate from post-nine in this class and was more than 14 lengths off the lead at the opening marker. He improved to sixth before the wire when he stepped his back-half in 56 seconds flat and his final quarter in 28.1. He will likely be in search of the lead in the early stages again tonight and has our call to repeat in the finale. Tyler Borth picks up the steer.

#2 JJ XAVIER got away fourth off the gate from the trailing post in NW3000L3 at Grand River Raceway on July 15th and made a move to the outside in the middle stages but ended up getting beaten by a wide margin in last. He had not raced in more than three weeks going into that effort and will now transition to the claiming ranks when getting back on the big track. This 13-time winner carried the optional tag of \$30,000 in the last three times he was offered for a price and should much prefer the company he keeps when racing for \$14,000 this time around. He was Louis-Philippe Roy's choice over the one above and can be more than competitive against this group.

#1 MACH IMPACT was the runner-up to Mr Beast last week in this class, albeit he was seven lengths in arrears to that foe at the wire. He paced his own mile in 1:52.3 and has now hit the board in two of his last three. This 42-time winner has hit the board in 106 of his 201 lifetime tries and is just over \$12,000 away from \$400,000 in earnings. He might be able to work out a favorable journey from the pole position and can hit the ticket.

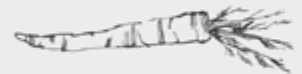
#8 LETS GET ROCKED has changed hands after each of his last two and will now race off the claim for trainer Cameron McQueen after he grabbed him out of his most recent effort for \$16,000. He made a break in stride in the stretch of that dash and was only able to beat one rival when securing a minor award in fifth. CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

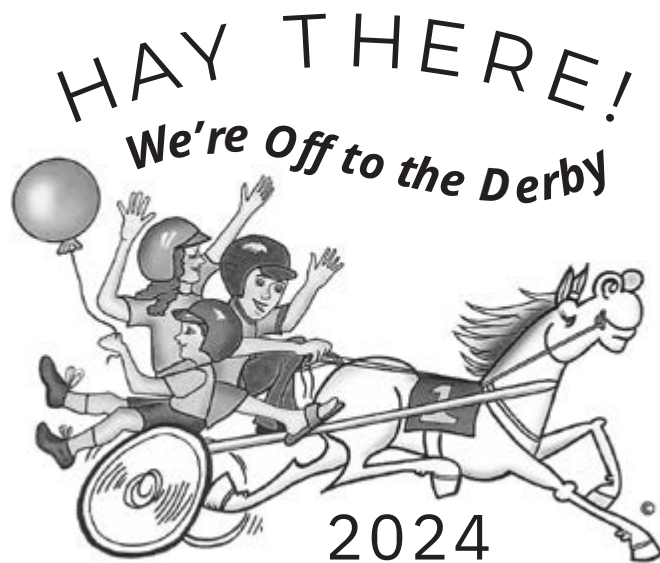
ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
