Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

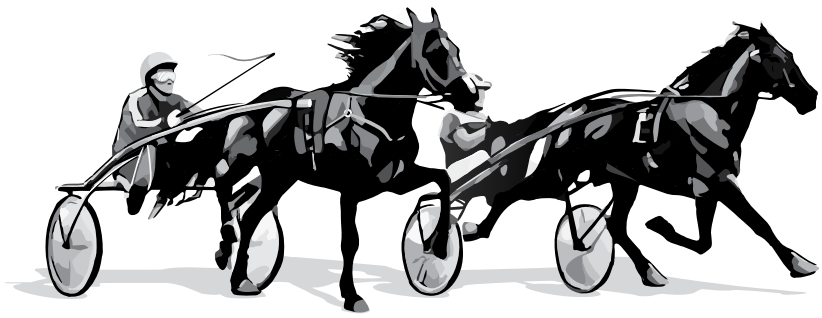
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#4 ODDS ON CARMEL made every call a winning one on November 30th at Flamboro Downs and was under wraps to the wire when he stopped the clock in 1:56.3. He returned 14-1 to his backers when dropping down for the price of \$8,000 after being third at 5/2 to Jj Landon in NW555L3 10 nights earlier on that half-mile oval, albeit he was 16 lengths in arrears to that rival at the finish. This 15-time winner will be making his fourth start back in the barn of trainer Gerard Demers and will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy, who piloted him to a pair of victories in 2022. He should be confident coming into this and has our nod to take down the opener.

#6 SPEEDY BLINDERS has been competing in the condition claiming ranks while carrying a claiming tag of \$20,000 in each of his last eight and had to leave from the eight-hole or worse in all of his last four. He was only able to muster a minor award over that span and that came when he was placed up to fifth from sixth through disqualification on November 8th. This son of Betterthancheddar will be discounted by \$12,000 to compete in this Pop-Up Series and gets James MacDonald back between the wheels. He will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and can wake up to a better result.

#8 BLAKESAGENT rebounded his way to a dominant victory at Flamboro Downs on November 21st and scored by a healthy margin on the lead as the definitive second choice in the betting. He tripped the timer in 1:57.2 and got a tough trip in the first-over position the week prior. This 17-time winner has enough early foot to overcome the outermost post in the contest and will have Jimmy Gagnon at the helm. He can land somewhere on the ticket.

#5 ALADDIN DU LAC was the runner-up to Sir Lucknow at The Raceway in London last week but was more than seven lengths behind that rival at the wire after taking support to the tune of 5/2. He was beaten by a wide margin at this venue before that but was placed up to the show spot on November 8th when completed the trifecta at odds of 94-1. This son of Sunshine Beach will start from the center of the gate and might utilize his tactical speed to get forward placed off the switch. He will have Trevor Henry at the reins for the second time and can pick up a piece.

#3 QUAN BLUE CHIP had to settle for a lesser share last week in condition claiming handicap affair and had open road in the lane on the outside before being within a length of a pair of rivals that could not be separated at the finish. He finished last by a wide margin in NW2500L4 in his return to the circuit more than two weeks prior and has not finished in the top-two in any of his 15 tries this season. This 29-time winner will be making his third start back under the care of conditioner Shayne Barrington and will be racing on lasix for the second time. He is in his fourth stint for this outfit and has hit the board in six of his 10 attempts for them overall.

#2 COOLSUNSHINE got up for the victory by a head last week at Flamboro Downs and sparked an upset at 12-1 when he stopped the clock in 1:57.2. He was sent to the early lead from post-eight in that contest and was relegated to third before the midway marker but went back on the attack in the first-over position on the backside for the last time. This 10-time winner grinded down the 1/5 favorite Fear The Shadow and they were more than 10 lengths clear of Time Stands Still in third. He can keep trending in the right direction in his fourth start under the care of conditioner Francis Guillemette and looms as a danger.

#8 NIGHT CLUB HANOVER faded back to last after getting an overland journey at Western Fair in his latest and was beaten by 30 lengths to Hollys Treasure in that NW1500L3 event. He went a long way on the engine as the 7/5 favorite two starts ago in that class but gave way to Lime In Da Coconut N. This 23-time winner is just one for 24 in his career but has hit the board eight times over that span. He has more than enough early foot to cross over in front of his rivals from the outermost post in the contest but was passed over by Jody Jamieson in favor of the one below. Phil Hudon picks up the steer.

#7 SHADOW WARRIOR has been the runner-up in each of his last two at Flamboro Downs and rounded out the exacta at 12-1 or higher in those efforts. He has picked up a prize in 12 of his last 15 overall and will now return to the big track for the first time since May of last year. This 22-time winner has hit the board in 10 of his 27 attempts in 2024 and will have Jody Jamieson calling the shots for the first time. He has been in good order for trainer Bruno Lacroce and should not be left out of the exotics.

#6 GOLDEN LEADER has spent each of her last four in the open claiming ranks while racing for the same price tag that she is in for this evening and has finished third in three of those efforts. She most recently completed the trifecta at 17-1 in a race that was topped by Del Diggity and was more than five lengths in arrears to that rival when she paced her own mile in 1:54.2. This 22-time winner has held her own against tougher foes in her outings since coming back from a layoff of nearly three months but is just one for 24 this season. She has 10 top-three finishes over that span and can get back to victory lane against this group.

#5 HILLBILLY JET claimed the show spot on Sunday night at Flamboro Downs and knifed through between horses in the dying strides to nearly get within a length of Silly But Serious at the finish. She has only missed one cheque in her last 19 overall and has racked-up a trio of victories in her last 10 since moving to the barn of trainer Jim Jarvis. This 40-time winner has hit the board in 20 of her 37 attempts this season and will likely make her presence felt at some point in the mile. She will have Jody Jamieson at the helm for the second time in her career and looks threatening.

#8 CODYS MOMENT has been seventh or worse in her last two when racing for a \$20,000 price tag in a condition claimer and disappointed as the 9/5 favorite on November 14th. She was only beaten by three quarters of a length in third before that in a softer version of that class and will now be discounted by \$12,000. This daughter of Control The Moment has hit the board in 10 of her 26 tries this season and will have Louis-Philippe Roy in the sulky for the first time. She has enough early foot to give herself options off the gate and is not without a chance.

#2 A DISRUPTOR faded back to last when stepping up to an open \$8,000 claimer in her most recent effort at Flamboro Downs and was beaten by more than five lengths to Fire Shine. She made a triumphant return off the shelf before that on November 21st and had not raced in more than three months going into that victory. This daughter of Sunshine Beach will be reunited with her part-owner Anthony Haughan in the bike and can be in the mix throughout. She can grab a share.

#2 DAPPER FELLA did not have much of a chance in his latest when he was taken back to last off the gate from post-seven at Flamboro Downs and was only able to improve to seventh before the wire after taking support to the tune of 5-1. He took on a tougher group when priced for \$9,500 on November 18th at The Raceway in London and was third here at Mohawk Park prior to that when carrying the same tag he will race for in this Pop-Up Event. This 11-time winner has hit the board in seven of his 12 attempts for trainer Gerard Demers and has been second or better the previous two times he was paired with top teamster James MacDonald. He will start from an inside draw and gets top billing.

#1 HES SURE GOOD had not raced in more than a month when he went postward from the second-tier in NW1865L3 at Flamboro Downs on November 27th and ended up finishing last by a wide margin at more than 28-1. He had hit the board in two of his previous three at Truro Raceway in Nova Scotia before that and will now be making his second start out of the barn of trainer Dustin Jones. This son of Hes Watching tries his luck in a trial for the Gold Cup & Saucer in Charlottetown in August and has four victories over this surface in the past. He will be making his second attempt back on the lasix program and lit the lamp in NW2 at this venue on that medication in October of 2023.

#3 OFFICER JONES has spent his last two in an \$8,000 open claimer and picked up a smaller share in his latest when he was fourth at 19-1. He crushed his competition in a softer spot on November 14th and scored by more than four lengths when he tripped the beam in 1:58.4. This 40-time winner is just three for 43 this season but has hit the board 14 times over that span. He will have Louis-Philippe Roy at the controls for the fourth time and fits in nicely in this series.

#7 ICENEEDSWHISKEY jumped it off behind the gate last week at Flamboro Downs and spotted his rivals several lengths before getting away eighth off the switch. He advanced a couple of spots before fading back to eighth at 15-1 and delivered as the odds-on favorite two starts ago on that half-mile oval when he beat an easier group by open lengths in 1:57.4. This 18-time winner has gotten his picture taken in two of his last six since moving to the care of conditioner Mitch Tierney and will have Brett MacDonald at the helm for the first time. He is worth including on the bottom end of the exotics.

He has not been worse than fourth in his three career attempts and trotted home in 28.4 or faster in each of his previous two when racing from further off the pace. This son Green Manalishi S has stepped his own mile in 1:58.4 or quicker in each of those efforts and figures to be making noise when it matters most again this evening. He has been knocking at the door and we will give him another chance.

#5 LA COEUR CHAPEAU was third in her latest when competing for the lowest price tag of \$8,500 in claiming handicap event at Rideau Carleton and was overland for much of that mile before almost getting within a length of winning favorite Ronda Du Lac. She has hit the board in two of her last three and has earned a cheque in five of her last eight at that five-eighths of a mile venue since moving to the barn of trainer Gavin Christie. This daughter of American Ideal will start from the center of the gate and gets Jody Jamieson at the reins for the first time in her career. She should offer some value on the board and is worth a whirl on top.

#3 GOLDIES ROCKIN has been fourth or better in each of her last two since returning to this circuit from Rideau Carleton but faded back to fourth after sitting a perfect two-hole in trip in her latest when facing a tougher group. She is making her third attempt under the care of conditioner Shayne Barrington and has lit the lamp in seven of her 30 tries this season. This 20-time winner has hit the board in 42 of her 98 lifetime tries and should much prefer the company she keeps in this Pop-Up Series. She looms as a logical danger and can be right there at the wire.

#1 COOL CUTE COOKIE was within a length of the one above on November 21st she completed the superfecta in fourth at 24-1. She has earned a cheque in 12 of her last 14 overall and will be making her third start back on the lasix program in tonight's tilt. This 11-time winner gets Louis-Philippe Roy in the bike for the first time in her career and will likely be pushing out for early position with rail control. She can make her presence felt throughout and is among the top contenders.

#4 SHAKEITIFYOUGOTIT is scheduled to come on just one day of rest and we do not know how she fared at The Raceway in London on Tuesday night at the time of writing this. She will likely take significant support from post-three in that winners-over \$8,000 claimer but could not deliver at 25 cents to the dollar after sitting a loose pocket at Flamboro Downs more than two weeks earlier. This 28-time winner is just four for 31 in 2024 after getting her picture taken in 10 of 34 last season but can be more than competitive in this spot. Her updated racing line might be the best way to gauge her chances but she has enough speed to be in the mix throughout.

#10 ZEBBS BREAKING DAWN was scratched out of a Pop-Up Series Final due to sickness on August 22nd after she paced away from her rivals to score by nearly a pair of lengths in the second round of that added-money event at odds of 9/2. She had hit the board in six of her last nine before going on the shelf and now resurfaces on the lasix program in what will be her first start out of the barn of trainer Shawn Steacy. This daughter of Hes Watching paced home in 28.3 off a back-half in 57.4 in a qualifier on November 29th but must overcome the dreaded 10-hole when transitioning to the condition claiming ranks. She will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald and they have four top-two finishes from five starts together .

#7 ULTRA has won two in a row and most recently delivered as the even-money favorite when she got up by a head over the one below in the final steps. She returned a juicy 4-1 to her backers one week earlier and has picked up a prize in each of her last 10 overall. This 11-time winner has hit the board seven times over that span and has been getting along splendidly with driver Phil Hudon. She should be brimming with confidence and will likely not go down without a fight.

#5 RED DIRT FLASH has been the runner-up in six of her last seven and has not missed a cheque in any of her last 12 overall. She got nailed in the dying strides by the one above in her latest but loses J-Mac to our top selection. This daughter of Malicious picks up the driving services of Anthony Haughan and gets to slide in a few spots on the gate to post-five. She is just five for 60 in the win-column in her career but has 25 on the board finishes over that span.

#6 FANCY LETTERING only mustered one minor award in her last four after she dropped down to NW2 and was offered for the optional price of \$40,000 in her most recent spin around this oval. She had that tag cut in half for tonight's tilt and might respond well to competing in a condition claimer for the first time. This daughter of Stag Party paced to her lifetime mark of 1:51.2 on September 27th when she captured the OSS Grassroots Consolation but will have to bounce back in this spot in order to return to victory lane. She will have the advantage of starting from post-six and will likely announce her presence off the switch.

#5 DELIGHTFUL MAGIC claimed the show spot at Flamboro Downs last Saturday night and was three lengths behind Odds On Carmel after getting away sixth off the gate. He was more than 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole before rolling three-wide on the spin for home and was only able to pick up lesser shares in two of his previous four before that. This 15-time winner is just five starts removed from running up the score on his foes in an open \$8,000 claimer at this venue on Halloween and stopped the clock in 1:53.3 on that occasion. He picks up Phil Hudon in the sulky and can bounce back in a big way in this spot.

#4 MUSIC TO MY GEARS was the runner-up to Night Terror when racing for the same price tag at Western Fair on November 25th and could not deliver as the even-money favorite in that dash. He got on the vet's list when he finished fourth at Flamboro Downs two back and now returns to the big track for the first time since he was ninth in a much tougher spot at this venue on October 28th. This 20-time winner is eight for 40 this season with 17 on the board finishes and got the nod from J-Mac over the one above. He figures to be moving forward off the gate from post-four and can be in the mix throughout.

#8 HES GOT SWAGGER exits the same race as our top pick and was never a factor in that contest despite being sent off as the 1/5 odds-on favorite. He was never able to get into contention after getting away seventh off the switch but did manage to earn minor awards in each of his previous two here at Mohawk Park after getting claimed for \$8,000 by trainer Gerard Demers on November 7th. This 54-time winner gets Louis-Philippe Roy back between the wheels and will likely try to get activated sooner in the mile this time out. He has rebound potential and will surely offer an opportunity to take back value for those that supported him in his latest.

#3 G A SPEED SAMMY has hit the board in two of his last four at Flamboro Downs but has been sixth or worse in six of his last eight overall. He will have his price tag slashed by \$1,000 to compete in this Pop-Up Series and will work from a favorable position on the gate. This 29-time winner picks up the driving services of Tyler Borth for the third time in his career and does not look out of place against this group. He might be able to help add some value to the exotics.

#2 PINK MONSTER produced a big effort to deliver as the 6/5 favorite on November 22nd at Western Fair and was first-over for a long way in that dash before forging clear of her rivals in the lane. She got an adventurous journey two starts ago when making her first start back under the care of conditioner David Bain and has hit the board in four of her 10 tries for this outfit. This daughter of Shadow Play will be getting on the big track for the first time since early February and should be feeling good about herself. She will have Tyler Borth calling the shots for the first time and should put us on the right side of value.

#4 STAY TRUE has been fourth or better in eight of her last 10 and is just one start removed from claiming the show spot in three consecutive efforts at Flamboro Downs. She has hit the board in seven of her 18 tries as a four-year-old and will now make her first start out of the barn of trainer Jacob Roberts. This daughter of Stay Hungry will be making her debut on the larger track configuration of Mohawk Park and has done her best work when she gets forwardly placed. She picks up Billy Davis Jr in the bike and is worth a look if the price is high enough.

#1 ACEFORTYFOUR DAISY has been taking on tougher foes in the open claiming handicap ranks at this venue in eight of her last nine and managed to hit the board twice over that span. She has only been able to muster a minor award in two of her last five but should much prefer the company she keeps this evening. This daughter of Dali will move in another couple of spots on the gate to the pole position and will likely try to be closer to the action this time around. She figures to take support on the odds board and can pick up a sizable slice.

#5 SOMETHING ROYAL was beaten by a wide margin in each of her last two when finishing fifth or worse on the B-tracks but hit the board in three straight before that. She is 10 for 40 in 2024 with 19 top-three finishes and will be reunited with top teamster James MacDonald, who guided her to a victory in a preliminary leg of a Pop-Up Event in early February. This 33-time winner will work from the center of the gate and has more than enough tactical speed to give herself options off the switch. She cannot be left out of the exotics.

#1 VENDETTA BLUE CHIP has won two in a row at this level and offered 3-1 or better in each of those victories. She jumped it off at long odds in NW2 before that but was a pari-mutuel refund for not receiving a fair start and has only finished worse than second in two of her 10 career attempts. This daughter of Bettors Delight should be brimming with confidence and will start from the pole position for the fourth time in five starts. She got the nod from J-Mac over the one below and has our call to extend her streak to three in the finale.

#5 MY LAST KISS was the runner-up to the one above in each of her last two and only missed by a nose on November 21st when she rallied again in the late stages after chopping-out the first three fractions. She has hit the board in three straight and has not missed a cheque in any of her last five. This daughter of All Bets Off will once again start from the center of the gate and picks up the driving services of Tyler Borth for the first time. She looms as a danger but might have to settle for being the bridesmaid again.

#9 IDEAL ENTRY exits the same race as the two above and claimed the show spot in the dash at odds of 5-1. She was three lengths in arrears of the winner when she paced her own mile in 1:55.4 with a 29.3 kicker and will now be making her third start back after missing six weeks of action. This daughter of American Ideal shifts out two spots on the gate to post-nine but has shown enough early foot to get forwardly placed off the switch. She can be in the mix throughout and can once again hit the ticket.

#8 MILLIES SPIRIT is an intriguing option when making the transition to the condition claiming ranks from NW2 and was second-best to Oh A Legend at the level below that on November 22nd. She will be making her third try under the care of conditioner Meg Crone and is just five outings removed from back-to-back victories at Batavia Downs in New York. This daughter of McWicked will have Anthony Haughan at the reins but must overcome an outside draw. She can make her presence felt against this group and should not be ignored.

#4 SAULSBROOK ANNIE has been fourth or better in each of her last five and hit the board in four straight going into her latest. She held on by a neck three starts ago at this level and will once again have her part-owner Louis-Philippe Roy at the helm. This daughter of Hes Watching is nine for 25 in her career with 16 top-three finishes and will likely take some catching. She is a threat to take them gate-to-wire.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
